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Introduction

South Africa has had three censuses since the first general elections in 1994. The first census was conducted in 1996, the second one followed five years later (2001), whilst the recent census was conducted just over a year ago (2011). In this publication, data from the three censuses are compared.

The following points are brought to the attention of the reader of this publication:

- Comparisons of the results of labour market indicators in the post-apartheid population censuses over time have been a cause for concern. Improvements to key questions over the years mean that the labour market outcomes based on the post-apartheid censuses have to be analysed with caution. Such analysis will be the subject of research published in a separate publication in 2013. The differences in the results over the years may be partly attributable to improvements in the questionnaire since 1996, rather than to actual developments in the labour market. The numbers published in this volume for the 1996, 2001, and 2011 censuses are therefore not comparable over time and are higher from those published by Statistics South Africa in the surveys designed specifically for capturing official labour market results.
- For purposes of comparison over the period 1996–2011, certain categories of responses to questions in the censuses of 1996, 2001 and 2011, have either been merged or separated.
- The tenure status question for 1996 has been dropped since the question asked was totally unrelated to that asked thereafter. Comparisons for 2001 and 2011 do, however, remain.
- All household variables are controlled for housing units only and hence exclude all collective living arrangements as well as transient populations.
- The slight differences in totals for annual household income as compared to that published in the Statistical Release of Census 2011 are due to rounding.
- When making comparisons of any indicator, it must be taken into account that the time period between the first two censuses is five years; and that between the second and third censuses is ten years. Although census captures information at one given point in time, the period available for an indicator to change is different.

9. Limpopo

9.1 Demographics

9.1.1 Age-sex structure

Figures 9.1.1.1 to 9.1.1.6 show the pyramids for Limpopo and its districts respectively. The pyramids indicate that the population is still young; the majority of the population is aged below 35 years.

Figure 9.1.1.1: Distribution of the population by age and sex, Limpopo – 1996, 2001 and 2011

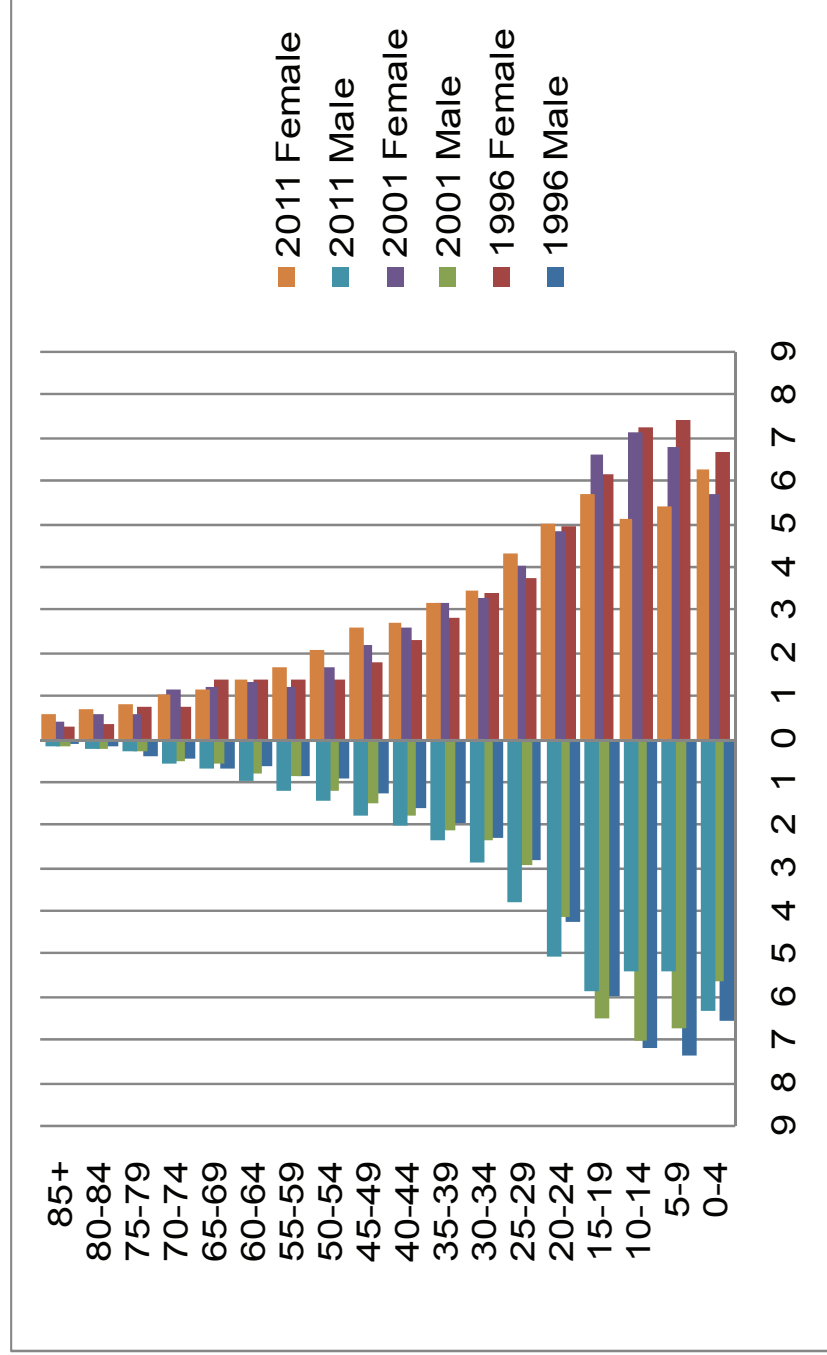


Figure 9.1.1.2: Distribution of the population by age and sex, Mopani District – 1996, 2001 and 2011

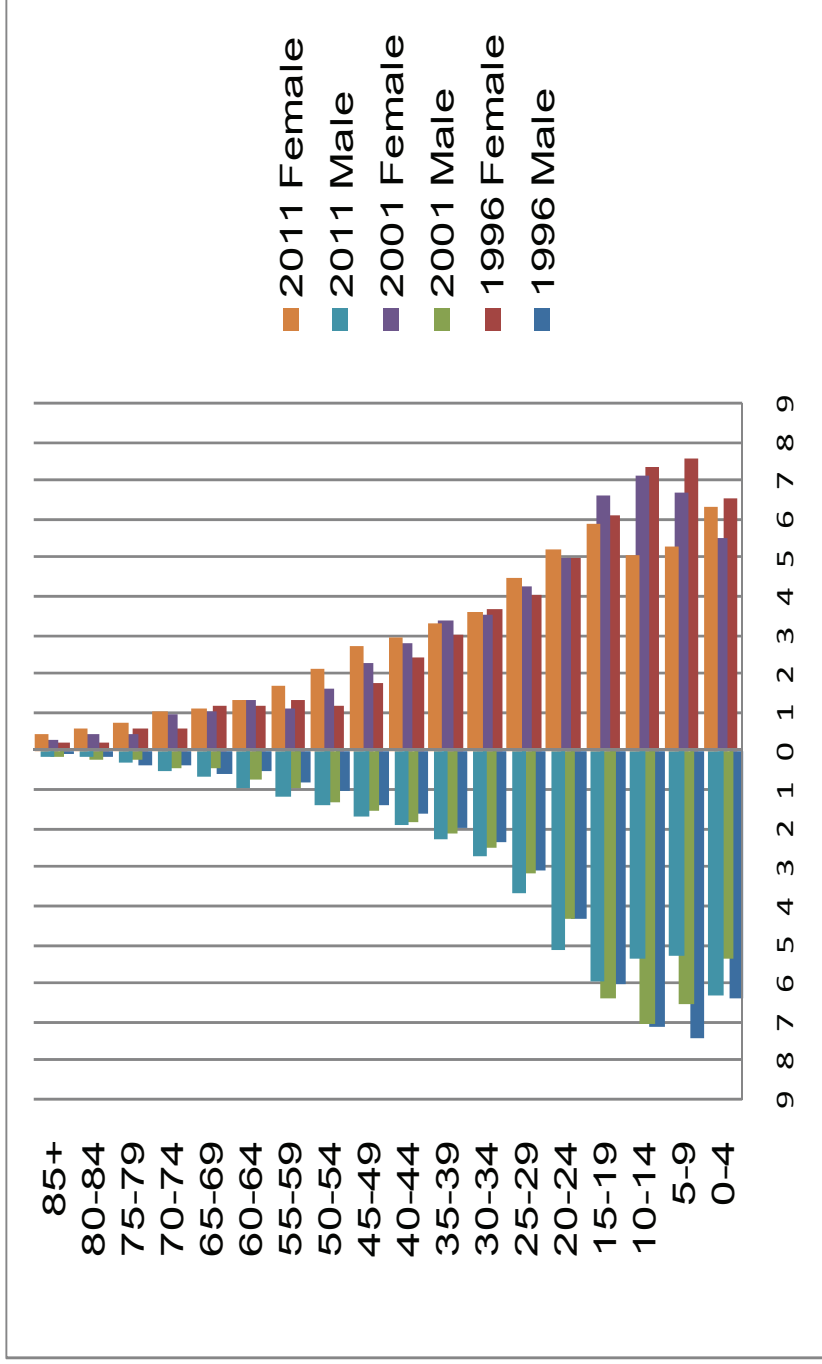


Figure 9.1.1.3: Distribution of the population by age and sex, Vhembe District – 1996, 2001 and 2011

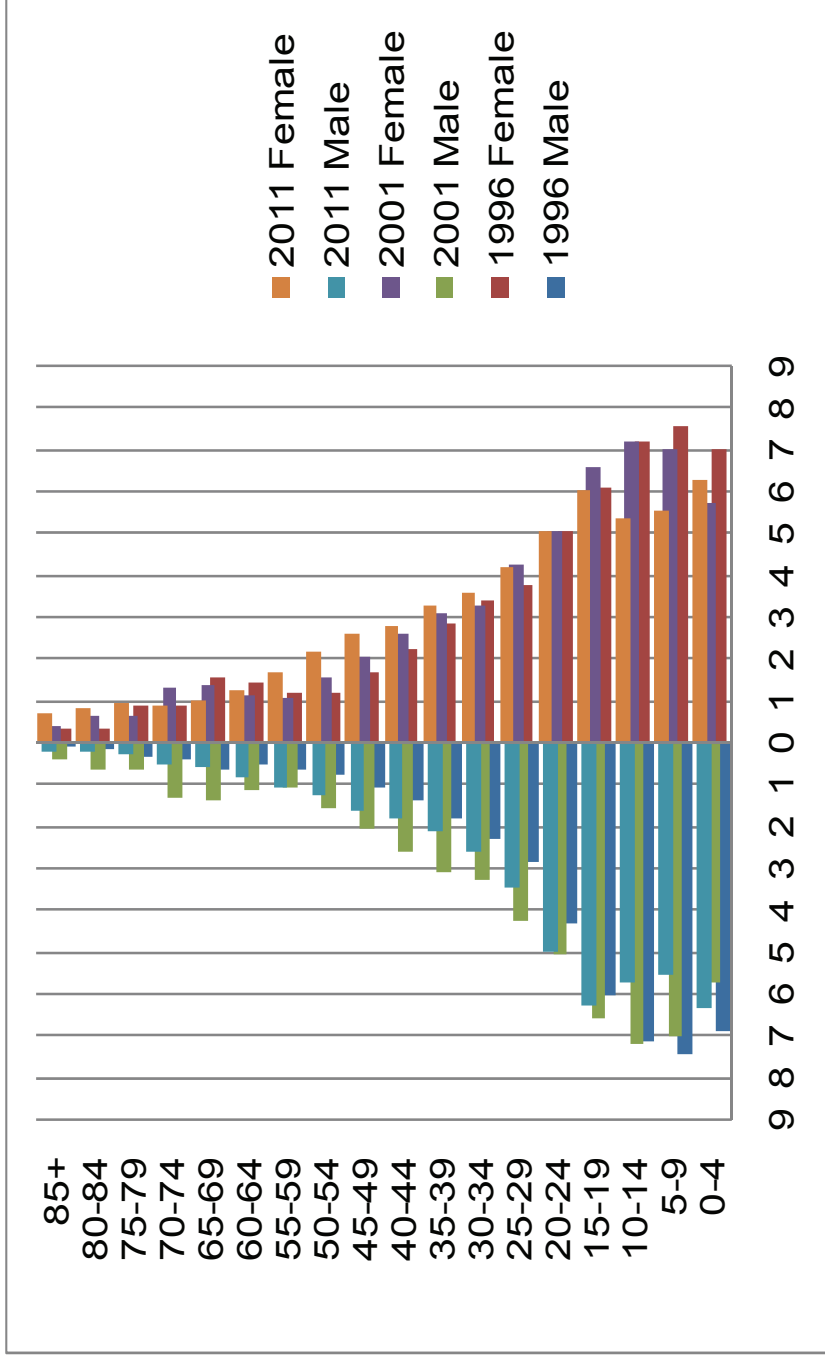


Figure 9.1.1.4: Distribution of the population by age and sex, Capricorn District – 1996, 2001 and 2011

