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Western Cape

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Introduction

South Africa has had three censuses since the first general elections in 1994. The first census was conducted in 1996, the second one followed five years later (2001), whilst the recent census was conducted just over a year ago (2011). In this publication, data from the three censuses are compared.

The following points are brought to the attention of the reader of this publication:

- Comparisons of the results of labour market indicators in the post-apartheid population censuses over time have been a cause for concern. Improvements to key questions over the years mean that the labour market outcomes based on the post-apartheid censuses have to be analysed with caution. Such analysis will be the subject of research published in a separate publication in 2013. The differences in the results over the years may be partly attributable to improvements in the questionnaire since 1996 rather than to actual developments in the labour market. The numbers published in this volume for the 1996, 2001, and 2011 censuses are therefore not comparable over time and are higher from those published by Statistics South Africa in the surveys designed specifically for capturing official labour market results.
- For purposes of comparison over the period 1996–2011, certain categories of responses to questions in the censuses of 1996, 2001 and 2011 have either been merged or separated.
- The tenure status question for 1996 has been dropped since the question asked was totally unrelated to that asked thereafter. Comparisons for 2001 and 2011 do, however, remain.
- All household variables are controlled for housing units only and hence, exclude all collective living arrangements as well as transient populations.
- The slight differences in totals for annual household income as compared to that published in the Statistical Release of Census 2011 are due to rounding.
- When making comparisons of any indicator it must be taken into account that the time period between the first two censuses is five years and that between the second and third censuses is ten years. Although Census captures information at one given point in time, the period available for an indicator to change is different.

1. Western Cape

1.1 Demographics

1.1.1 Age-sex structure

Figures 1.1.1.1 to 1.1.1.6 show the pyramids for Western Cape and its districts respectively. The pyramids indicate that the population is still young; the majority of the population is below 35 years.

Figure 1.1.1.1: Distribution of the population by age and sex, Western Cape - 1996, 2001 and 2011

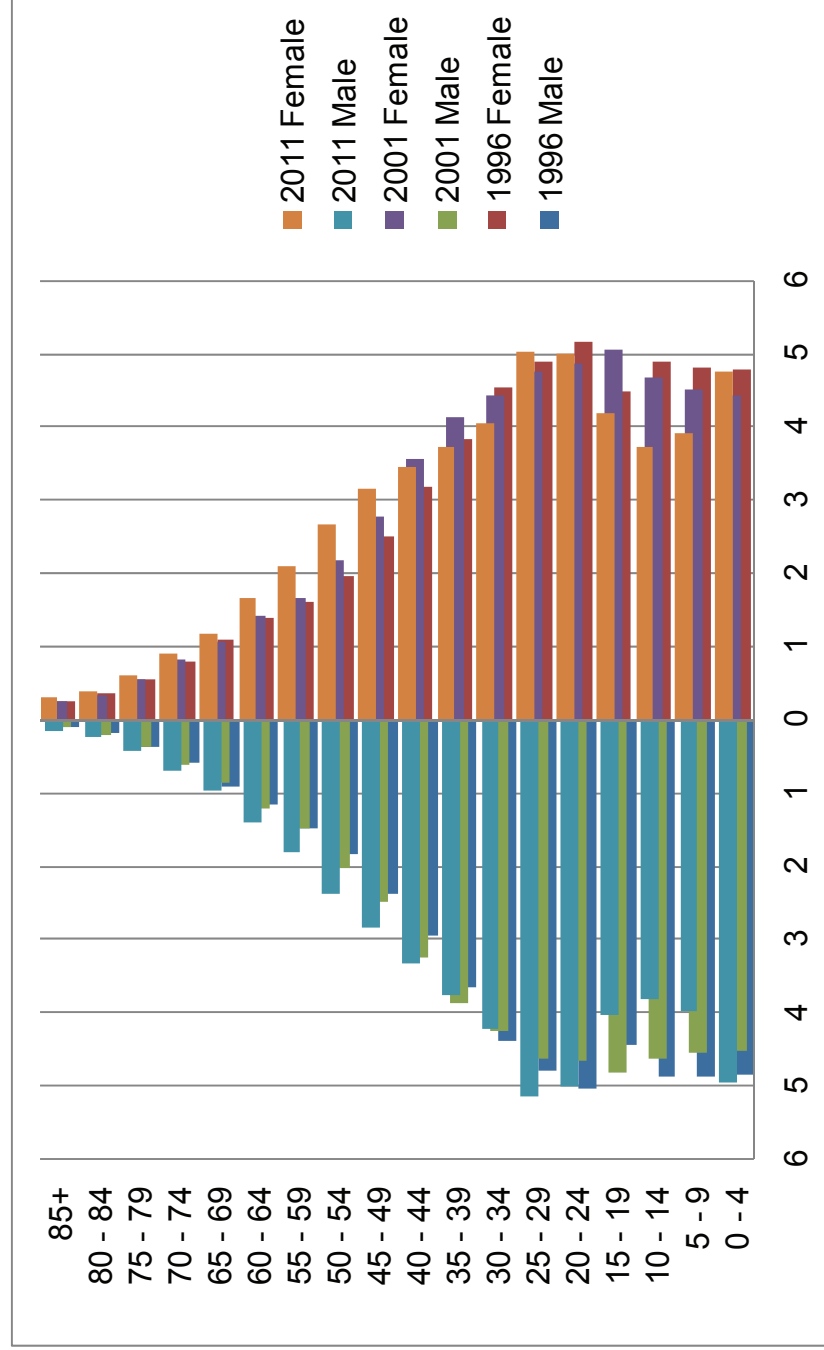


Figure 1.1.1.2: Distribution of the population by age and sex, West Coast - 1996, 2001 and 2011

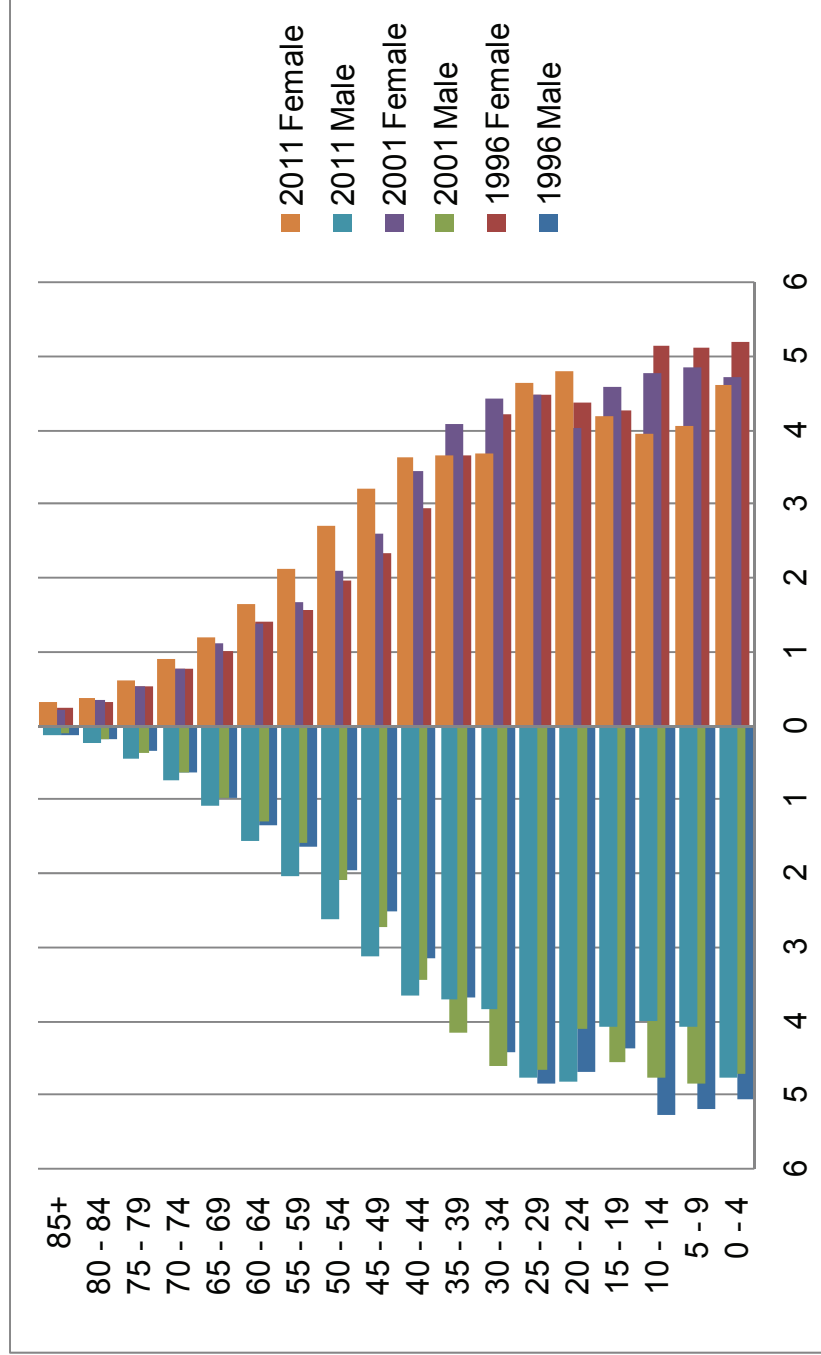


Figure 1.1.1.3: Distribution of the population by age and sex, Cape Winelands - 1996, 2001 and 2011

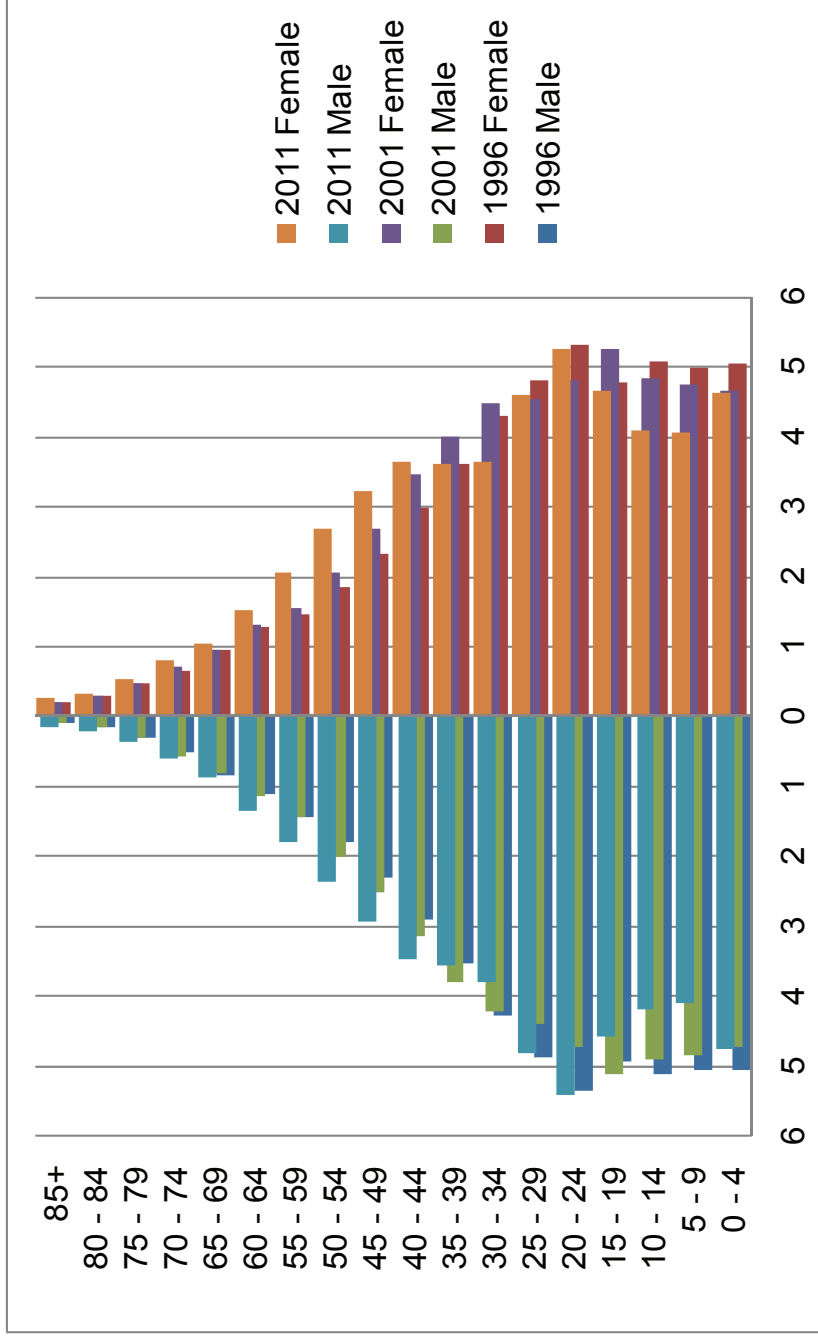


Figure 1.1.1.4: Distribution of the population by age and sex, Overberg - 1996, 2001 and 2011

