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Northern Cape

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Introduction

South Africa has had three censuses since the first general elections in 1994. The first census was conducted in 1996, the second one followed five years later (2001), whilst the recent census was conducted just over a year ago (2011). In this publication, data from the three censuses are compared.

The following points are brought to the attention of the reader of this publication:

- Comparisons of the results of labour market indicators in the post-apartheid population censuses over time have been a cause for concern. Improvements to key questions over the years mean that the labour market outcomes based on the post-apartheid censuses have to be analysed with caution. Such analysis will be the subject of research published in a separate publication in 2013. The differences in the results over the years may be partly attributable to improvements in the questionnaire since 1996 rather than to actual developments in the labour market. The numbers published in this volume for the 1996, 2001 and 2011 censuses are therefore not comparable over time and are higher from those published by Statistics South Africa in the surveys designed specifically for capturing official labour market results.
- For purposes of comparison over the period 1996–2011, certain categories of responses to questions in the censuses of 1996, 2001 and 2011, have either been merged or separated.
- The tenure status question for 1996 has been dropped since the question asked was totally unrelated to that asked thereafter. Comparisons for 2001 and 2011 do, however, remain.
- All household variables are controlled for housing units only and hence, exclude all collective living arrangements as well as transient populations.
- The slight differences in totals for annual household income as compared to that published in the Statistical Release of Census 2011 are due to rounding.
- When making comparisons of any indicator it must be taken into account that the time period between the first two censuses is five years, and that between the second and third censuses is ten years. Although the census captures information at one given point in time, the period available for an indicator to change is different.

3. Northern Cape

3.1 Demographics

3.1.1 Age-sex structure of province

Population pyramids indicates the age-sex structure of the population. Figure 3.1.1.1 to 6 suggest a general increase in the number of people in the older ages.

Figure 3.1.1.1: Distribution of the population by age and sex, Northern Cape – 1996, 2001 and 2011

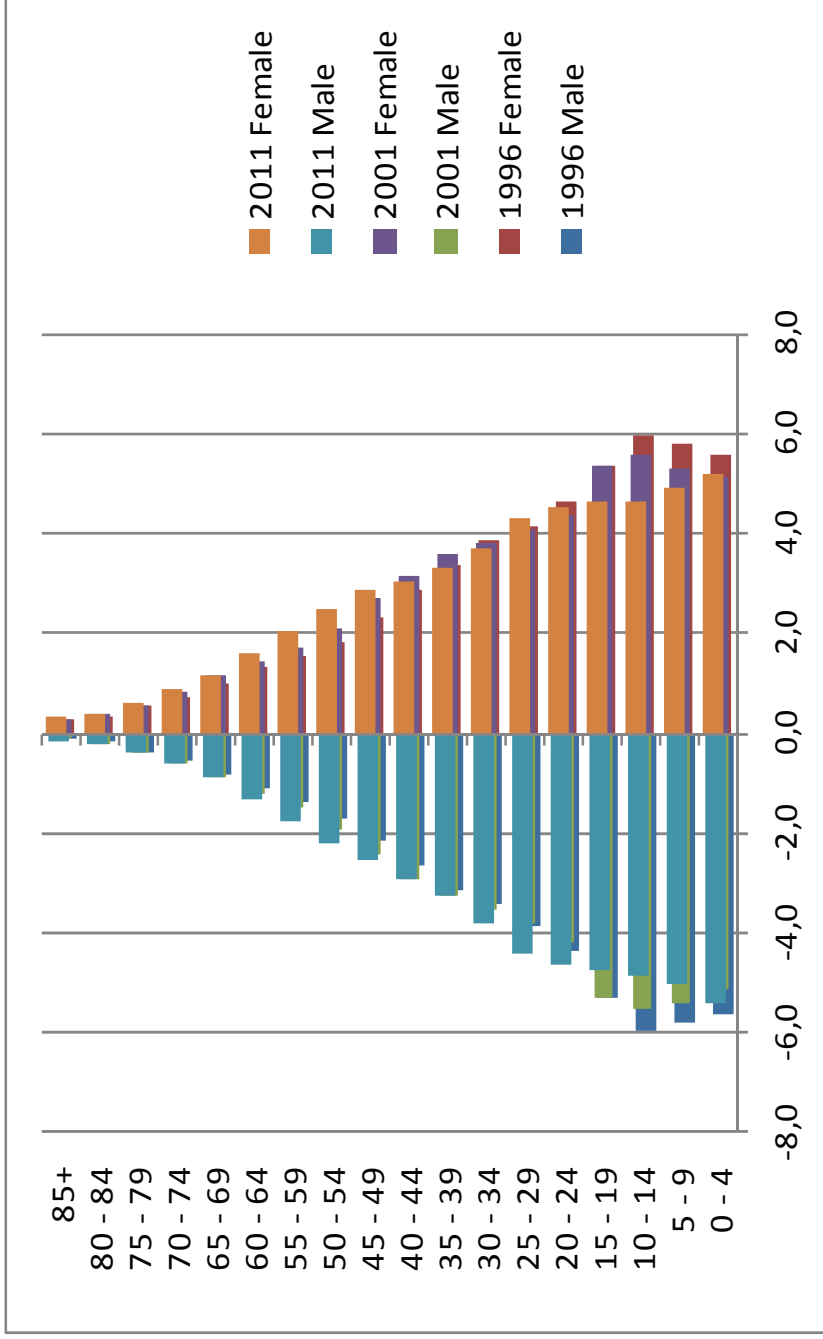


Figure 3.1.1.2: Distribution of the population by age and sex, Namakwa – 1996, 2001 and 2011

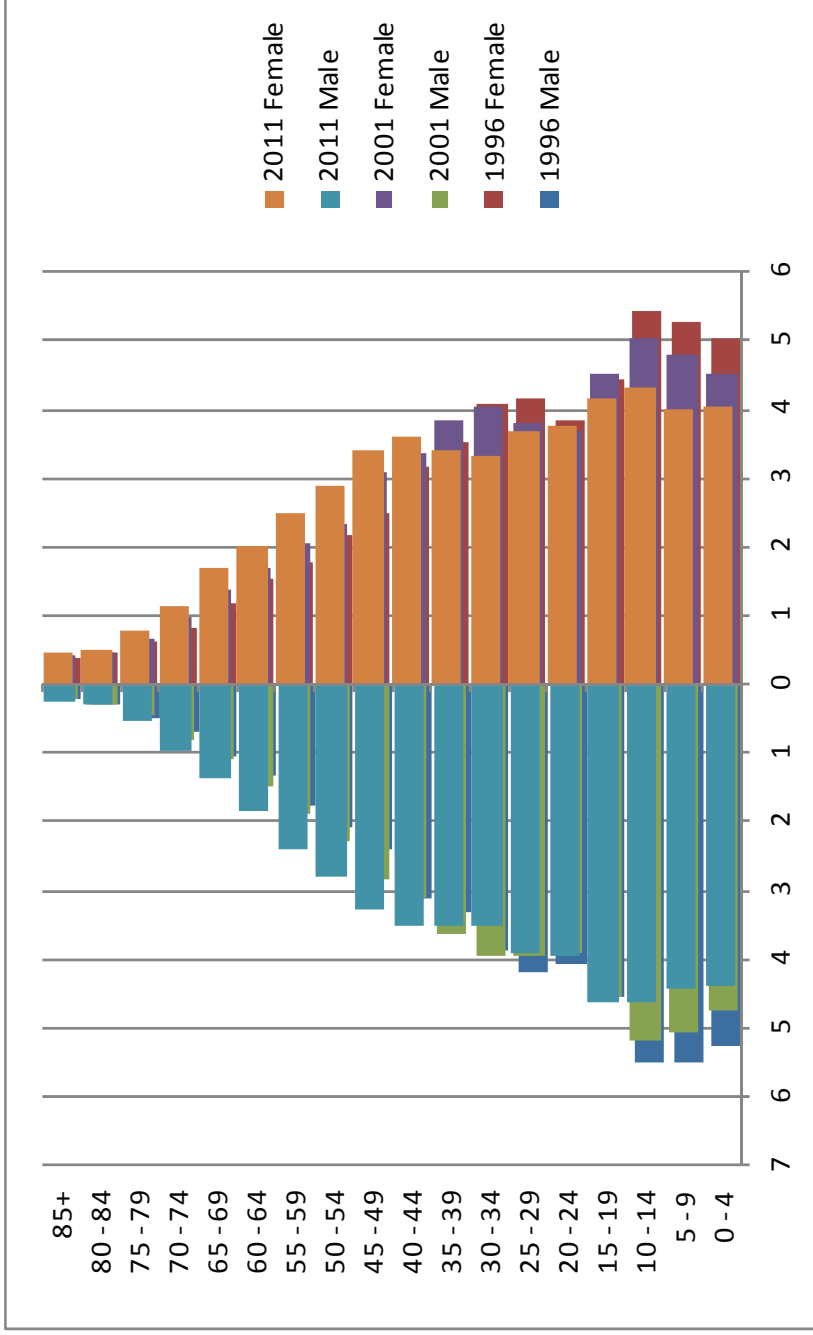


Figure 3.1.1.3: Distribution of the population by age and sex, Pixley ka seme – 1996, 2001 and 2011

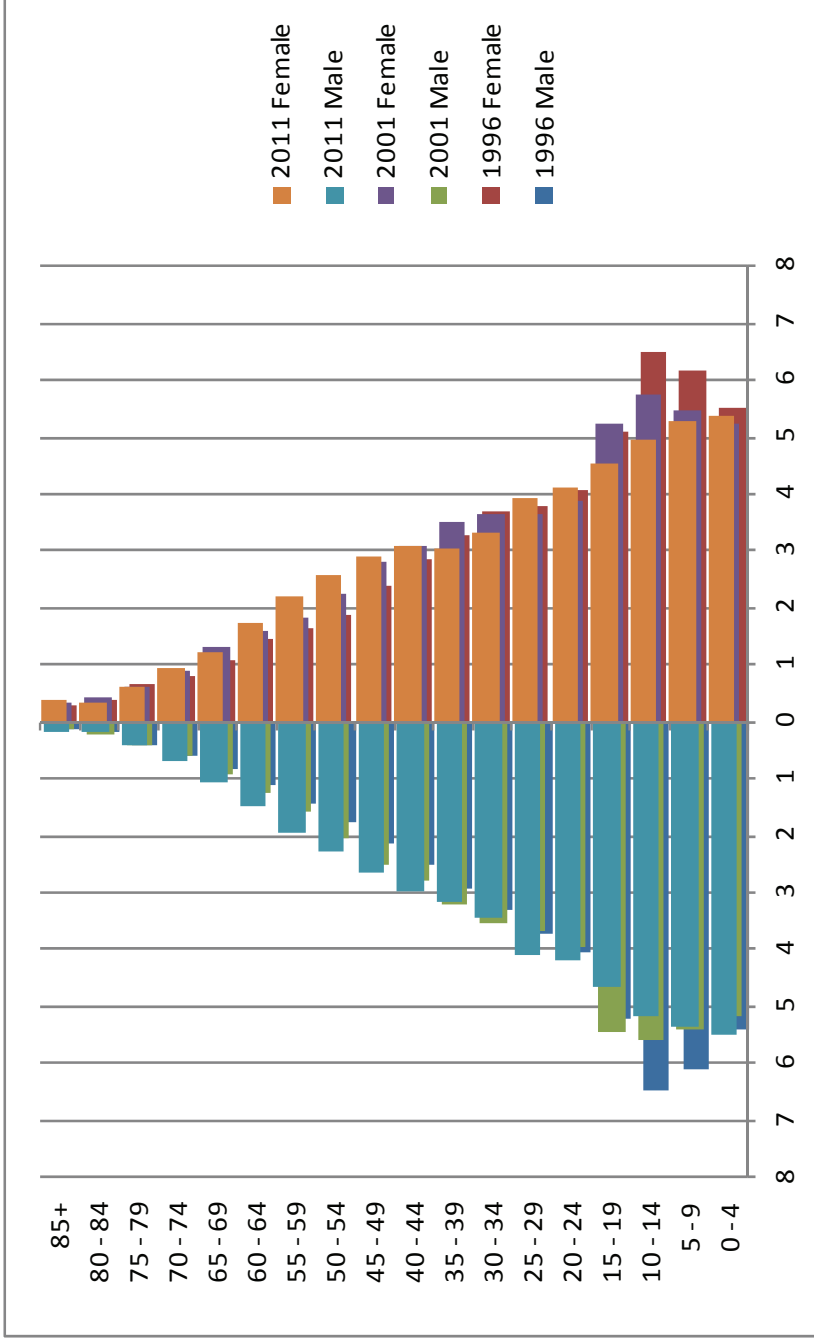


Figure 3.1.1.4: Distribution of the population by age and sex, Siyanda – 1996, 2001 and 2011