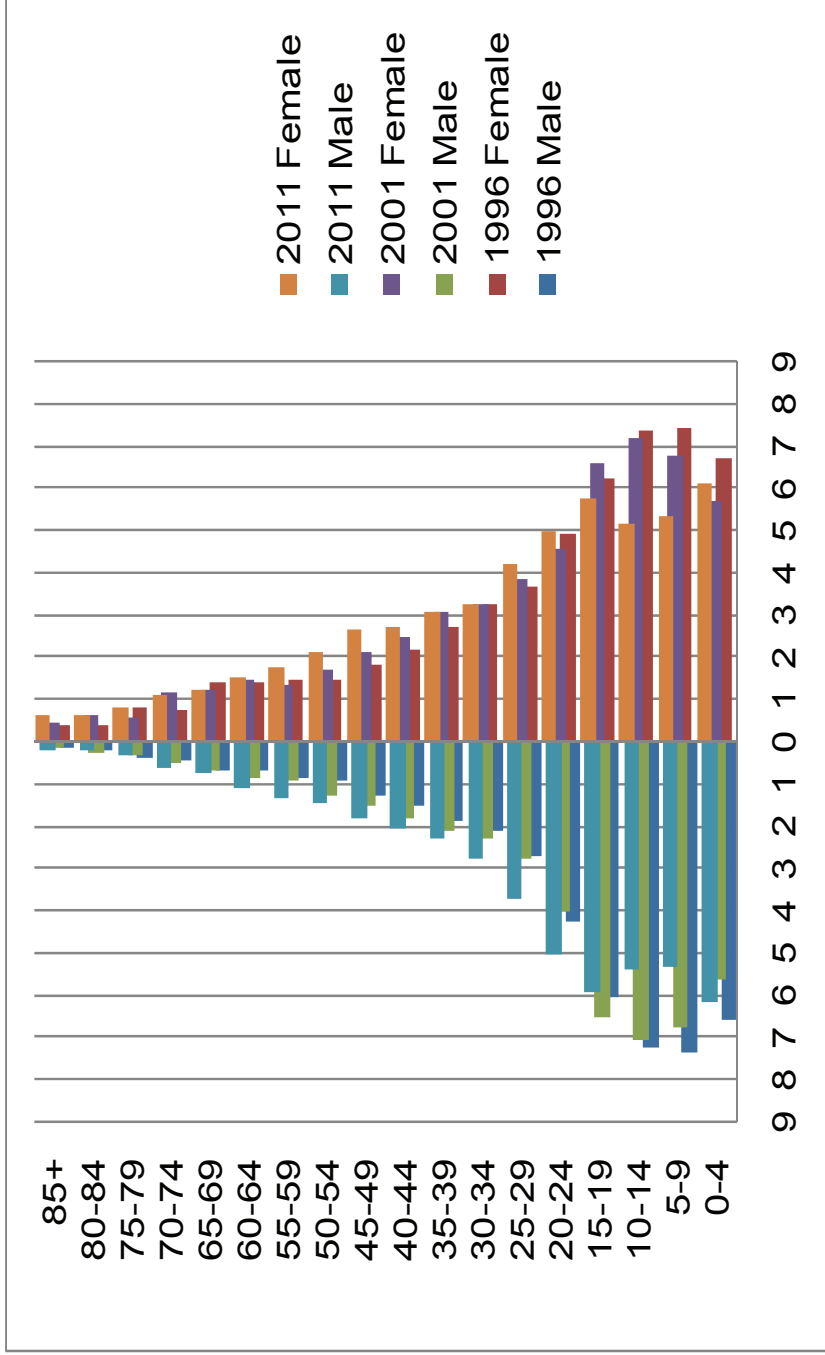


Figure 9.1.1.5: Distribution of the population by age and sex, Waterberg District – 1996, 2001 and 2011

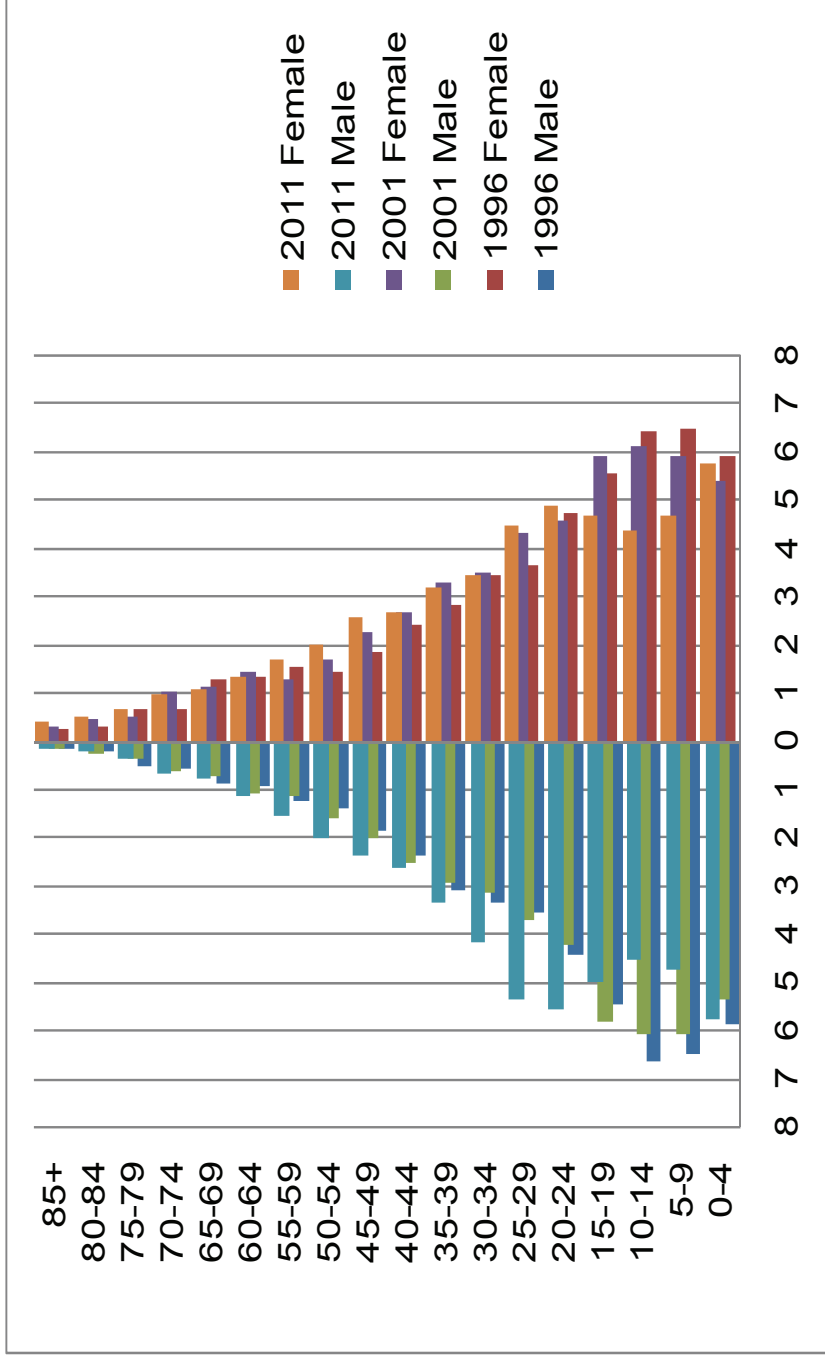
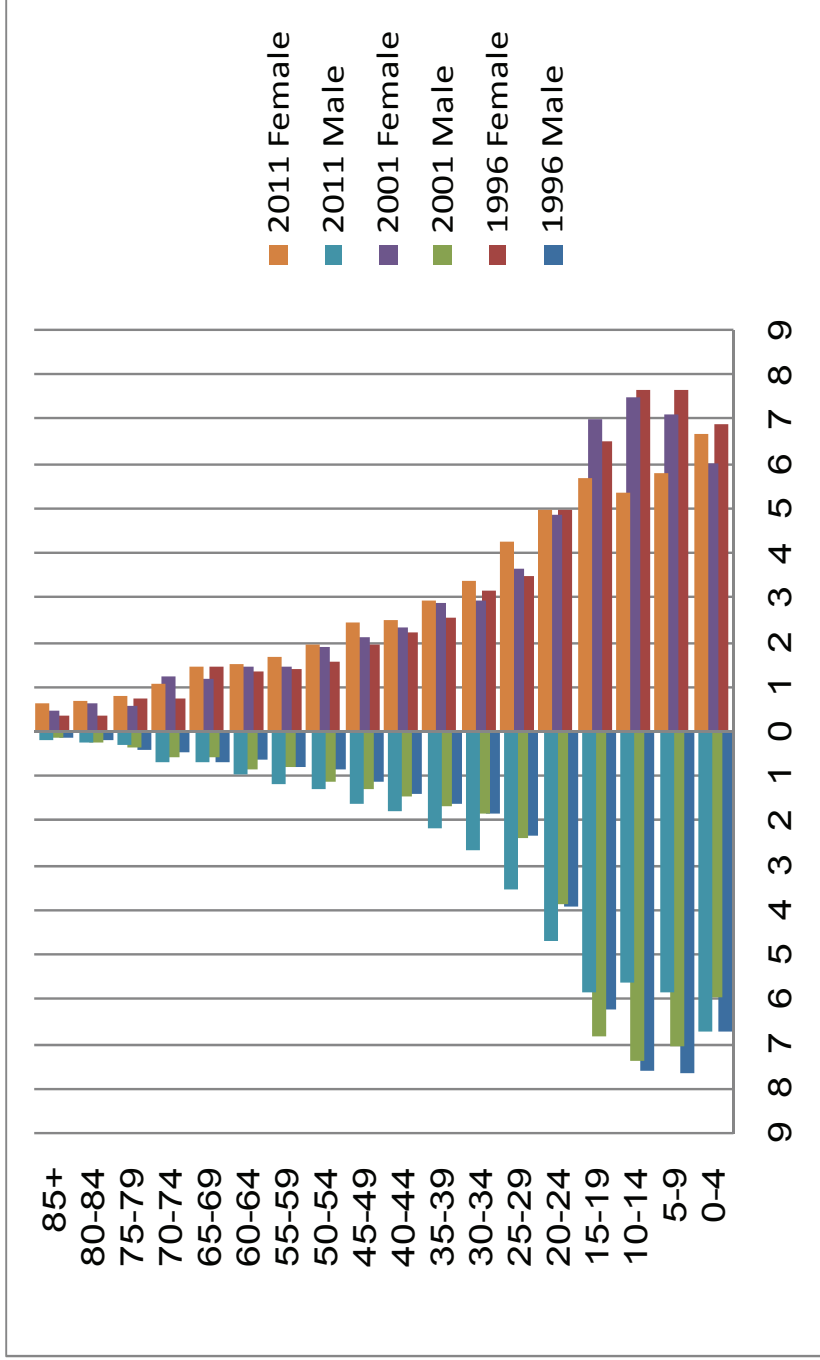


Figure 9.1.1.6: Distribution of the population by age and sex, Greater Sekhukhune District – 1996, 2001 and 2011



9.1.2 Population growth rates

Figure 9.2.1.1: Population growth rates by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

