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KEY FINDINGS

1. Historical trends: foreign travellers and South African residents 1980-2008

In the 1980s the trends in the numbers of arrivals and departures of foreign travellers were fairly similar in pattern. Figure 1 and Table 1.1 show that prior to 1986, the trend in the number of arrivals and departures remained reasonably steady at around 650 000 per annum. From 1986 to 1990, there was a gradual increase in the number of foreign travellers to South Africa (SA) and between 1990 and 1993, the rise was very steep. After 1993 the pace of increase in arrivals continued, but there was a marked lag between the number of arrivals and the number of departures. The number of arrivals and departures declined in 1997 and 2001. However, the volume of arrivals has steadily increased over the past five years *i.e.* since 2003. There was an increase of 42,8% from 6 815 196 in 2004 to 9 728 860 in 2008. The volume of departures grew by 39,1% from 6 093 313 in 2004 to 8 474 663 in 2008.

Figure 2 and Table 1.1 show the trend in arrivals and departures of SA residents from 1980 to 2008. In general, the volume of arrivals and departures was more or less the same. The sudden drop in the number of arrivals and departures of SA residents after 2002 was mainly due to the changes in the immigration acts regarding the recording of information on the international movements of South African residents. Act No.13 of 2002 resulted in information on arrival and departure of SA residents not being collected. Collection through the scanning of passports resumed after the implementation of Act No.19 of 2004.

2. Foreign arrivals to South Africa in 2008

2.1 Distribution by region

A detailed description of the monthly distribution of foreign arrivals in 2008 by region is given in Table 2.1.3. The highest number (974 975) of foreign arrivals was recorded in the summer month of December while the lowest number (699 695) was recorded in the winter month of June. However, as the data indicate, there are observed differences by region and country.

Foreign arrivals to South Africa continue to be predominantly residents from the SADC countries and very few from Middle East and North Africa. Thus out of the 9 728 860 foreign arrivals, 7 226 736 (74,3%) came from SADC countries; 1 447 823 (14,9%) from Europe; 351 158 (3,6%) from North America; 230 343 (2,4%) from Asia; 122 382 (1,3%) from Australasia; 80 659 (0,8%) from East and Central Africa; 75 315 (0,7%) from West Africa; 65 002 (0,7%) from Central and South America; 39 448 (0,4%) from Middle East; and 12 704 (0,1%) from North Africa. The country of residence of 77 279 (0,8%) arrivals was not specified.

2.2 Distribution by country of residence

As presented in Figure 3a and Table 2.1.3 the leading countries for overseas arrivals in 2008 were: the UK, 493 235 (21,9%); the USA, 292 884 (13,0%); Germany, 243 578 (10,8%); France, 131 512 (5,8%); the Netherlands, 130 083 (5,8%); Australia, 101 312 (4,5%); India, 59 186 (2,6%) and Canada, 58 195 (2,6%).

Figure 3b and Table 2.1.3 indicate that Lesotho, 2 165 505 (30,0%); Zimbabwe, 1 248 043 (17,3%); Mozambique, 1 228 979 (17,0%); Swaziland, 1 090 056 (15,1%); Botswana, 807 292 (11,2%); Namibia, 222 817 (3,1%); Zambia, 193 677 (2,7%) and Malawi, 164 248 (2,3%) were the leading source countries for residents from SADC countries.

Figure 3c and Table 2.1.3 show that Nigeria, 46 364 (27,5%); Kenya, 29 218 (17,3%); Ghana, 14 112 (8,4%); Uganda, 13 684 (8,1%); Ethiopia, 9 953 (5,9%); Cameroon 5 529 (3,3%); Egypt, 5 305 (3,1%) and Congo, 4 939 (2,9%) were the leading source countries for arrivals from other African countries.