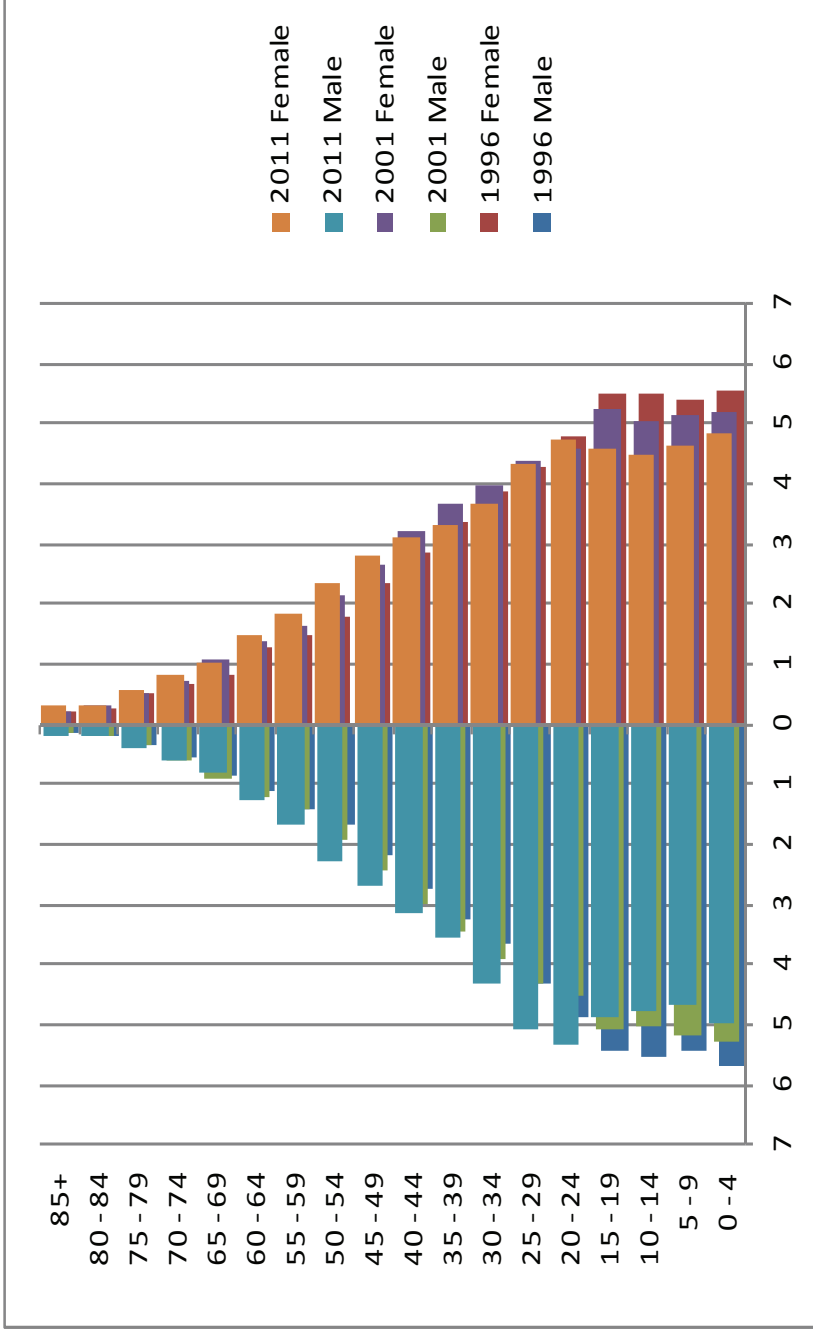


Figure 3.1.1.5: Distribution of the population by age and sex, Frances Baard – 1996, 2001 and 2011

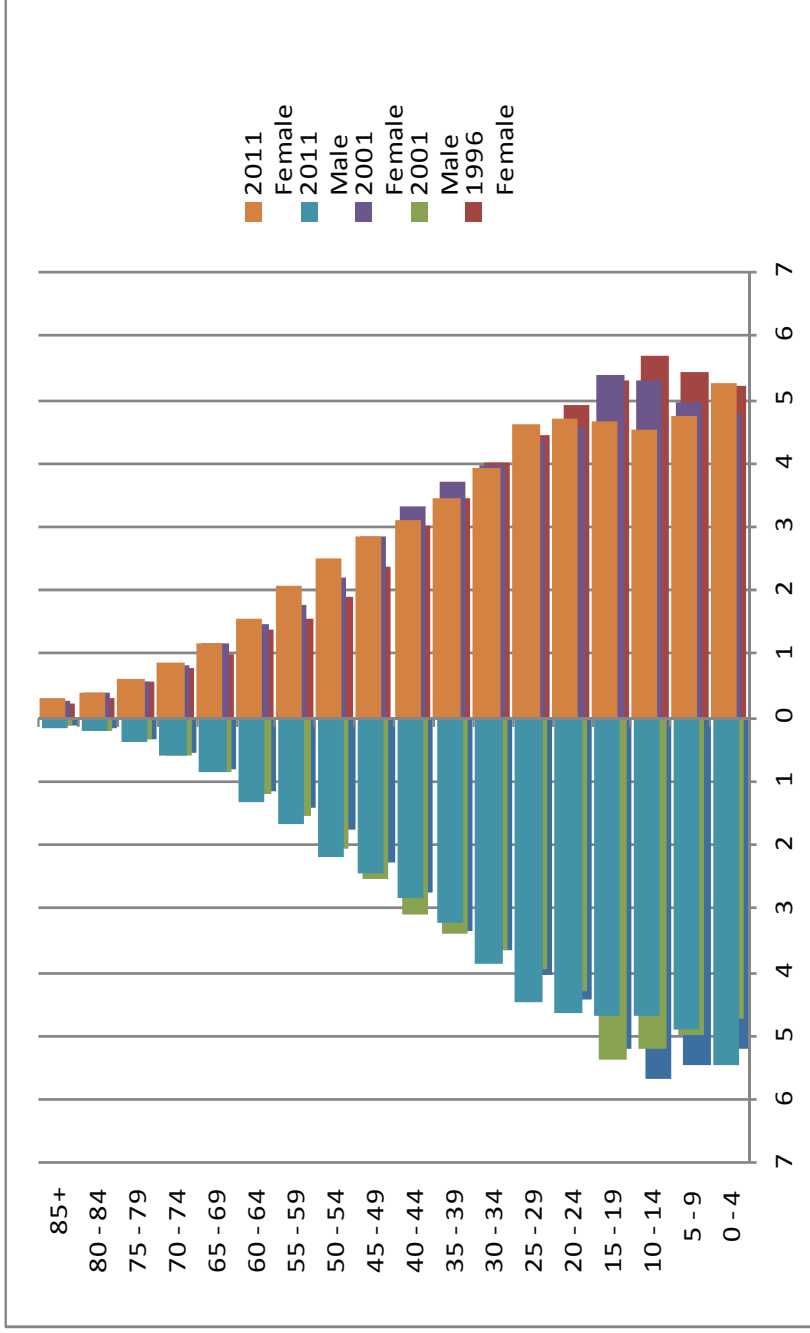
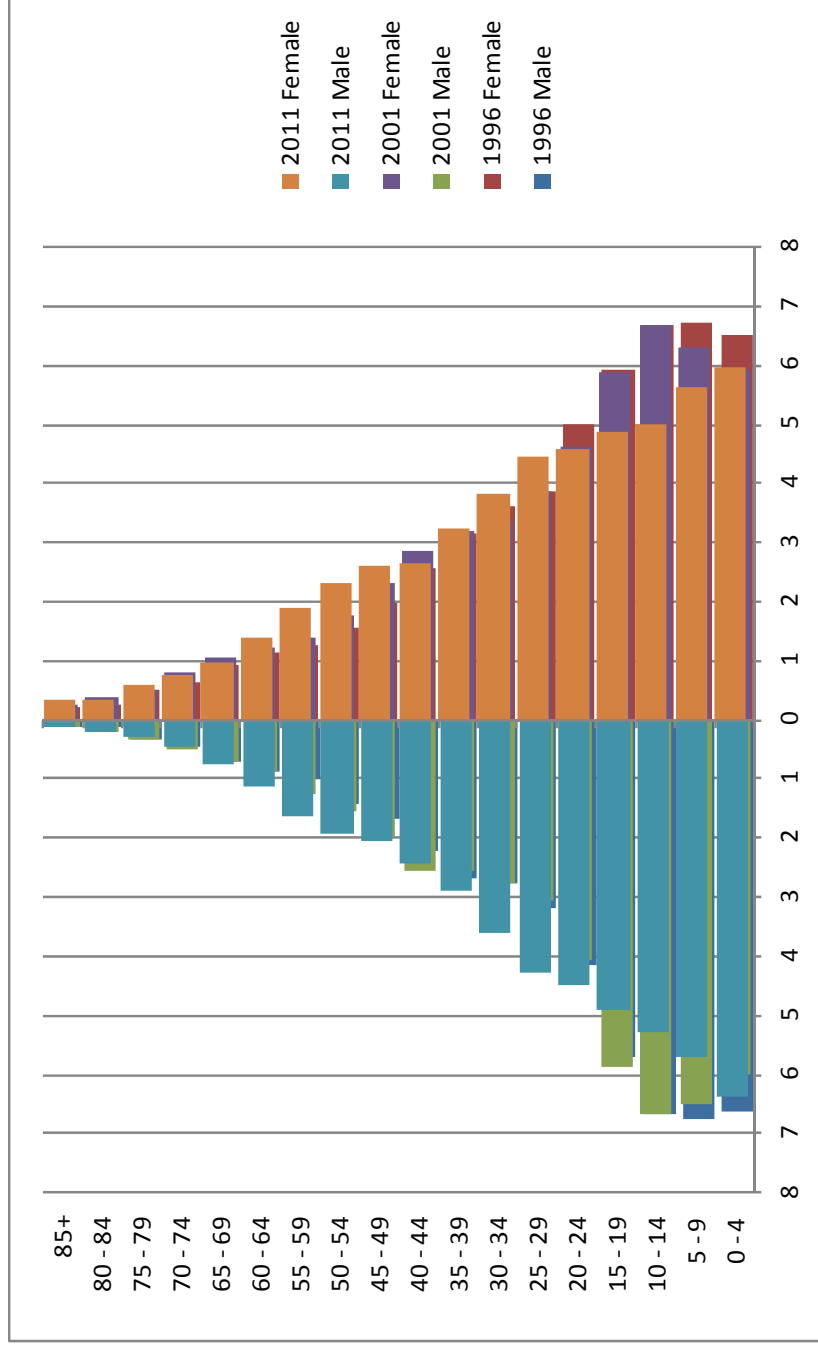


Figure 3.1.1.6: Distribution of the population by age and sex, John Taolo Gaetsewe – 1996, 2001 and 2011



3.1.2 Population growth rates

Figure 3.1.2.1: Population growth rates by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

