KEY FINDINGS FOR FEBRUARY 2012

MONTHLY CHANGES IN THE CPAP INDICES

The work group indices for February 2012 show relatively large monthly percentage changes in a number of the work groups reported on by Stats SA. Monthly percentage changes in the index figures range from 0,0% for Work group 170 to 3,6% for Work group 110. The Consumer Price Index for February 2012 increased by 0.6%.

The 4 indices reflecting relatively large monthly percentage changes mainly due to factors other than the headline CPI are:

- Work group 110: The monthly percentage increase of 3,6% reflected by this index is mainly due to a 3,8% monthly increase in the PPI for Cement retail price, which accounts for approximately 45,0%, a 4,6% monthly increase in the PPI for Aggregate crush stone, which accounts for approximately 20,0% of the work group 110 index.
- Work group 122: The monthly percentage increase of 2,7% reflected by this index is mainly due to a 4,1% monthly increase in the PPI for Fibre cement roof sheets, which accounts for approximately 40,0% of the work group 122 index.
- Work group 172: The monthly percentage increase of 2,3% reflected by this index is mainly due to a 4,3% monthly increase in Seifsa for Metal prices Copper, which accounts for approximately 40,0% of the work group 172 index.
- Work group 154: The monthly percentage increase of 2.1% reflected by this index is mainly due to a 4,6% monthly increase in the PPI for Aggregate crush stone, which accounts for approximately 34,0% of the work group 154 index.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

1. Contract Price Adjustment Provisions

The contract between Statistics South Africa and JBCC expired on the 31st December 2011.

Existing subscribers will receive their indices on the last Thursday of every month as before until the end of February 2012.

No new subscriptions will be available.

From March 2012, on the last Thursday of every month, the P0151 statistical release will be posted on Stats-SA's website as a free down load document.

- The JBCC publication consists of indices derived from changes in the cost structures prevailing in 37
 different sectors of the building industry and is reported on by Stats SA on a monthly basis. The indices
 reported on in this publication are mainly based on a combination of PPI and CPI indices for the particular
 month.
- 3. The indices contained in this release are calculated and published on behalf of the Joint Building Contracts Committee (JBCC) for use in conjunction with the "Haylett Formula".
- 4. - 6. Price information on materials refers to the first seven days of the relevant month.
- 7. Sales tax (GST) and value-added tax (VAT) are not included in these indices.
- 8. At the request of the JBCC, the following changes were affected -
- as from July 2009 the compilation of work group 160 was changed to labour CPI Stats SA (10%), SEIFSA Table C4 (10%), Electrical Installation materials (45%), Galvanised sheets (SEIFSA Table E-Ex) (10%), Fully galvanised wire 2.00 mm (SEIFSA Table N) (5%) and Copper 7,90 mm rod (SEIFSA Table N) (20%).
- as from July 2009 the compilation of work group 162 was changed to labour CPI Stats SA (8%), SEIFSA Table C4 (8%), Electrical Installation materials (34%), Galvanised sheets (SEIFSA Table E-Ex) (12%), Fully galvanised wire 2.00 mm (SEIFSA Table N) (8%) and Copper 7,90 mm rod (SEIFSA Table N) (30%).
