

# **Census 2011 Municipal report**

## **Free State**

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## Introduction

South Africa has had three censuses since the first general elections in 1994. The first census was conducted in 1996, the second one followed five years later (2001), whilst the recent census was conducted just over a year ago (2011). In this publication, data from the three censuses are compared.

The following points are brought to the attention of the reader of this publication:

- Comparisons of the results of labour market indicators in the post-apartheid population censuses over time have been a cause for concern. Improvements to key questions over the years mean that the labour market outcomes based on the post-apartheid censuses have to be analysed with caution. Such analysis will be the subject of research published in a separate publication in 2013. The differences in the results over the years may be partly attributable to improvements in the questionnaire since 1996, rather than to actual developments in the labour market. The numbers published in this volume for the 1996, 2001, and 2011 censuses are therefore not comparable over time and are higher from those published by Statistics South Africa in the surveys designed specifically for capturing official labour market results.
- For purposes of comparison over the period 1996–2011, certain categories of responses to questions in the censuses of 1996, 2001 and 2011, have either been merged or separated.
- The tenure status question for 1996 has been dropped since the question asked was totally unrelated to that asked thereafter. Comparisons for 2001 and 2011 do, however, remain.
- All household variables are controlled for housing units only and hence exclude all collective living arrangements as well as transient populations.
- The slight differences in totals for annual household income as compared to that published in the Statistical Release of Census 2011 are due to rounding.
- When making comparisons of any indicator, it must be taken into account that the time period between the first two censuses is five years, and that between the second and third censuses is ten years. Although census captures information at one given point in time, the period available for an indicator to change is different.

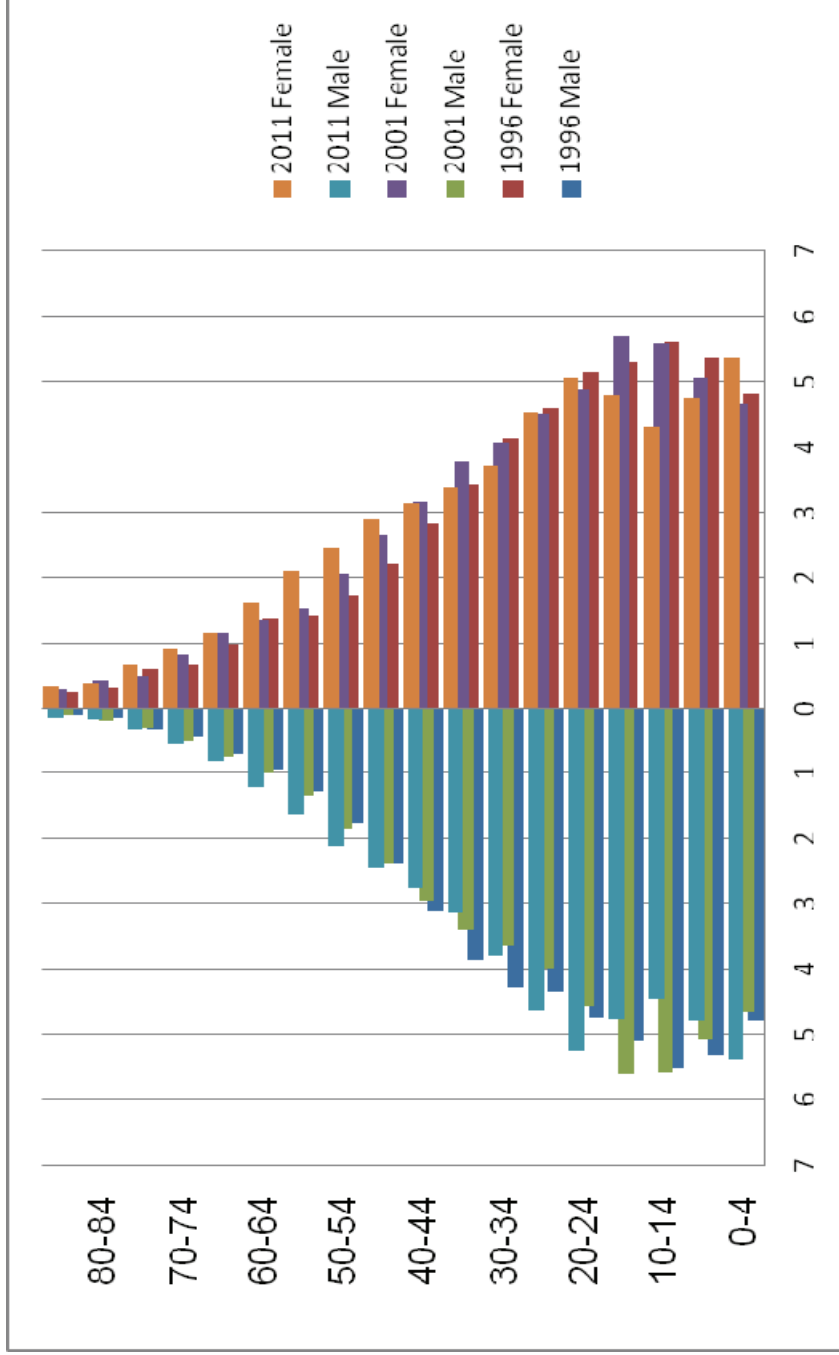
## 4. Free State

### 4.1 Demographics

#### 4.1.1 Age-sex structure of province

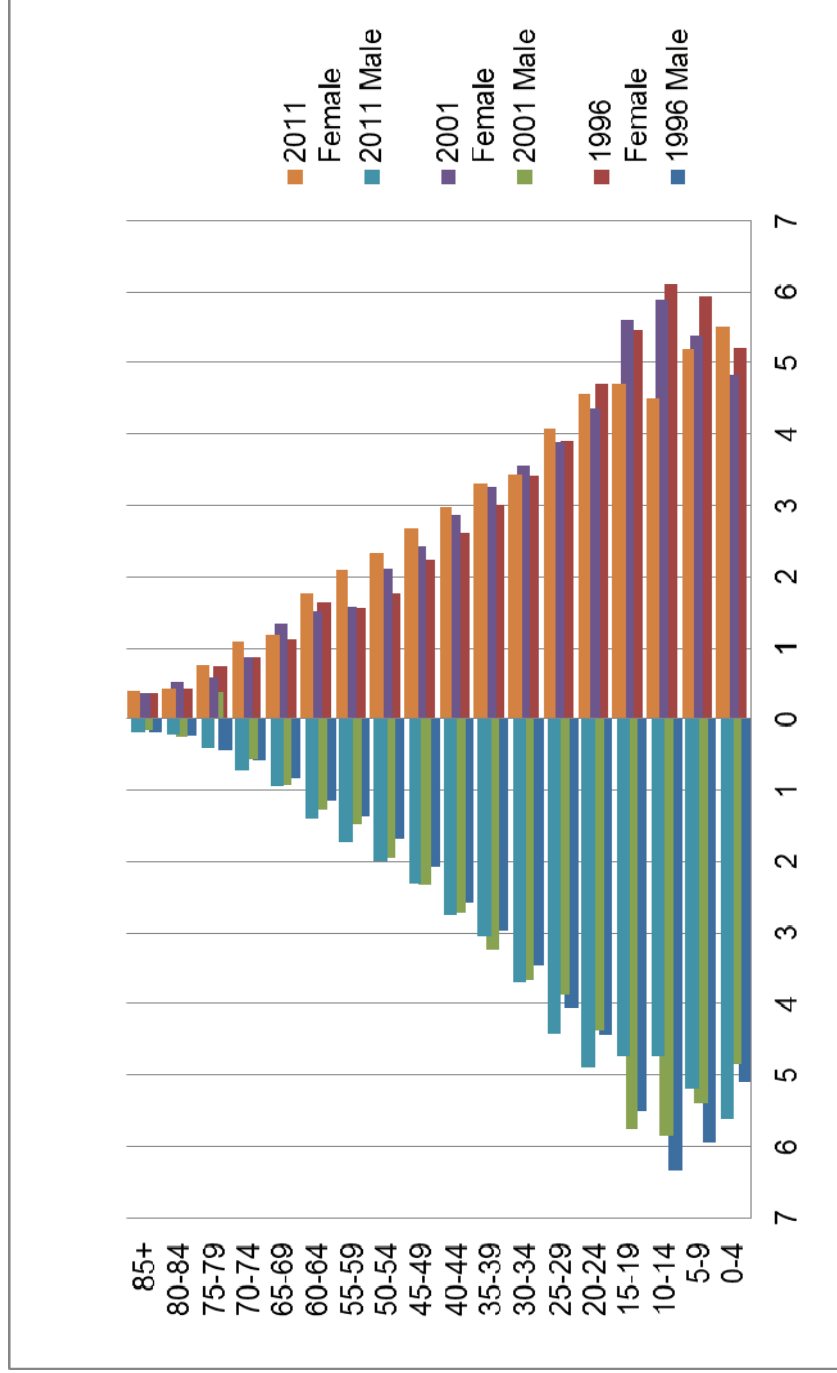
Figures 4.1.1.1 to 4.1.1.6 show population pyramids for Free State and its district municipalities. The pyramids indicate that the Free State population is still young.