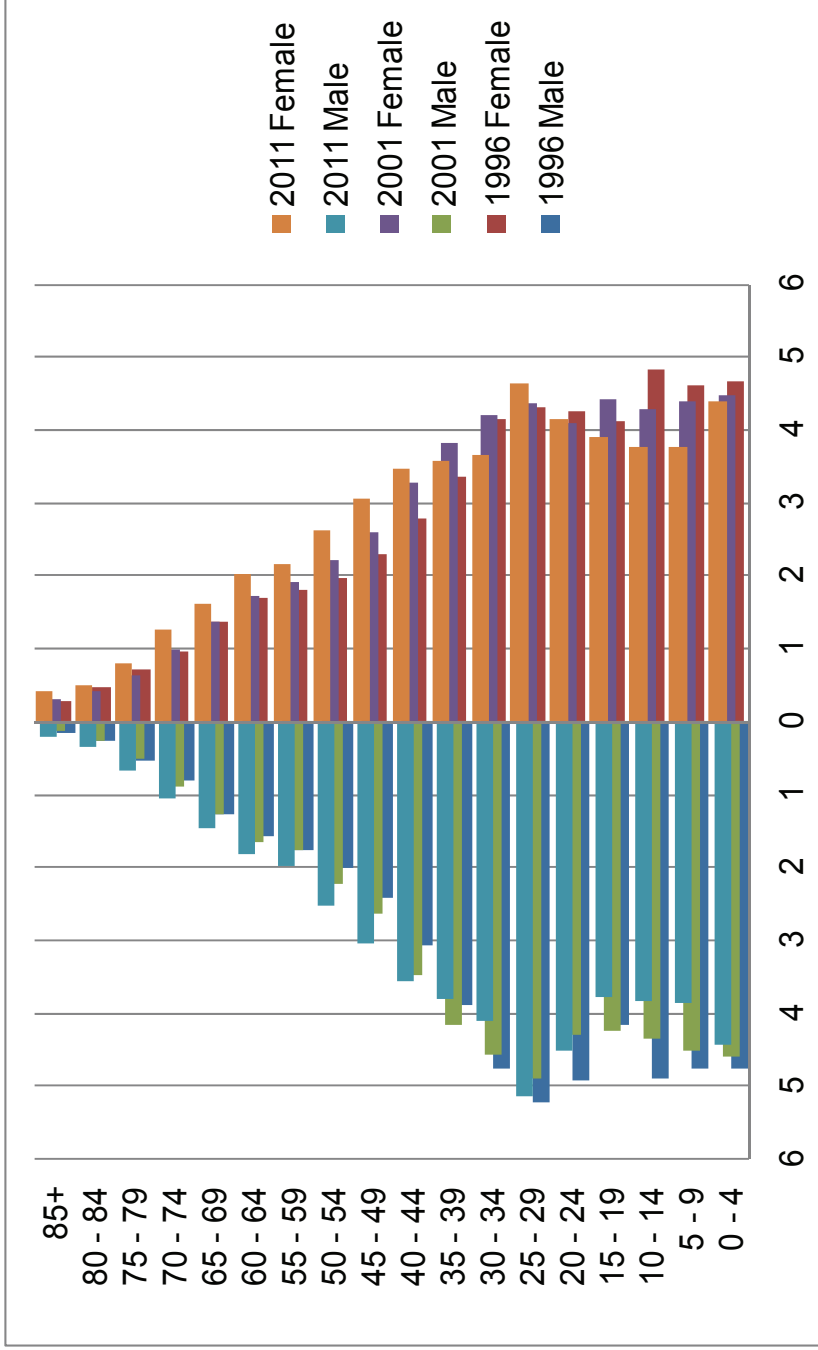


Figure 1.1.1.5: Distribution of the population by age and sex, Eden - 1996, 2001 and 2011

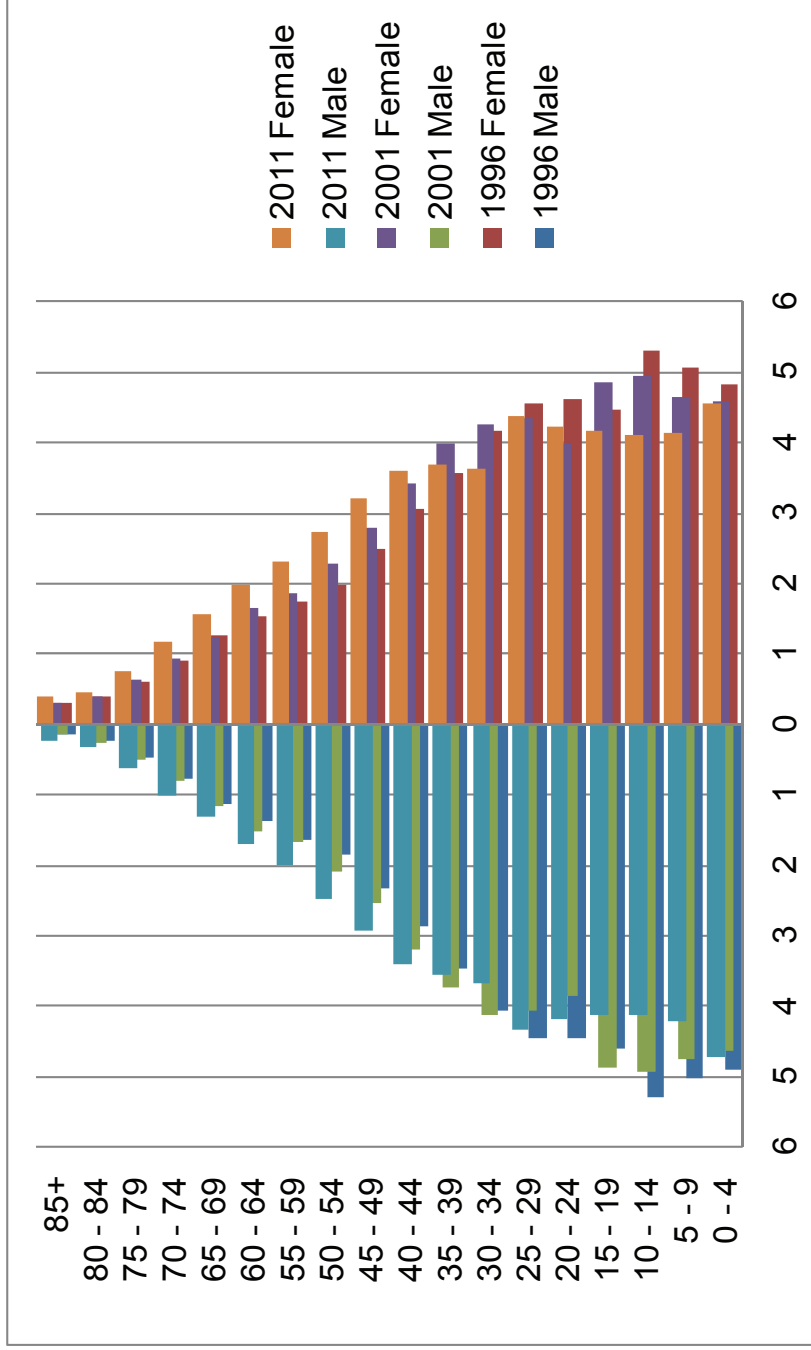


Figure 1.1.1.6: Distribution of the population by age and sex, Central Karoo - 1996, 2001 and 2011

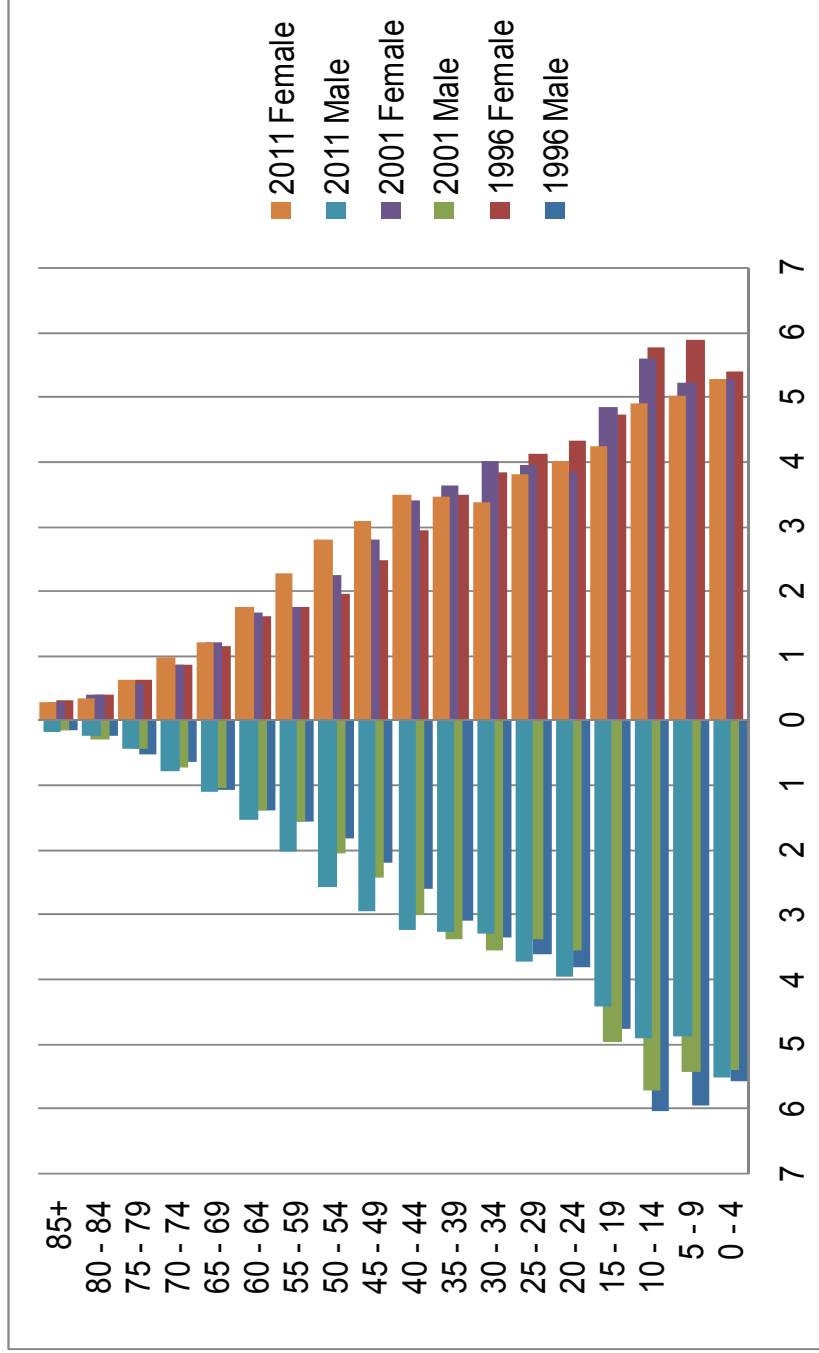
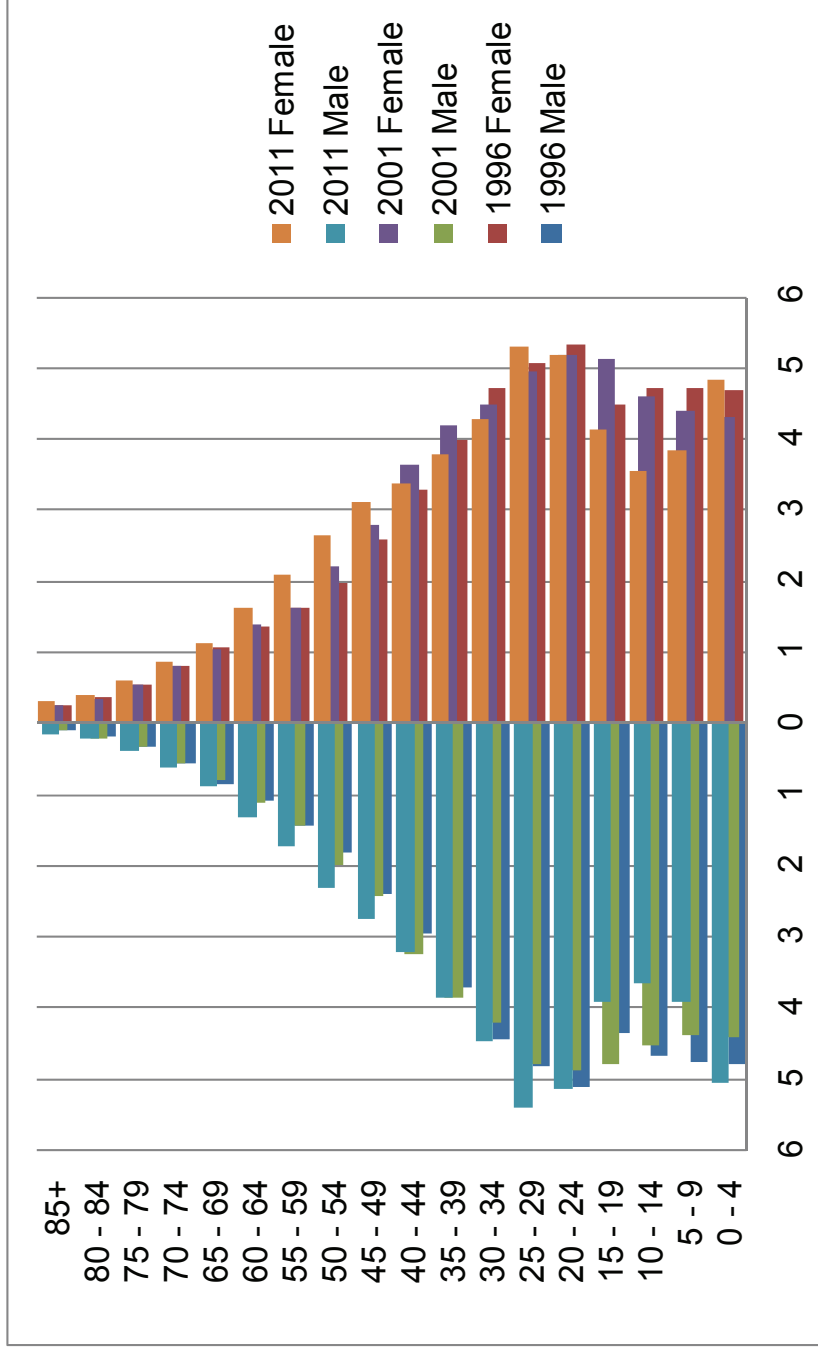