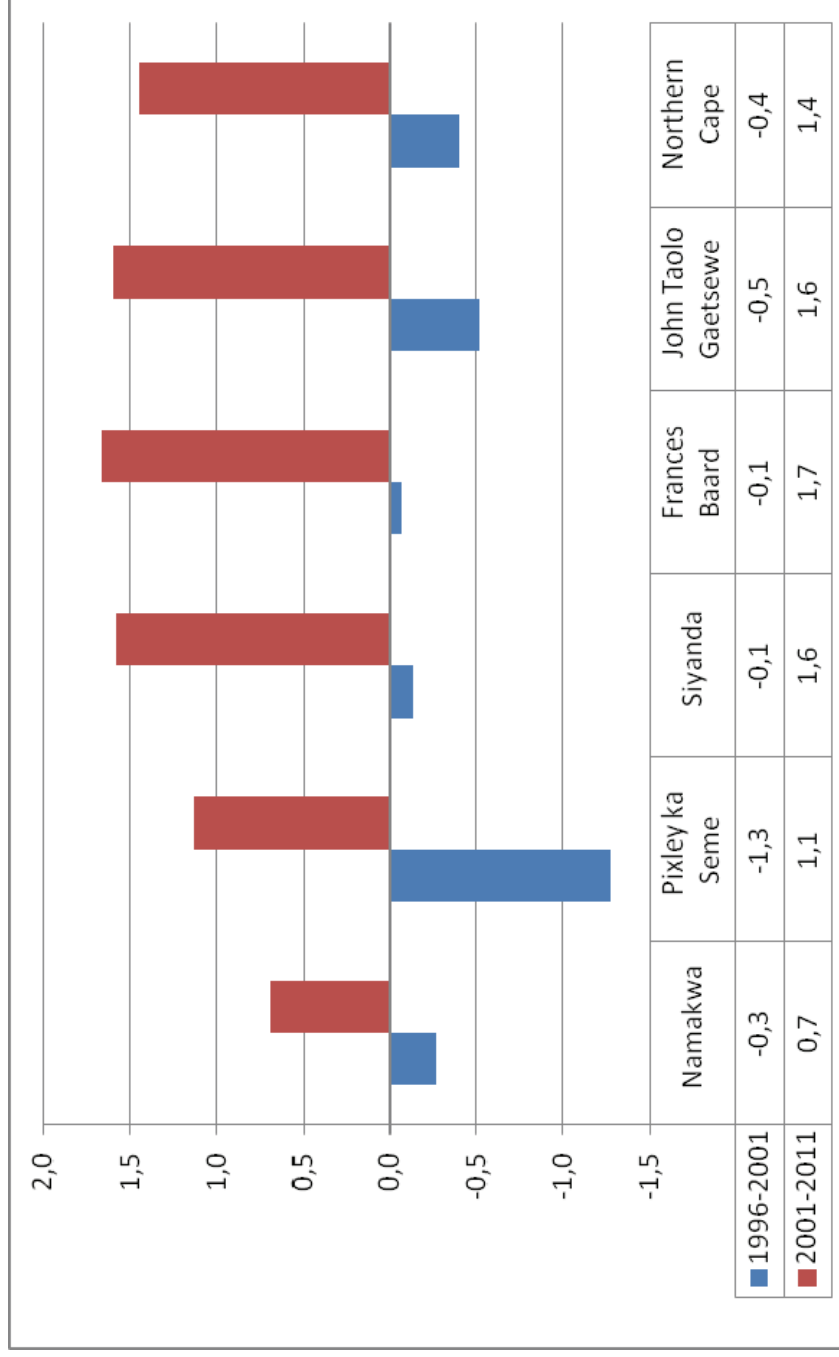


Figure 3.1.2.1 shows that the population growth was negative across all districts between 1996 and 2001. However in the period 2001 and 2011 all the districts recorded a positive growth.

3.1.3 Sex ratios

Figure 3.1.3.1: Sex ratios by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

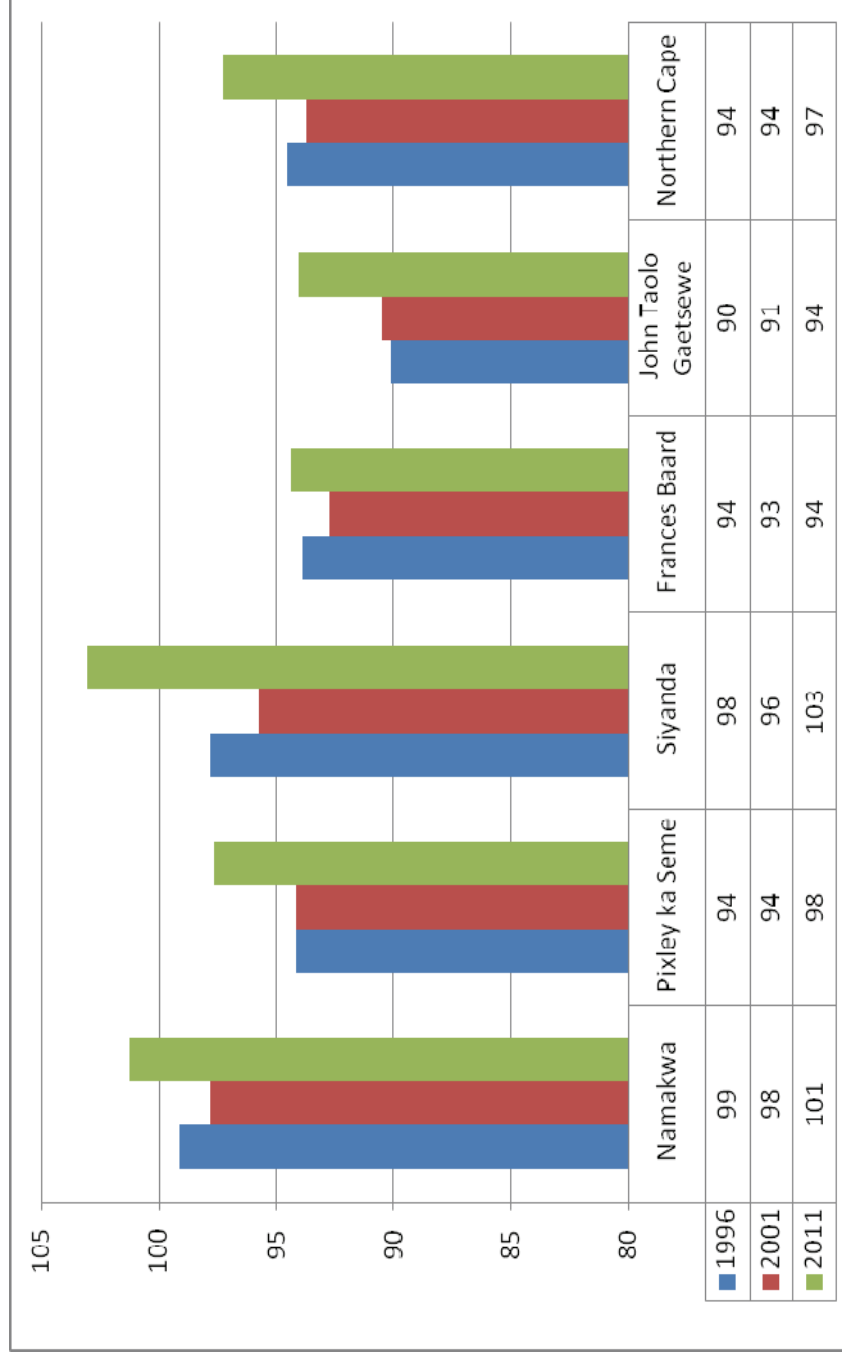


Figure 3.1.3.1 shows that there are more females than males across all districts except in Namakwa and Siyanda districts in 2011.

3.1.4 Population group

Figure 3.1.4.1: Distribution of the population by population group and district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

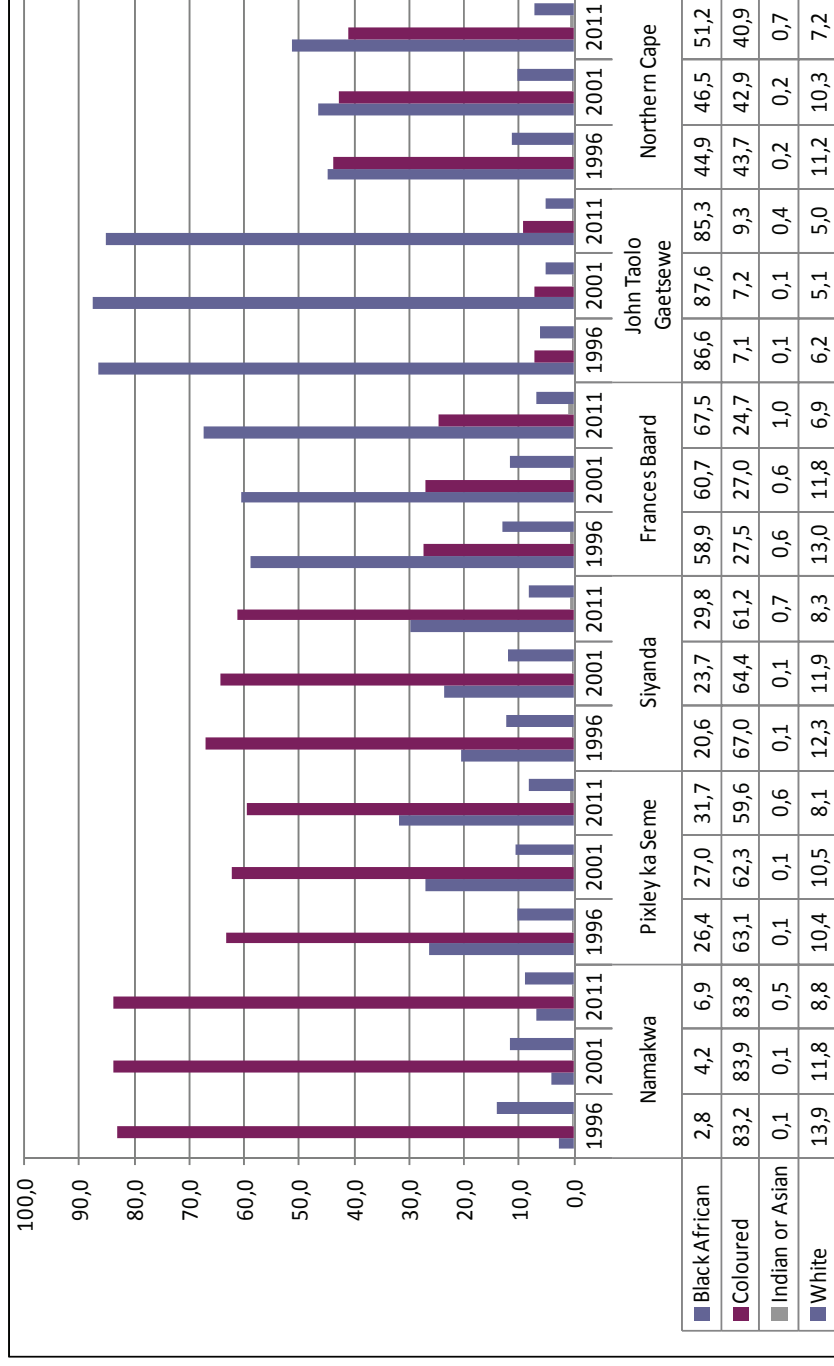


Figure 3.1.4.1 above, shows that the Black African population group constitute the majority in the province, though there are disparities across districts. The Coloured population constitute the majority in all the districts except in Frances Baard and John Taolo Gaetsewe. The Black African population group increased while the White population declined over time. The Indian/ Asian population remained constant between 1996 and 2001, but increased in 2011.