2.3 Mode of travel and ports of entry

There are four modes of travel that can be used to enter or exit South Africa. Table 2.1.2 shows mode of travel used and the port through which the travellers entered the country. Due to a large number of land ports in the countries surrounding South Africa, *i.e.* where road and rail could be used, border countries are used in the table instead of the specific land port. That is, data for all ports found in the border country is combined. Road, 6 959 695 (71,5%) was the most frequently used mode of travel in 2008 indicating that most of the foreign arrivals came through South Africa bordering countries. The largest number of arrivals by road came through the border posts in Lesotho 2 056 881 (29,6%). This group is followed by those who came through border posts in Zimbabwe 1 347 177 (19,4%); Swaziland 1 266 719 (18,2%) and Mozambique 1 150 801 (16,5%). Air travel 2 581 352 (26,5%) was the second most frequently used mode of travel. In 2008, the largest number of air travellers entered air the country through OR Tambo international airport 2 008 823 (77,8%). Cape Town and Durban international airports were used by 552 453 (21,4%) and 5 448 (0,2%) respectively. Other smaller international airports recorded 14 628 (0,6%) arrivals. In 2008, 1 745 (0,02%) travellers entered the country through the sea ports. An equally smaller number 777 (0,01%) came through the border countries by rail.

Detailed information provided in Table 2.1.4 indicate that there were 1 989 465 (88,2%) overseas residents that arrived by air in 2008. The number of overseas residents that arrived by road was 261 377 (11,6%) and those that came by sea and rail were 1 689. The mode of travel of 3 625 (0,2%) was not specified. The total number of residents from SADC countries that arrived by road was 6 643 026 (91,9%). The number arriving by air was 428 344 (5,9%) and those by sea, and rail were 644. The mode of travel of 154 722

(2,1%) arrivals was not specified. The number of residents from 'other' African countries that came by air was 140 839 (83,5%) and arrivals by road was 27 225 (16,1%). Whereas 92 came in by rail and sea, the mode of travel of 522 (0,3%) was not specified.

2.4 Purpose of travel

An overwhelming majority, 9 081 303 (93,3%) of foreign arrivals in 2008 was admitted into the country on visitor's temporary resident permit (see Table 2.1.1). Relatively, very few arrivals came to South Africa for business 185 853 (1,9%); work 137 032 (1,4%) and studies 109 053 (1,1%).

Figure 4 shows that, 2 089 310 (92,6%) of the overseas arrivals reported that they were in South Africa on holiday, while 68 992 (3,1%); 74 026 (3,3%) and 14 526 (0,6%) had come for business, to work and to study respectively.

For arrivals from SADC countries 6 833 033 (94,6%) reported that they were in South Africa on holiday, while 105 772 (1,5%); 36 202 (0,5%) and 73 697 (1,0%) had come for business, to work and to study respectively.

Unlike arrivals from overseas and SADC countries, relatively fewer arrivals from 'other' African countries came to South Africa for holidays 138 048 (81,8%). Rather, a higher proportion of arrivals from 'other' African countries had come for business 10 374 (6,1%); to work 10 585 (6,3%) and to study 7 920 (4,7%).

Data in Table 2.1.5 and Figures 5, 6, 7 and 8 series reveal that the majority of overseas arrivals on holiday (22,4%); business persons (21,5%) and workers (10,9%) were UK

residents. However, the highest proportion of overseas students (18,7%) came from USA. Arrivals from SADC countries were more diverse. Persons on holiday (29,1%) were predominantly Lesotho residents. Whereas the majority of students (24,1%) were Botswana residents; the business persons (25,9%) and workers (58,1%) were mainly Zimbabwe residents. Nigeria residents predominated among arrivals from 'other' African countries in three categories namely, holiday (28,4%); work (27,2%) and study (23,7%). The majority of business persons (22,8%) was from Kenya.

3. South African residents in 2008

The mode of travel used by South African residents was quite similar to that of foreign travellers. Data in Table 2.2.1 indicate that during 2008, as many as 2 634 437 (59,6%) South African residents arrived in South Africa by road, followed by 1 764 971 (40,0%) air arrivals. A total of 19 079 (0,4%) arrived by sea, rail and unspecified mode of travel. Of the total number of South Africa residents arriving by air, 1 469 944 (83,3%) arrived through OR Tambo International Airport, while 239 098 (13,6%) arrived through Cape Town International Airport; 14 486 (0,8%) arrived through Durban International Airport and 41 443 (2,4%) came in through other airports.

