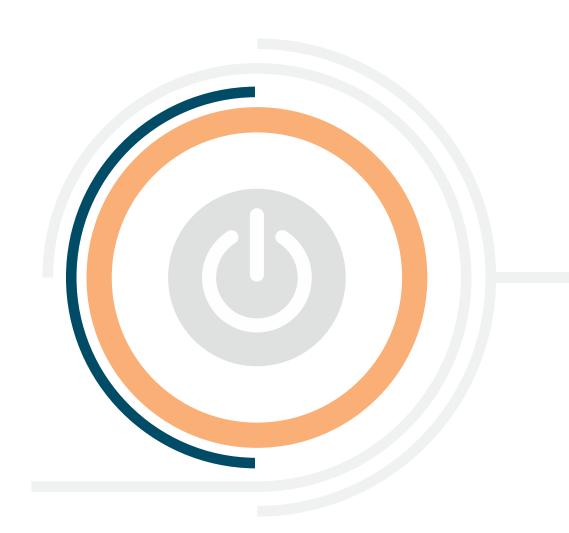
1. INTRODUCTION

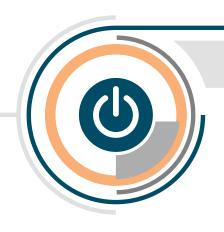

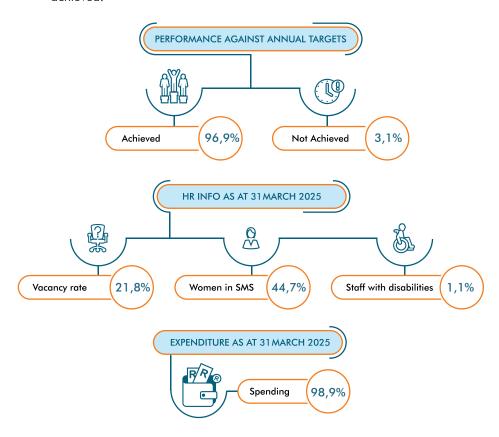




2. OVERVIEW OF DEPARTMENTAL PERFORMANCE



Stats SA achieved 96,9% (380) of its annual targets (392) of which 96,8% (368) were achieved as scheduled; 1,3% (5) were achieved earlier than scheduled, and 1,9% (7) were achieved later than scheduled. 3,1% (12) of targets were not achieved.





3. PROGRAMME PERFORMANCE



3.1 Programme 1: Administration

Programme purpose: Provides strategic leadership, management, and support services to the department.

Linking programmes with strategic outcomes: Programme 1 contributes to the following strategic outcomes:

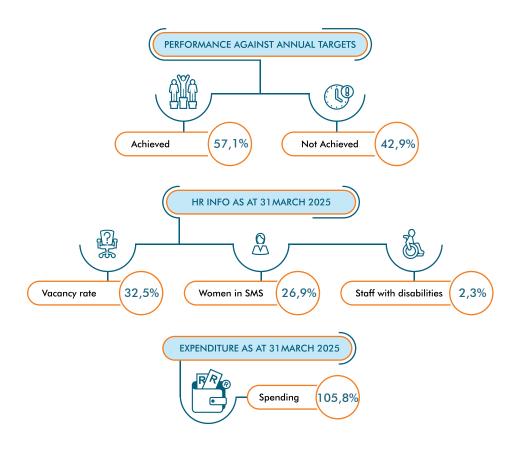

Overall programme performance:

Programme 1: Administration achieved 57,1% of its annual targets (14) as at 31 March 2025. 42,9% of targets (6) were not achieved.



Subprogrammes:

Departmental Management provides strategic leadership, management, and support services to the department, including executive and project management support services, strategic management and organisational development services, and risk, anti-corruption, and integrity management services.