3.1.5 Functional age groups

Figure 3.1.5.1: Distribution of the population by functional age groups and district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

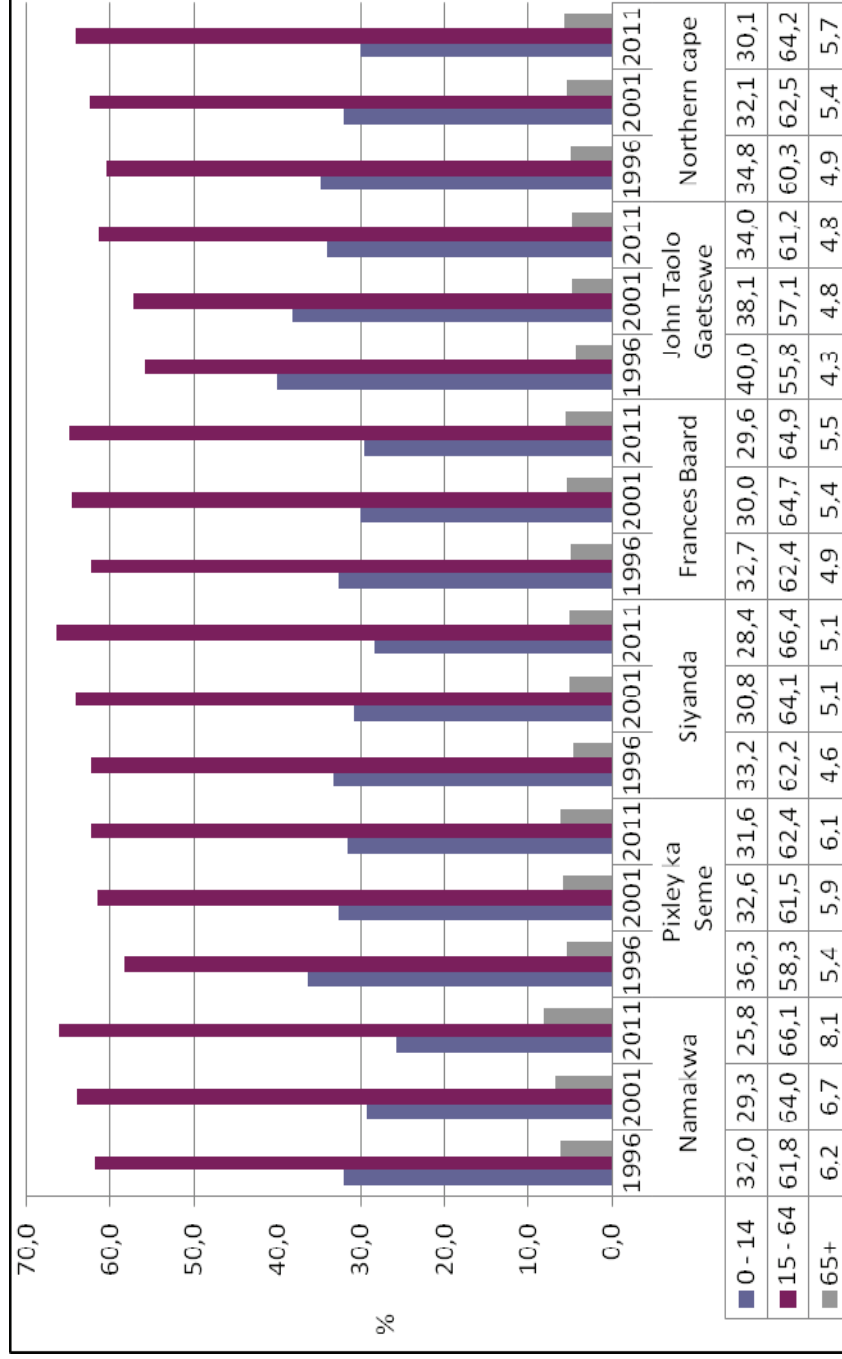


Figure 3.1.5.11 shows a consistent decline in the proportion of the population aged 0-14 years and an increase in the proportion of the population aged 15-64 and 65+ in the province over time.

3.1.6 Dependency ratios

Dependency ratios provide insights into the burden borne by those who are in the working age group (15–64) to support those aged 0–14 and 65+ years.

From Figure 3.1.6.1 above, it is observed that the dependency ratios have decreased across all districts. Pixley ka Seme and John Taolo Gaetsewe districts consistently have the highest dependency ratios in the province.

3.1.7 Marital status

Figure 3.1.7.1: Distribution of the population by marital status and district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

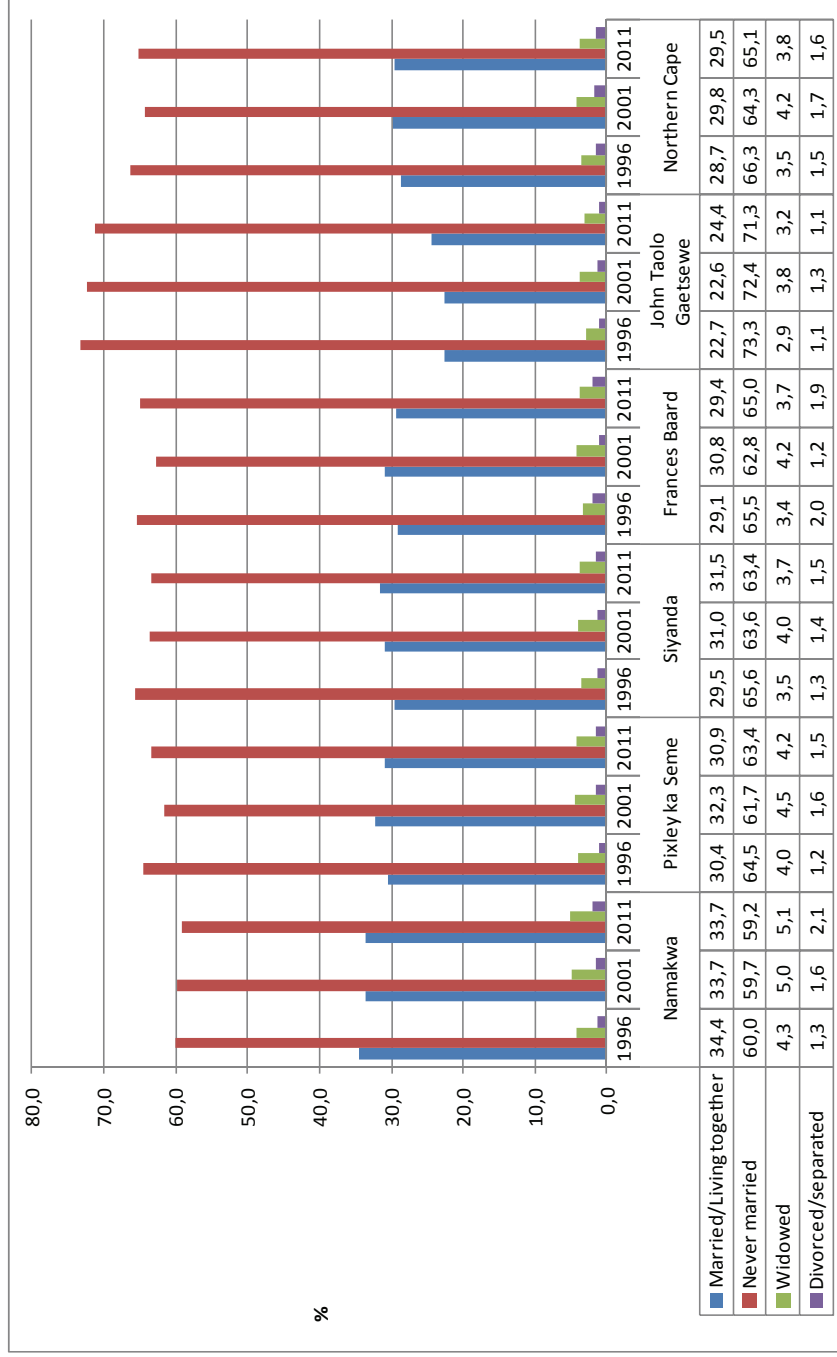


Figure 3.1.7.1 above shows that there is a higher proportion of the population that is never married compared to other marital statuses.

3.2 Education

3.2.1 Highest level of education attained

Figure 3.2.1.1: Distribution of the population aged 20 years and older by highest level of education and district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

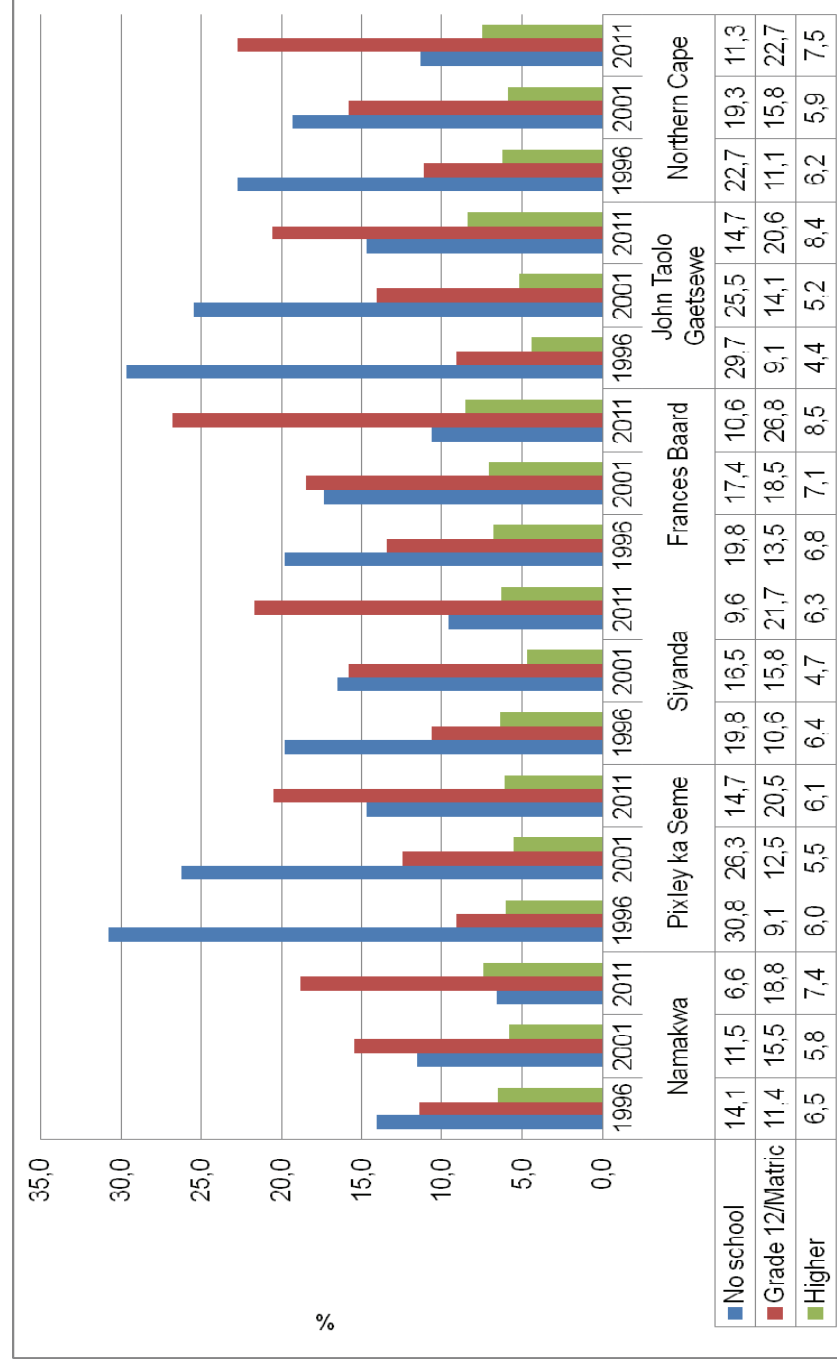


Figure 3.2.1.1 above suggests that the proportion with no schooling has declined significantly over time across all districts. The percentage of people who completed Grade 12/ Matric and higher education has increased. Frances Baard has the highest percentage with completed Grade 12/ Matric and higher education.