Figure 1.1.1.7: Distribution of the population by age and sex, City of Cape Town - 1996, 2001 and 2011



1.1.2 Population growth rates

Figure 1.1.2.1: Population growth rates by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

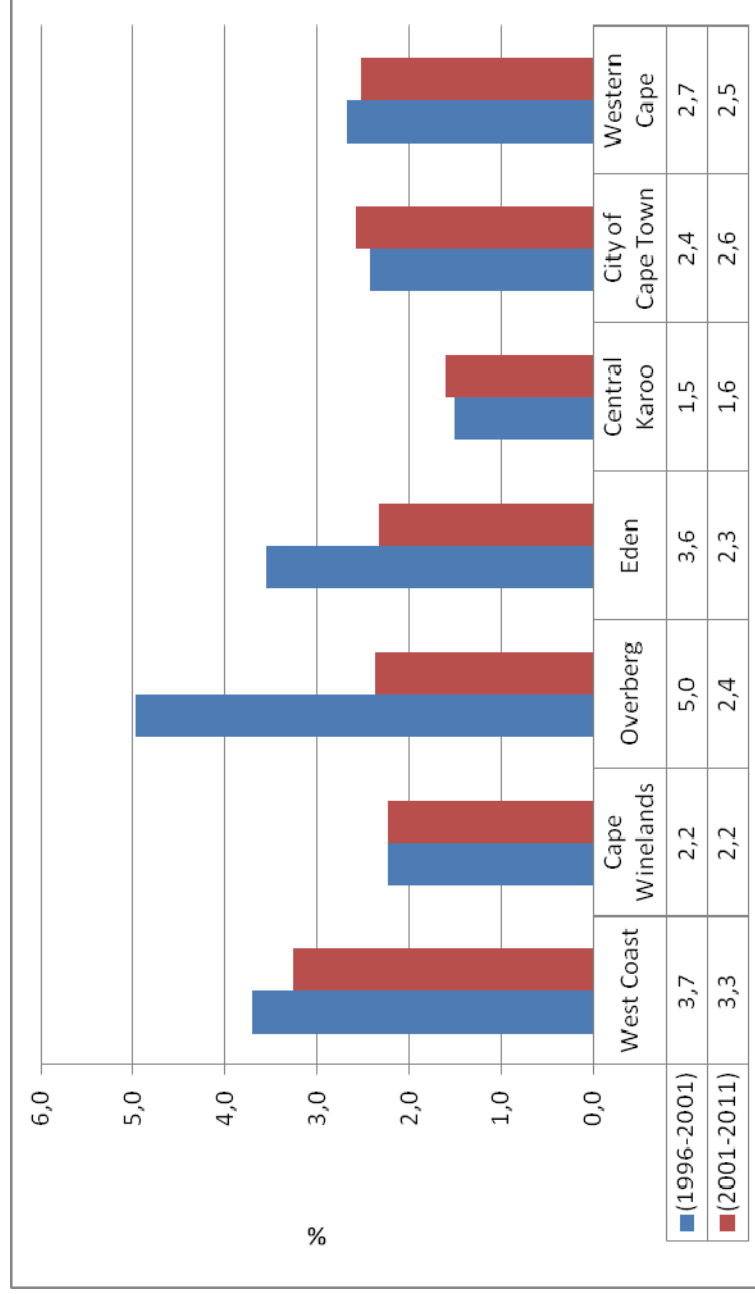


Figure 1.2.1.1 shows that the population growth has slowed down across the province with the exception of Cape Winelands, which remained largely unchanged, and the City of Cape Town, that experienced a faster growth in the period 2001–2011. Of note is the 5,0% growth for Overberg between 1996 and 2001 and the decline to 2,4% during the period 2001–2011.

1.1.3 Sex ratios

Figure 1.1.3.1: Sex ratios by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

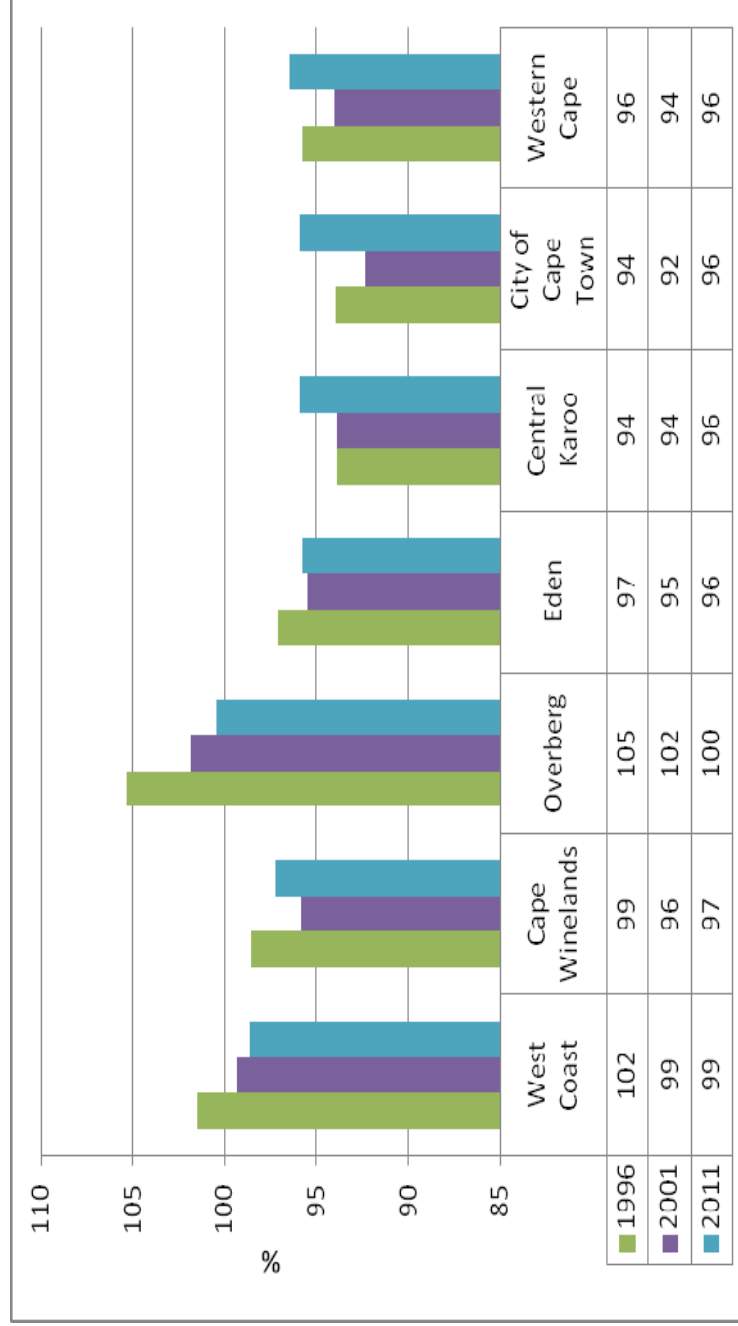


Figure 1.3.1.1 shows that there were more females than males across all districts except in Overberg and in West Coast in 1996.