- a) **Executive and Project Management Support** provides various management support services, including international relations support, ministerial support, interdepartmental and executive secretarial support to structures such as the Statistics Council and Exco. Key outputs included a report on support provided to the Continuous Population Survey (CPS) project, and the development of 25% (Phase 3) of prioritised Management Information Repository (MIR) functions.
- b) **Strategy, Operations and Organisational Development** provides strategic management services including the compilation of the strategic, annual performance and operational plans, quarterly and annual reports, the service delivery improvement plan and reports, change and business management support, and organisational and job design services. Key outputs included the mapping of a business process for job evaluation, and the compilation of a transformation and change management plan for 2025/26. The new 5-year strategic plan was compiled in line with the Medium-Term Development Plan.
- c) Risk, Anti-corruption and Integrity Management provides risk, integrity, and business continuity management services to the department. A disaster risk reduction plan was not compiled as scheduled due to human resource constraints. The activity is dependent on the availability of resources.

Corporate Services is responsible for providing a legal advisory service to the department, efficient facilities, security and logistical services, human resource management and development support services.

- a) **Human Resource Management and Development** provides human resource management and development support services and promotes sound human management principles in line with the Public Service Act and other applicable labour legislation. A skills audit was not conducted as scheduled due to the complexity of the activity, which will commence in 2025/26 and be undertaken in phases over the next three years. The 16 Days of Activism for No Violence Against Women and Children initiative was supported through awareness campaigns.
- b) Facilities, Transport and Security Management provides efficient facilities, security, and logistical services to the department. Key outputs included the compilation of a security plan and a report on the roll-out of Phase 1 of the accommodation plan.

Financial Management Services provides financial, asset and procurement support services to the department; it promotes financial practices for good governance and administration in line with the Public Finance Management Act (PFMA). Key outputs included reports on the reduction of irregular expenditure and the reduction of audit findings from the 2023/24 Auditor-General audit. The reduction of fruitless, wasteful and unauthorised expenditure was not achieved as scheduled due to resource constraints.

Internal Audit provides an independent audit service to the department; it assists management in improving internal controls, risk management and governance by providing independent risk-based assurance services, as well as advisory services as required by the Public Finance Management Act. A performance audit report on asset management was not compiled as scheduled due to internal processes. A regulatory audit on asset management is scheduled for 2025/26.

Response to prioritising women, youth and persons with disabilities: The programme is committed to improving employment equity through the prioritisation of women, youth and persons with disabilities in the recruitment process.

Strategy to overcome areas of underperformance/Challenges and impact of resource constraints: The high vacancy rate of 32,5% had an impact on the achievement of targets in the work programme. The meeting of employment equity targets and the filling of critical vacant posts will remain a priority for the department in the 2025/26 financial year. The implementation of the 5-year strategic plan is dependent on the availability of resources.

3.2 Programme 2: Economic Statistics

Programme purpose: Produce economic statistics to inform evidence-based economic development.

Objectives:

- o Produce economic indicators to inform evidence-based planning, monitoring, evaluation and decision-making for use by the public and private sectors by:
- o publishing monthly, quarterly, annual and periodic statistical releases on various industries in the private and public sectors;
- o publishing monthly statistical releases on a range of price indexes;
- o publishing quarterly and annual estimates of gross domestic product (GDP); and
- o improving the measurement of economic indicators through the application of internationally recognised standards and practices on an ongoing basis.

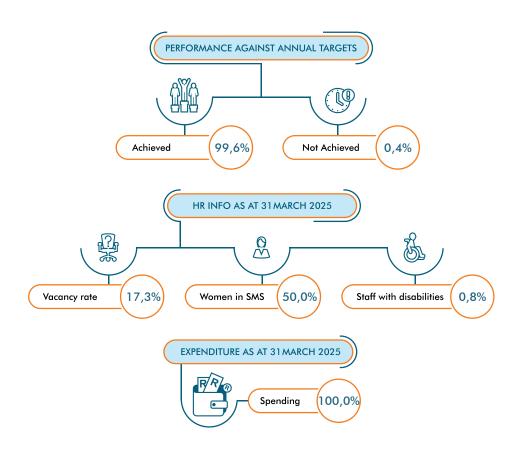

Overall programme performance:

Programme 2: Economic Statistics achieved 99,6% (251) of its annual targets (252) as at 31 March 2025. 0,4% (1) target was not achieved.



Subprogrammes:

Programme Management for Economic Statistics provides strategic direction and leadership to this programme. Key activities in 2024/25 included sign-off of statistical releases and reports, the updating and monitoring of the implementation of the economic statistics strategy and maintaining relations with key partners in the national statistics system. This programme informed economic planning, monitoring, and decision-making by providing accurate, relevant, and timely statistical information on the level of economic activity in relation to the primary, secondary, and tertiary sectors of the economy, price stability, financial information on private sector businesses and government, and information on sustainable resource use and management.