3.2.2 School attendance

Figure 3.2.2.1: Distribution of the population aged 5–24 attending school by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

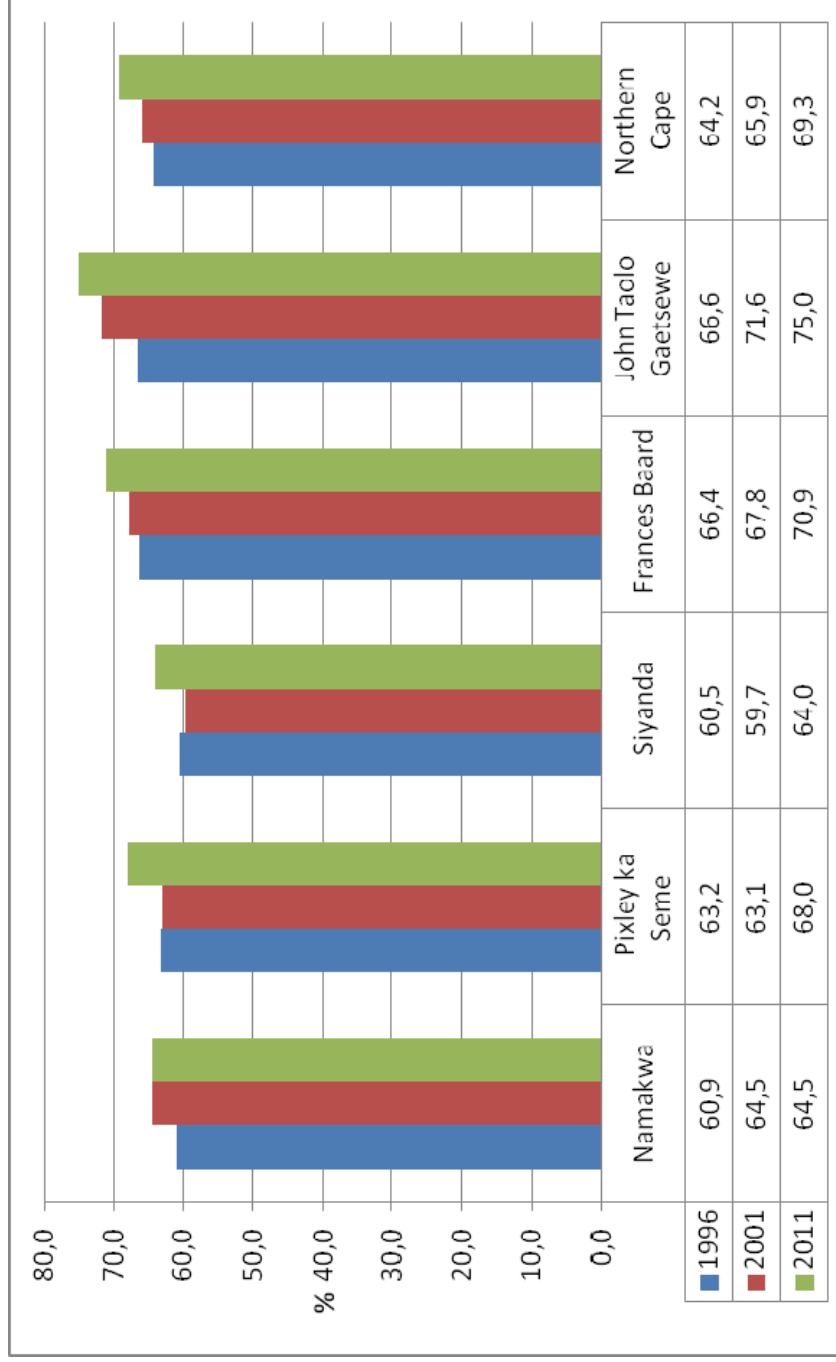


Figure 3.2.2.1 above shows an increase in the proportion of the population who attended school in the province. John Taolo Gaetsewe and Siyanda districts consistently have the highest and lowest proportions respectively.

3.3 Labour makert

3.3.1 Unemployment rate

Figure 3.3.1.1: Distribution of the population aged 15–64 by unemployment rate and district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

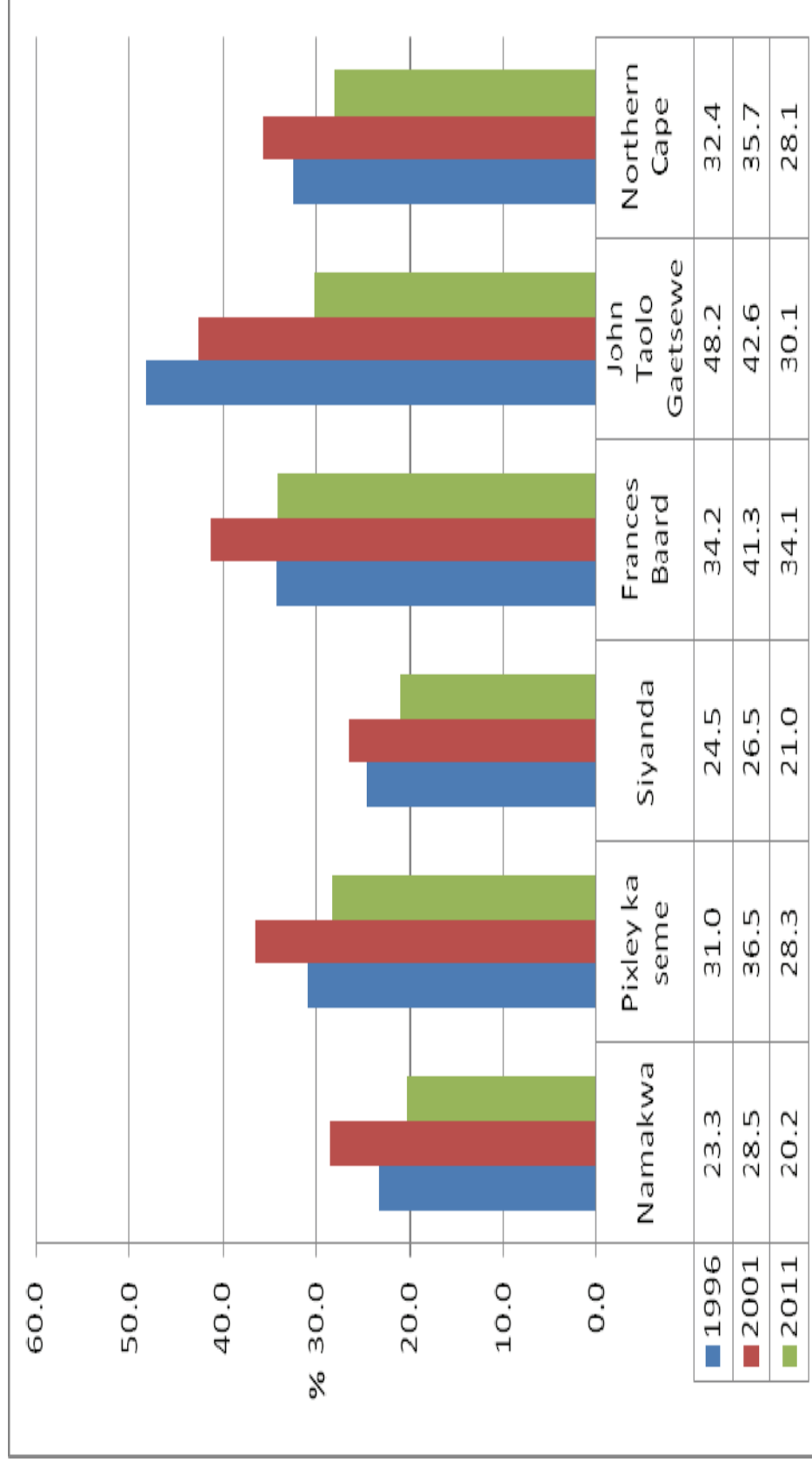


Figure 3.3.1.1 above suggests that the unemployment rate was highest in 2001 across all districts except for John Taolo Gaetsewe district which shows a consistent decline. **Readers are requested to heed the disclaimer in the introduction to this publication.**

3.4 Housing

3.4.1 Average household size

Figure 3.4.1.1: Average household size by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

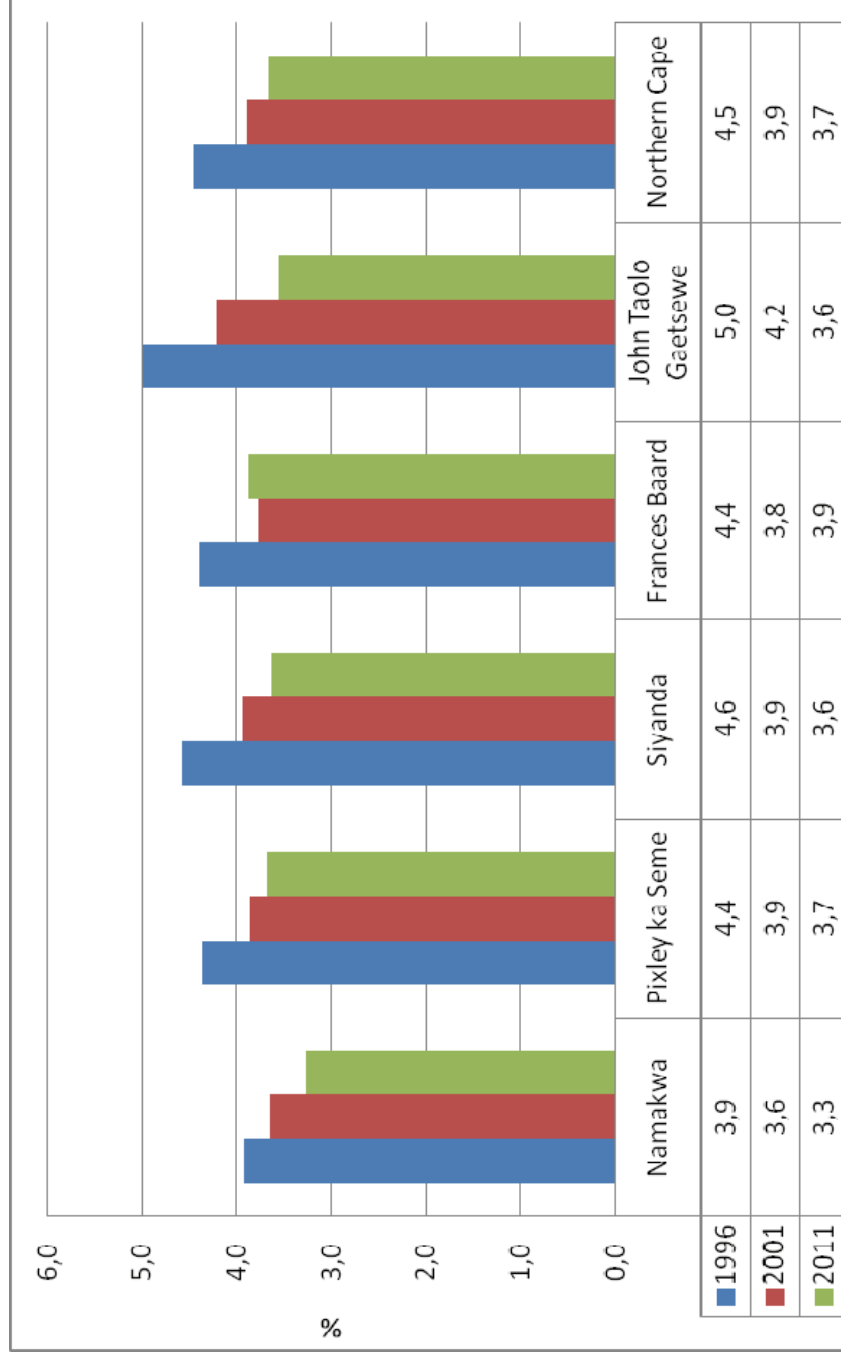


Figure 3.4.1.1 above shows that the average household size in Northern Cape has decreased over time. Namakwa district consistently has the lowest average household size in the province.