**Figure 4.1.1.1: Distribution of the population by age and sex, Free State – 1996, 2001 and 2011**

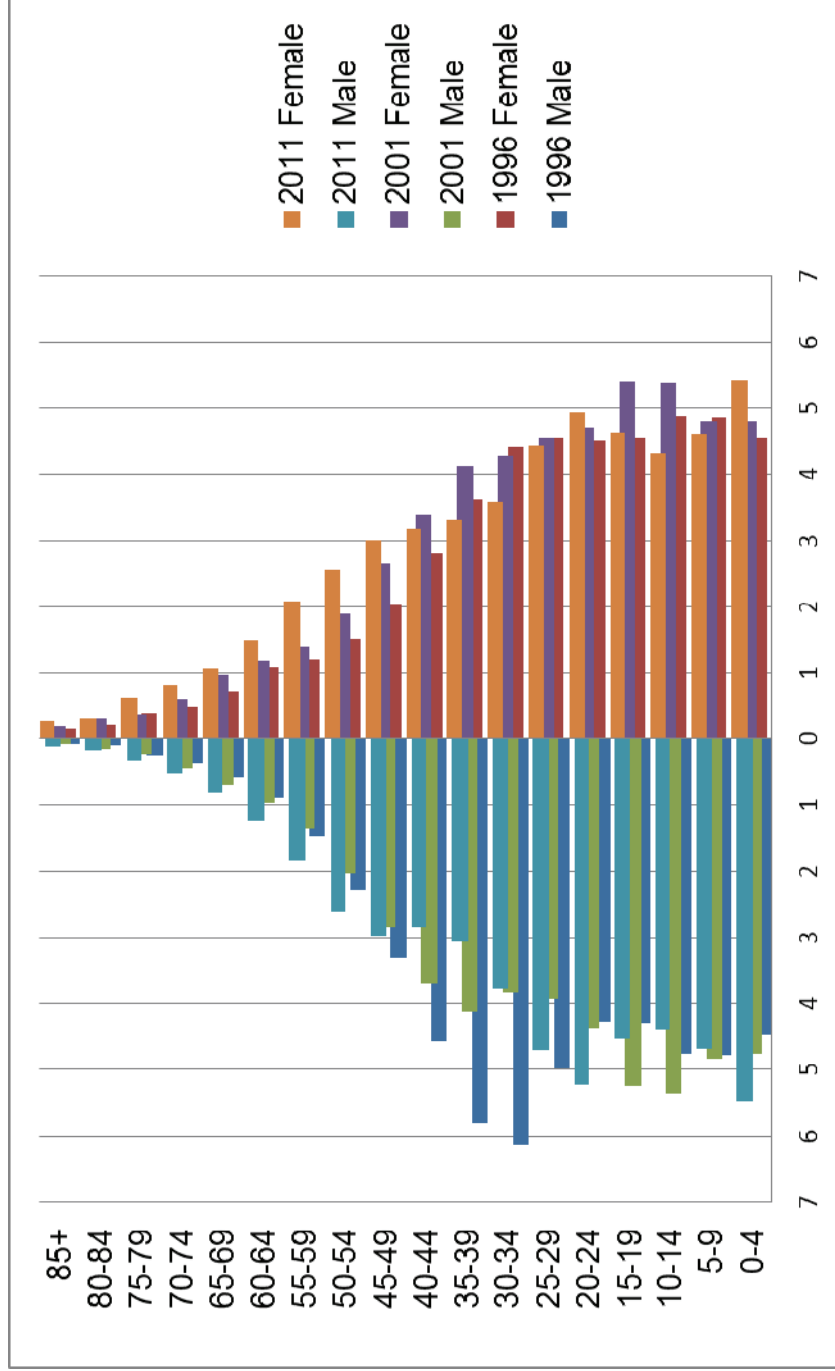




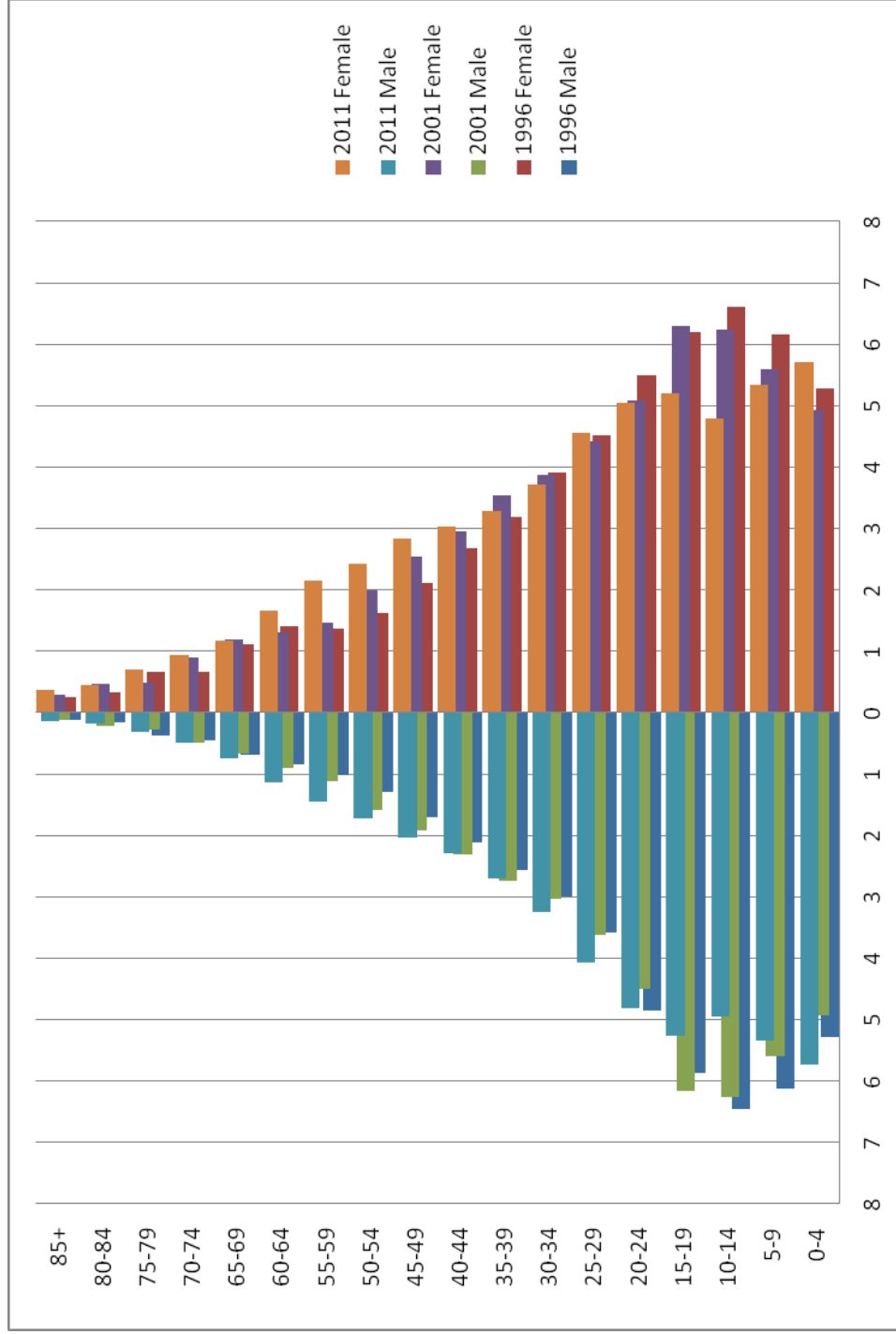
**Figure 4.1.1.2: Distribution of the population by age and sex, Xhariep – 1996, 2001 and 2011**



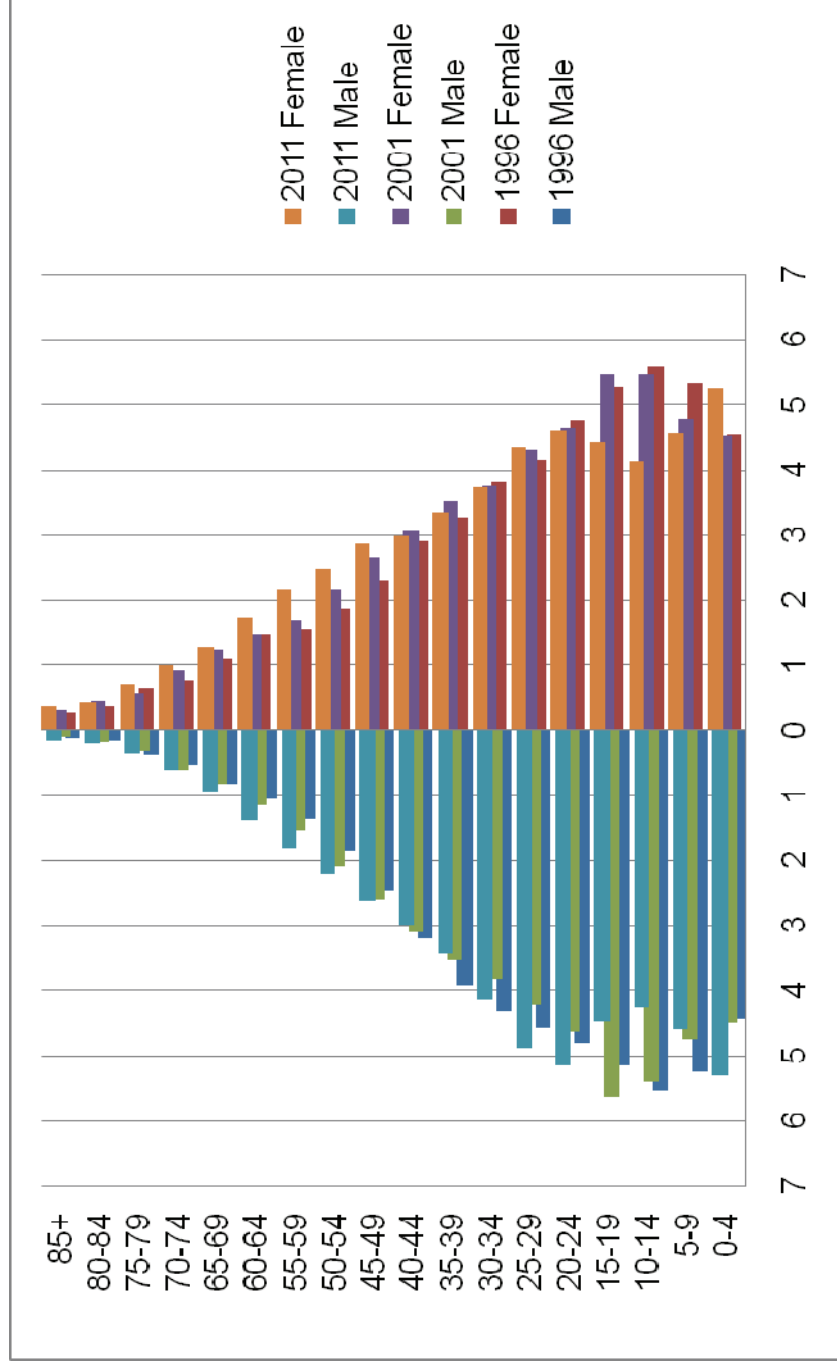
**Figure 4.1.1.3: Distribution of the population by age and sex, Lejweleputswa – 1996, 2001 and 2011**



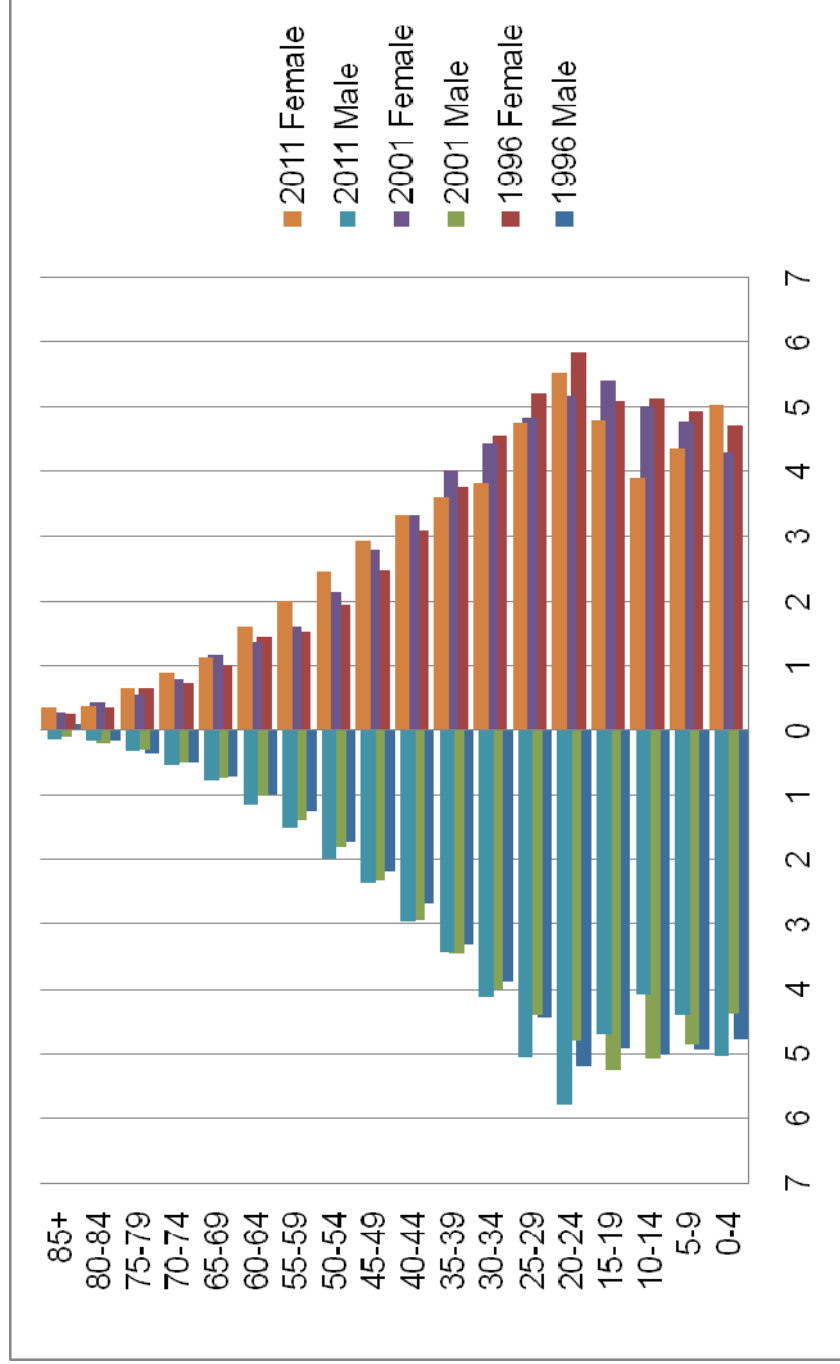
**Figure 4.1.1.4: Distribution of the population by age and sex, Thabo Mofutsanyane – 1996, 2001 and 2011**