Business Cycle Indicators provides statistical information on turnover and volumes in various industries through the publication of monthly, quarterly, and annual releases. Key outputs included **150** published releases consisting of 144 monthly releases, 4 quarterly releases and 2 annual releases on business cycle indicators, and 3 reports on improving business cycle indicator The results of piloting deflation of the tourist accommodation survey were not published as scheduled due to data challenges. Work will continue in 2025/26.

Structural Industry Statistics publishes periodic statistical information on the income and expenditure of industries and selected non-financial variables. Key outputs included the publication of **8** periodic reports on mining, wholesale trade, retail trade, motor trade, accommodation, food and beverages, post and telecommunications and agriculture statistics.

Five additional releases were published, including 2 reports on the COEGA Special Economic Zone for 2023 and 2024 and reports on Forestry, logging and related services for 2023; Ocean, fisheries and related services for 2023; and Census 2022 Agricultural Households.

Price Statistics provides information on inflation by compiling the consumer price index (CPI) and various producer price indices (PPI). Key outputs included **61** published releases consisting of monthly CPI, PPI, CMPI, and XMUVI, 10 monthly RPPI releases, 2 RPPI discussion documents, and a release on updated CPI weights. In addition, PPI weights for 2025 were published.

Private Sector Financial Statistics tracks the financial performance of private sector organisations. Key outputs included **9** published releases consisting of 4 quarterly releases on financial statistics of private sector enterprises, **1** annual release on financial statistics of the private sector, and 4 quarterly releases on capital expenditure.

Government Financial Statistics tracks public sector spending. Key outputs included 12 published releases consisting of 4 quarterly releases on selected financial statistics of municipalities, 1 annual release on the non-financial census of municipalities, and 7 annual releases on government financial statistics. A report on the testing of administrative data for the Quarterly Financial Statistics of Selected Municipalities (QFSSM) was compiled.

National Accounts produces GDP data and other integrated statistical products. Key outputs included 6 published releases consisting of 4 quarterly Gross Domestic Product (GDP) releases, 1 regional GDP release, and Supply and Use tables for 2021. A discussion document on Environmental-Economic Accounting (EEA) as part of the Natural Capital Accounting (NCA) series was published.

Response to prioritising women, youth and persons with disabilities: The programme is committed to improving employment equity through the prioritisation of youth and persons with disabilities in the recruitment process. Women in SMS as at the end of March 2025 were 50,0%.

Strategy to overcome areas of underperformance/Challenges and impact of resource constraints: The vacancy rate within the branch, linked with the loss of experienced staff, leaves the programme in a vulnerable position. The response rates of some surveys are gradually decreasing, instances of delays in publications are occurring, and the inherent quality of the data at a granular level needs improvement. There is no capacity to increase the scope of the current surveys, nor to introduce additional surveys that can measure emerging areas of economic activity and the environment. The implementation of newly adopted international frameworks and classifications will be delayed until capacity constraints are addressed.

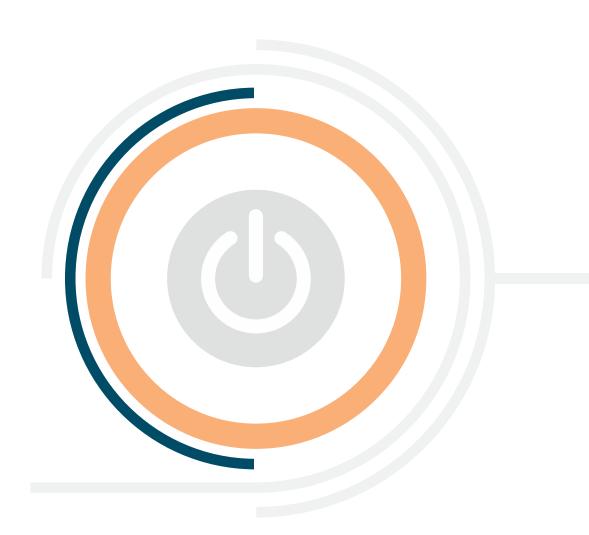

3.3 Programme 3: Population and Social Statistics

Programme purpose: Produce population and social statistics to inform evidence-based socio-economic development.