3.4.2 Type of main dwelling

Figure 3.4.2.1: Distribution of households by type of main dwelling and district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

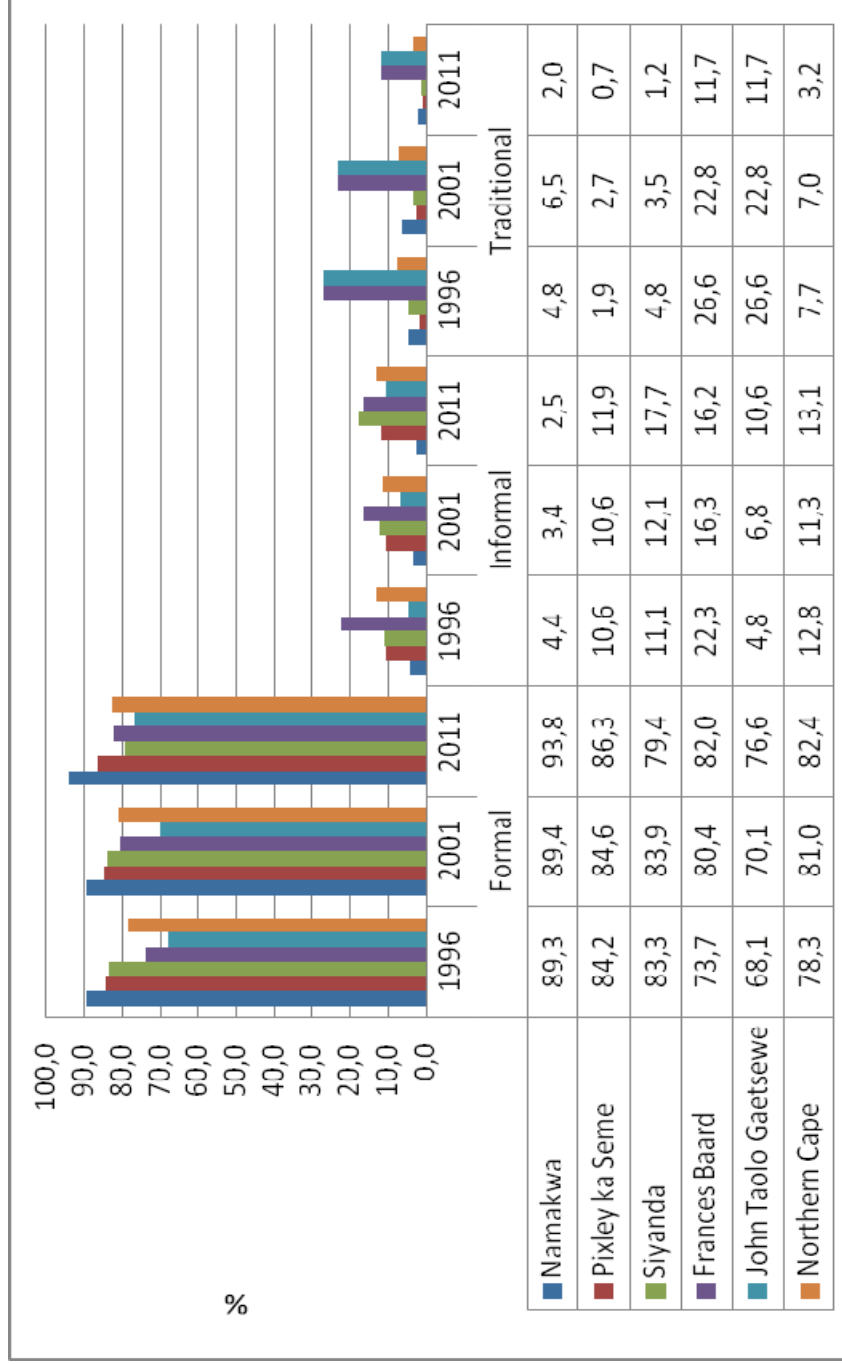
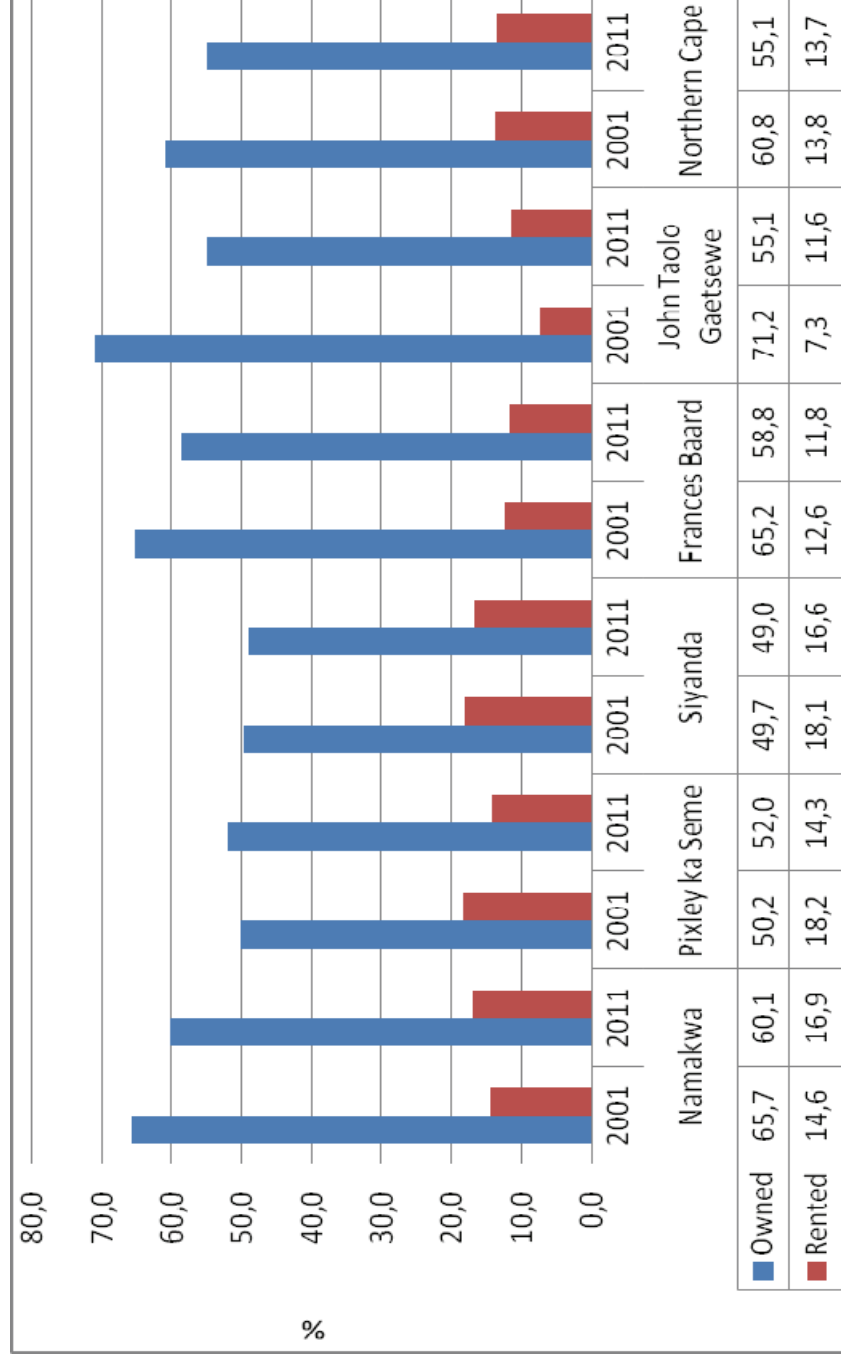


Figure 3.4.2.1 shows that the majority of households reside in formal dwellings and the highest proportion is found in Namakwa district. The proportion of households residing in traditional dwellings has significantly declined across the province.

3.4.3 Tenure status

Figure 3.4.3.1 above shows that the proportion of households who own their dwellings have declined with the exception of Pixley ka Seme district. Only Namakwa and John Taolo Gaetsewe districts have recorded an increase in the proportion of households with rented dwellings.

3.4.5 Electricity for lighting, heating, and cooking

Figure 3.4.5.1: Distribution of households using electricity for lighting, cooking and heating by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

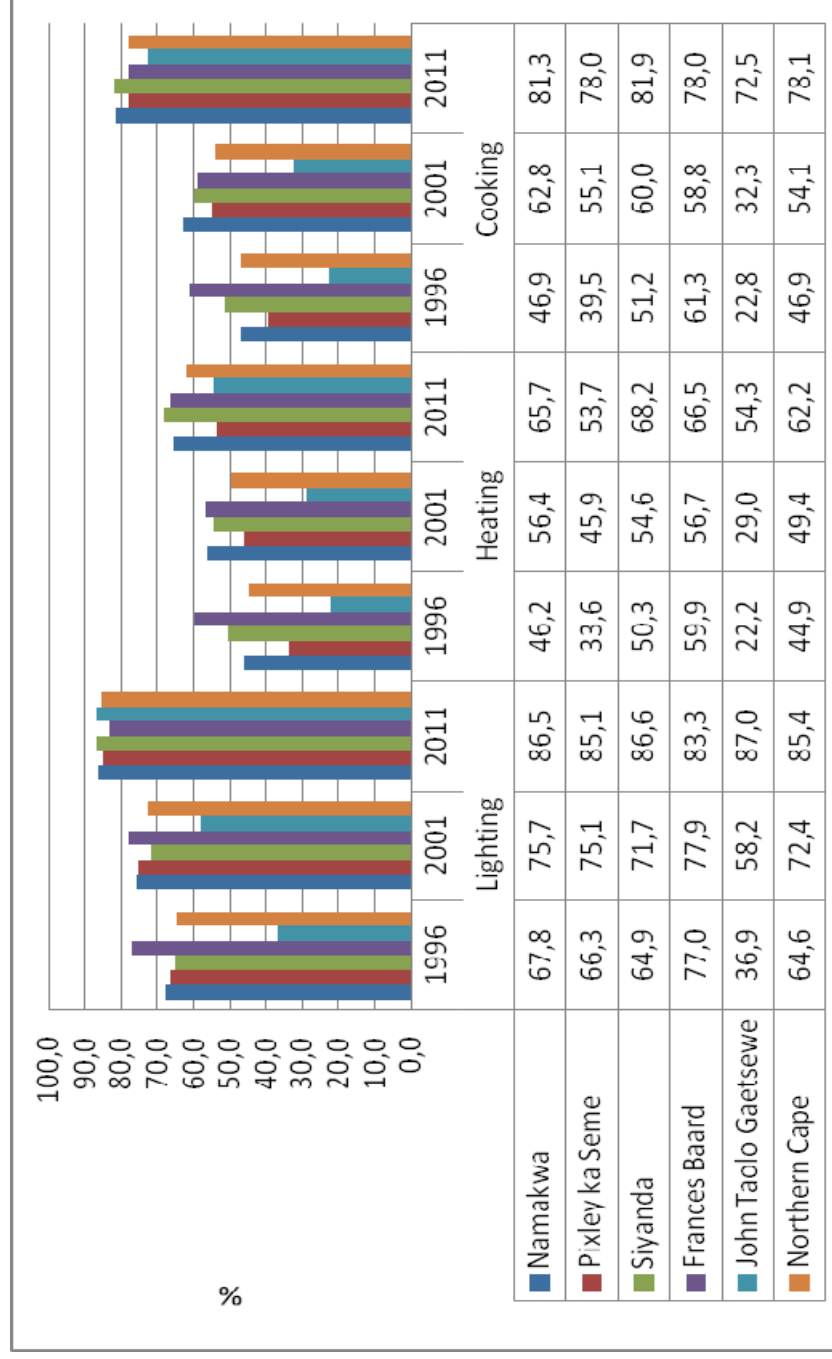


Figure 3.4.5.1 shows that over the period 1996–2011, the proportion of households using electricity as the main source of energy for lighting; heating and cooking increased in the province. Electricity is predominantly used as a source of lighting and cooking.