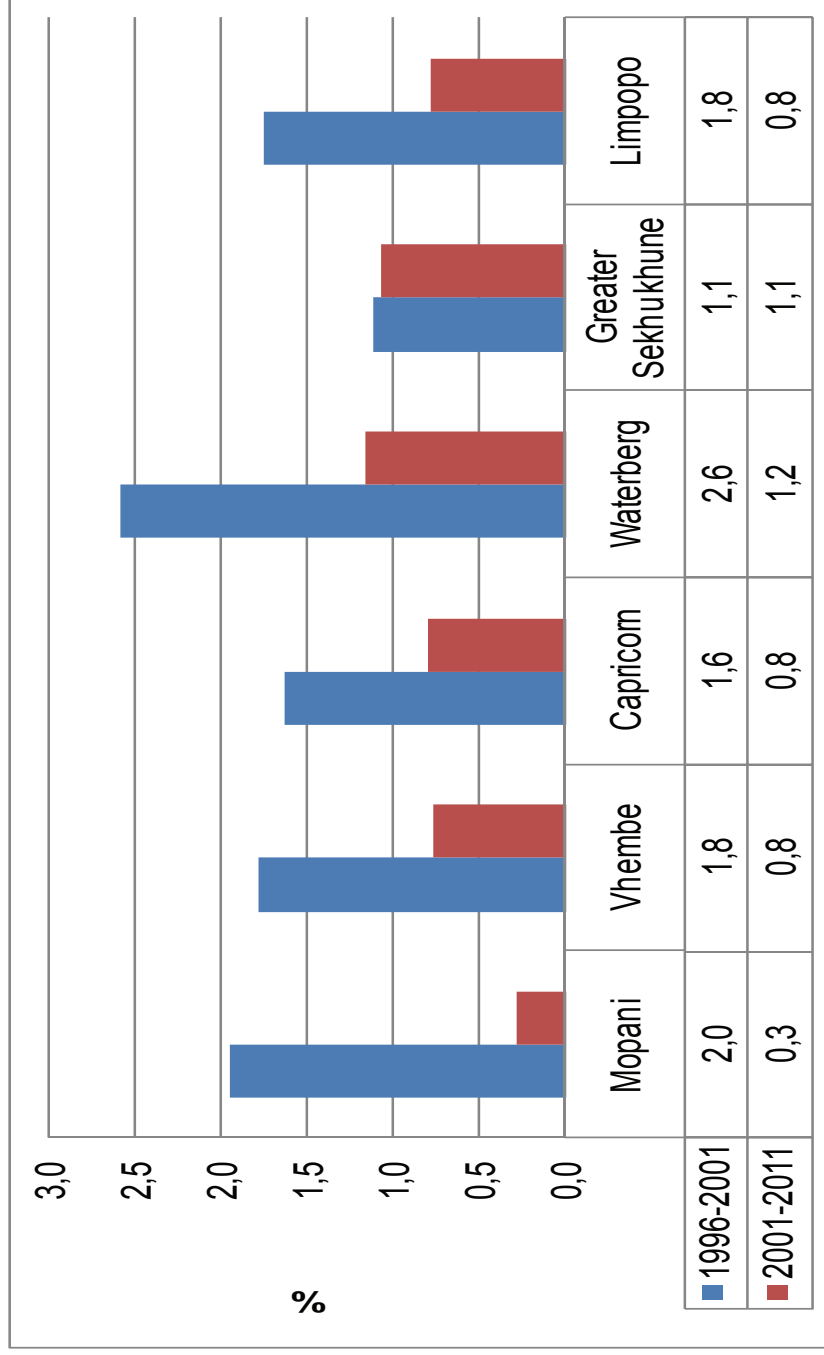


Figure 9.2.1.1 shows that the province has experienced a slow population growth; for the period between 1996 and 2001 and 2001 and 2011, the provincial population is estimated to have grown by 1,8% and 0,8% respectively. Similar growth patterns are also seen in all the districts, except Greater Sekhukhune, which has been constant. Vhembe mirrors the average growth rates for the province and Mopani experienced the most decline.

9.1.3 Sex Ratios

Figure 9.3.1.1: Sex ratios by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

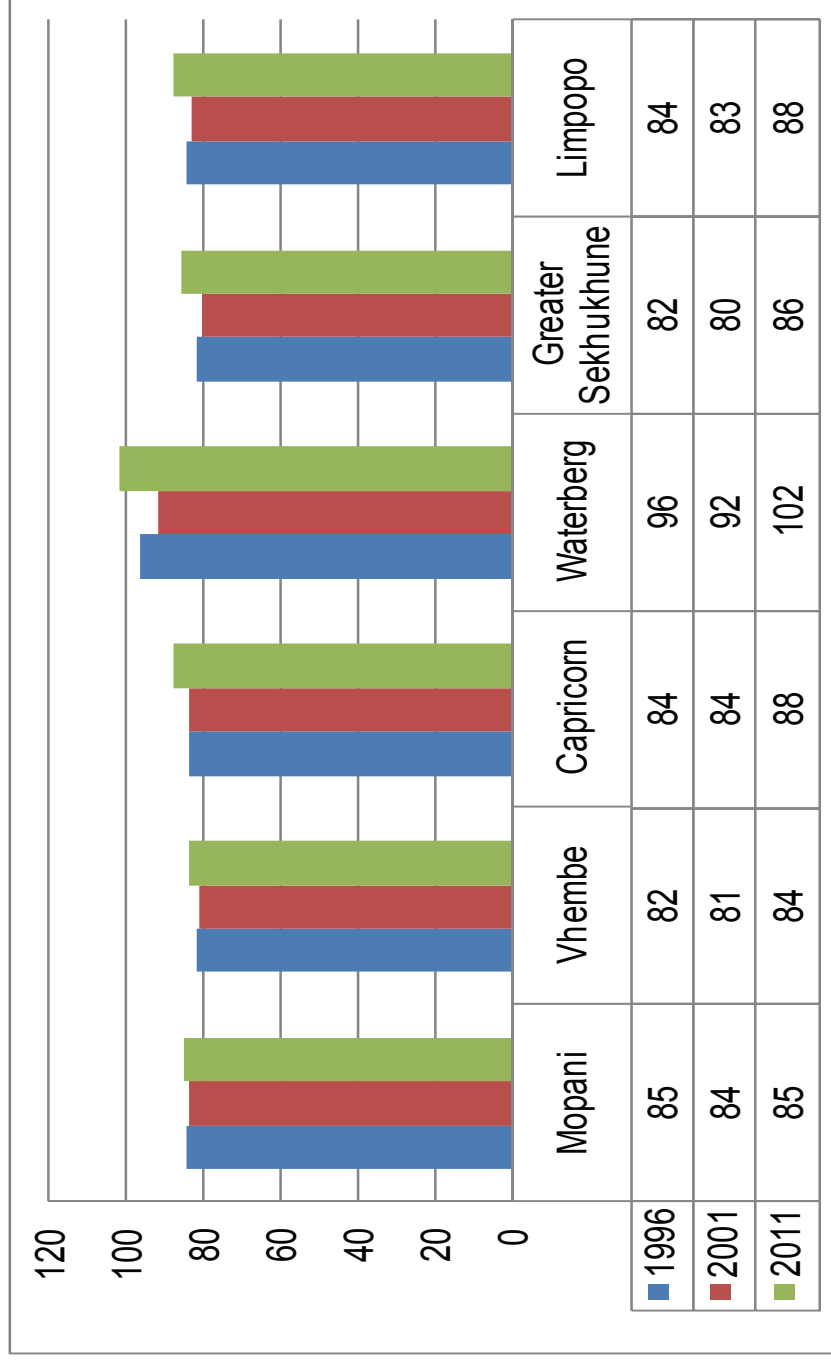


Figure 9.3.1.1 shows that there are more females than males across all districts except for Waterberg in 2011.

9.1.4 Population group structure

Figure 9.4.1.1: Percentage distribution of the population group by population group and district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

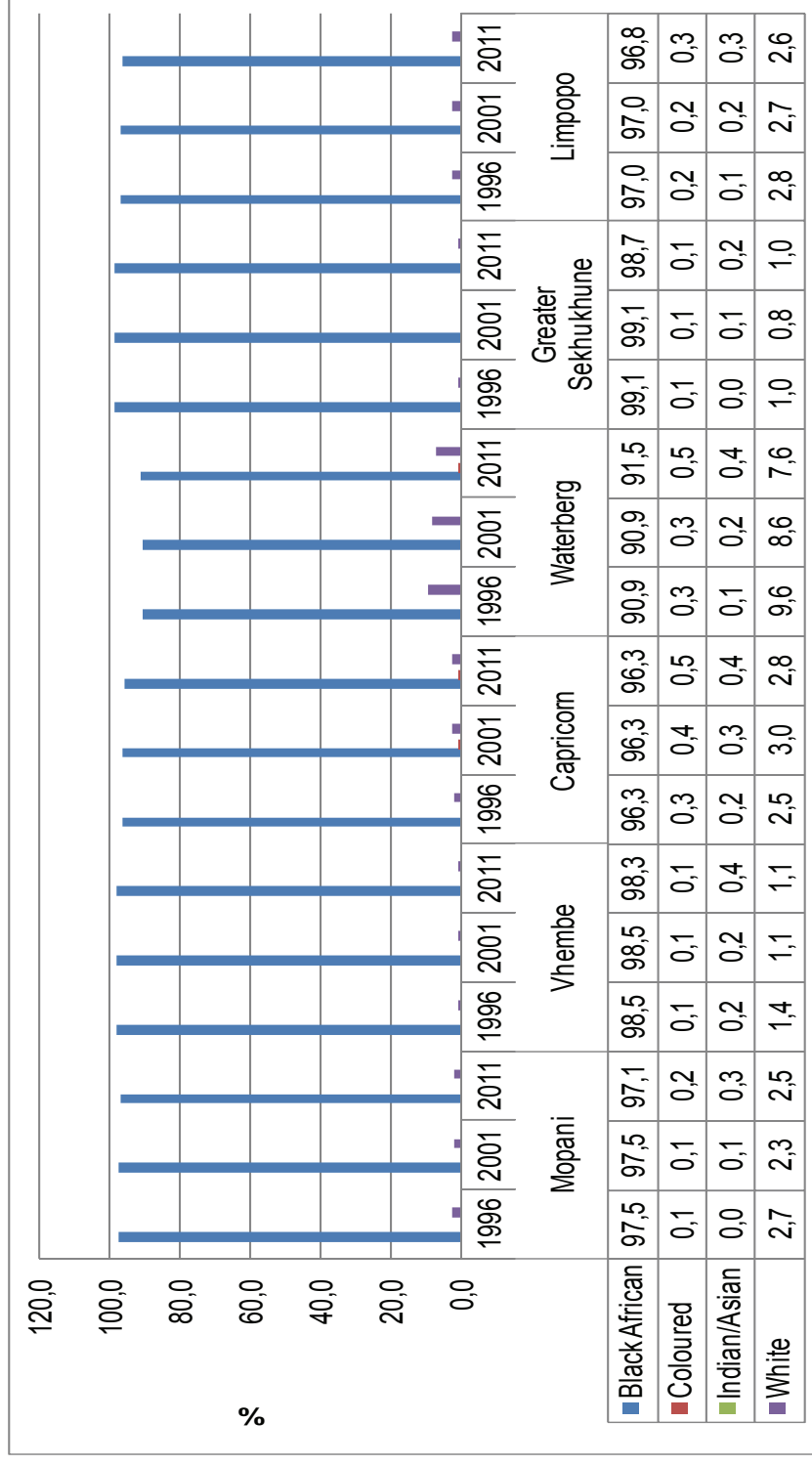


Figure 9.4.1.1 mirrors the population group composition of the country; with the majority being Black African, with Coloured and Indian/ Asian population groups constituting the lowest percentage.

