

Classification changes












- CPI is classified according to the international Classification of Individual Consumption by Purpose (COICOP)
- New version adopted by United Nations
 Statistics Commission in 2018
- Aims to provide greater detail and international comparability






Key changes: Split of division 12 into Insurance and Financial services (12) and Miscellaneous (13)




Impact

- 1. Creation of new division (Insurance and financial services)
- 2. Expenditure collected for the first time for certain groups
- 3. No revision of previous data, but will provide an indicative re-classified time series
- 4. Changes to names on publication
- 5. Change to codes in Excel files. Will provide a concordance table with old and new codes

Today's presentation uses new COICOP for like-on-like comparison







Index re-referencing (rebasing)





- 1. Index reference period is where all indices = 100
- 2. Usually re-reference with basket and weights update to facilitate changes
- 3. Re-referencing removes influence of historical inflation on current readings
- 4. Current index reference period is December 2021=100
- 5. New reference period will be December 2024=100
- 6. Re-referencing only changes the level of the indices
- 7. All rates of change remain as published

Background to basket and weights update











- Weights of CPI are proportions of total household consumption expenditure
- A weight is attached to each product in the basket of goods and services
- Weights determine the relative impact of price changes in a product on the headline CPI
- Current reference period = 2019
- New reference period = 2023

Results adjusted in certain groups for:

- additional detail
- instances of underreporting
- methodological differences
- better alignment with Household Final Consumption Expenditure (HFCE) account


















Method to determine basket and calculate weights





- Calculate expenditure value for each product
- Select cumulative 80% value in each product category
- Minimum 0,01% of total expenditure
- Value for non-selected products redistributed to those selected
- All values are then converted to percentages






Headline CPI weights






Provincial proportion of total expenditure