3.4.6 Access to piped water

Figure 3.4.6.1: Distribution of households having access to piped (tap) water by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

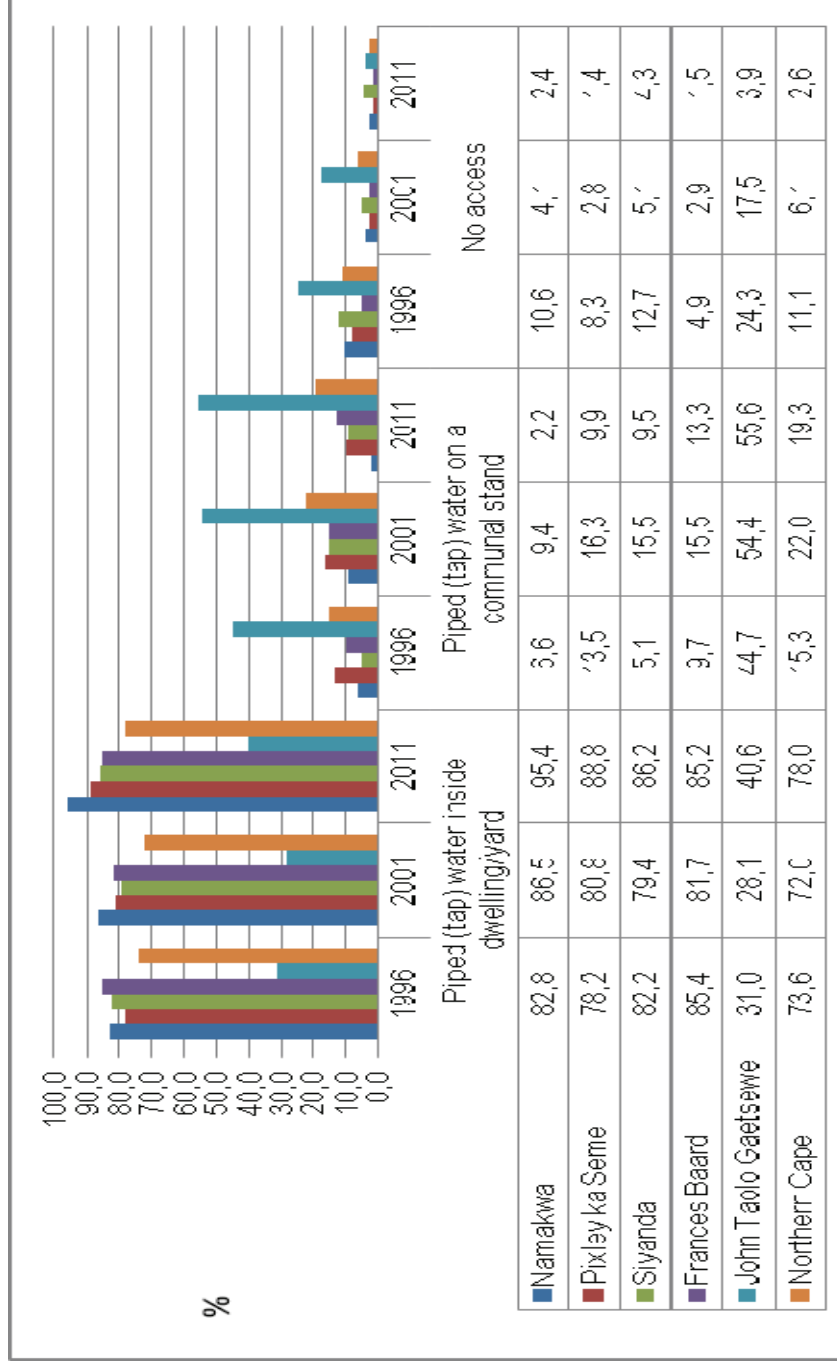


Figure 3.4.6.1 shows that the percentage of households with access to piped water inside the dwelling or yard has increased over time. There is however huge disparities in the province; Namakwa has 95% of the households with access to piped water inside the dwelling or yard and John Taolo Gaetsewe district has only 40%. The percentage of households with access to piped water on a communal stand was highest in 2001 and showed a decline in 2011 across all districts with the exception of John Taolo Gaetsewe district which has consistently increased over time and has the highest percentage in the province. A significant decline is observed in the percentage of households with no access to piped water across the districts.

3.4.7 Refuse disposal

Figure 3.4.7.1: Distribution of households by refuse removal and district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

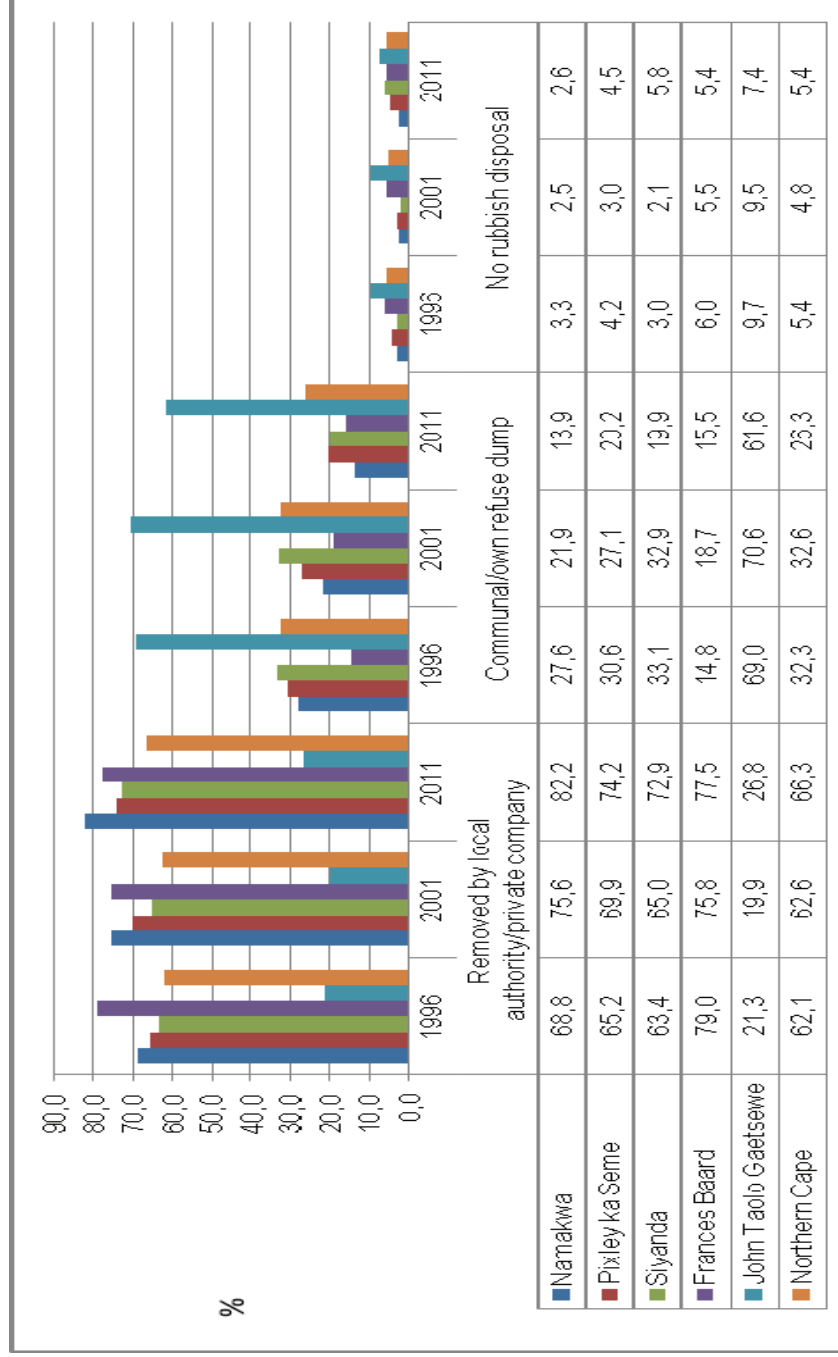


Figure 3.4.7.1 shows that the proportion of households with refuse removed by local authority or private company increased in the province except in Frances Baard district. There are also huge disparities in the province; Namakwa and John Taolo Gaetsewe districts have the highest and lowest proportion of households with refuse removed by local authority or private company (82,2 compared to 26,8%) respectively. There is a general decrease in the proportion of households that used communal or own refuse dumps.

3.4.8 Toilet facilities

Figure 3.4.8.1: Distribution of households by type of toilet and district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

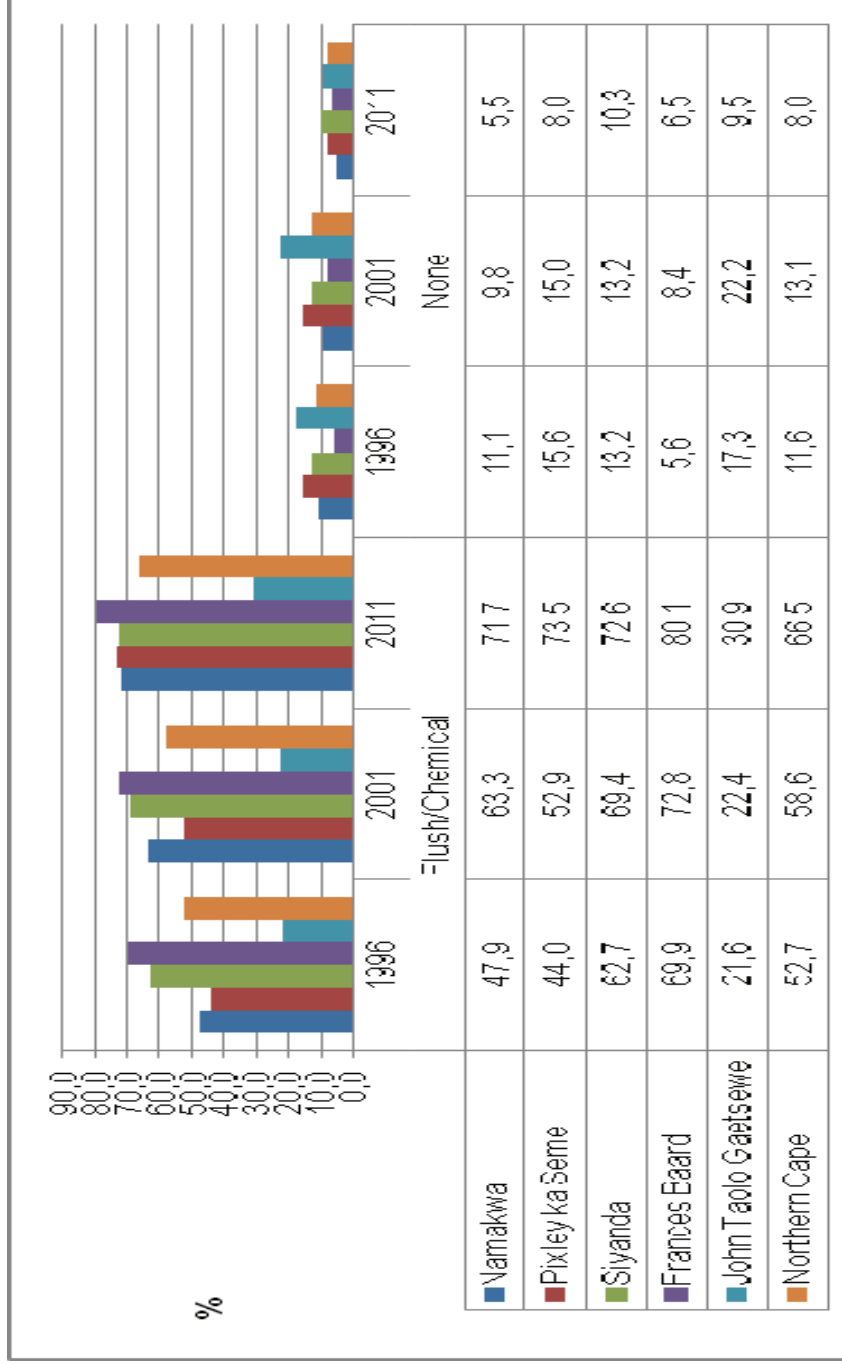


Figure 3.4.8.1 shows that the percentage of households with access to flush or chemical toilet has increased in all the districts. Alongside is the general decrease in the proportion of households with no access to a toilet facility.