### 4.1.2 Population growth rates

**Figure 4.1.2.1: Population growth rates by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011**

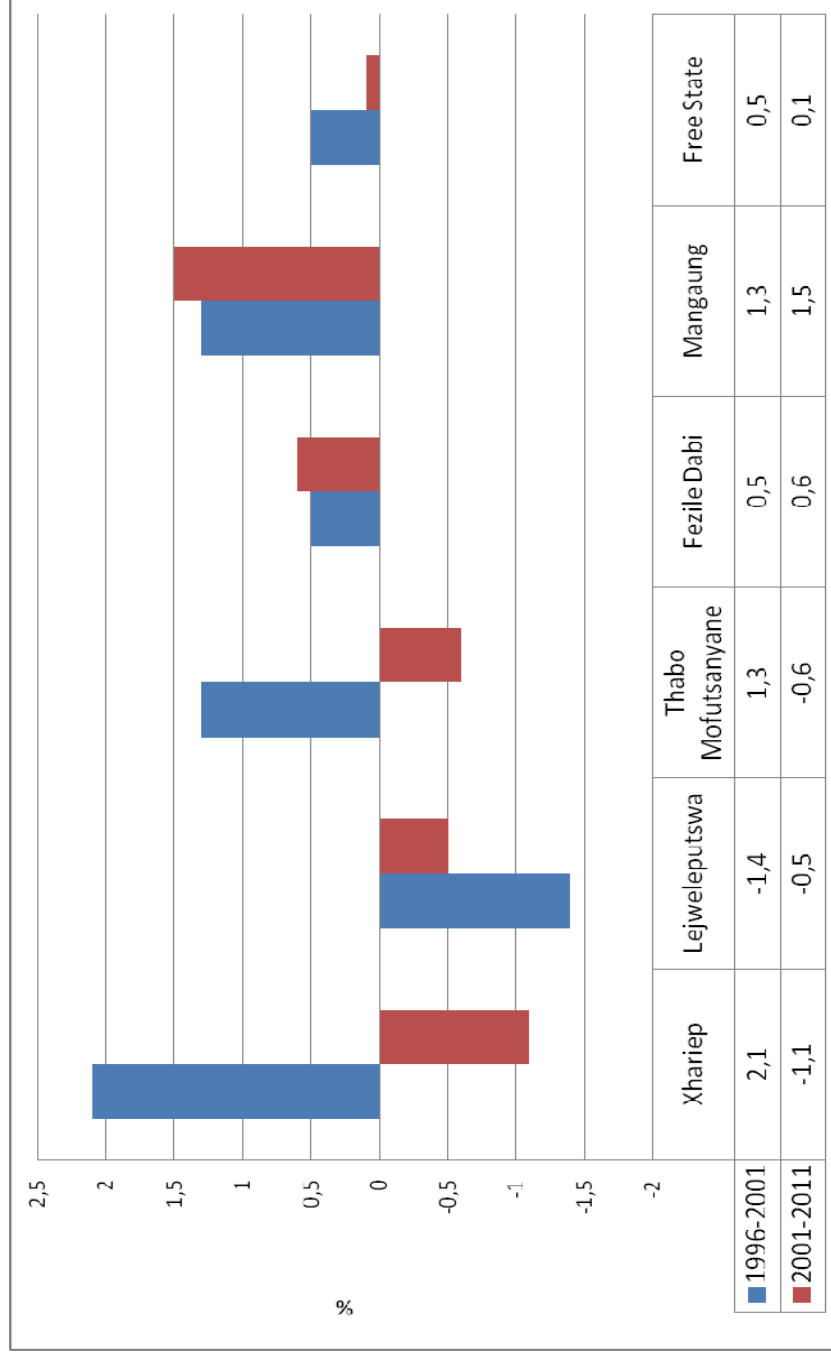


Figure 4.1.2.1 shows the population growth rate from 1996 to 2001 and 2001 to 2011 respectively. Results show that Free State grew by 0,5% in the period 1996–2001 and 0,1% in the period 2001–2011. Xhariep, Lejweleputswa and Thabo Mofutsanyane districts experienced a negative growth in the period 2001–2011.

### 4.1.3 Sex ratios

**Figure 4.1.3.1: Sex ratios by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011**

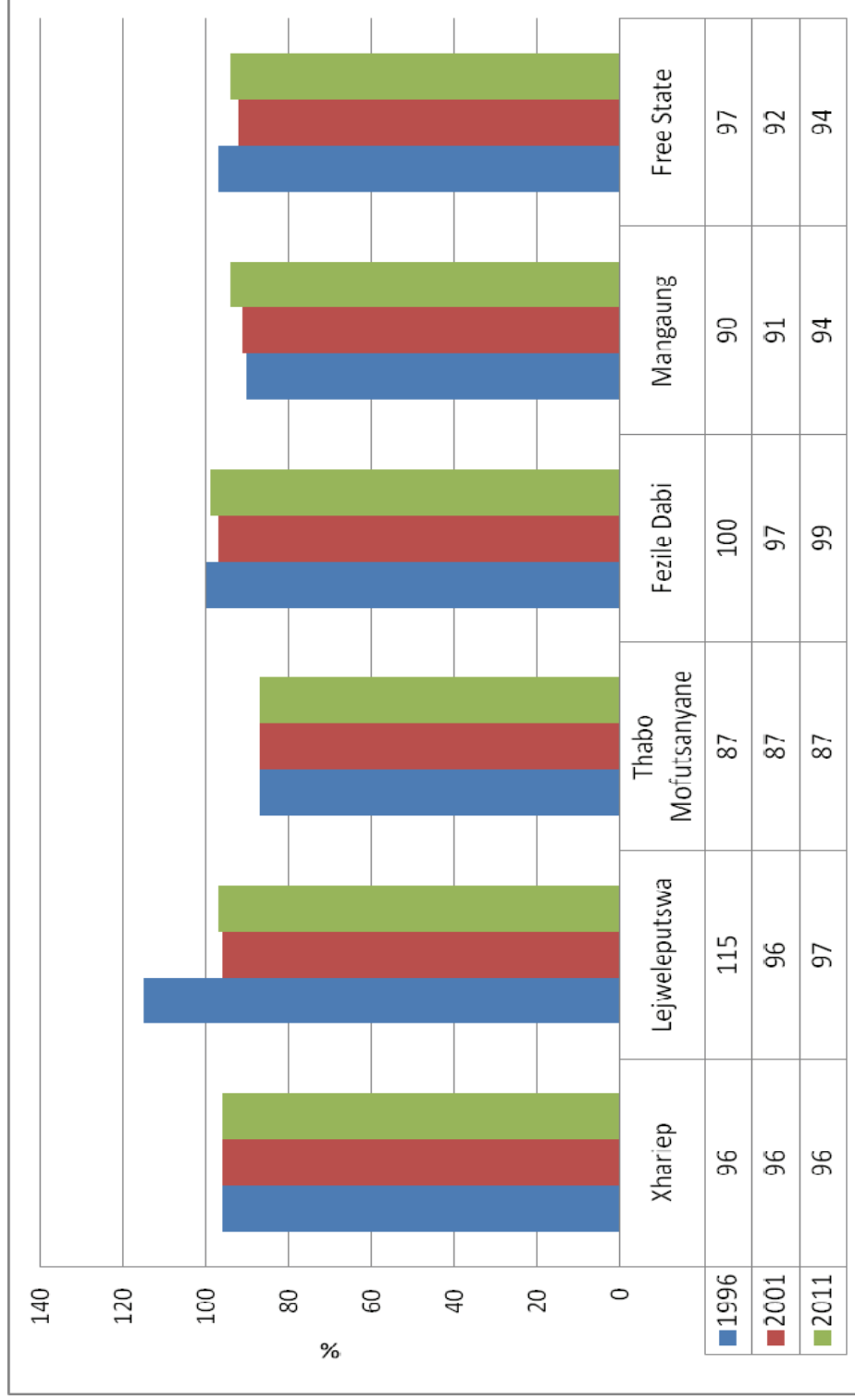


Figure 4.1.3.1 shows that there were more females than males across all districts except for Lejweleputswa district in 1996.

### 4.1.4 Population groups

**Figure 4.1.4.1: Distribution of the population by population group and district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011**

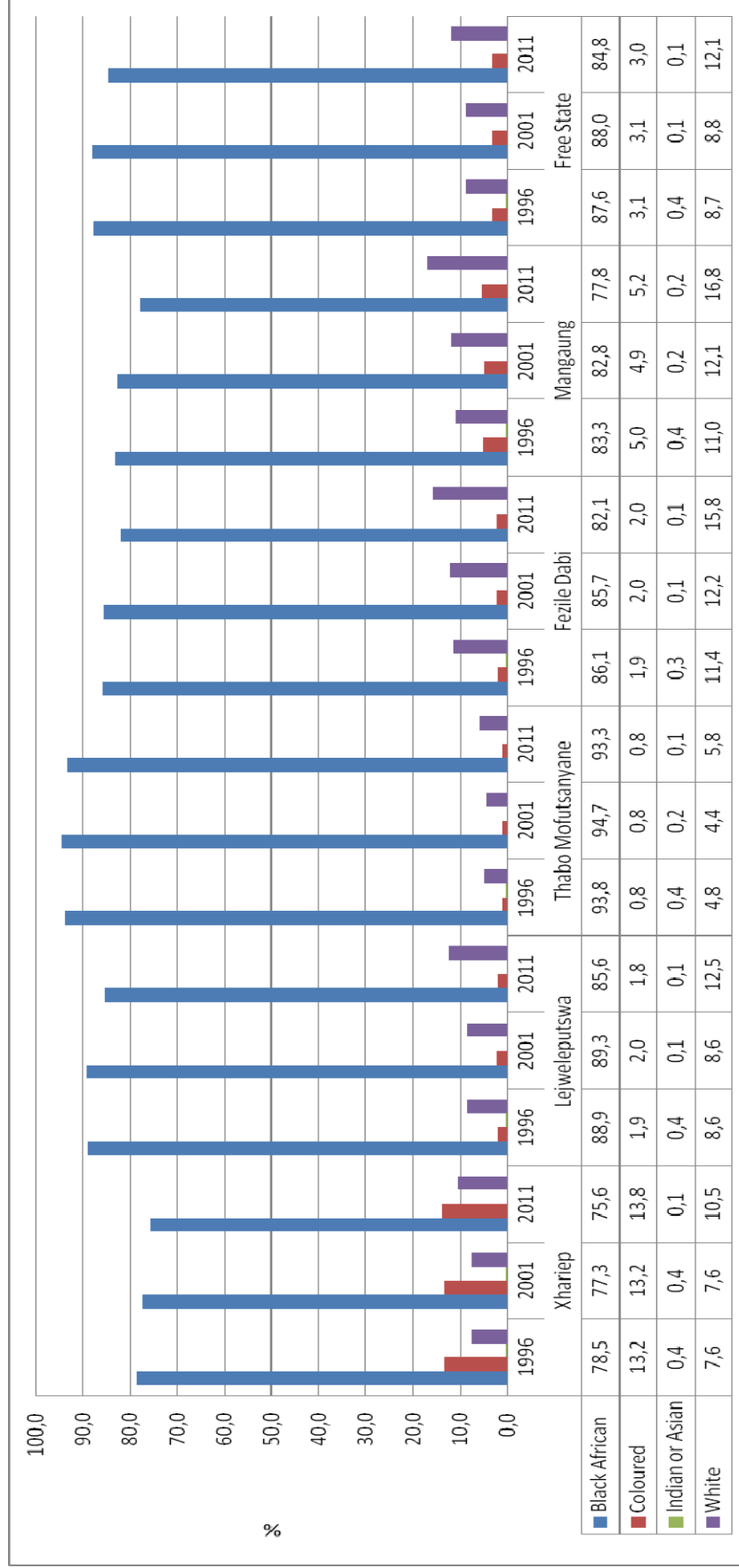


Figure 4.1.4.1 shows that the Black/African population group constitute the majority in the province (85%), followed by the White population group (12%). The Coloured and Indian/ Asian population groups constitute the minority in the province (3,0 % and 0,1% respectively).