1.1.4 Population group

Figure 1.1.4.1: Distribution of the population by population group and district municipality - 1996, 2001 and 2011

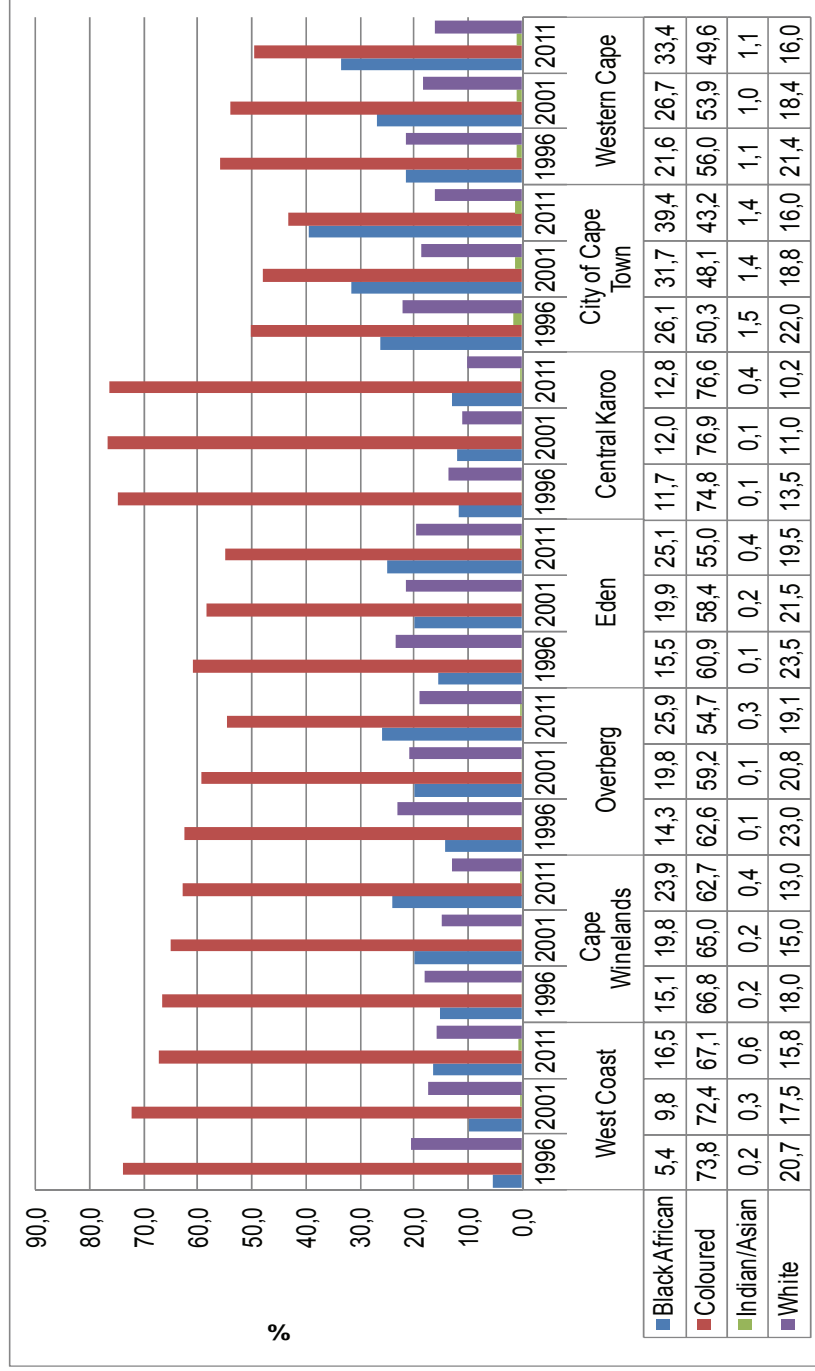


Figure 1.4.1.1 shows that the majority population group is Coloured; followed by Black African, White and then Indian/Asian. Of note is the decline in the proportion of the Coloured (except in the Central Karoo) and White populations and the increase in the Black African population group across the districts.

1.1.5 Functional age group

Figure 1.1.5.1: Distribution of the population by functional age groups and district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

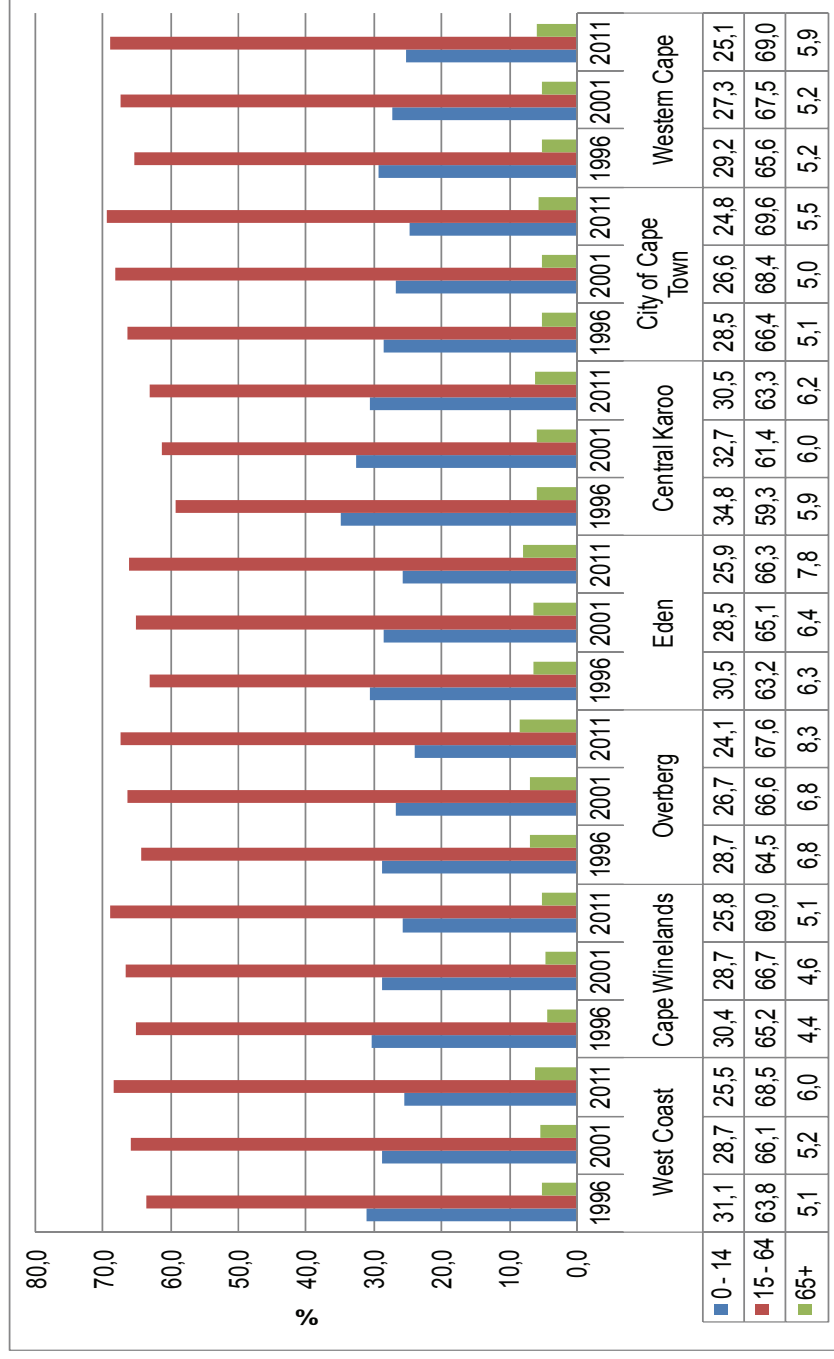


Figure 1.5.1.1 shows a decline in the proportion of the population aged 0–14, and an increase in the proportion of the population aged 15–64 and 65+ in the province.

1.1.6 Dependency ratios

Dependency ratios provide insights into the burden borne by those who are in the working-age group (15–64) to support those aged 0–14 and 65+ years.

Figure 1.1.6.1: Dependency ratio by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011



Figure 1.6.1.1 shows that the dependency ratios has been declining over time in all districts, with City of Cape Town consistently recording a lower than average ratio.

1.1.7 Marital status

Figure 1.1.7.1: Distribution of the population by marital status and district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

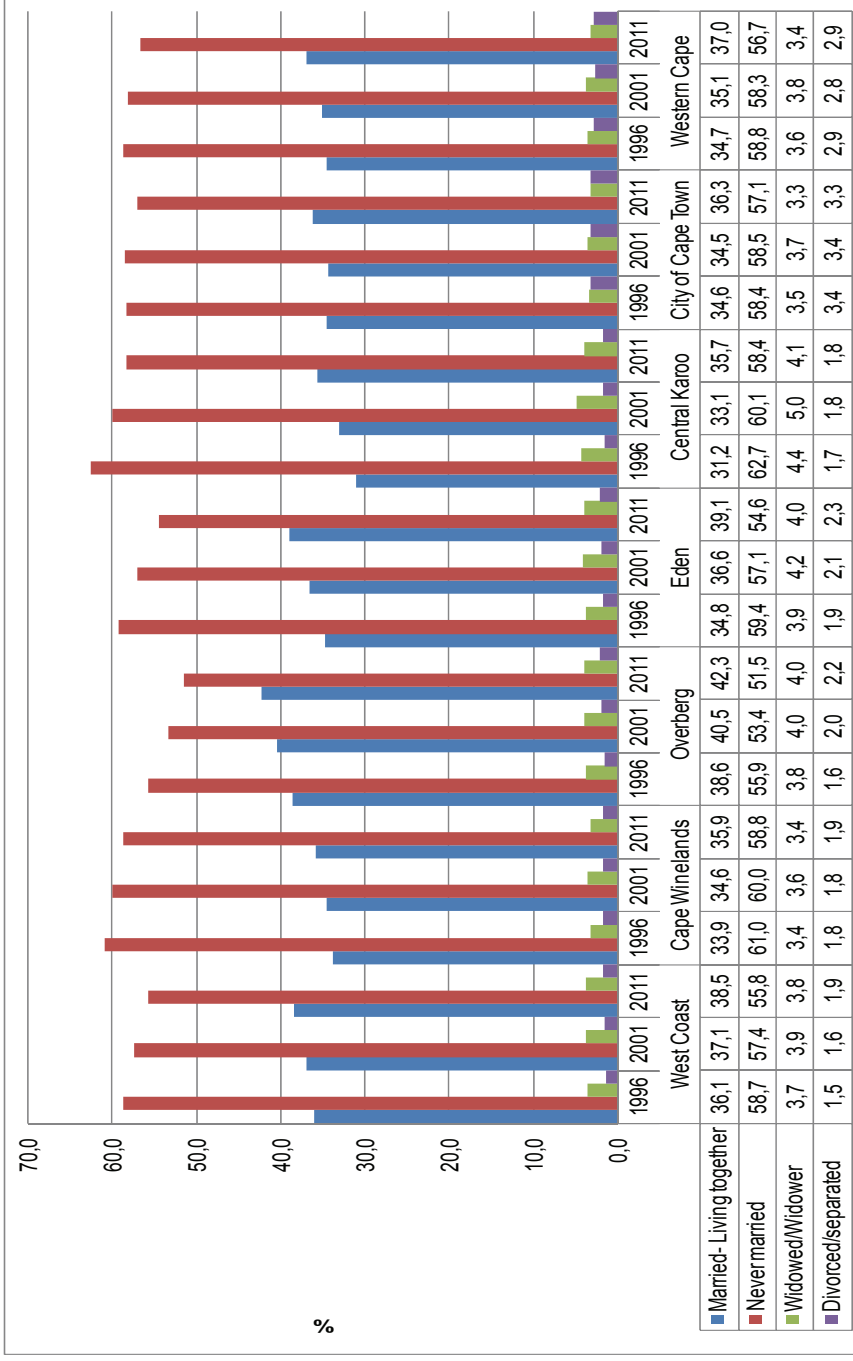


Figure 1.7.1.1 shows a marginal decline in the proportion of the population who had never been married and a slight increase in the proportion of those who were married or living together. Though still insignificant, the proportion of the population that had been widowed increased across districts from 1996 to 2001, and thereafter decreased.