9.1.5 Population by functional age group

Figure 9.5.1.1: Population by functional age group and district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

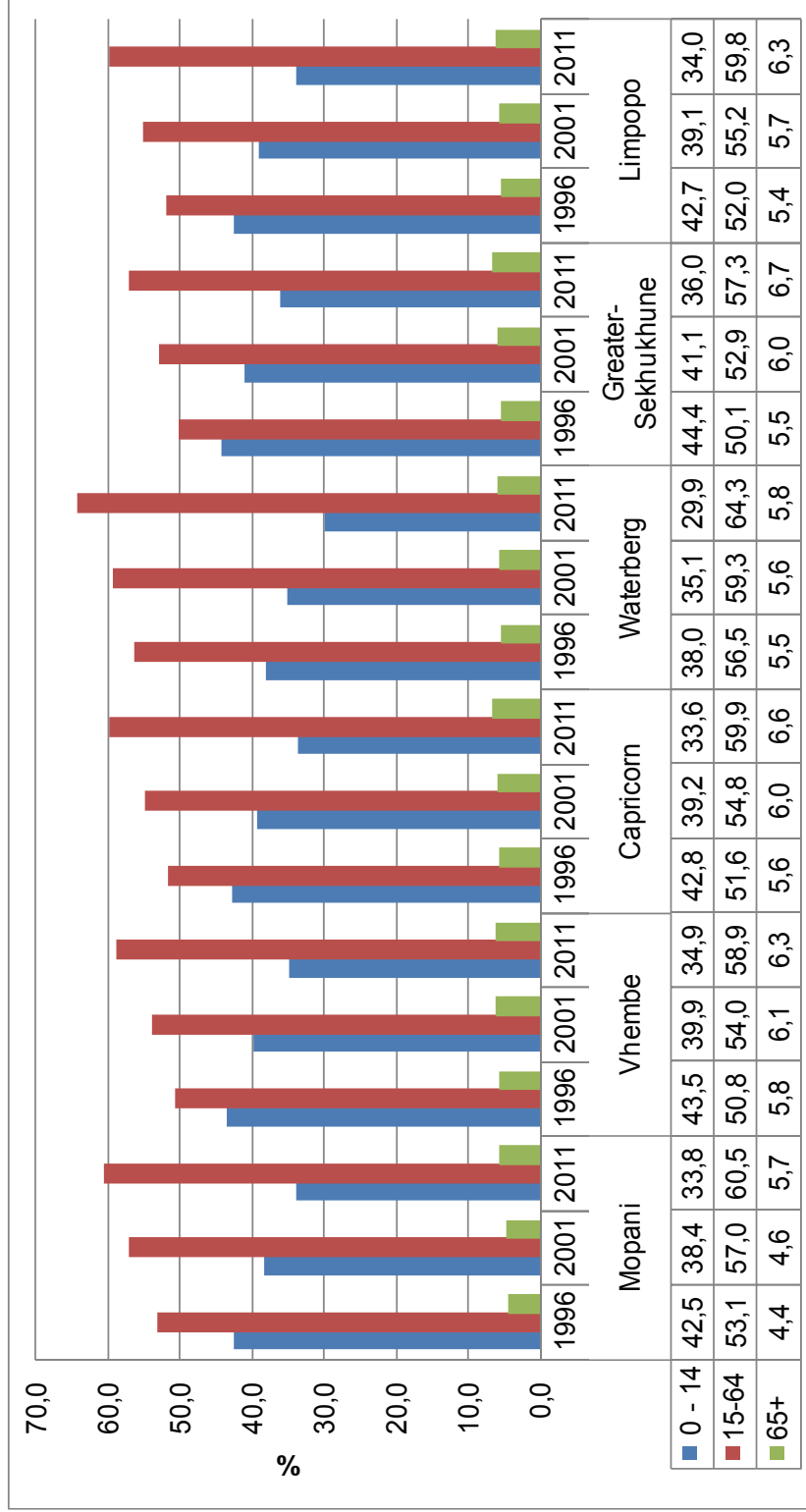


Figure 9.5.1.1 shows a consistent decline in the proportion of the population aged 0–14 years; an increase in the proportion of the 15–64 and 65+ in the province over time. Waterberg has the lowest and highest proportion of population aged 0–14 and 15–64 respectively.

9.1.6 Dependency ratios

Dependency ratios provide insights into the burden borne by those who are in working age group (15–64) to support those aged 0–14 and 65+ years.

Figure 9.6.1.1: Dependency ratio by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

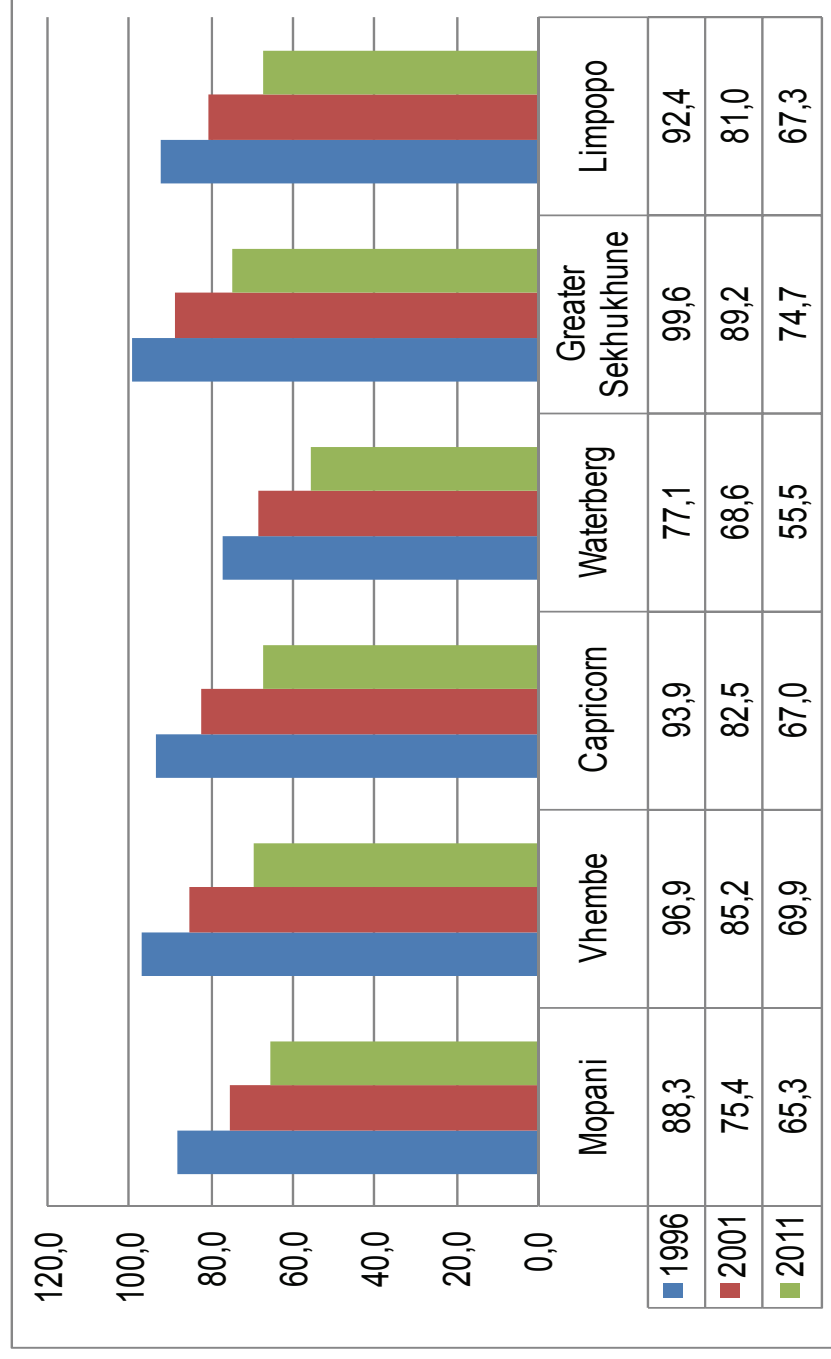


Figure 9.6.1.1 suggests that Capricorn district has dependency ratios compatible with the provincial average over time. The dependency ratios have been declining over time; Waterberg consistently shows a lower than provincial average.

9.1.7 Marital status

Figure 9.7.1.1: Distribution of population by marital status and district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

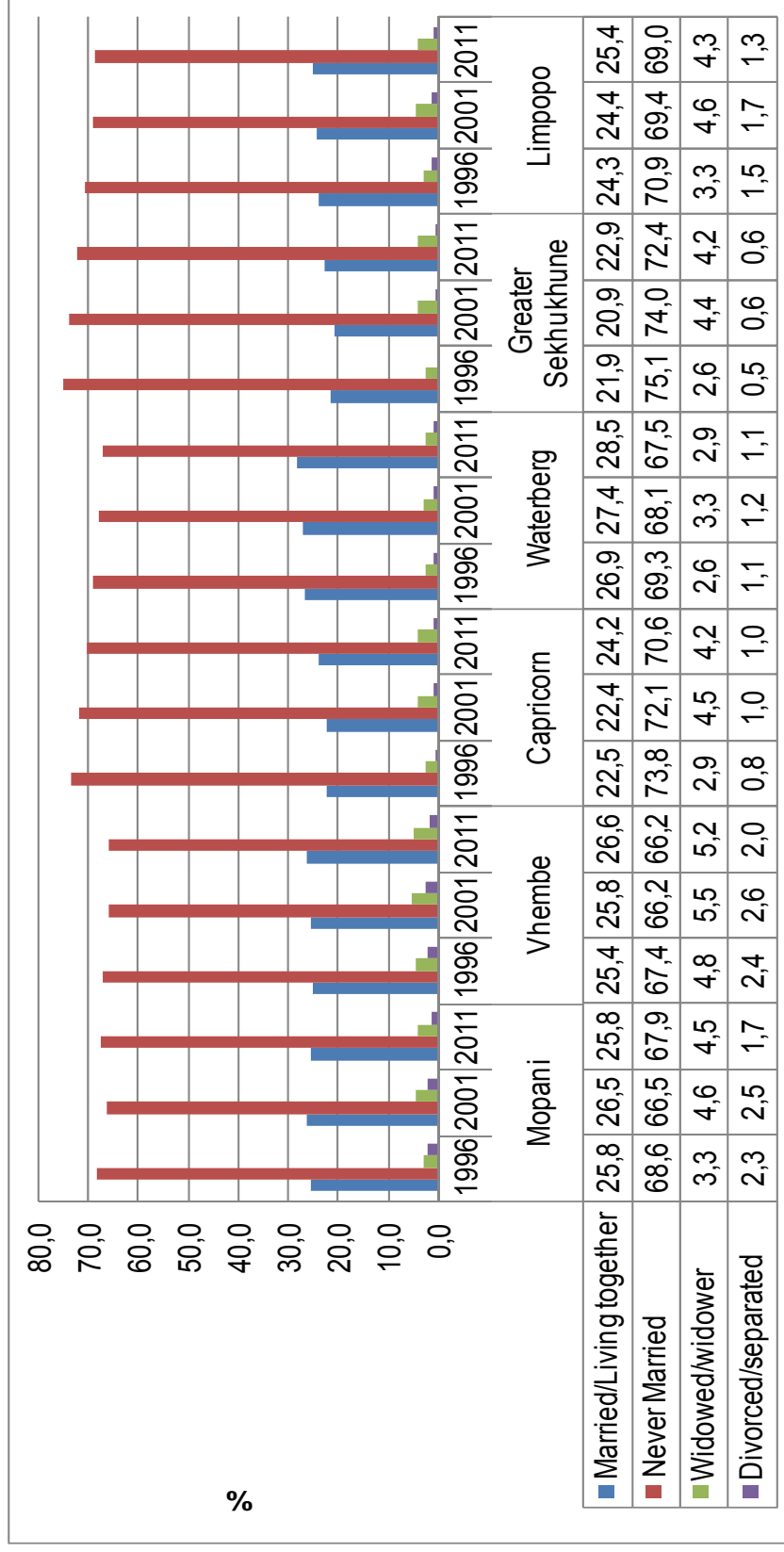


Figure 9.7.1.1 shows a marginal decline in the proportion of the population never married and a slight increase in the proportion married or living together.

9.2 Education

9.2.1 Highest level of education attained

Figure 9.2.1.1: Distribution of the population aged 20 years and older by highest level of education and district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

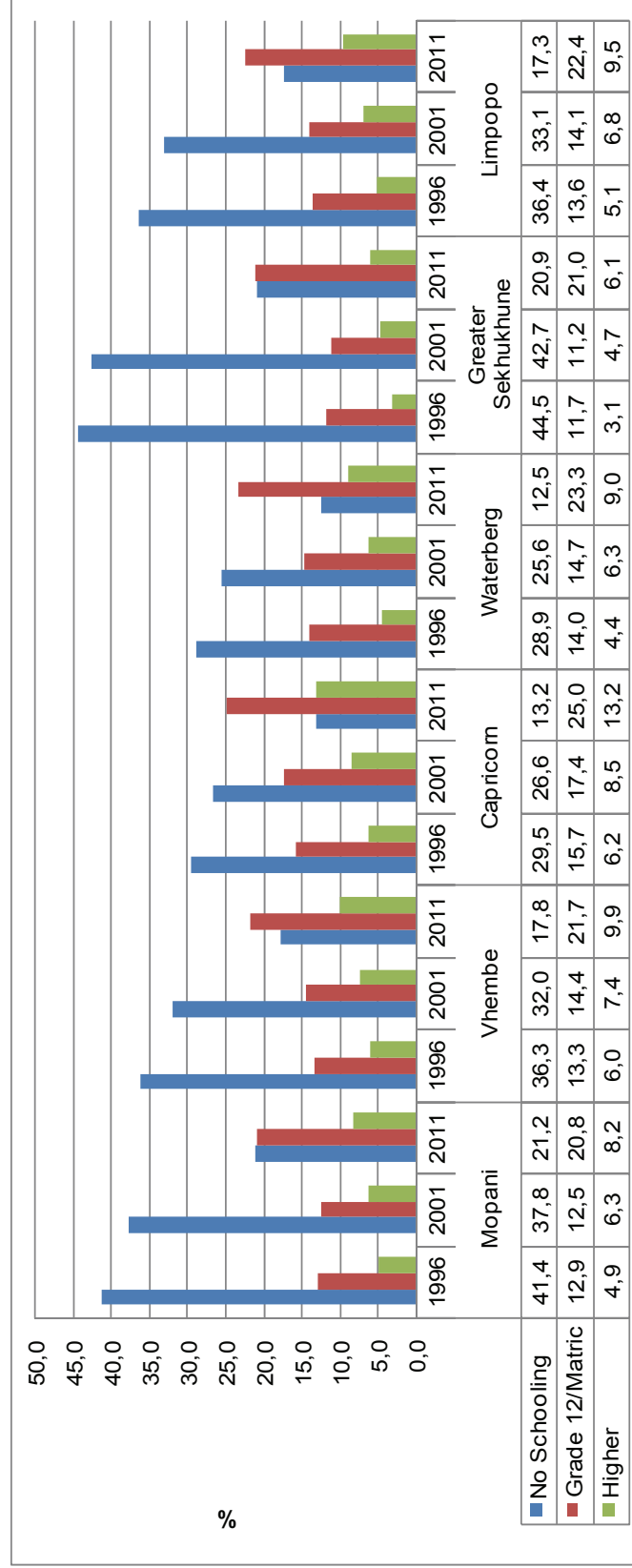


Figure 9.2.1.1 shows an increase in the proportion of the population with Grade 12/ Matric and higher education. Also striking is the drastic reduction in the population with no schooling; which halved in all the districts.