Similarly, road, 2 627 608 (59,3%), was the most common mode of travel used by South African residents departing South Africa (see Table 3.2.1). This was followed by air travel, 1 800 211 (40,6%). A total of 1 580 (0,04%) left by sea, rail and unspecified mode of transport. Of the total number of residents departing by air, (85,1%) used OR Tambo International Airport, while 242 652 (13,5%) left through Cape Town International Airport; 15 353 (0,8%) through Durban International Airport and 41 348 (2,3%) through other airports.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

1. Introduction

This annual report contains information on population movements into and out of South Africa for the year 2008. It reports on arrivals and departures of South African and foreign travellers. Travellers include (a) same-day visitors and tourists and (b) other travellers such as migrant workers, business persons and students.

Legal movements across South African borders as well as legal immigration into South Africa fall under the jurisdiction of the Department of Home Affairs (DHA). Statistics South Africa (Stats SA) collects, processes and publishes this information.

Administrative data sources from the DHA, that is, information from all the country's ports of entry constitute the only comprehensive source of information on foreign arrivals and departures. The information from this source of data provides the best national coverage (in terms of both space and time) of the population movements of South African residents and foreign travellers. The data:

- can be used to estimate, monitor and understand salient characteristics of foreign travellers and volumes of South African residents travelling outside South Africa;
- can, in the absence of information on foreign tourists, be further analysed to provide some indication of international tourism; and
- provide information that can be used to (a) assess the extent of government's progress in strengthening bilateral political and economic relations by assessing the number of international tourist arrivals; and (b) benchmark surveys focusing on demand for local tourism services by foreign travellers.

2. Data

Data routinely collected by immigration officers at all land, air and sea entry ports on all travellers (South African residents and foreign travellers) arriving into or departing from South Africa are captured into the DHA's population Movement Control System (MCS). Generally the data are collected directly from travel documents either by scanning or capturing onto the port's electronic database. No forms or cards are used (except in rare occasions when the system is down) to collect information from travellers. Individual ports regularly transmit data onto the national database at the head office of the DHA. Statistics South Africa (Stats SA) downloads the data covering a particular calendar month from the mainframe of the State Information Technology Agency (SITA), where the DHA stores its data.

3. Definitions**3.1 Definitions used by the United Nations World Tourism Organisation (UNWTO)**

Visitor refers to any person travelling to a place other than that of his/her usual environment for less than 12 months and whose main purpose of the trip is other than the exercise of an activity remunerated from within the place visited.

Tourist (overnight visitor) is a visitor who stays at least one night in collective or private accommodation in the place visited.

Tourism comprises the activities of persons travelling to, and staying in places outside their usual environment, for not more than one consecutive year, for leisure, business and other purposes. The usual environment of a person consists of a certain area around his/her place of residence, plus all other places he/she frequently visits.

3.2 Definitions used specifically in this report

South African resident: refers to either a South African citizen or a non-South African citizen with a South African permanent residence permit.

Foreign traveller: refers to a traveller who is not a South African citizen or permanent resident.

Region: refers to the following country classification: Europe, North America, Central and South America, Australasia, the Middle East, Asia, SADC, East and Central Africa, West Africa and North Africa.

Country: refers to individual countries within a region. With the exception of Tables 2.1.2; 2.2.1; 3.1.1 and 3.2.1 where the countries mentioned are the bordering countries of South Africa; **country** is used as the country of residence of foreign travellers.

Africa: refers to all the countries in Africa (both mainland and island countries).

SADC: refers to the thirteen countries, excluding South Africa, that belong to the Southern African Development Community.

'Other' African countries: refers to all African non-SADC member countries.

Overseas refers to all other countries outside Africa.

5. Limitations

The main limitation of the published information is its inability to directly measure the volume of tourists. The main aspects of the United Nations World Tourism Organisation's (UNWTO) definition of a tourist are duration of stay and whether individuals are remunerated in the place being visited. Although the intended duration of stay can be inferred from the expiry date of the temporary residence permit, this does not necessarily translate into actual duration of stay. In addition, the data do not provide information on the remuneration status of travellers in South Africa.

6. Related publications

Tourism statistics are also published in the quarterly *Bulletin of Statistics* and in the monthly Statistical Release P0351: *Tourism and Migration*.