### 4.1.5 Functional age groups

Figure 4.1.5.1: Distribution of the population by functional age groups and district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

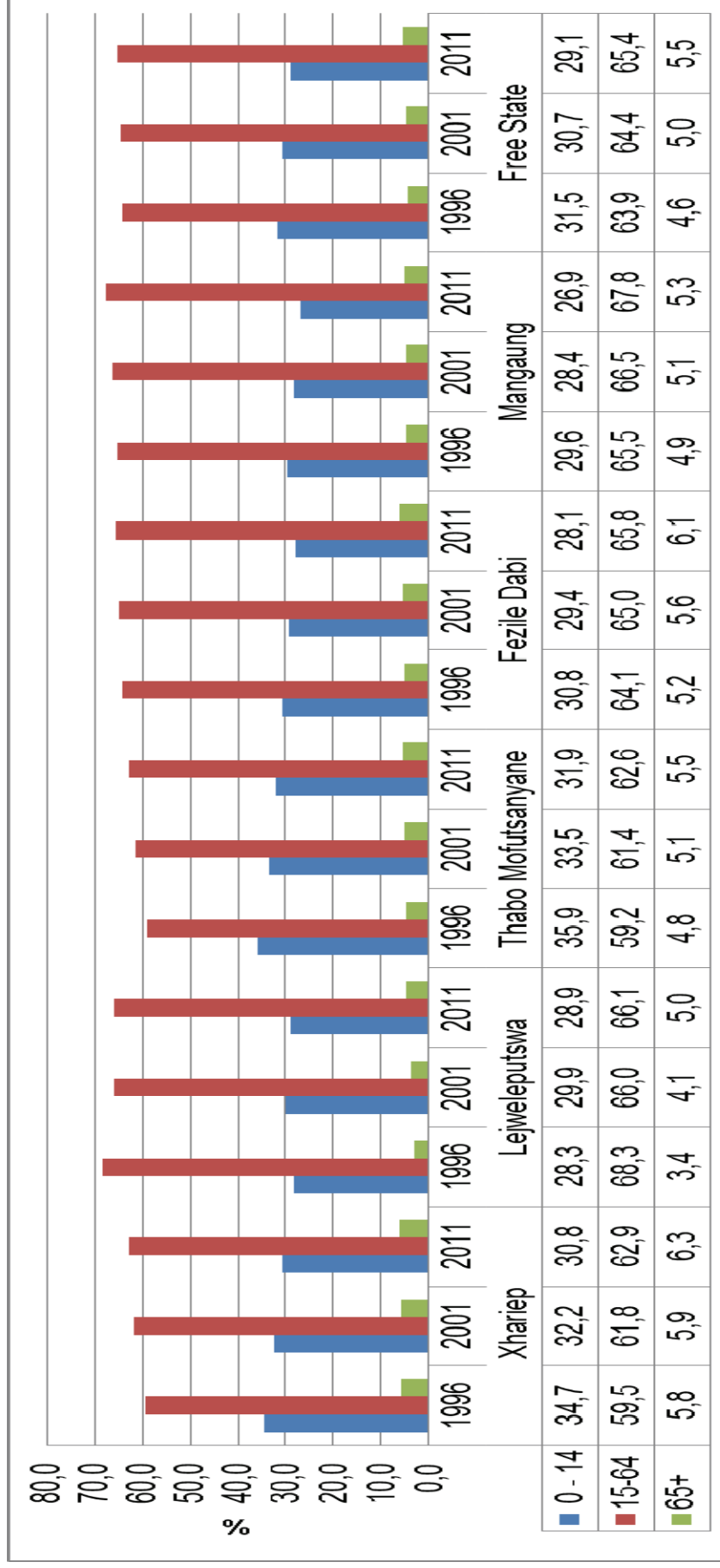


Figure 4.1.5.1 shows a general decline in the proportion of the population aged 0–14 and an increase in the proportion of the population aged 15–64 and 65+.

### 4.1.6 Dependency ratios

Dependency ratios provide insights into the burden borne by those who are in the working age group (15–64) to support those aged 0–14 and 65+ years.

**Figure 4.1.6.1: Dependency ratios by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011**

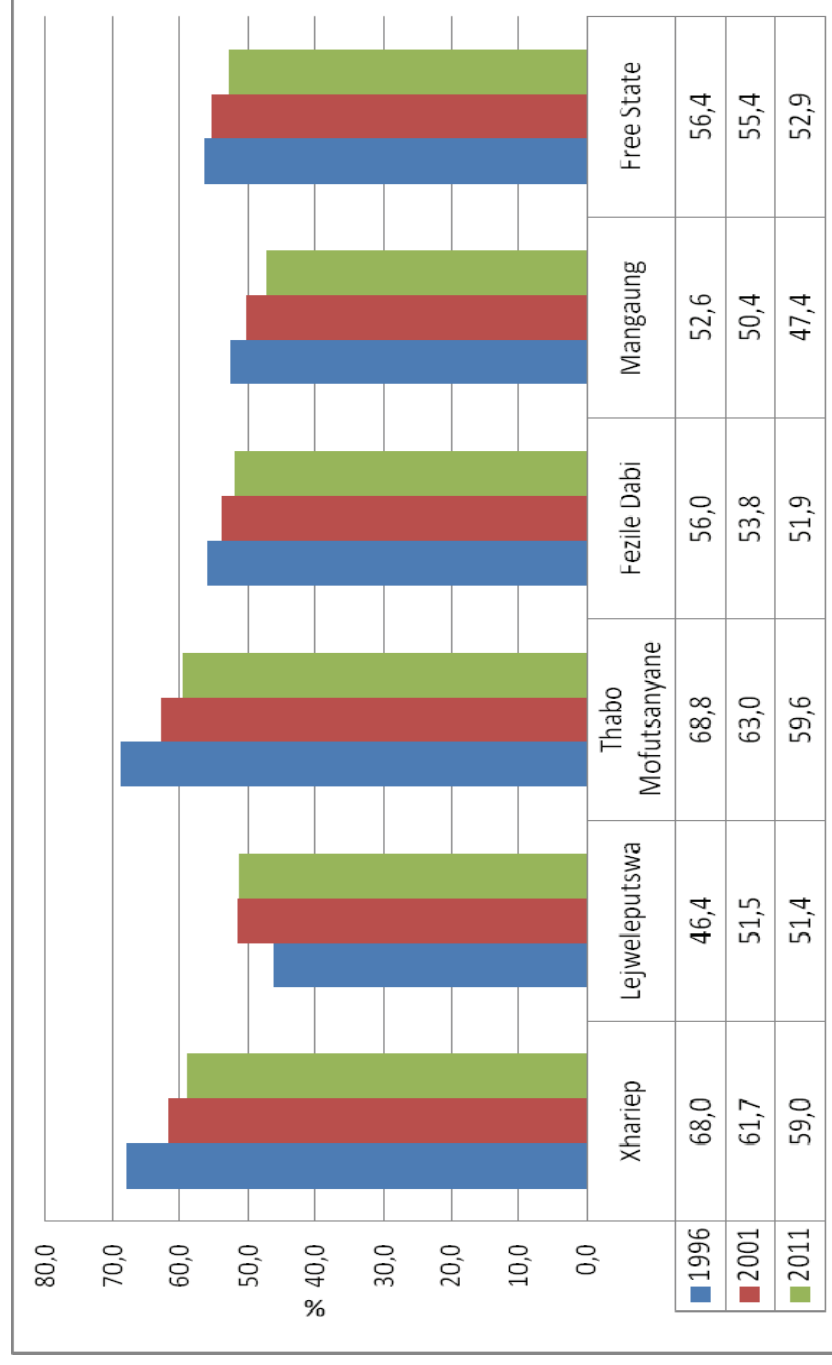


Figure 4.1.6.1 suggests that Xhariep and Thabo Mofutsanyane districts consistently have higher dependency ratios relative to the provincial average.

### 4.1.7 Marital status

Figure 4.1.7.1: Distribution of the population by marital status and district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

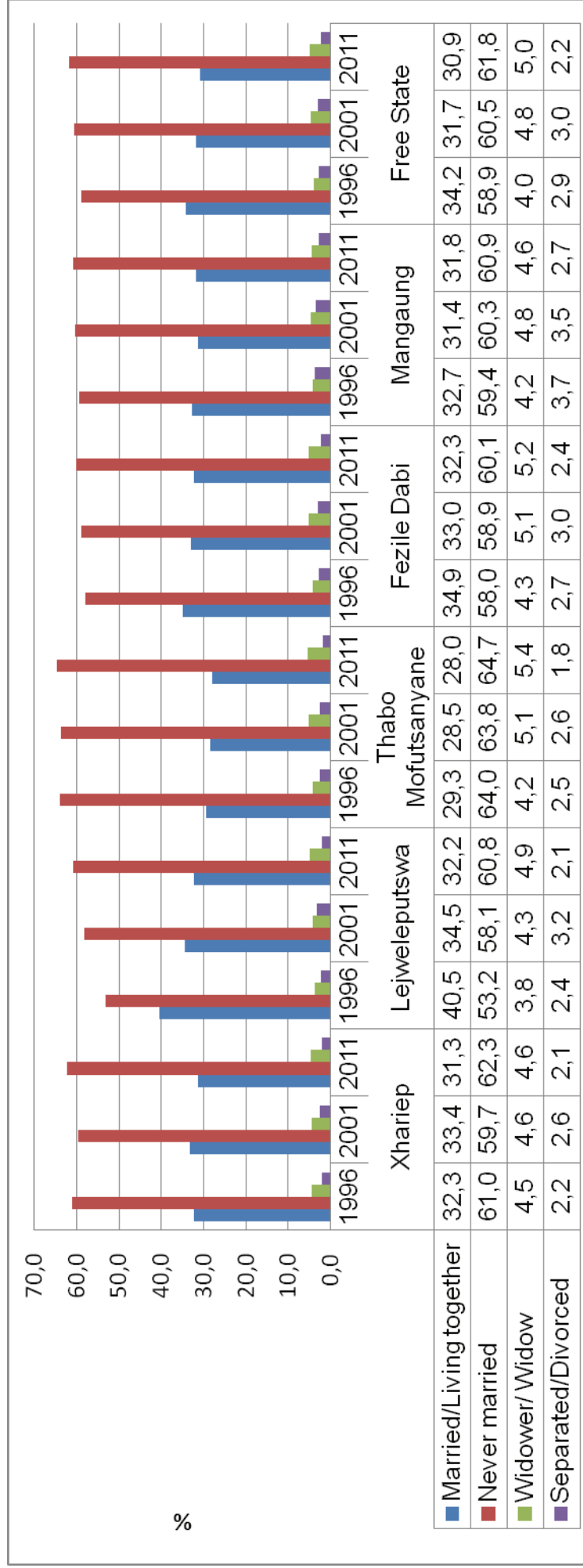


Figure 4.1.5.1 shows that there is a general increase in the proportion of the population that is never married and a decline in the proportion of the population married or living together.

## 4.2 Education

### 4.2.1 Highest level of education attained

**Figure 4.2.1.1: Distribution of the population aged 20 years and older by highest level of education attained and district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011**

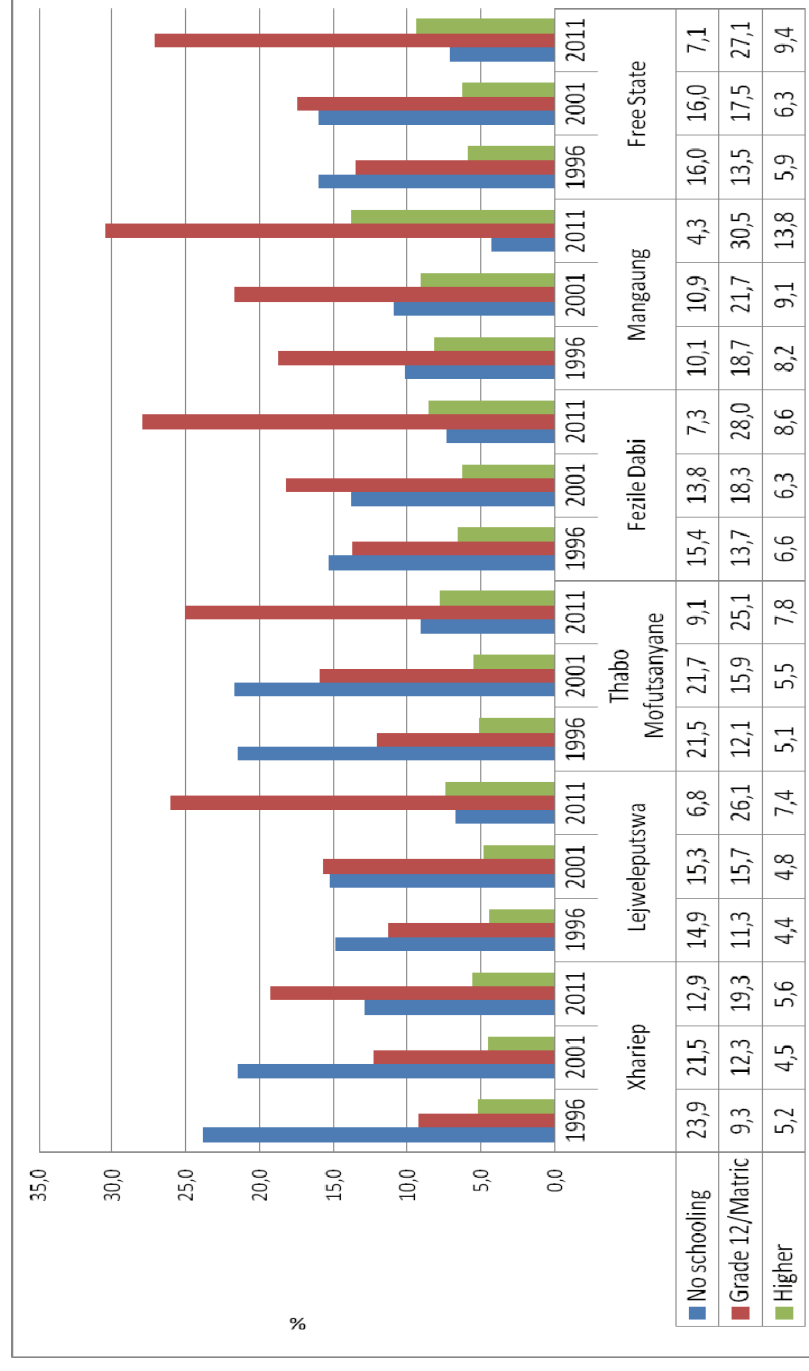


Figure 4.2.1.1 shows a general increase in the proportion of the population with higher education and who completed Grade 12/Matric. Mangaung district has the highest proportion of the population with higher education (13,8% compared to the 9,4% provincial average). Concomitantly; is the reduction in the population with no schooling.