Figure 9.2.2.1: Distribution of the population aged between 5–24 years by school attendance and district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

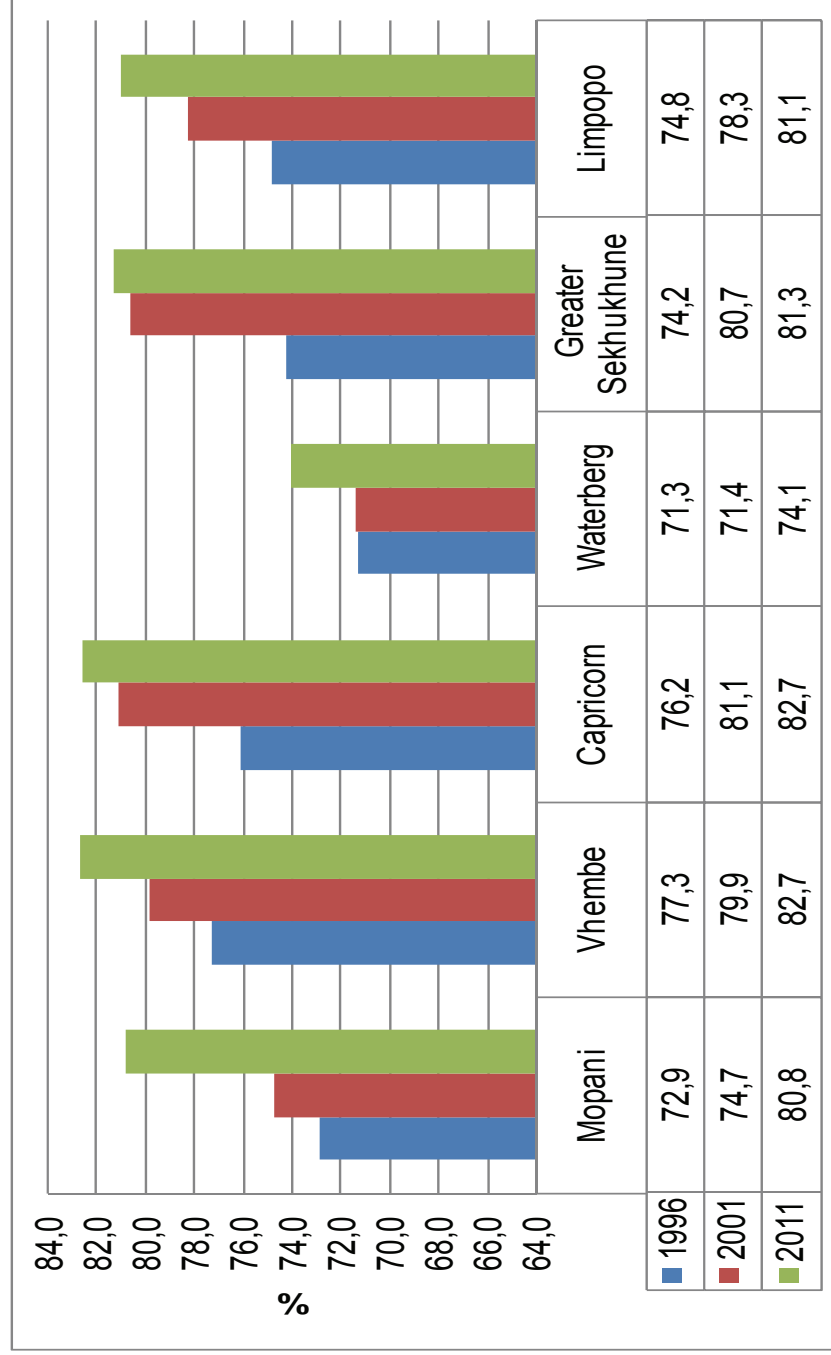
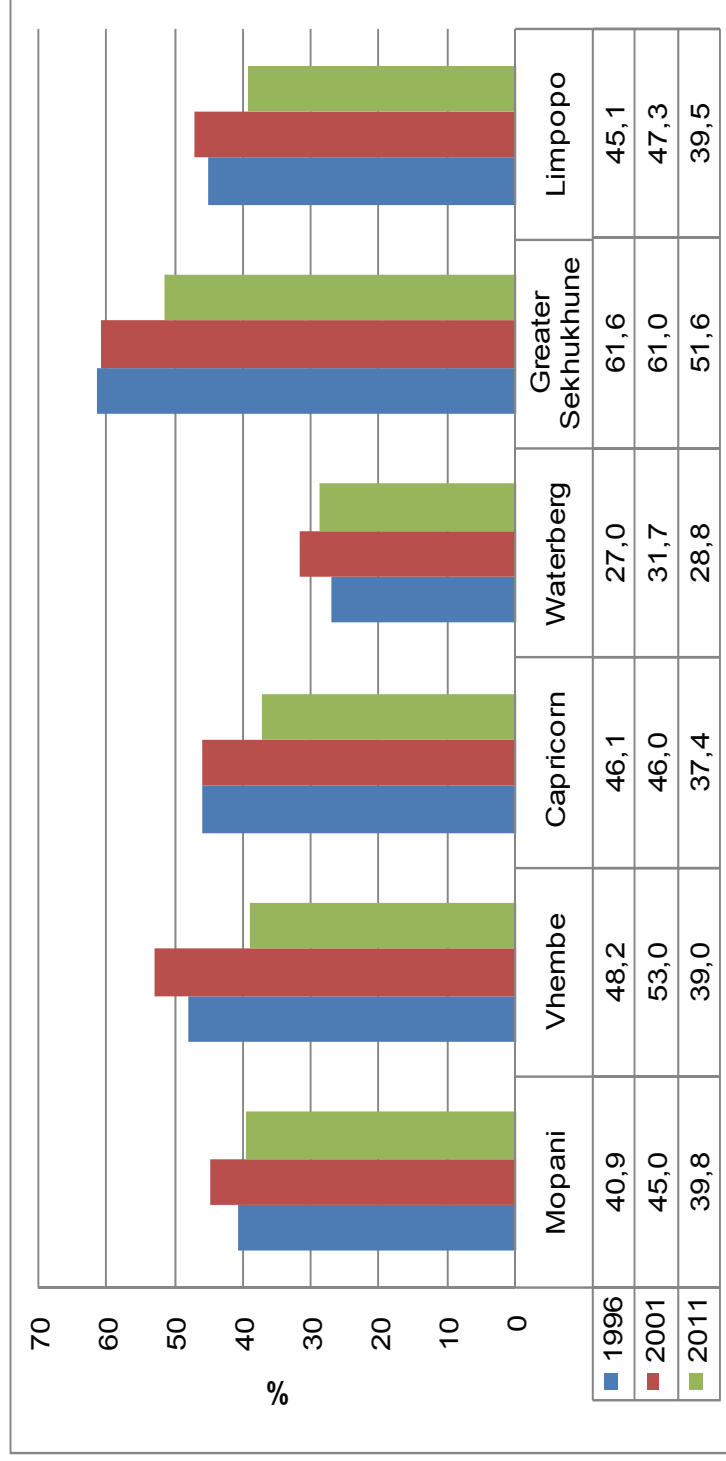


Figure 9.2.2.1 shows a general increase in the proportion of the population attending school across the province.

Trends in unemployment rate, as shown by Figure 9.3.1.1, suggest an increase between 1996 and 2001, and thereafter a decline across districts. **Readers are requested to heed the disclaimer in the introduction to this publication.**

9.4.1 Average household size

Figure 9.4.1.1: Average household size by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

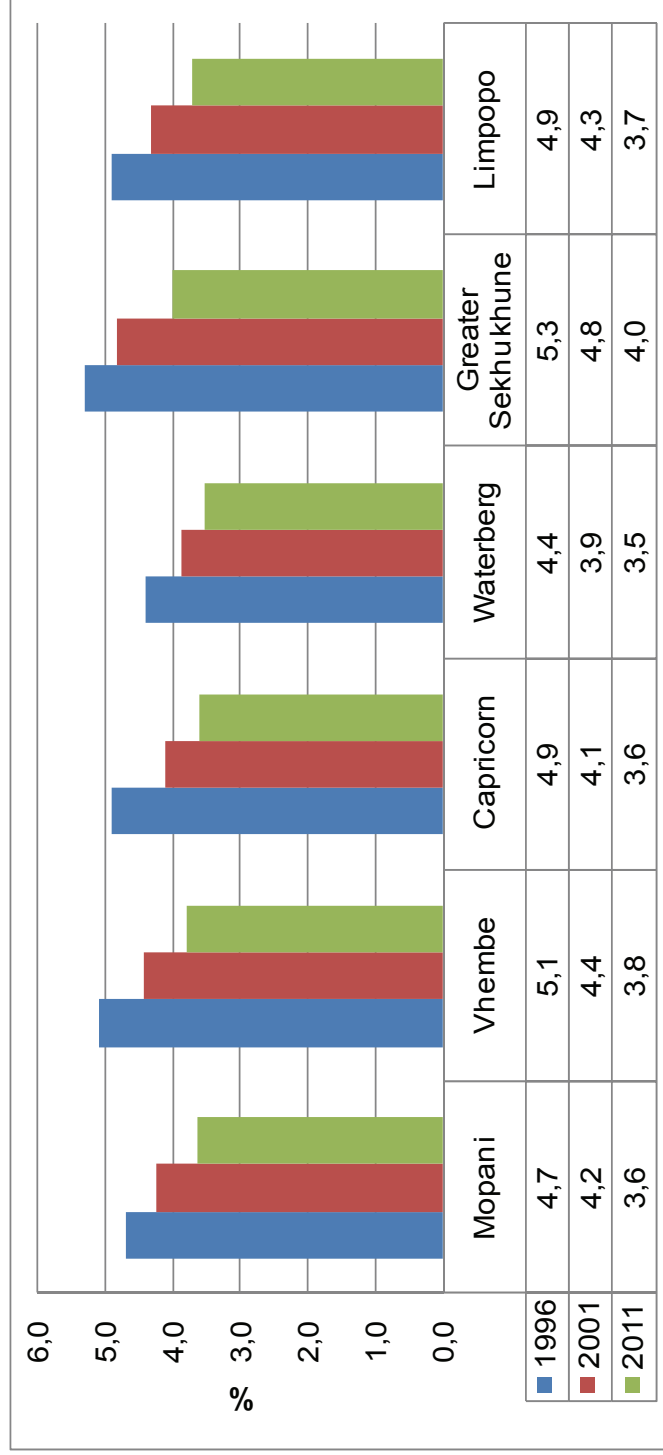


Figure 9.4.1.1 shows a decline in average household size. Greater Sekhukhune and Vhembe have a consistently higher than average household size.