1.2 Education

1.2.1 Highest level of education attained

Figure 1.2.1.1: Distribution of the population aged 20 years and older by highest level of education and district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

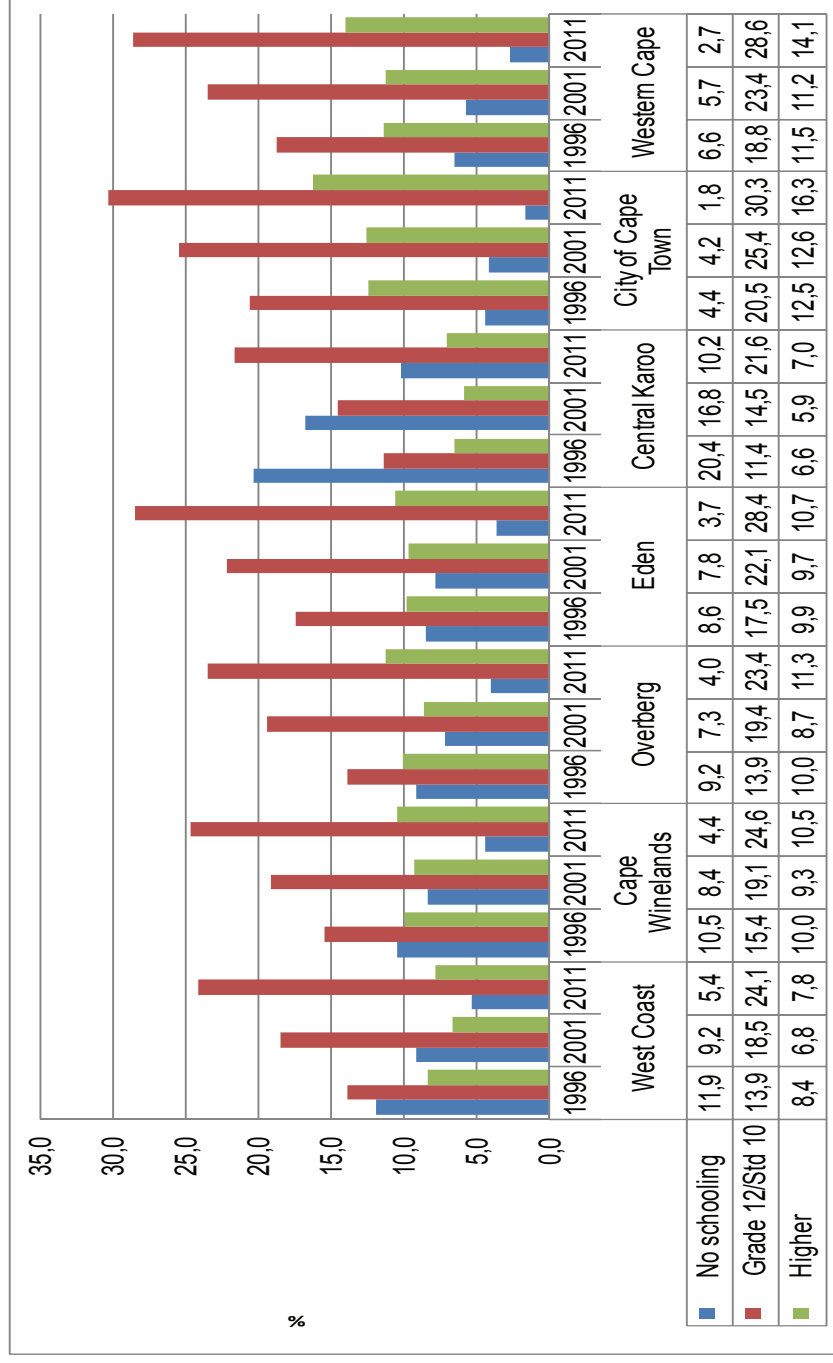


Figure 1.2.1.1 shows a significant decrease and increase in the proportion of the population with no schooling and who have completed Grade 12/Std 10 respectively.

1.2.2 School attendance

Figure 1.2.2.1: Distribution of the population aged 5–24 years attending school by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

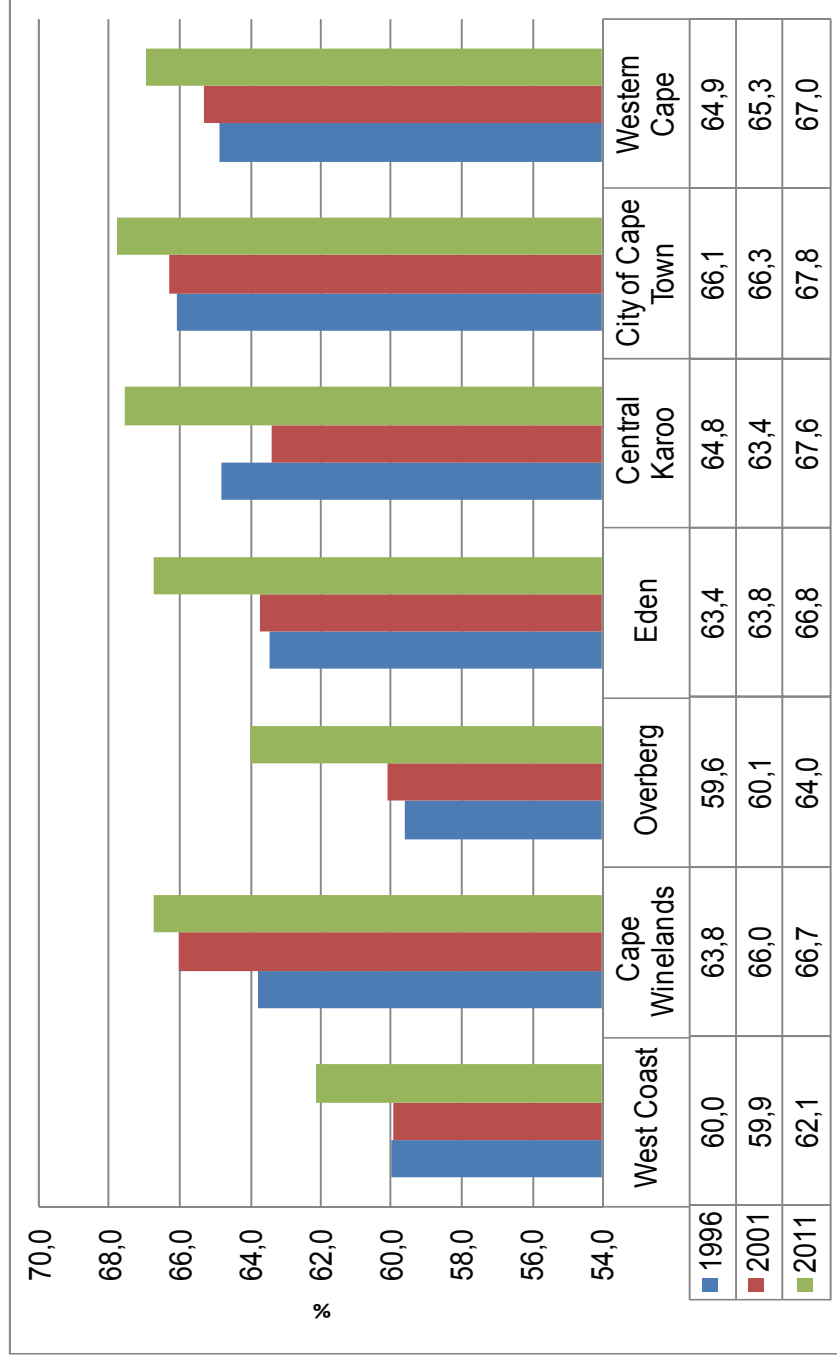
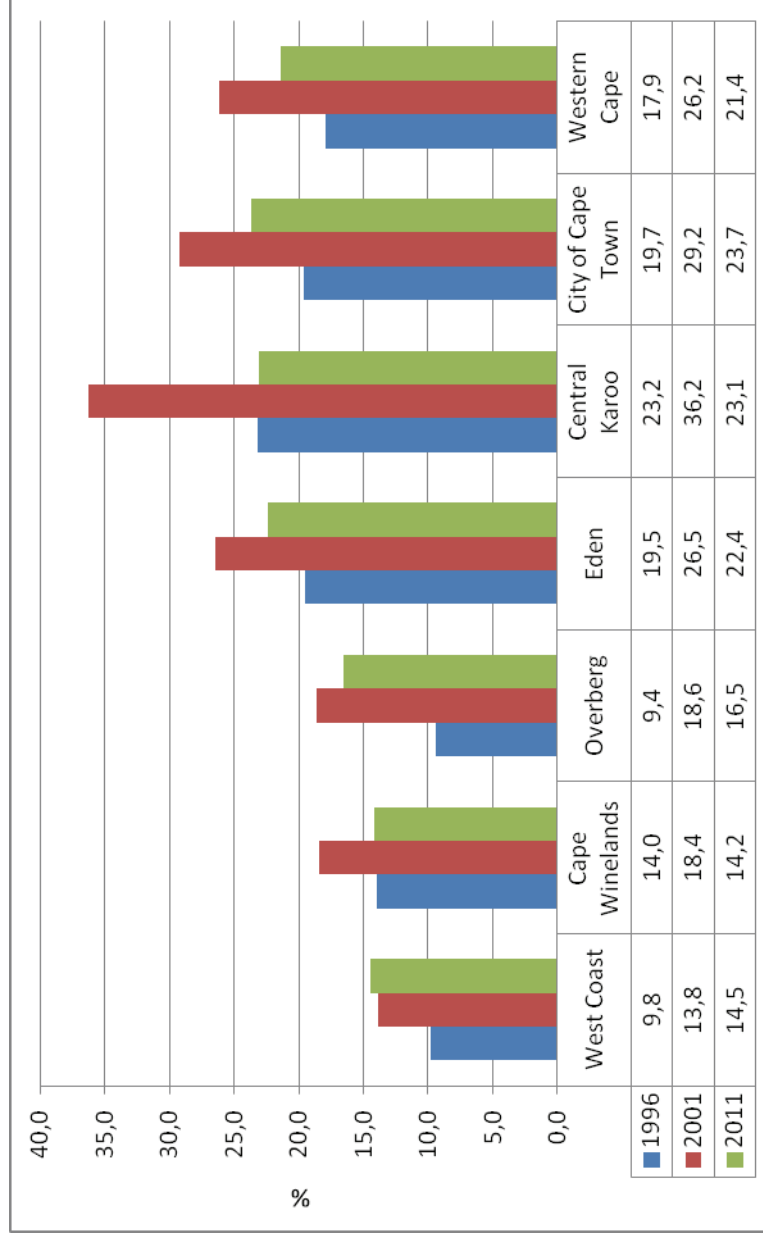


Figure 1.2.2.1 shows a general increase in the percentage of those who were attending school across the province.

1.3 Labour market

1.3.1 Unemployment rate

Trends in the unemployment rate as shown in Figure 1.3.1.1 suggest an increase between 1996 and 2001 and thereafter a decline across all districts except for West Coast. **Readers are requested to heed the disclaimer in the introduction to this publication.**

1.4 Housing

1.4.1 Average household size

Figure 1.4.1.1: Average household size by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

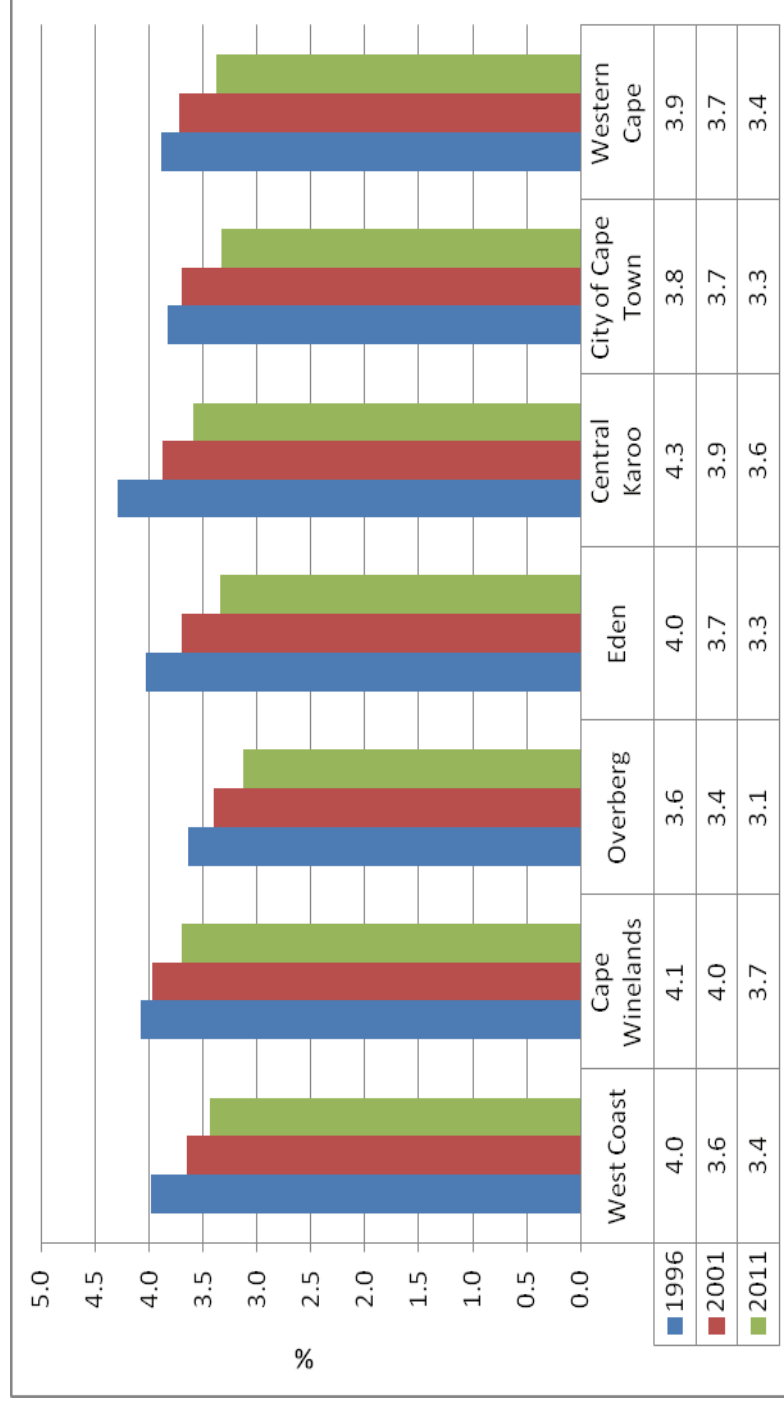


Figure 1.4.1.1 shows a decline in the average household size over time. Central Karoo and Cape Winelands consistently had a higher average household size relative to the provincial average.

