You've got no one to blame except yourself. Admit it. You totally forgot about Valentine's Day. You've got to come up with something fast!


You grimace as you look in your wallet, realising that you used your credit card a tad too much in December. No time; little money.


Tourist accommodation generates less income in 2017

The total amount of income generated from tourist accommodation in 2017 was up by 4,6% compared with 2016.

This is according to Stats SA's *Tourist* accommodation release for December 2017, covering data collected from hotels, caravan parks, camping sites, and guest houses.

The tourism industry generated just over R25,2 billion from accommodation in 2017, up from R24,1 billion in 2016. The 4,6% rise was lower than the increases recorded for 2016 (11,3%) and 2015 (8,4%).


Western Cape leads with rising prices

The prices of goods and services for South African consumers increased by 5,3% in 2017, according to Stats SA's *Consumer Price Index (CPI)* release for December 2017.

This is lower than the 6,4% rise recorded in 2016 but higher than 4,6% in 2015.

In 2017, consumer prices rose faster in Western Cape (up 6,2%) than in all other provinces. Northern Cape consumers experienced the slowest rise in overall inflation.