9.4.2 Type of main dwelling

Figure 9.4.2.1: Percentage distribution of households by type of main dwelling and district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

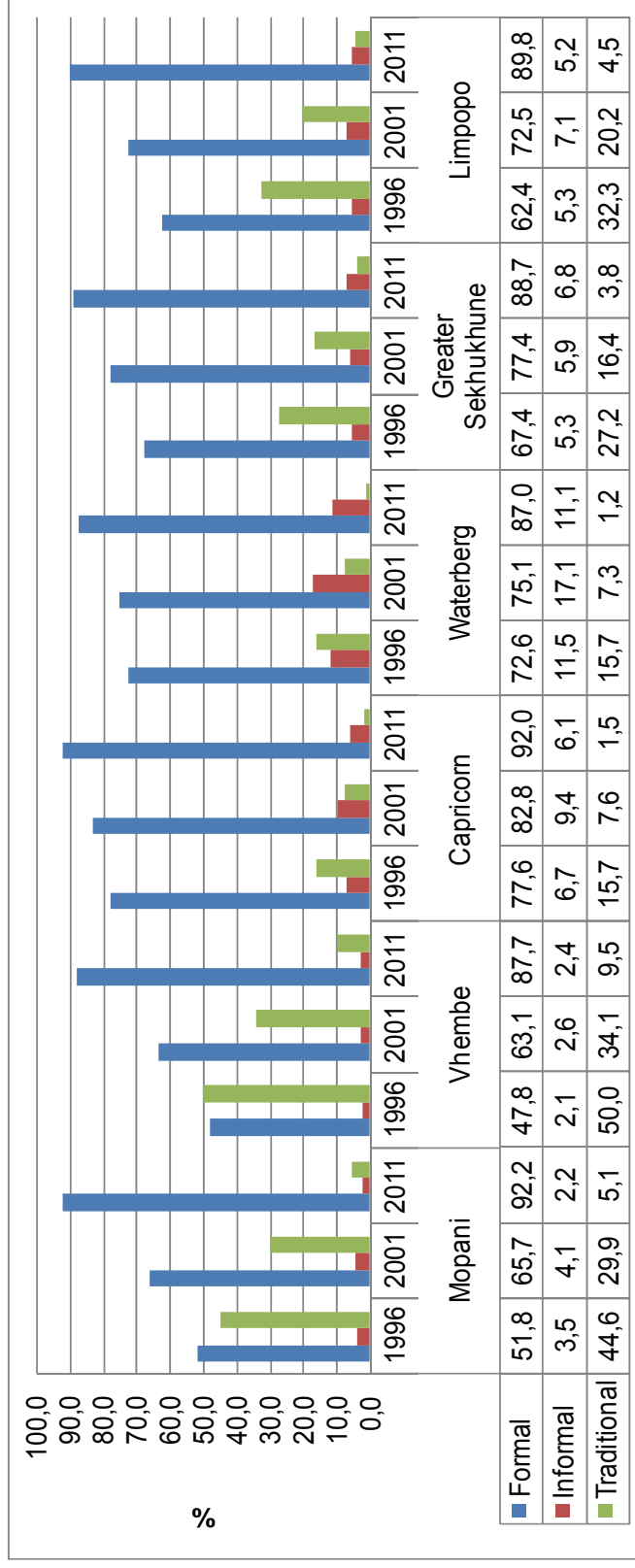
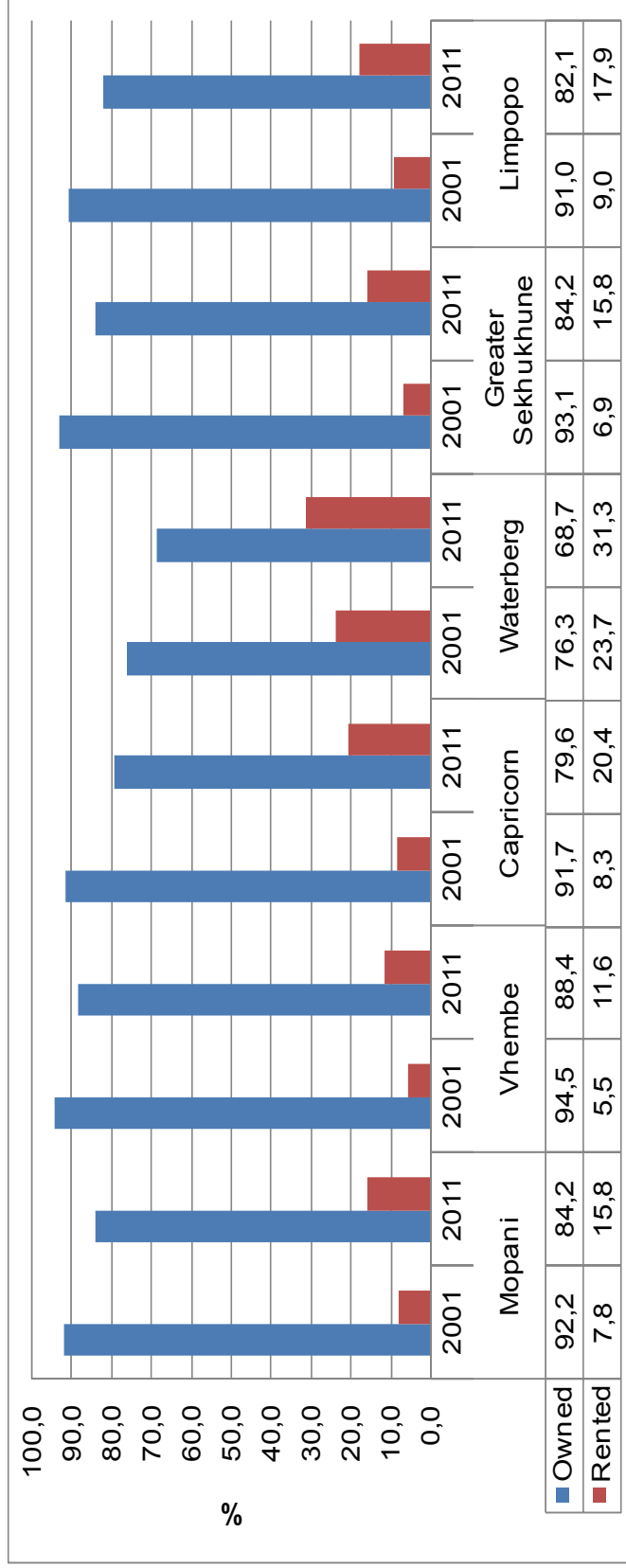


Figure 9.4.2.1 shows a significant increase in the proportion of households resident in formal dwellings across the province. Concomitantly, is the decline in traditional dwellings.

9.4.3 Tenure status

Figure 9.4.3.1 shows a decline in the proportion of households that own their dwellings except in Vhembe and Waterberg districts. On the other hand, the proportion of households whose dwellings are rented increased significantly.

9.4.4 Household goods

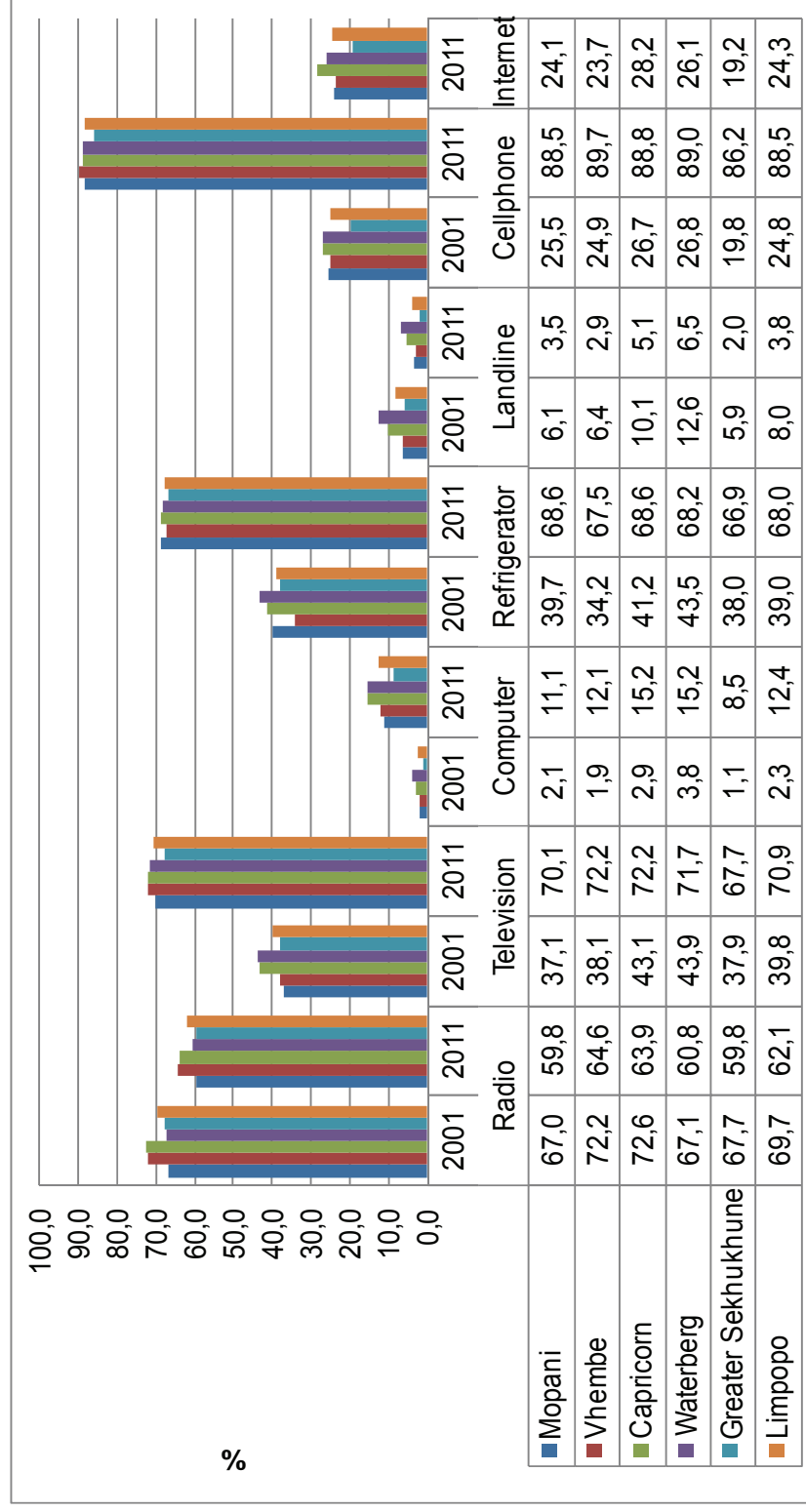


Figure 9.4.4.1 shows a decline in the proportion of households owning radios; landlines/telephones; an increase in the proportion of households owning televisions; computers; refrigerators and cell phones from 2001 to 2011. The proportion of households with access to internet is highest in Capricorn and Waterberg.