1.4.2 Type of main dwelling

Figure 1.4.2.1: Distribution of households by type of main dwelling type and district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

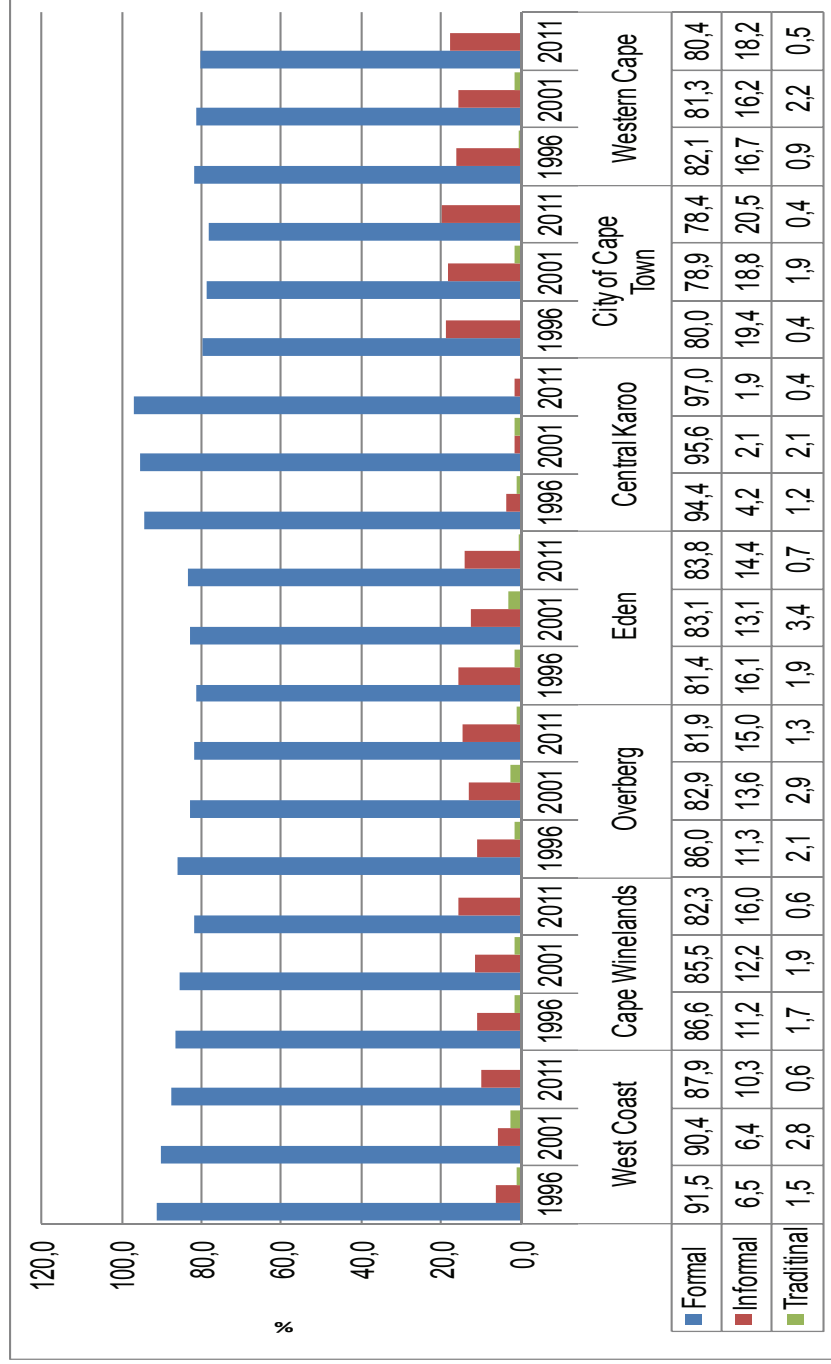
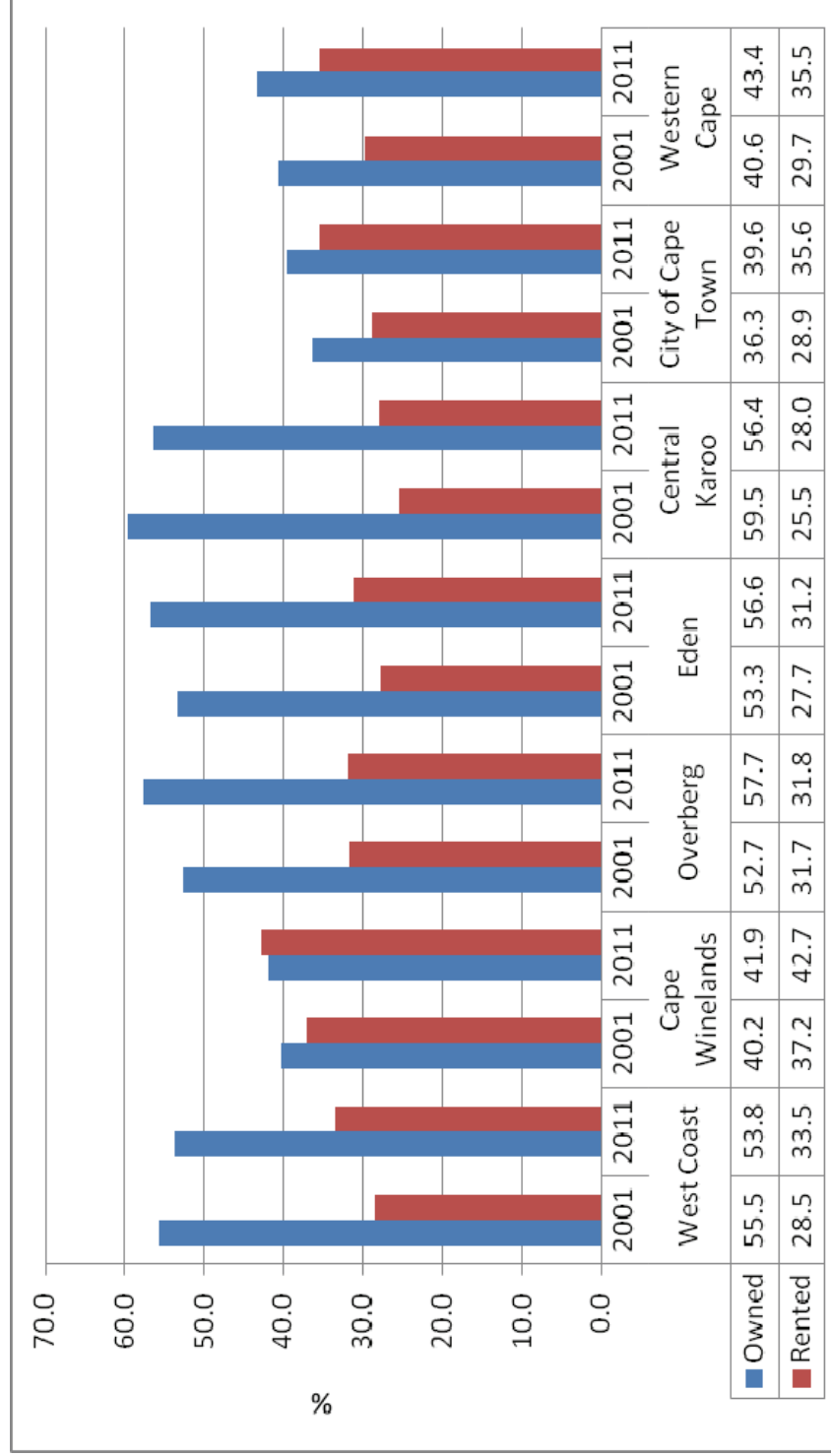


Figure 1.4.2.1 shows a decrease in the proportion of households resident in formal dwellings across the province, with the exception of Eden and Central Karoo districts. The two districts are the only ones to experience a decline in the proportion of households resident in informal dwellings in the province.

1.4.3 Tenure status

Figure 1.4.3.1 shows an increase in the proportion of households that owned the dwellings that they occupied except for West Coast and Central Karoo.

1.4.4 Household goods

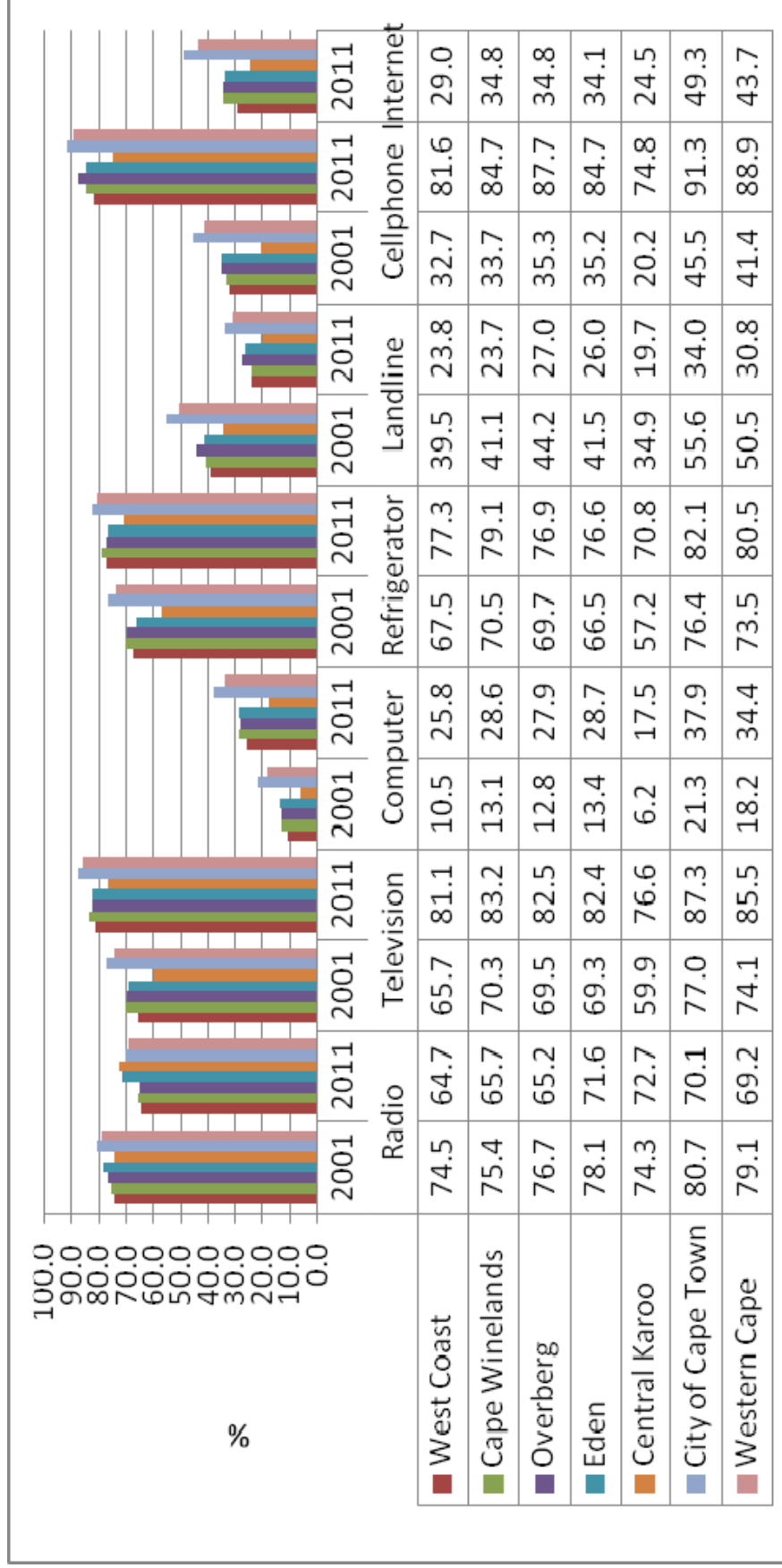


Figure 1.4.4.1 shows a decline in the proportion of households owning radios or landline/telephones; an increase in the proportion of households owning televisions, computers, and refrigerators. The City of Cape Town had the highest proportion of households with access to internet (almost 50%).