Figure 1. Arrival and departure of foreign travellers in South Africa, 1980 - 2008

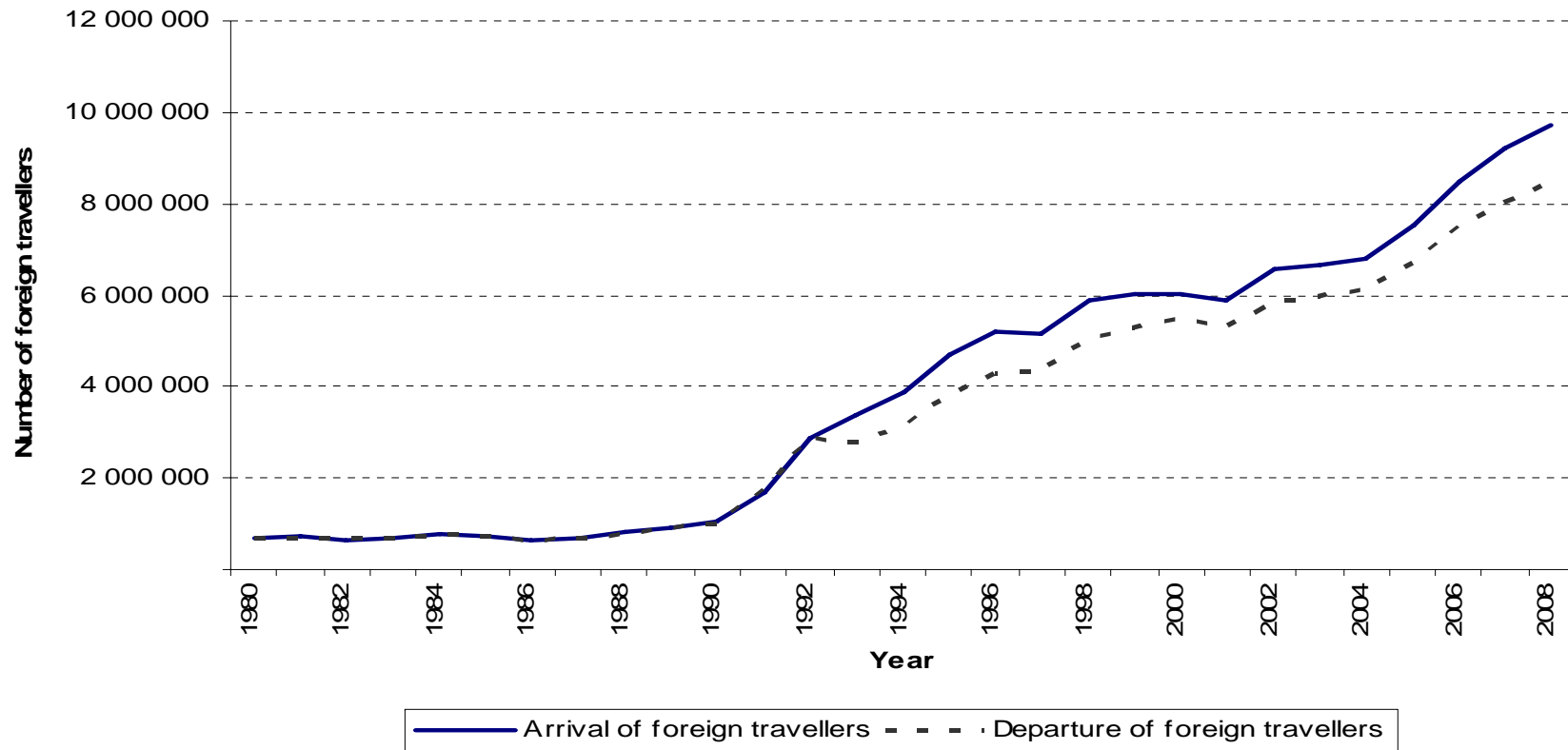
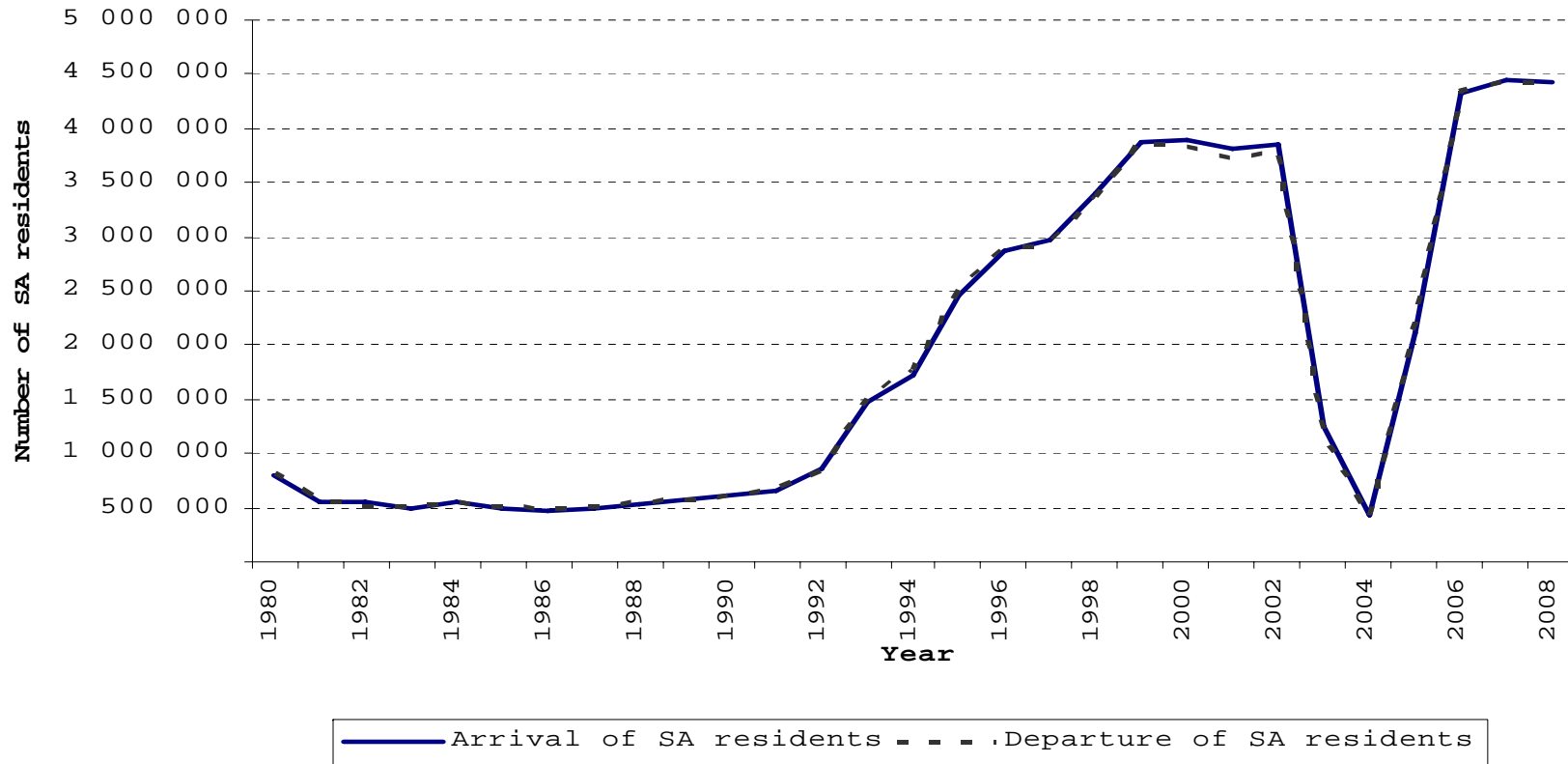