9.4.5 Electricity for lighting, heating and cooking

Figure 9.4.5.1: Distribution of households using electricity for lighting heating and cooking by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

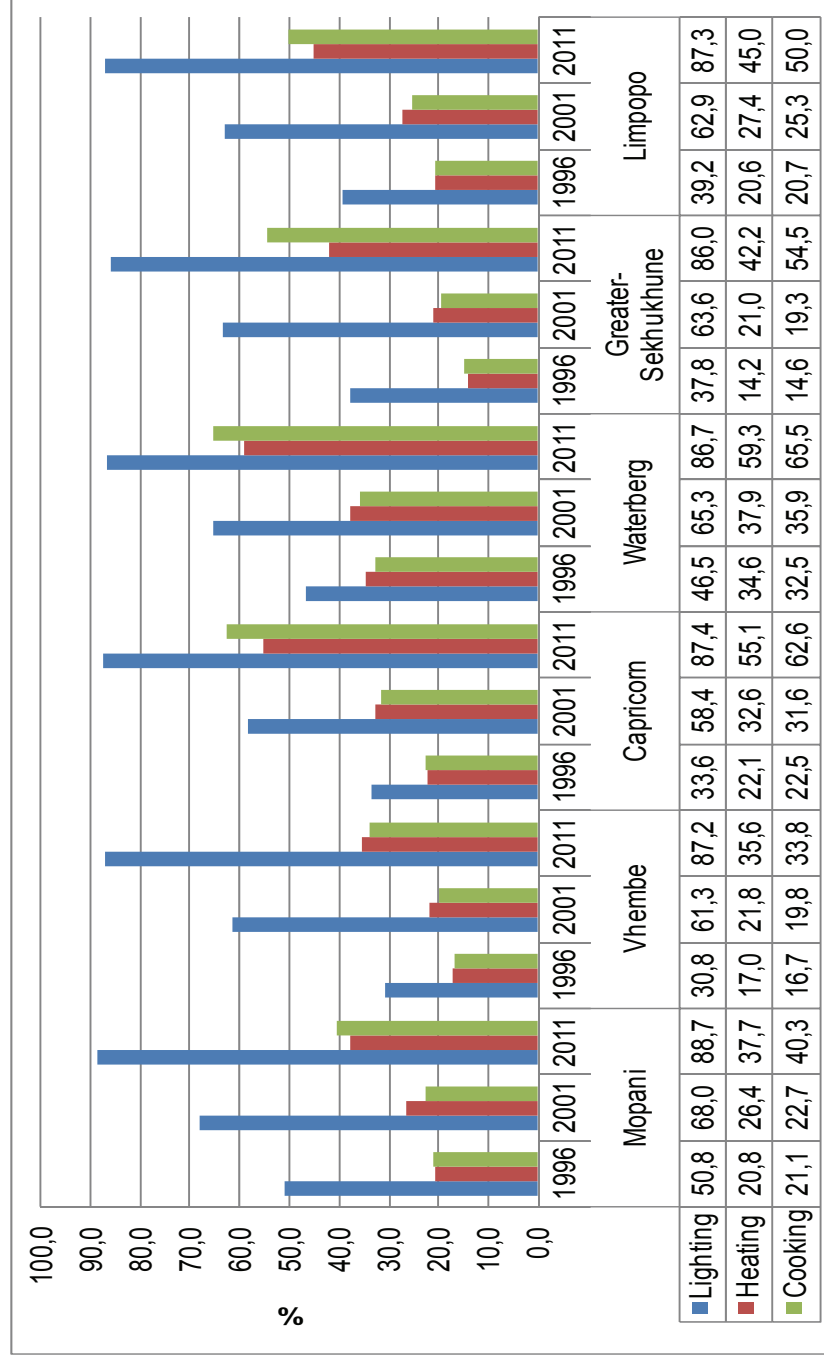


Figure 9.4.5.1 shows that over the period 1996–2011, the proportion of households using electricity as the main source of energy for lighting; heating and cooking increased significantly across the province.

9.4.6 Access to piped water

Figure 9.4.6.1: Percentage of households having access to piped water by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

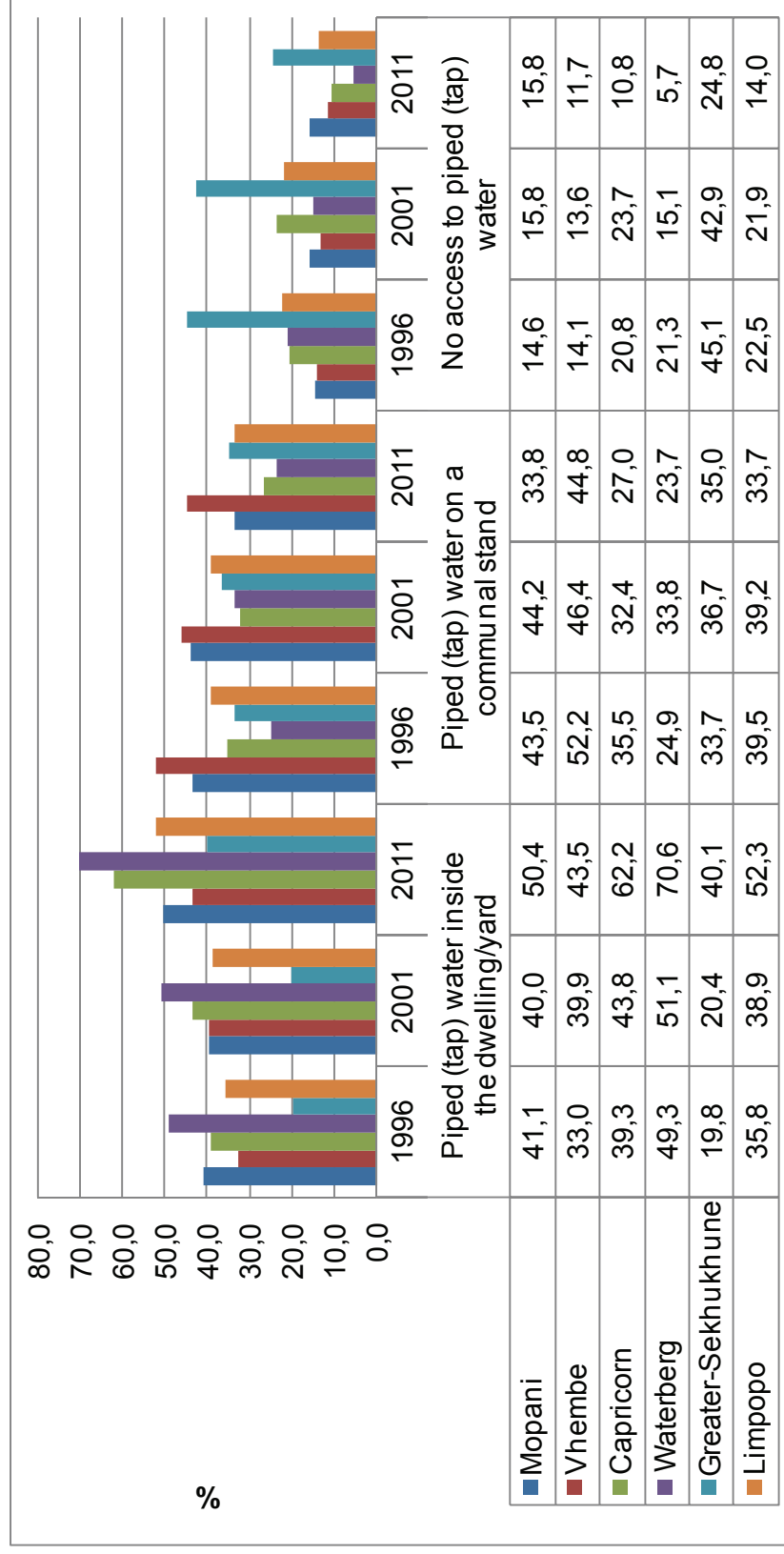


Figure 9.4.6.1 shows that the percentage of households with access to piped water inside the dwelling or yard has increased in all five districts. While the highest increase is seen in Greater Sekhukhune; the highest proportion of households with access to piped water is found in Waterberg. The proportions of households with access to piped water on a communal stand have declined; this is also true of households with no access to piped water, with the exception of Mopani. Waterberg district experienced the most decline in the proportion of households with no access to piped water, 21,3% in 1996 to 5,7% in 2011.

9.4.7 Refuse disposal

Figure 9.4.7.1: Distribution of households by type of refuse disposal and district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

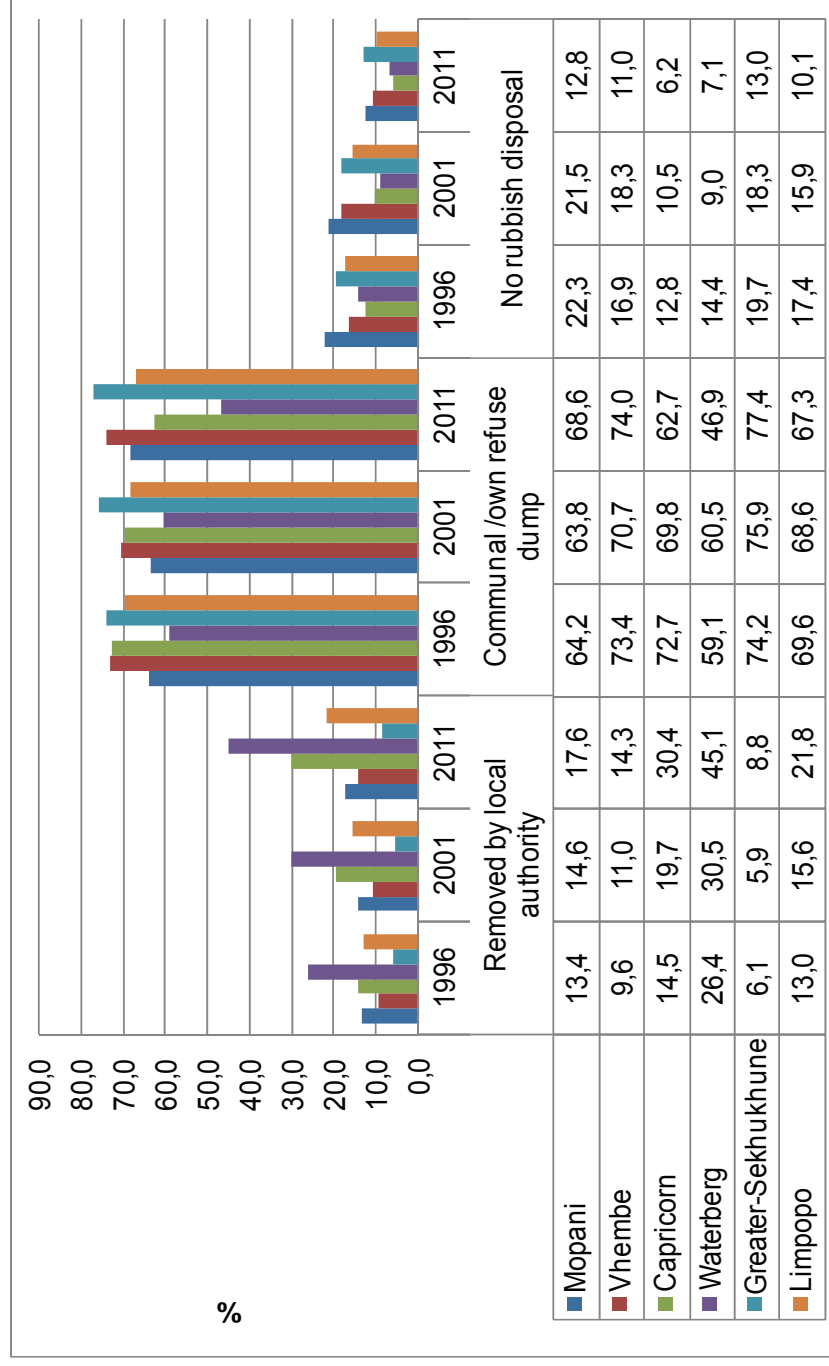


Figure 9.4.7.1 shows that the proportion of households whose refuse is removed by local authority or private increased in all districts; the highest proportion of households are seen in Capricorn and Waterberg districts. However; the majority of the households used communal or own refuse dump.

9.4.8 Toilet facilities

Figure 9.4.8.1: Percentage of households by type of toilet facility by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

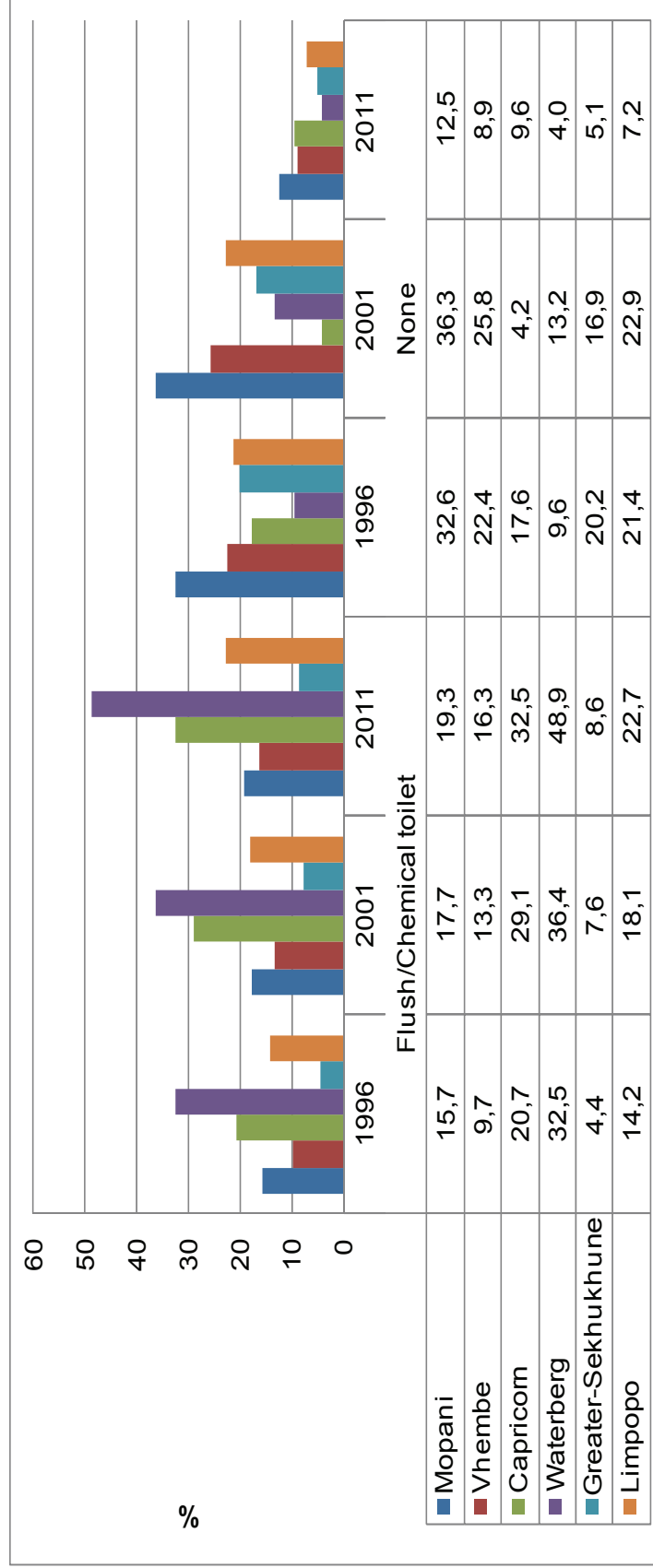


Figure 9.4.8.1 shows that the percentage of households with access to flush or chemical toilet has increased in all districts. On the other hand, the proportions with no access to a toilet facility decreased across the districts.