### 4.2.2 School attendance

**Figure 4.2.2.1: Distribution of the population aged 5-24 years attending school by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011**

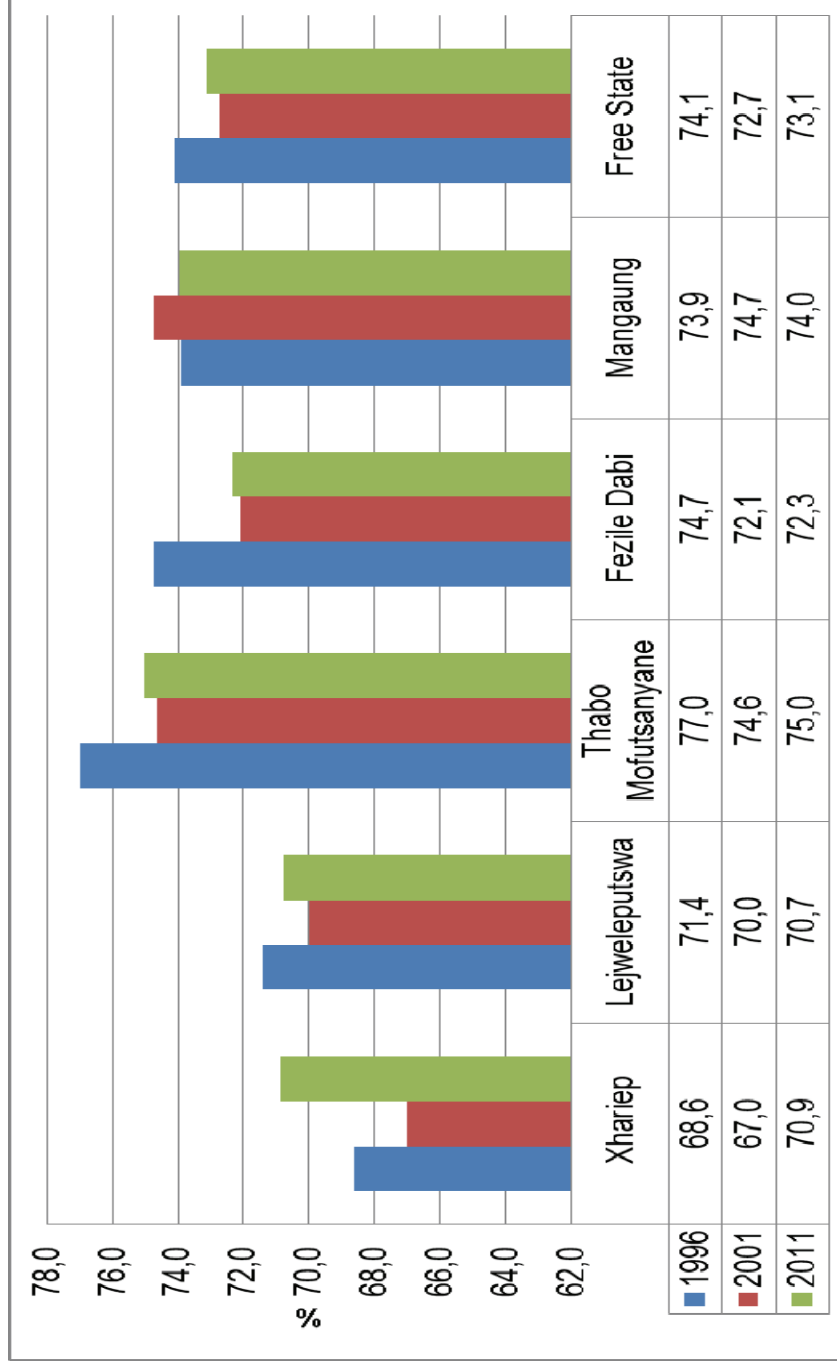


Figure 4.2.2.1 shows that the proportion of the population attending school is consistently higher and lower than the provincial average in Thabo Mofutsanyane and Xhariep districts respectively.

### 4.3 Labour market

#### 4.3.1 Unemployment rate

Trends in the unemployment rate as shown in Figure 4.3.1.1 suggest an increase between 1996 and 2001 and thereafter a decline across districts. **Readers are requested to heed the disclaimer in the introduction to this publication.**

## 4.4 Housing

### 4.4.1 Average household size

Figure 4.4.1.1: Average household size by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

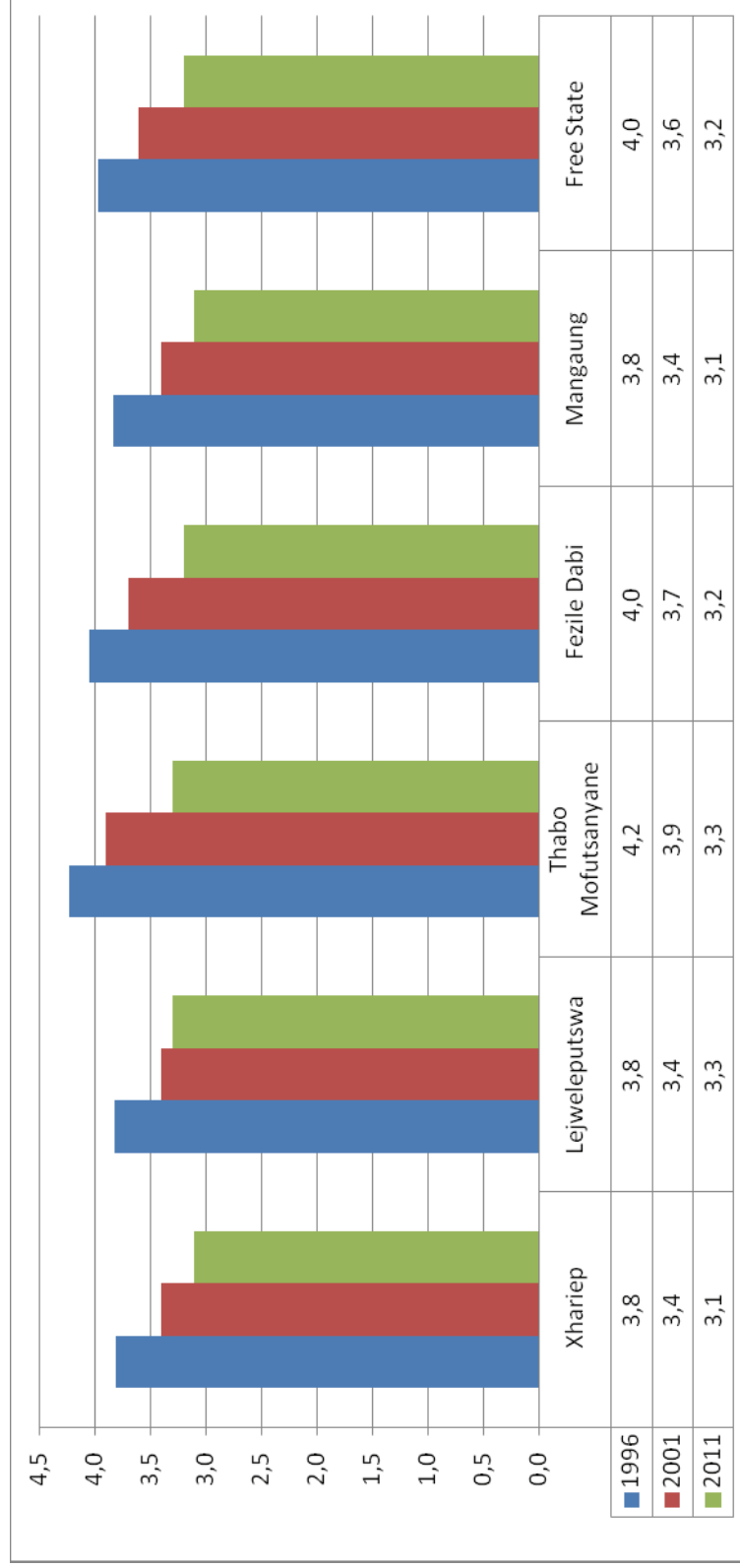


Figure 4.4.1.1 shows a decline in the average household size; Fezile Dabi's average household size is compatible with the provincial average.

### 4.4.2 Type of main dwelling

Figure 4.4.2.1: Distribution of households by type of main dwelling and district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