1.4.5 Electricity for lighting, cooking, heating

Figure 1.4.5.1: Distribution of households using electricity for lighting, cooking and heating by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

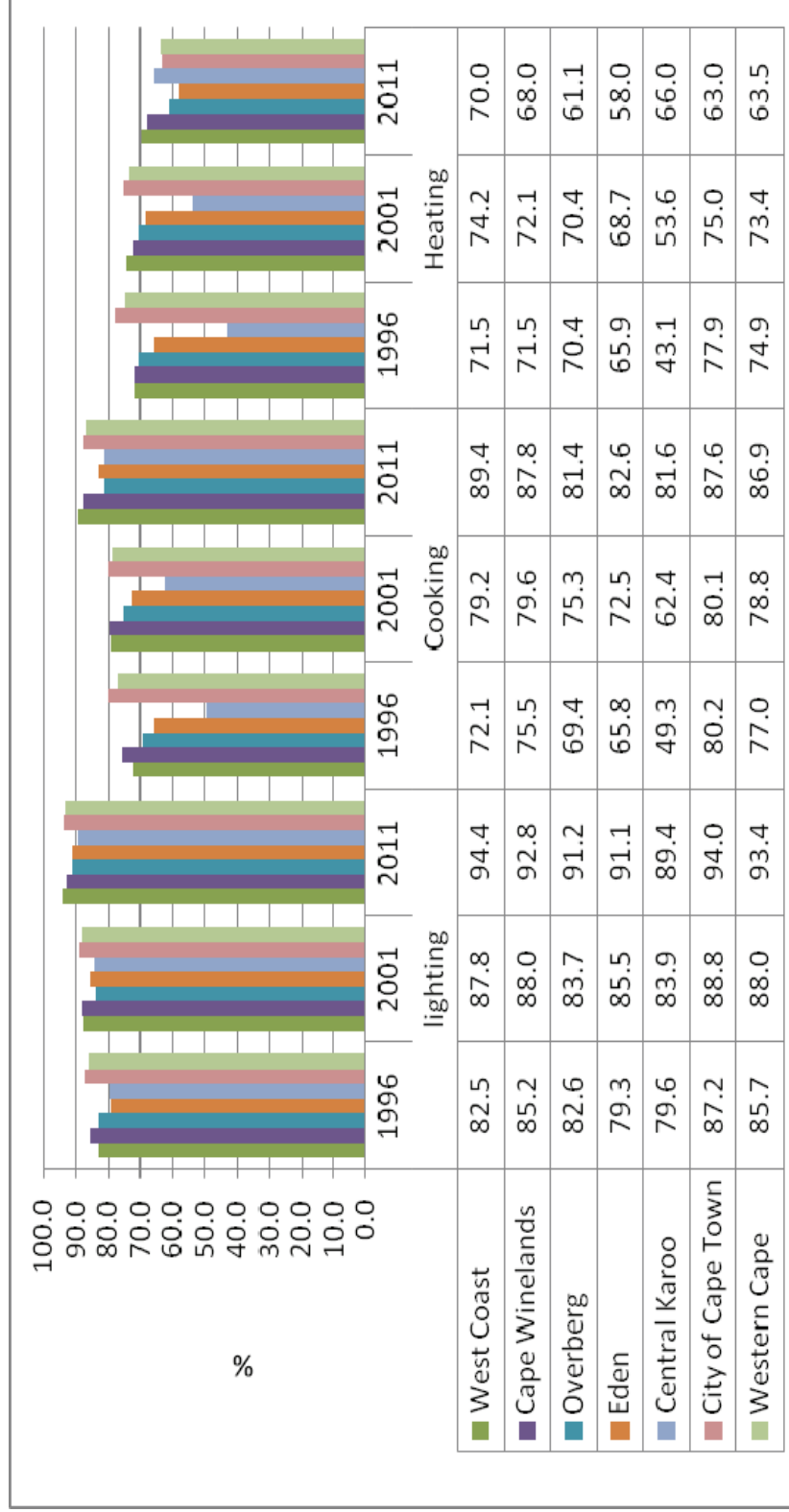


Figure 1.4.5.1 shows that the proportion of households using electricity as the main source of energy for lighting and cooking has increased over time and across the province. The proportion of households using electricity as the main source of energy for heating, however, has decreased across the province.

1.4.6 Access to piped water

Figure 1.4.6.1: Percentage of households having access to piped water by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

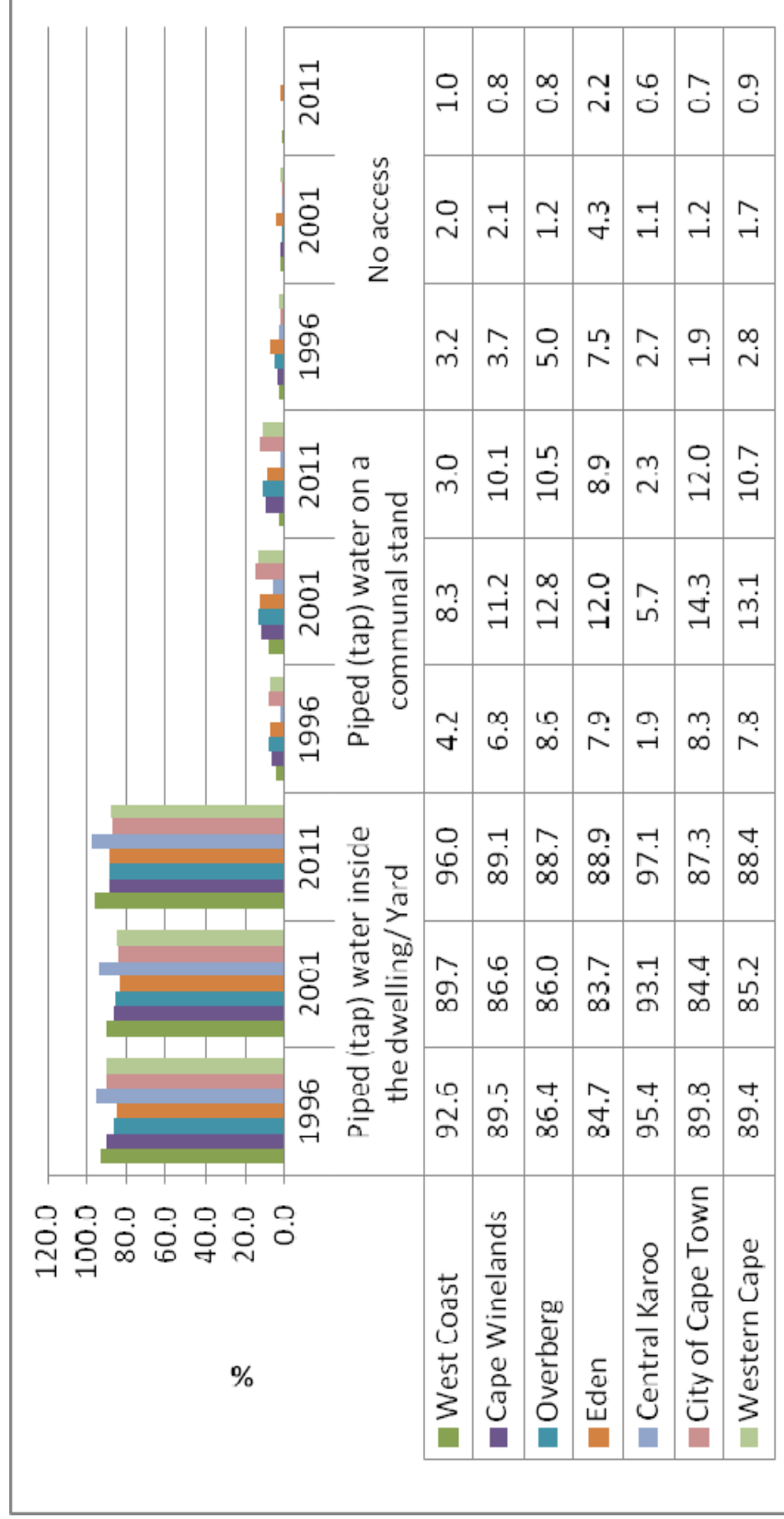


Figure 1.4.6.1 shows that the percentage of households with access to piped water inside the dwelling or yard has decreased between 1996 and 2001, and then increased between 2001 and 2011 in all districts. The highest proportion of households with access to piped water was found in the Central Karoo and the West Coast. A negligible proportion of households had no access to piped water.

1.4.7 Refuse disposal

Figure 1.4.7.1: Distribution of households by type of refuse removal and district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

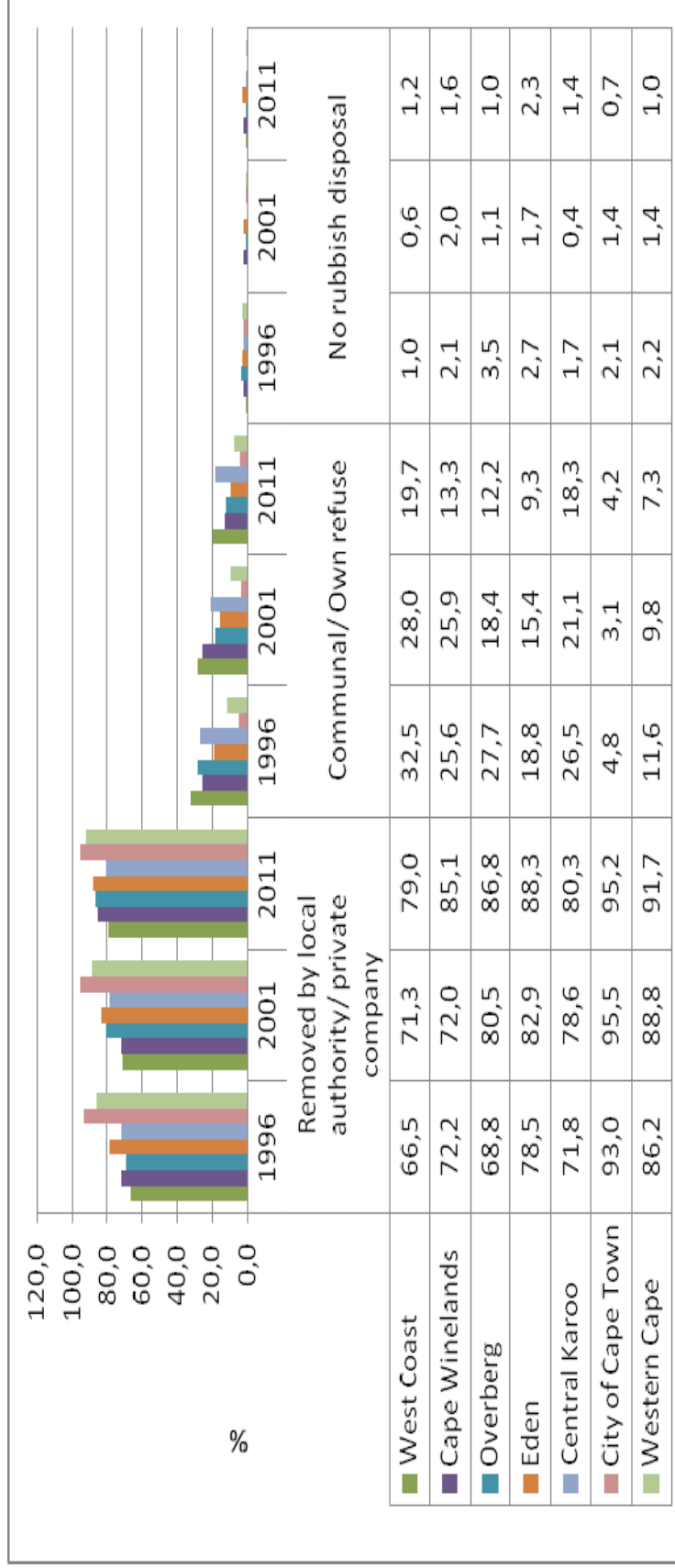


Figure 1.4.7.1 shows that the proportion of households whose refuse was removed by local authority or private company increased in all districts. A decline is seen in the proportion of households with a communal or own refuse dump, and a small proportion of households in the province had no access to rubbish disposal.