Figure 2: Arrival and departure of South African residents, 1980 - 2008



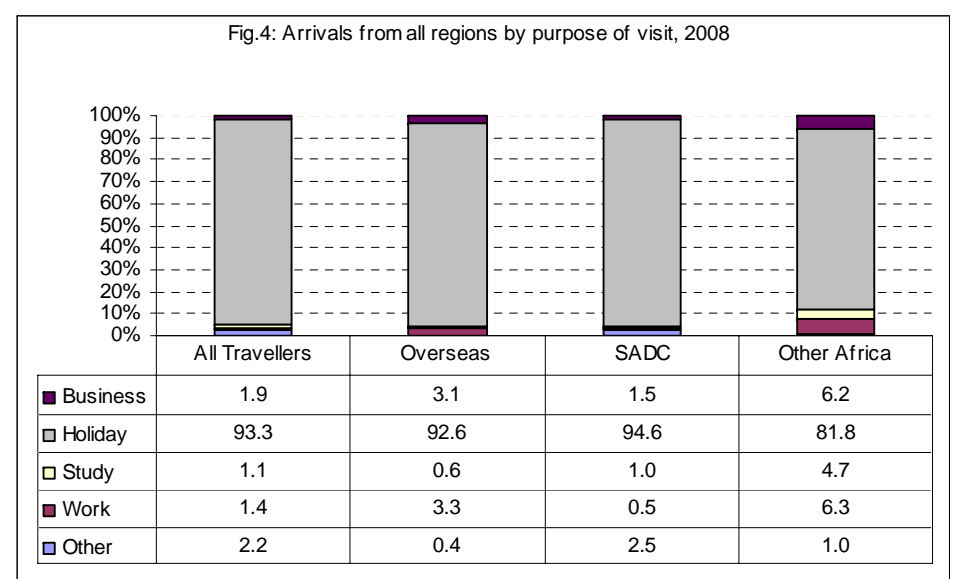
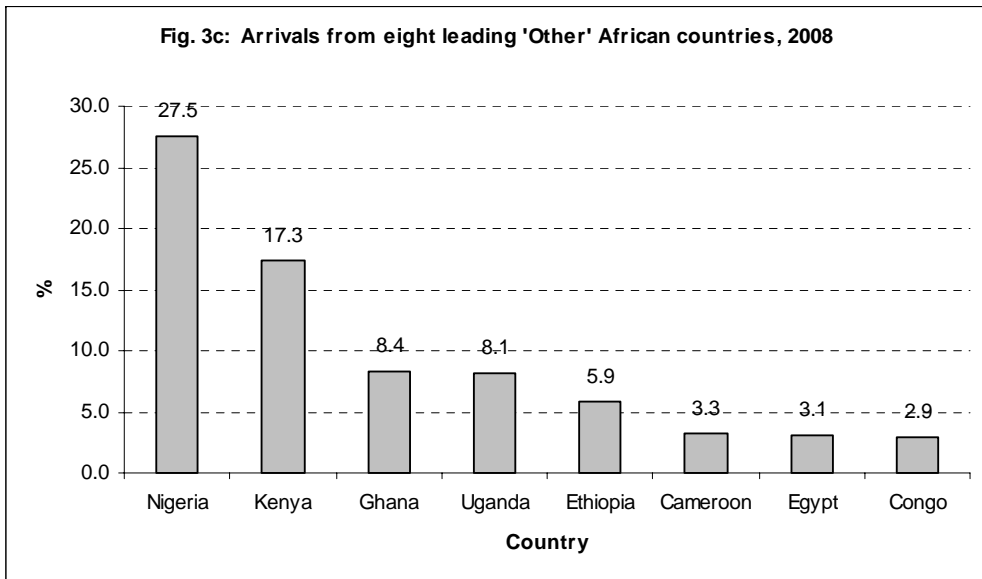
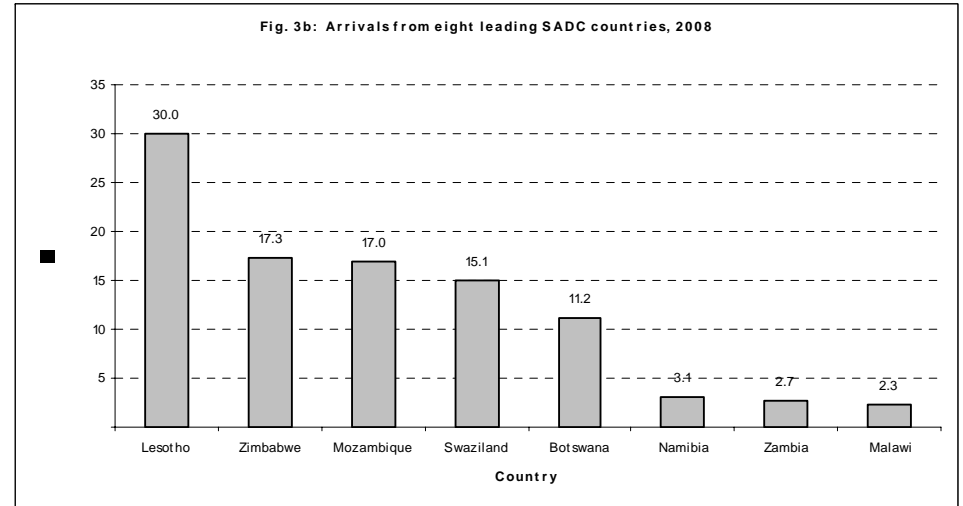
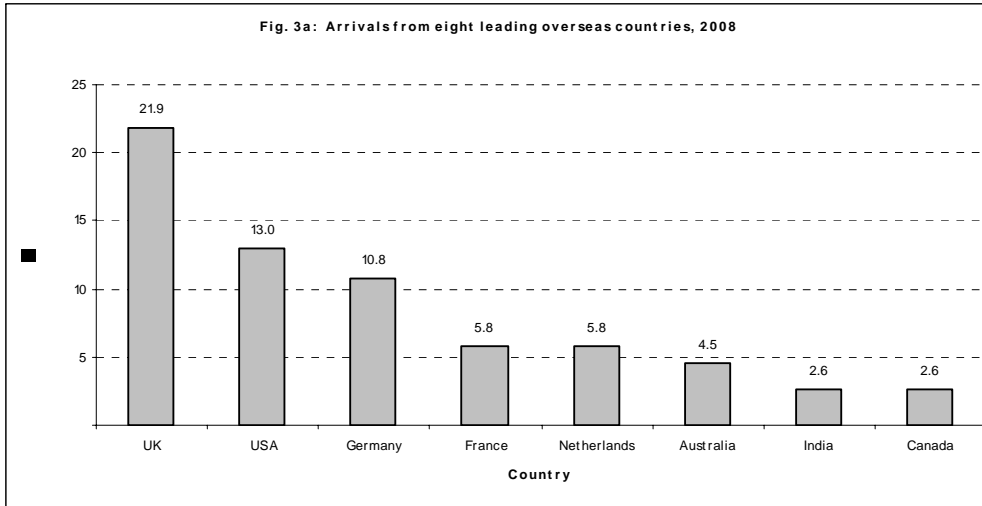