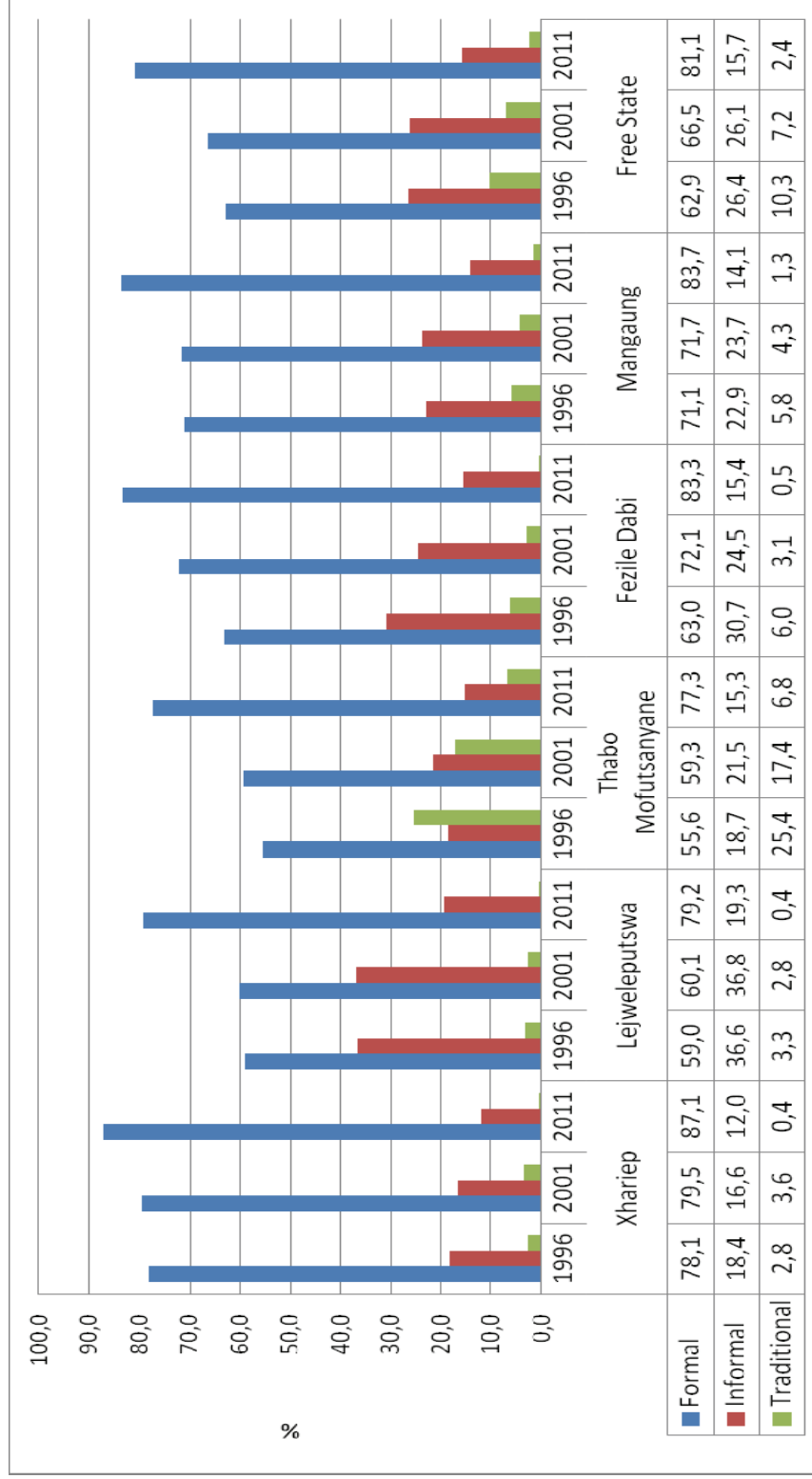
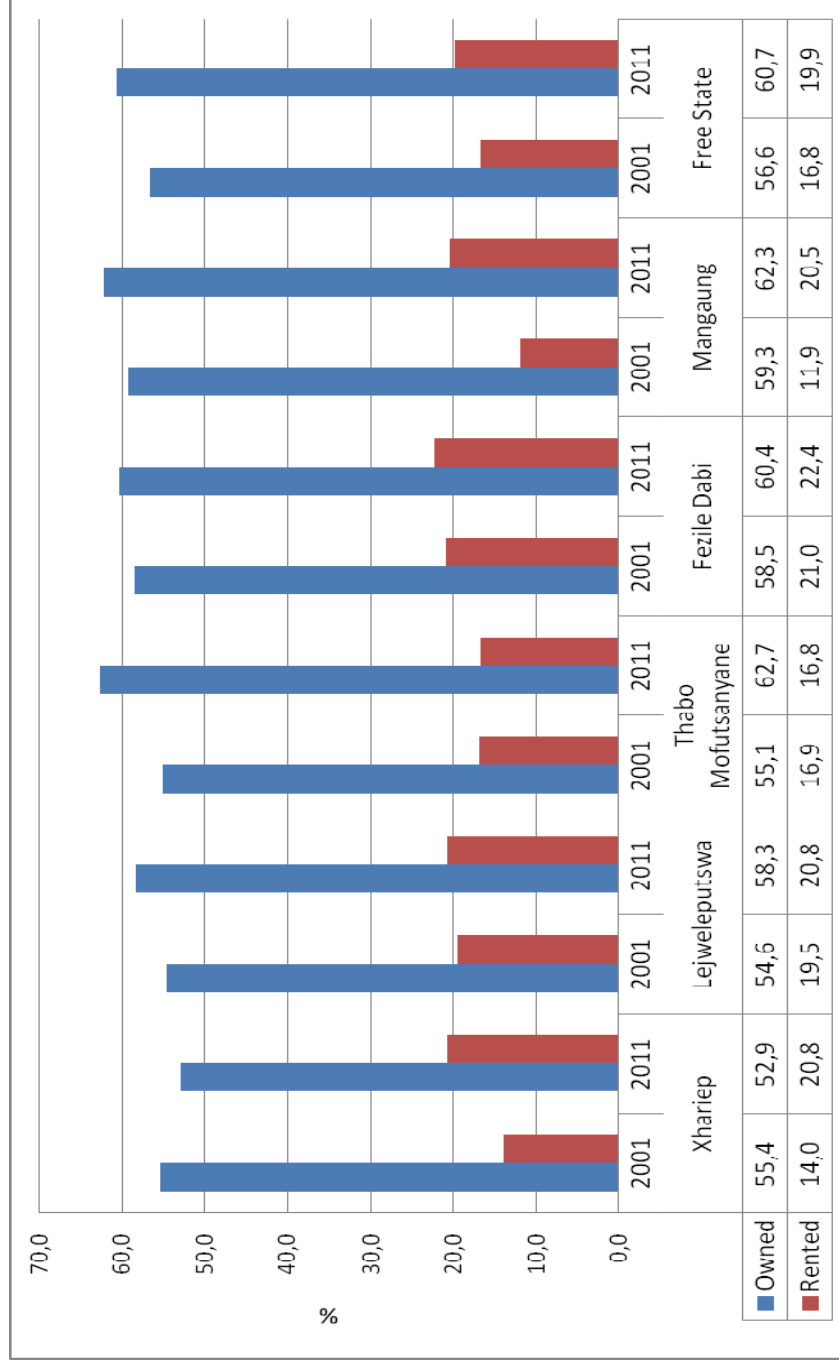


Figure 4.4.2.1 shows a significant increase in the proportion of households resident in formal dwellings across all the districts and alongside is the decline in the proportion of households resident in informal and traditional dwellings.



### 4.4.3 Tenure status

\*Owned refers to fully paid off and not yet paid off dwelling units.

Figure 4.4.3.1 shows a general increase in the proportion of households that are owning their dwellings (except for Xhariep, which shows a decline from 55,4% in 2001 to 52,9% in 2011). The graph also suggests an increase in the proportion of households that are renting their dwellings with the exception of Thabo Mofutsanyane which remained relatively the same. Mangaung and Xhariep recorded the highest increase in the proportion of households that are renting their dwellings.

### 4.4.4 Household goods

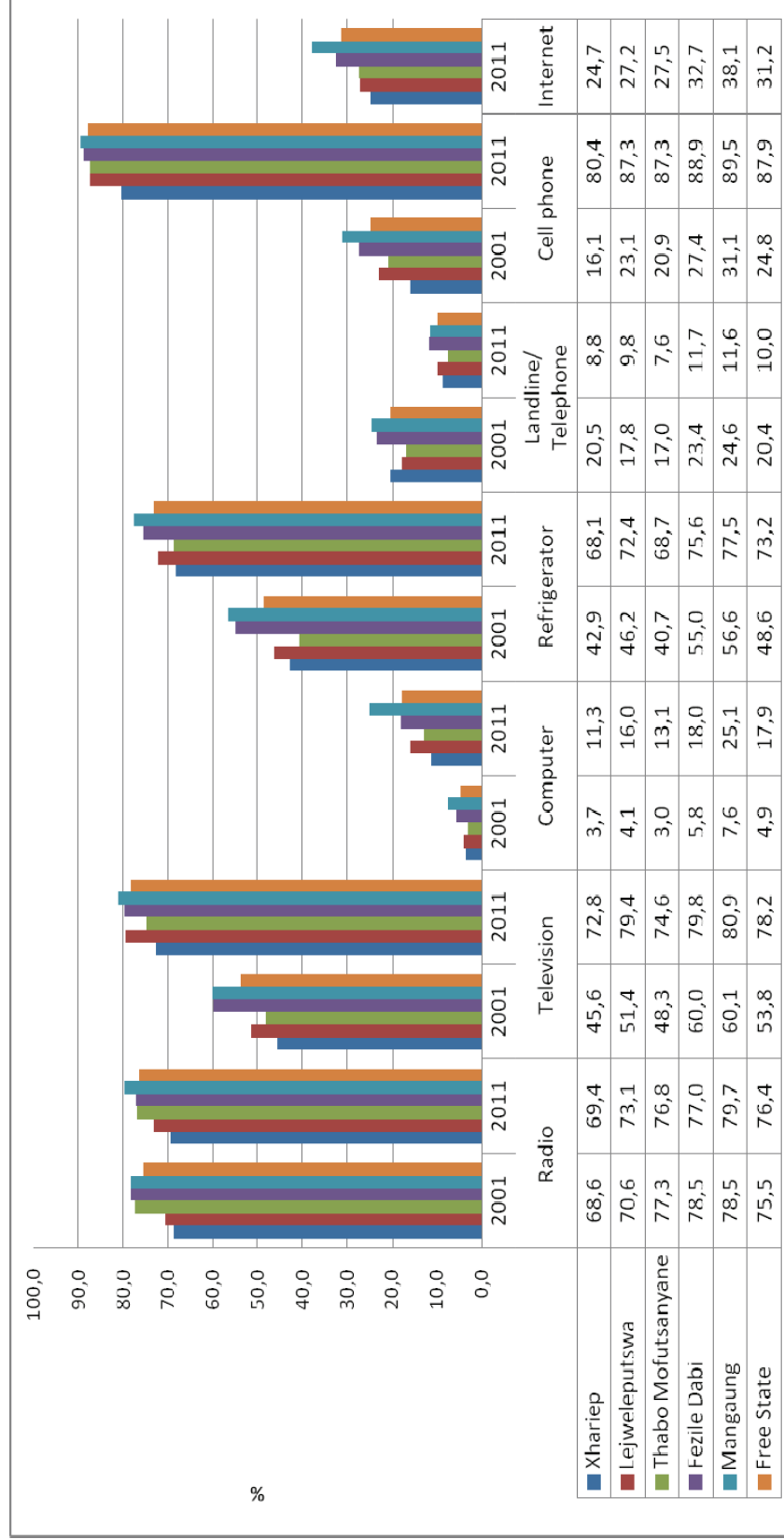


Figure 4.4.4.1 shows a significant increase in the proportion of households owning televisions, computers, refrigerators and cell phones. Households with landline/telephone declined. Almost 40% of households in Mangaung district have access to internet; the highest in the province.

### 4.4.5 Electricity for lighting, cooking and heating

**Figure 4.4.5.1: Distribution of households using electricity for lighting, cooking and heating by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011**

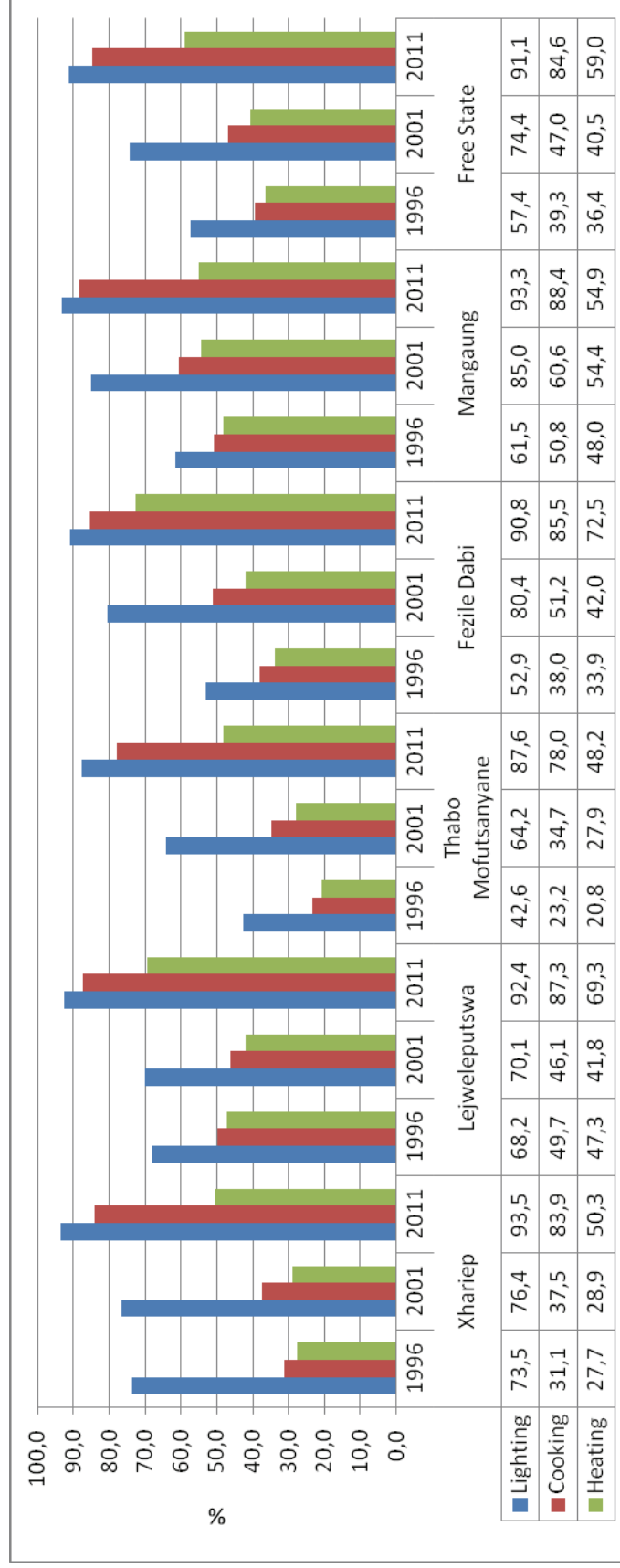


Figure 4.4.5.1 shows that the proportion of households using electricity as the main source of energy for lighting; cooking and heating has increased across the province.