Figure 3.4.9.1: Distribution of average household income by district municipality – 2001 and 2011

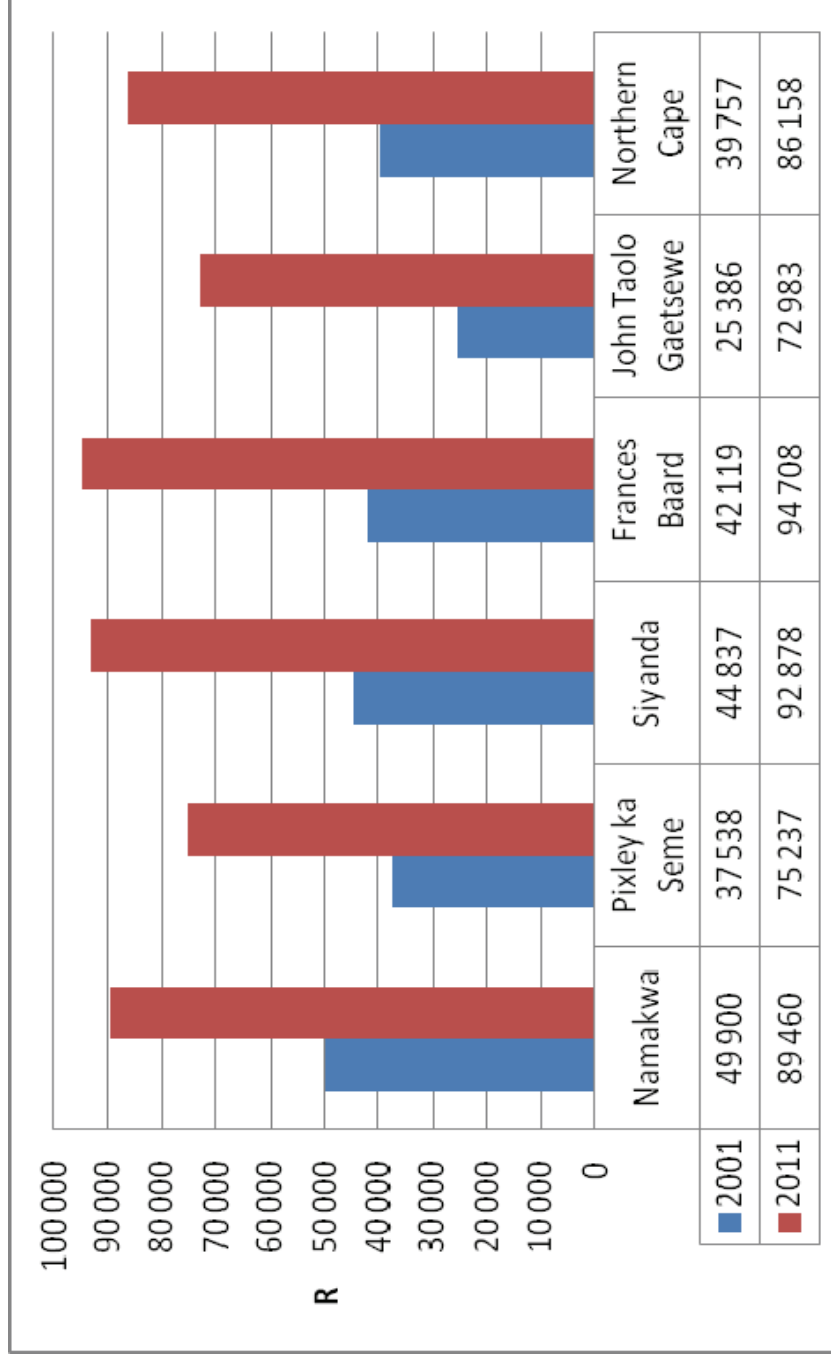


Figure 3.4.9.1 shows an increase in the provincial average household income.

Figure 3.4.10.1: Distribution of female headed households by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

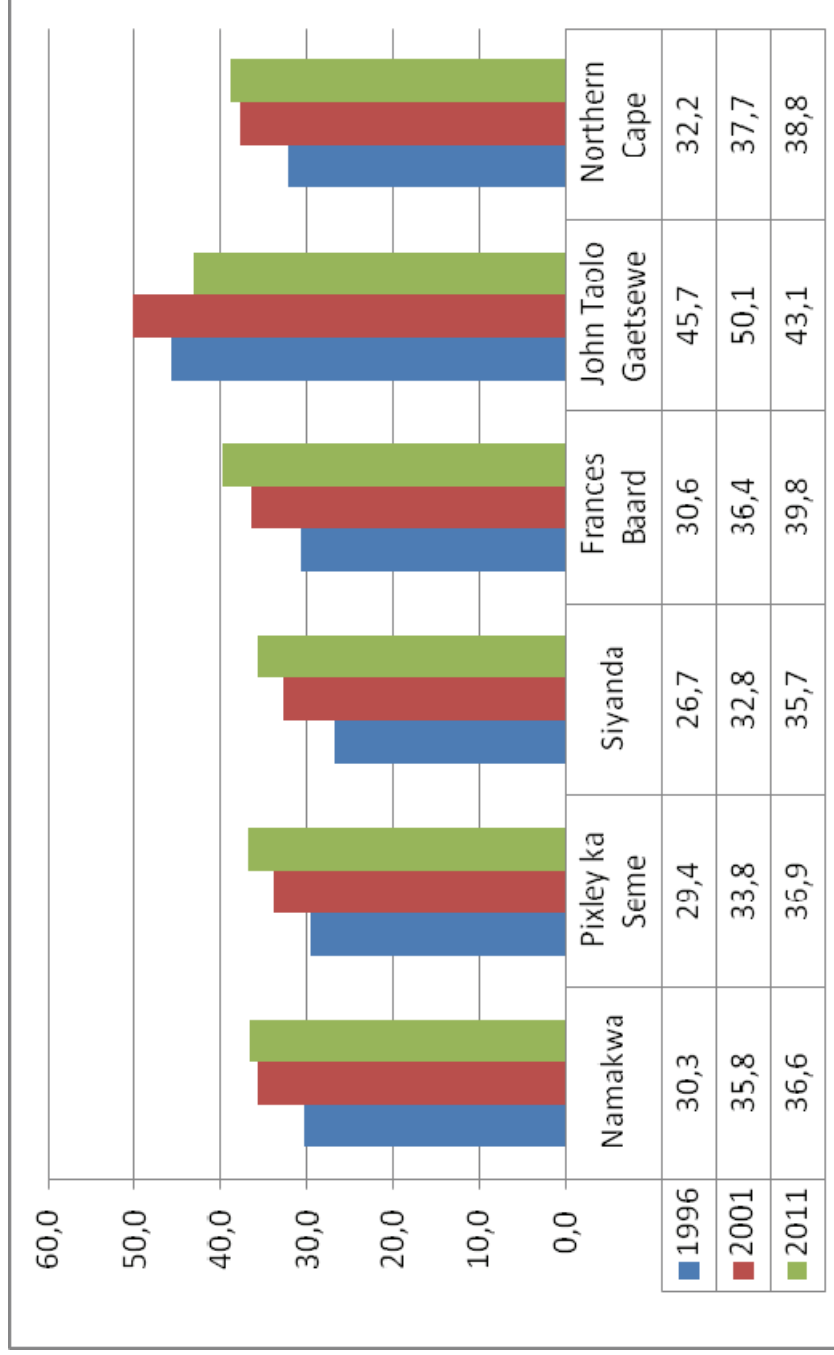


Figure 3.4.10.1 indicates that there has been an increase in female headed households except in John Taolo Gaetsewe district in 2011.

Figure 3.4.11.1: Distribution of child headed households by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

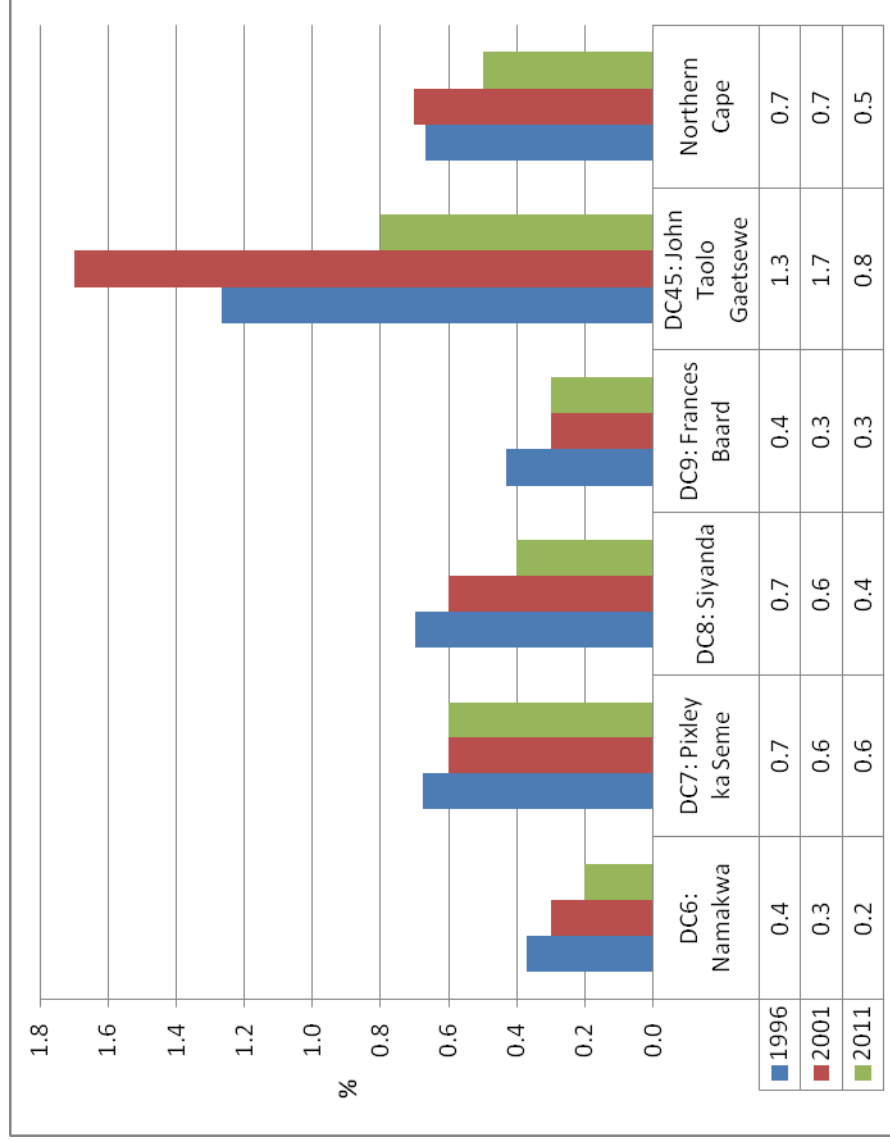


Figure 3.4.11.1 shows that the proportion of households headed by children has declined in all districts in 2011.