Fig. 5a: Percentage distribution of arrivals from eight leading overseas countries on holiday, 2008

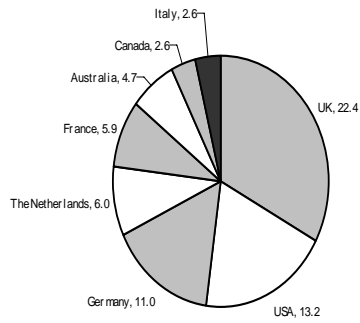


Fig. 5b: Percentage distribution of arrivals from eight leading SADC countries on holiday, 2008

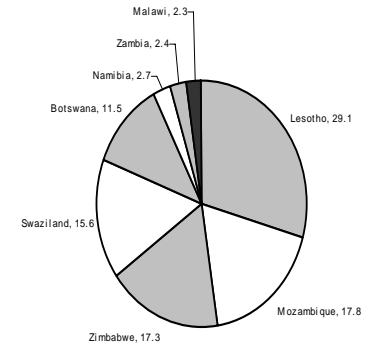


Fig. 5c: Percentage distribution of arrivals from eight leading 'other' African countries on holiday, 2008

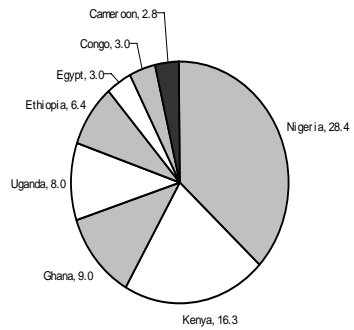


Fig. 6a: Percentage distribution of arrivals from eight leading overseas countries on business, 2008