### 4.4.6 Access to piped water

**Figure 4.4.6.1: Distribution of households having access to piped water by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011**

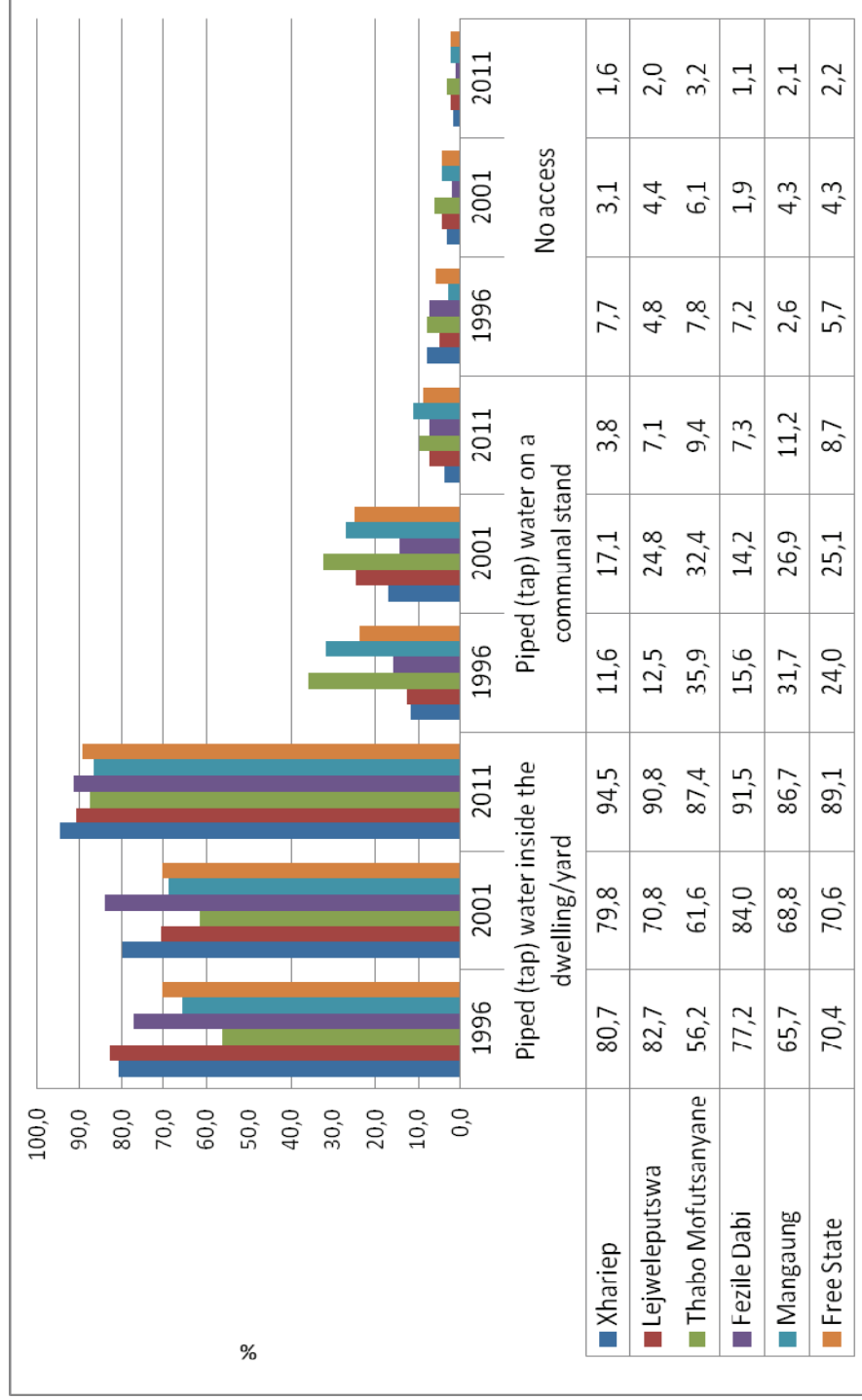


Figure 4.4.6.1 shows that the proportion of households with access to piped water inside the dwelling or yard has increased in all the five districts, the proportion of households with access to water on a communal stand or no access to piped water declined. Xhariep reported the highest proportion of households with access to piped water inside their dwelling/yard, followed by Fezile Dabi and Lejweleputswa (94,5%, 91,5% and 90,8% respectively).

### 4.4.7 Refuse disposal

**Figure 4.4.7.1: Distribution of households by type of refuse removal and district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011**

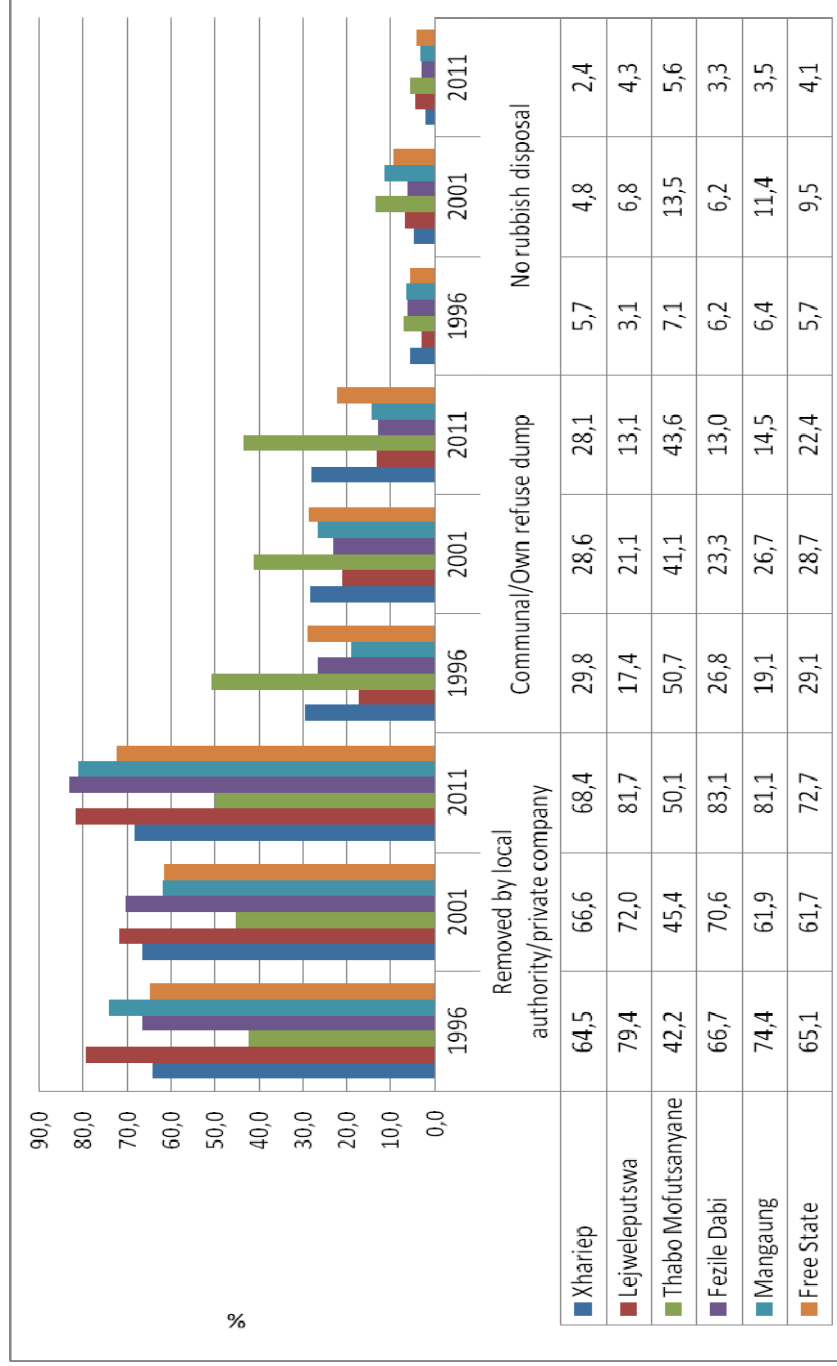


Figure 4.4.7.1 shows that Fezile Dabi, Lejweleputswa and Mangaung have the highest proportion of households whose refuse is removed by local authority or private company. The graph also suggests a decline in the proportion of the households with communal or own refuse dump or no rubbish disposal.

### 4.4.8 Toilet facilities

**Figure 4.4.8.1: Distribution of households by type of toilet facility and district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011**

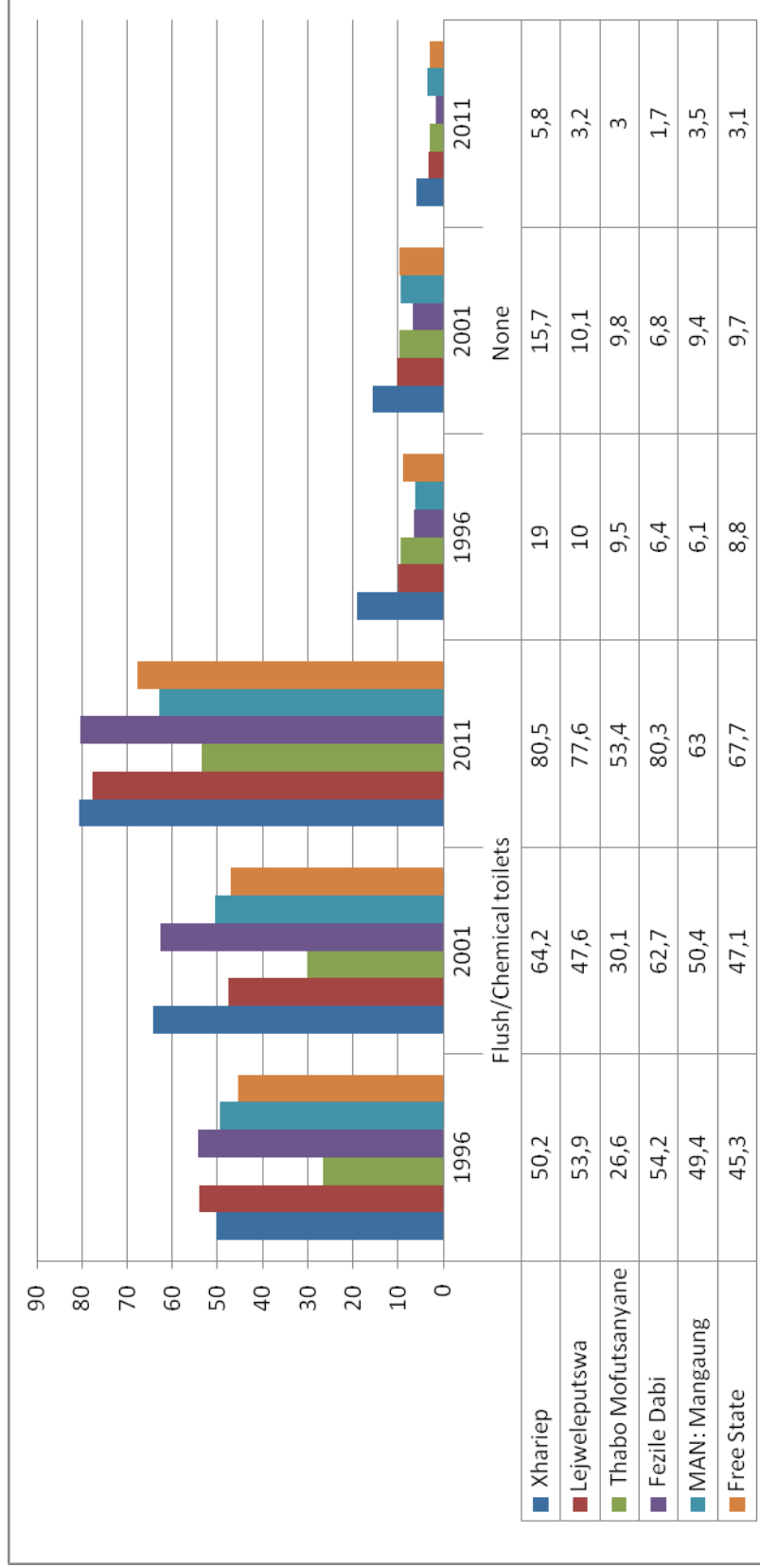


Figure 4.4.8.1 shows that the proportion of households with access to flush/chemical toilet increased; on one hand the proportion of households with no access to toilet facilities decreased over time across the districts.