Figure 9.4.9.1: Distribution of average household income by district municipality – 2001 and 2011

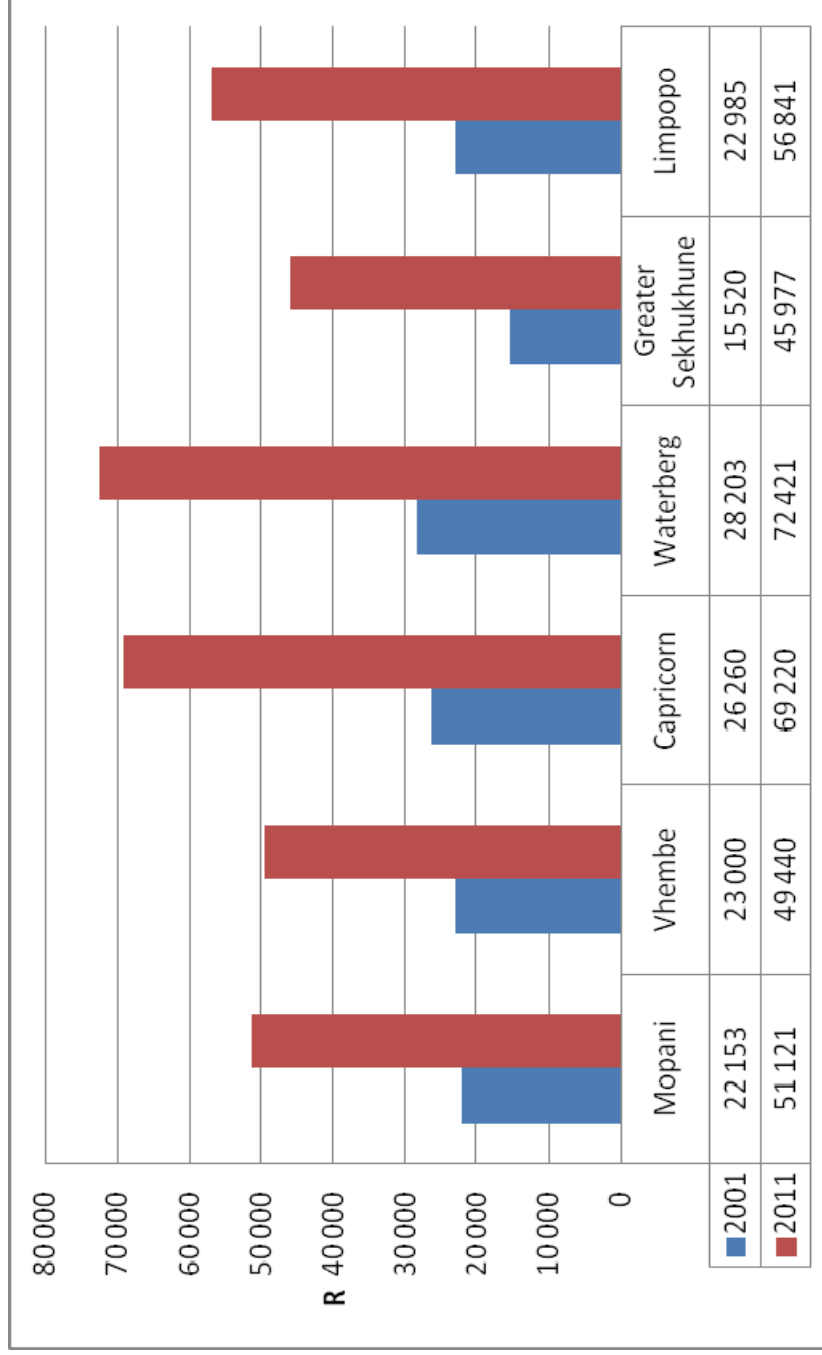


Figure 9.4.9.1 shows a more than 100% increase in the average household income in the province.

Figure 9.4.10.1: Distribution of female headed households by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

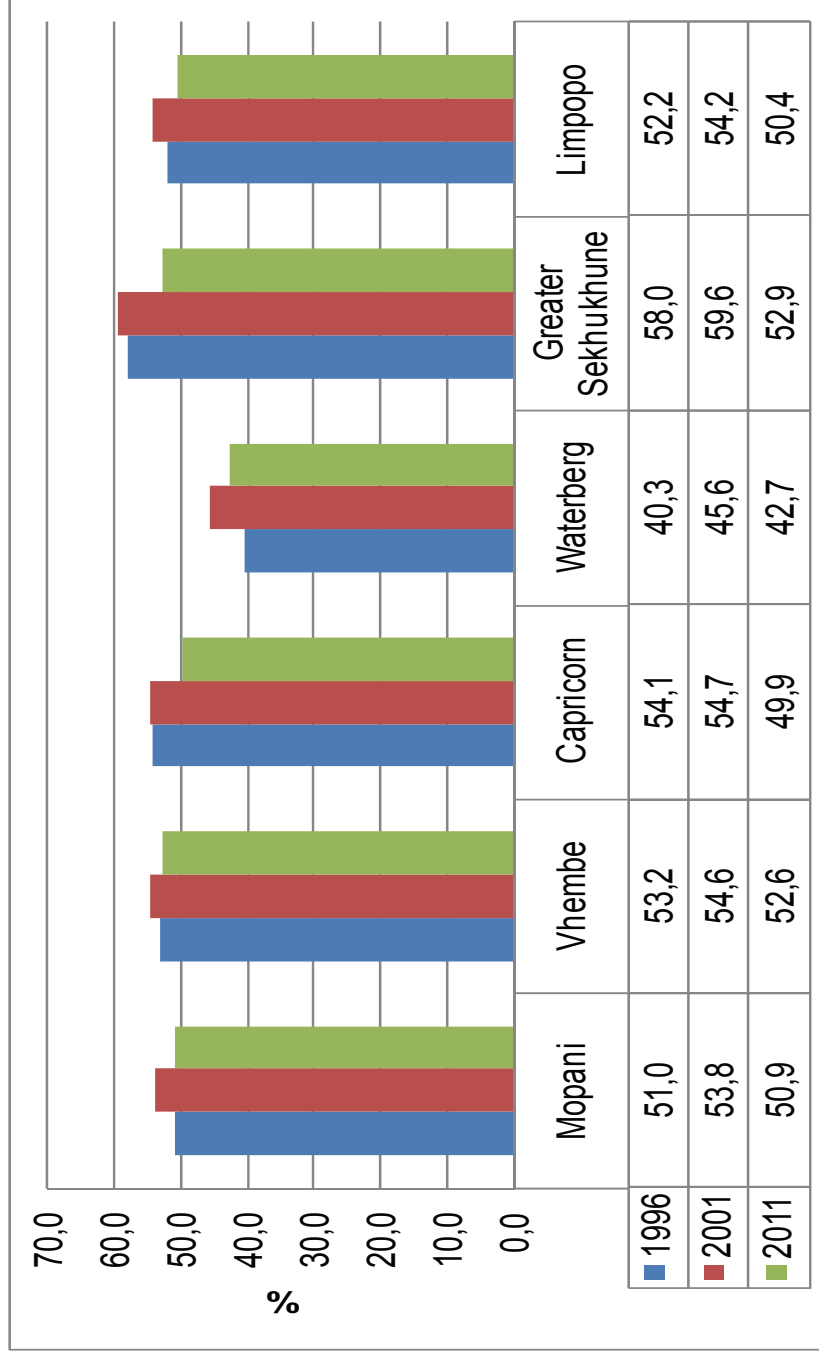


Figure 9.4.10.1 suggests that approximately 50% of the households are headed by females with Waterberg having the lowest proportion of female headed households in the province.

Figure 9.4.11.1: Distribution of child headed households by district municipality – Limpopo, 1996–2011

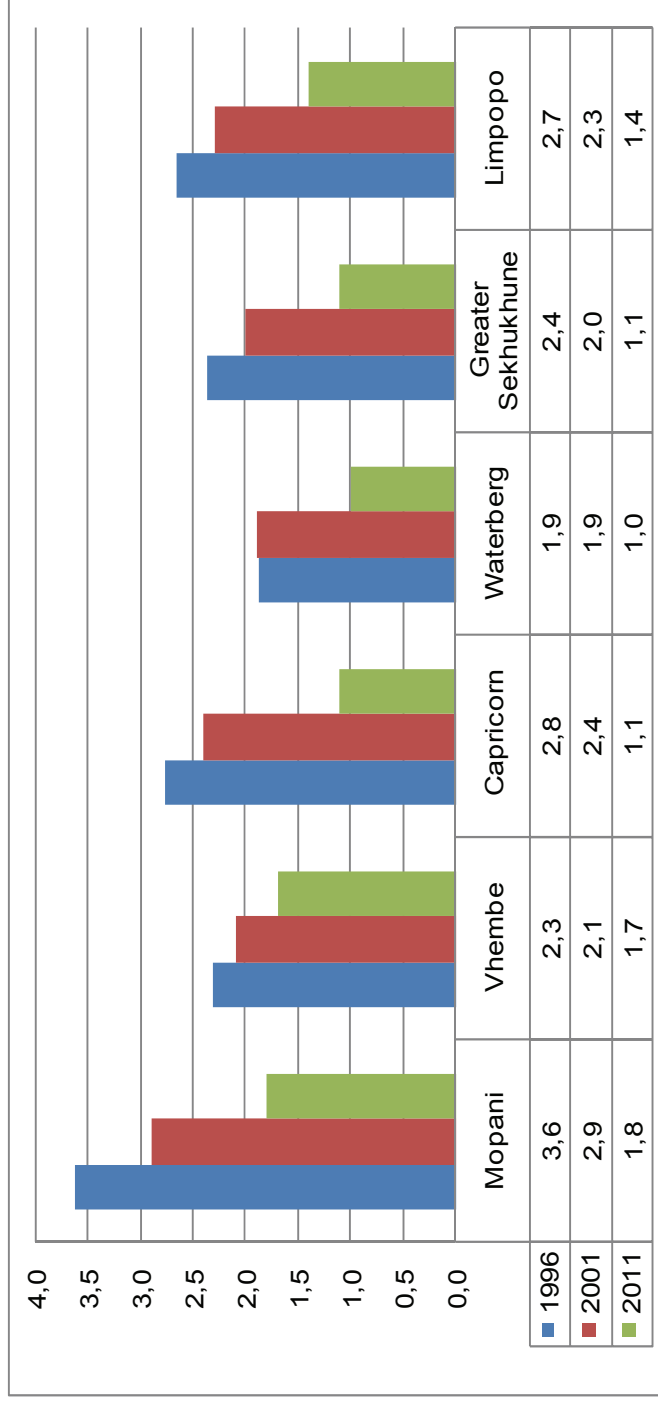


Figure 9.4.11.1 shows that the proportion of households headed by children has declined over the three epochs and across districts. Mopani and Vhembe districts consistently have the highest proportion of child headed households.