1.4.8 Toilet facilities

Figure 1.4.8.1 shows that the percentage of households with access to flush or chemical toilets has increased in all districts, alongside is the decline in the proportion of the households with no access to a toilet facility.

Figure 1.4.9.1: Distribution of average household income by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

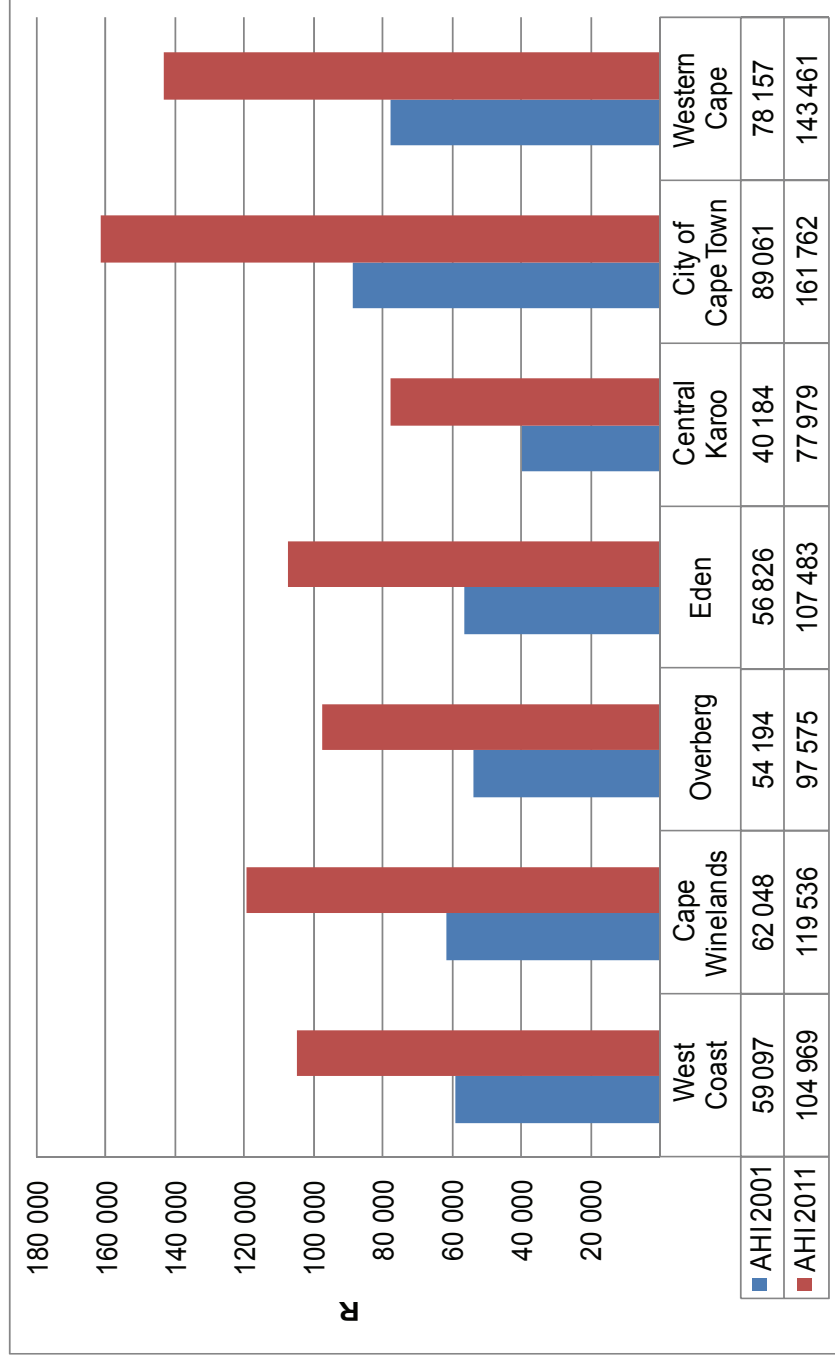


Figure 1.4.9.1 shows a substantial increase in the average household income over time.

Figure 1.4.10.1: Distribution of female headed households by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

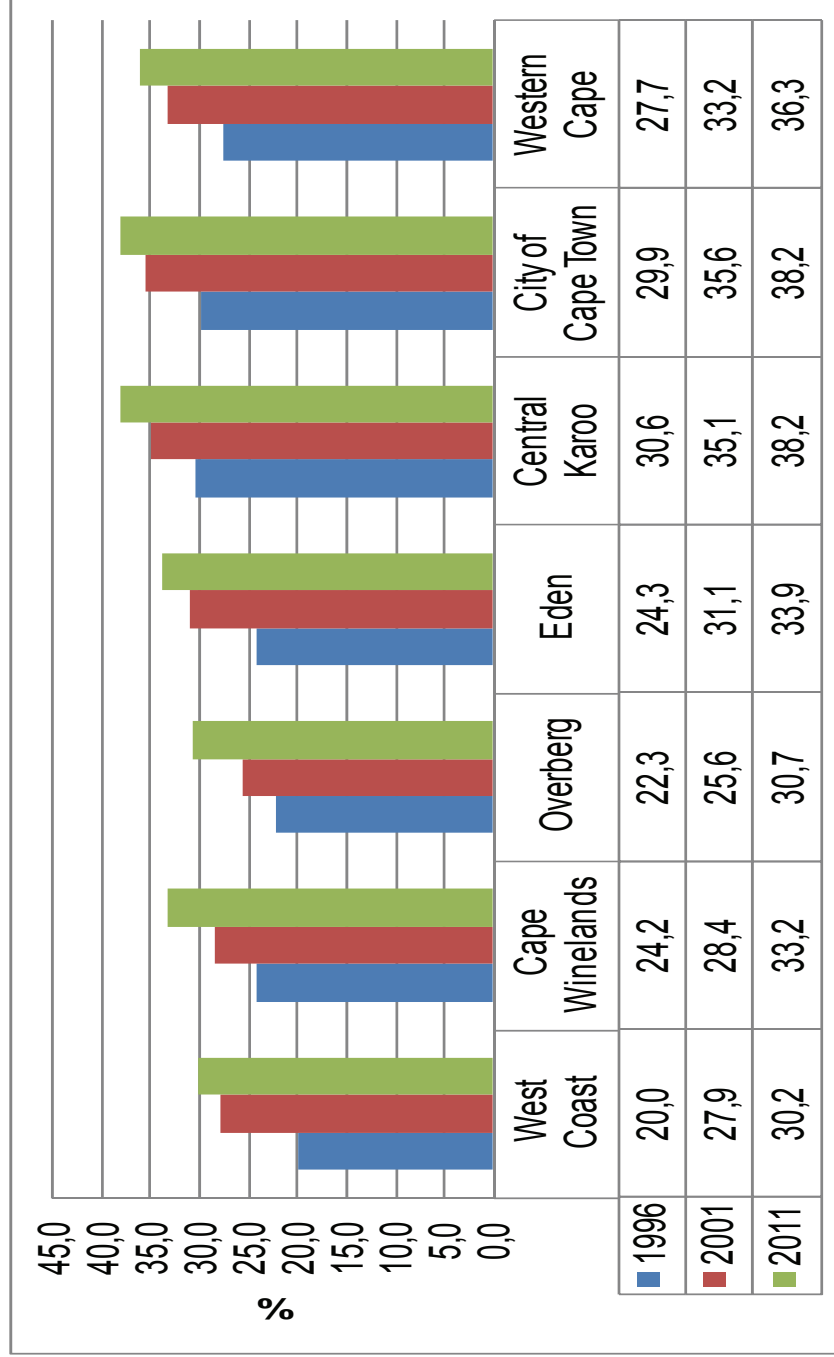


Figure 1.4.10.1 indicates an increase in the proportion of households headed by females.

Figure 1.4.11.1: Distribution of child headed households by district municipality – 1996, 2001 and 2011

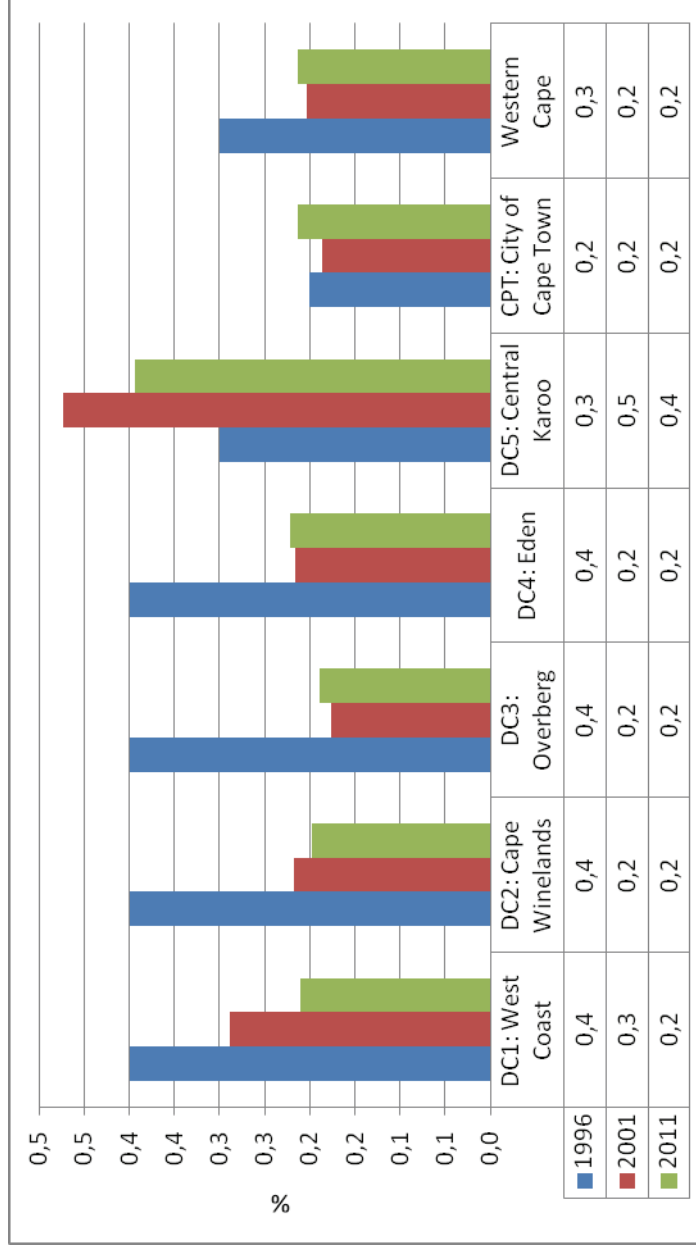


Figure 1.4.11.1 shows that the proportion of child-headed households has declined over time, and is negligible in the province.