**Figure 4.4.9.1: Distribution of average household income by district municipality – 2001 and 2011**

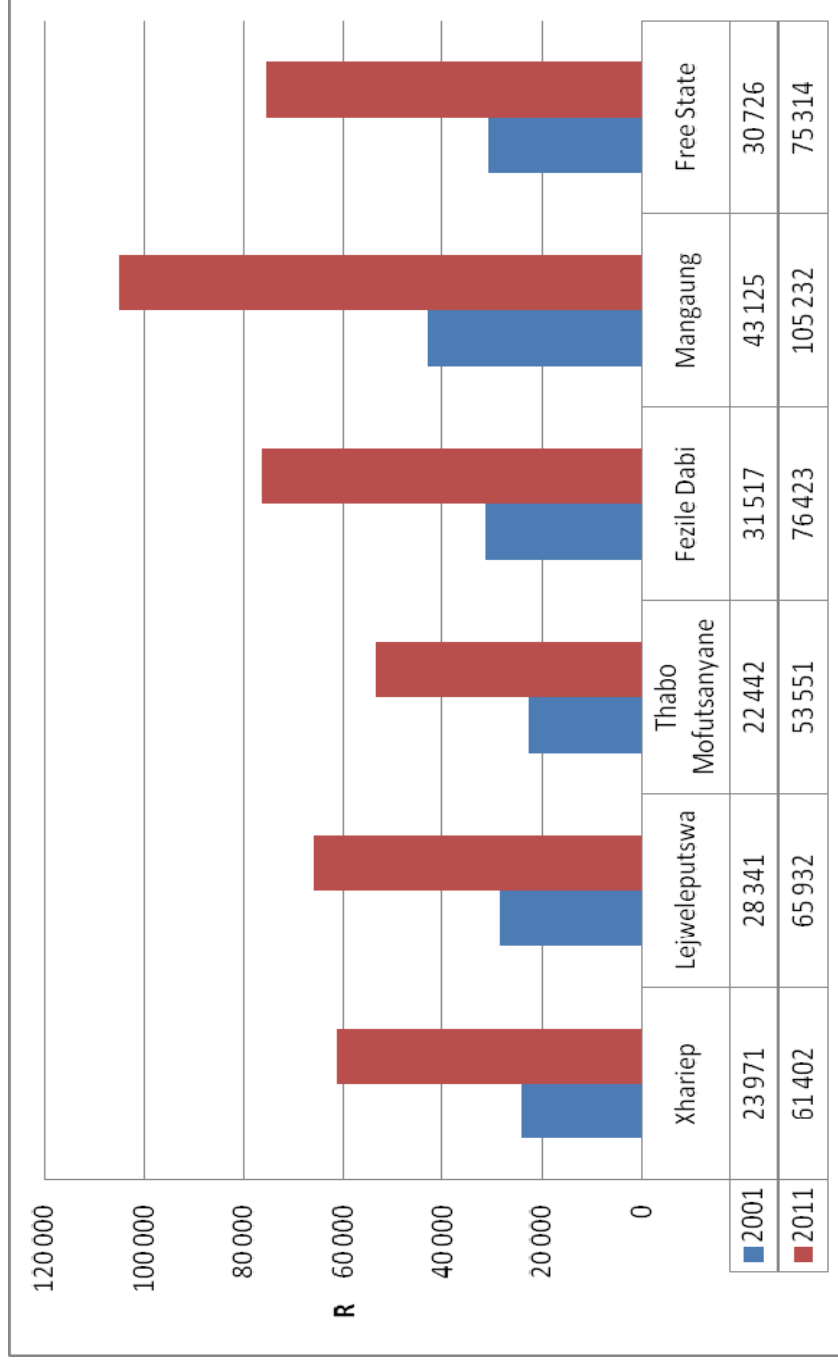


Figure 4.4.9.1 shows an increase in the average household income across districts.

Figure 4.4.10.1: Distribution of female headed households by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

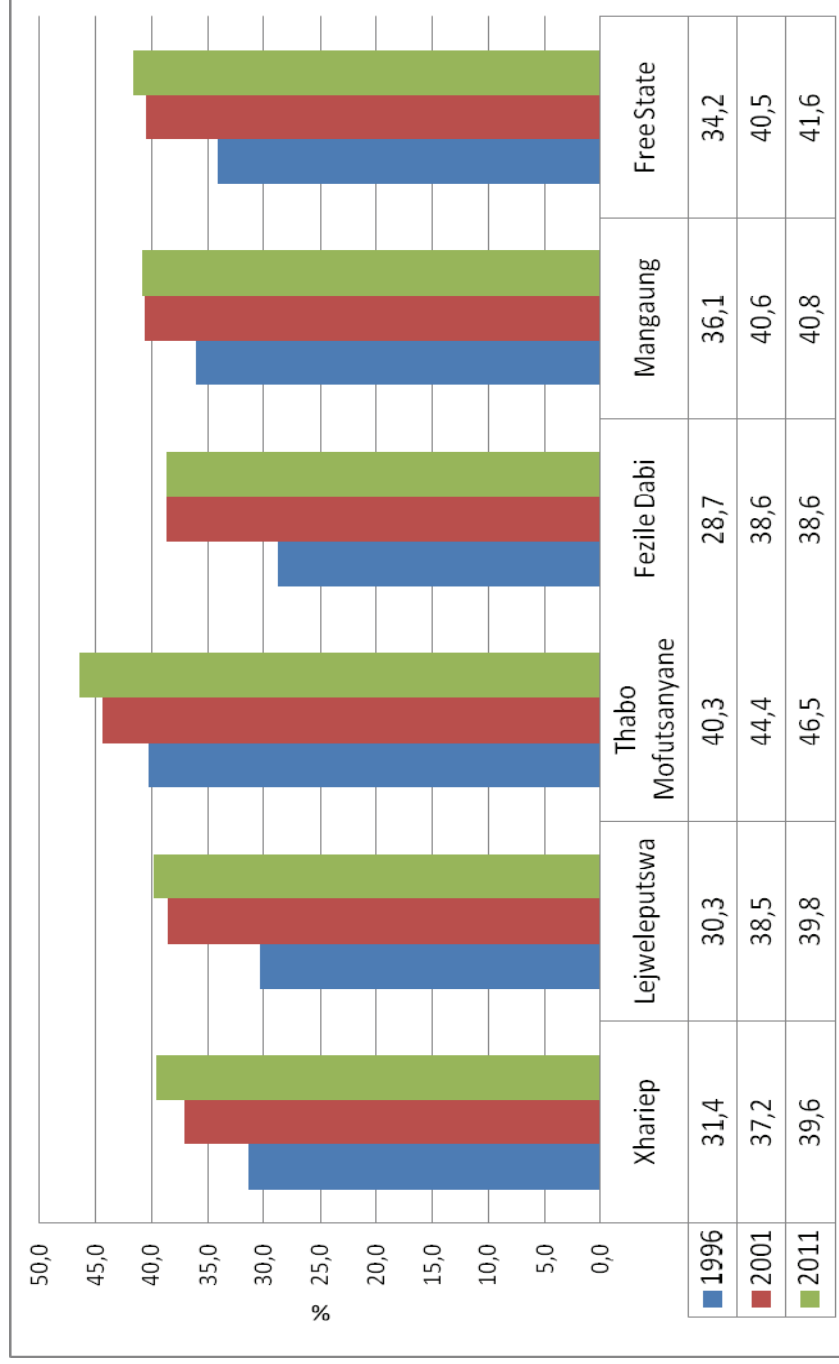


Figure 4.4.10.1 indicates an increase in the proportion of households headed by females. Mangaung and Thabo Mofutsanyane have the highest proportion of female headed households in the province.

**Figure 4.4.11.1: Distribution of child headed households by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011**

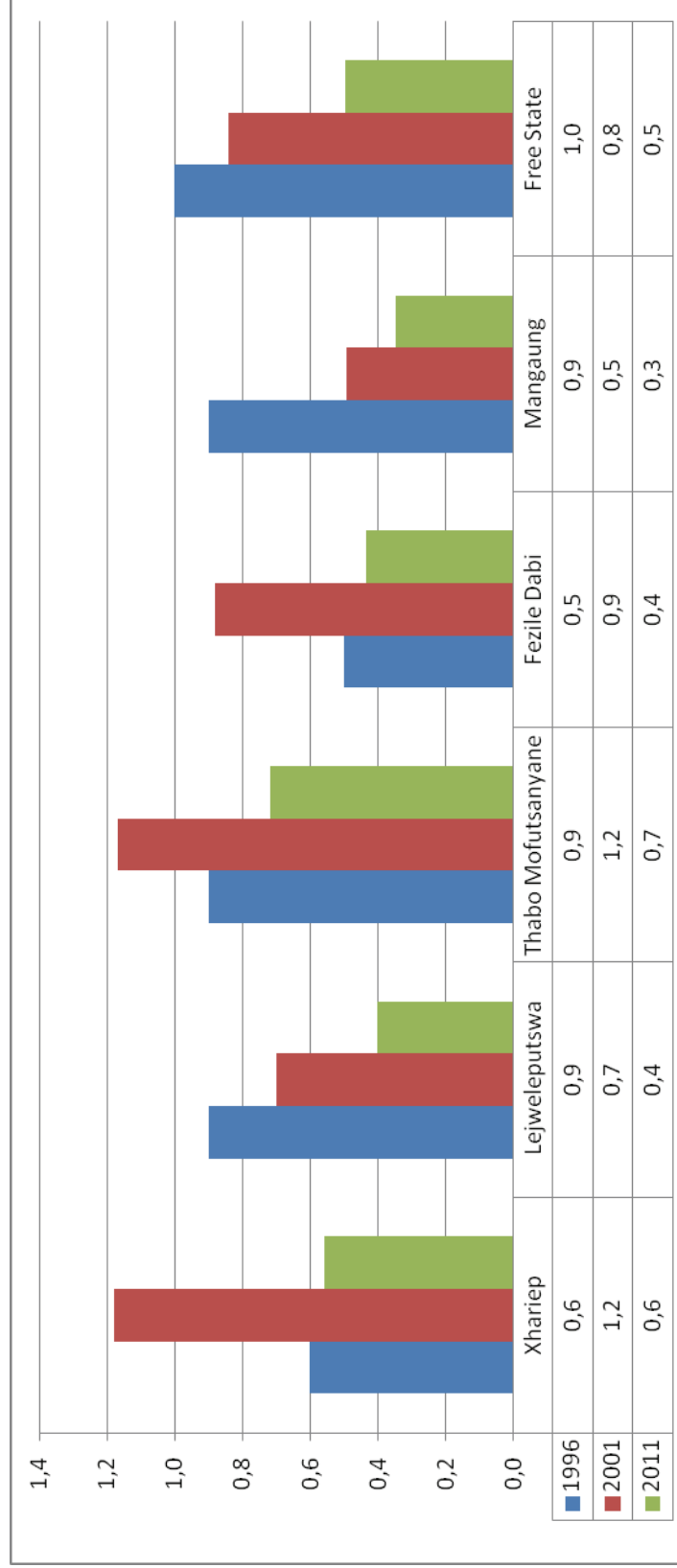


Figure 4.4.11.1 shows that the proportion of households headed by children has declined over time and across districts. The proportion of child headed households is consistently low. Xhariep and Thabo Mofutsanyane districts consistently have the highest proportion of child headed households.