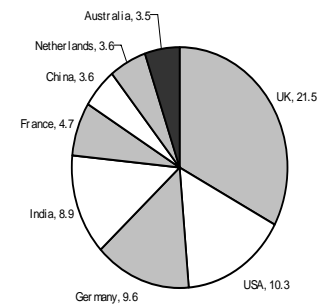


Fig. 6b: Percentage distribution of arrivals from eight leading SADC countries on business, 2008

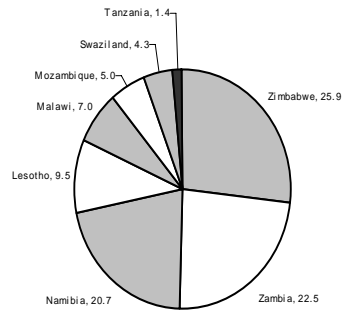


Fig. 6c: Percentage distribution of arrivals from eight leading 'other' African countries on business, 2008

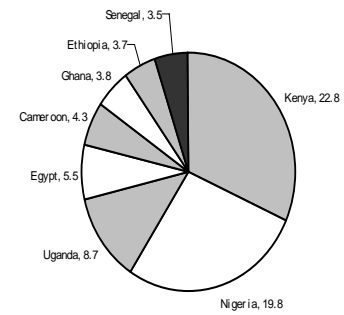


Fig. 7a: Percentage distribution of arrivals from eight leading overseas countries on study, 2008

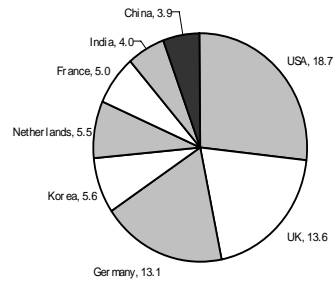


Fig. 7b: Percentage distribution of arrivals from eight leading SADC countries on study, 2008

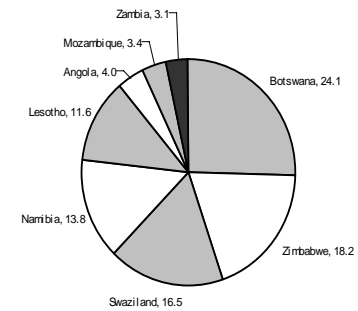


Fig. 7c: Percentage distribution of arrivals from eight leading 'other' African countries on study, 2008

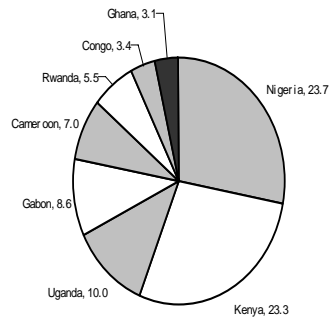


Fig. 8a: Percentage distribution of arrivals from eight leading overseas countries on work, 2008

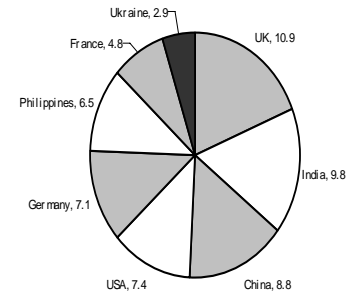


Fig. 8b: Percentage distribution of arrivals from eight leading SADC countries on work, 2008

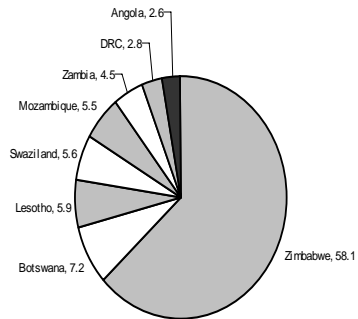
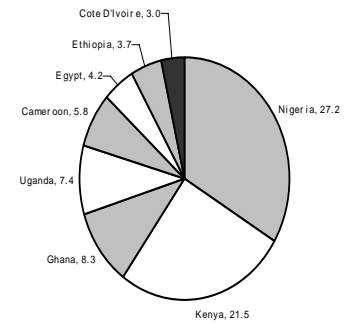


Fig. 8c: Percentage distribution of arrivals from eight leading 'other' African countries on work, 2008