Objectives:

- O Sustain national population and social indicators to inform evidence-based planning, monitoring and decision-making for use by the public and private sectors by:
- o publishing quarterly and annual statistical information on the labour market, and on employment and earnings in the formal and informal sectors;
- o publishing monthly and annual statistical information on vital registrations based on administrative sources;
- o publishing annual and periodic statistical information on poverty levels, living conditions, service delivery, population dynamics and demographic trends; and
- o improving the measurement of social indicators through the application of internationally recognised standards and practices on an ongoing basis.

Linking programmes with strategic outcomes and objectives: Programme 3 contributes to the following strategic outcome.

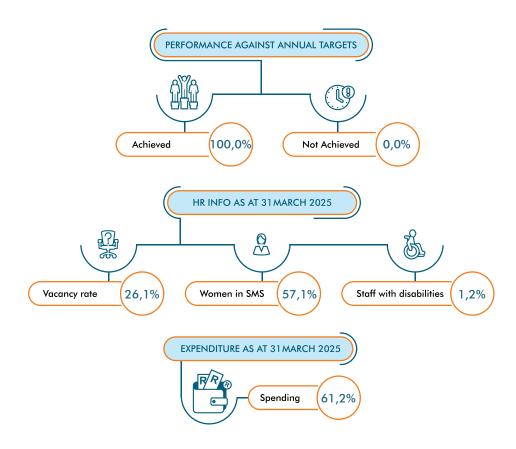




- a) Put stakeholders at the centre to increase usage and trust

Programme 3: Population and Social Statistics achieved 100% (67) of its annual targets as at 31 March 2025 of which 85,0% (57) of targets were achieved as scheduled; 6,0% (4) of targets were achieved earlier than scheduled, and 9,0% (6) of targets were achieved later than scheduled.



Programme Management for Population and Social Statistics provides strategic direction and leadership to the programme. Key activities in 2024/25 included sign-off of statistical releases and reports, monitoring the implementation of the population and social statistics strategy, and maintaining relations with key partners in the national statistics system. This programme contributed to informing social and economic development planning, monitoring, and decision-making by providing relevant, timely and accurate statistical information on living conditions, population dynamics, vital events, employment, crime, and poverty levels.

Demographic and Population Statistics publishes population statistics, demographic trends, and mid-year population estimates (MYPE) collected through population censuses and surveys, and from other administrative sources. Key outputs included 18 published releases/reports consisting of Mid-year population estimates (MYPE) at national and provincial and district levels (2), 1 technical report on MYPE estimation, 1 report on age and sex structure, 1 report on migration statistics, and 13 reports on Census 2022. 2 concept notes on local municipal MYPE estimation and household estimation and 1 technical report on fertility from Census data were compiled.

Health and Vital Statistics publishes statistics on births, deaths, marriages, divorces, tourism, and migration based on administrative records. Key outputs included **16** published releases/reports consisting of 12 monthly releases on international tourism, 1 annual report on international tourism, and 3 annual releases on vital statistics. In addition, a release on perinatal deaths in SA was published.

Social Statistics provides information on living conditions, domestic tourism and crime collected through household surveys. Key outputs included 10 published releases/reports consisting of 3 annual releases on domestic tourism, social and household service delivery, and victims of crime statistics, 2 annual releases on development indicators, 2 annual reports on marginalised groups, and 3 thematic reports on gender, child and household services statistics. A technical report on improving domestic tourism and a research report on alternative data sources on education and child statistics were compiled. An additional release on child statistics was published.

Labour Statistics provides information on employment levels in the formal non-agricultural sector, and on labour market trends in South Africa. Key outputs included 10 published releases/reports consisting of 4 releases on quarterly employment statistics (QES), and 4 releases on quarterly labour force survey (QLFS), an annual report on labour market statistics, and a report on the informal sector (SESE).

Poverty and Inequality Statistics provides information on poverty levels, and household income and expenditure trends in South Africa. Key outputs included 3 published reports/releases consisting of reports on national poverty lines for 2024, food security, and household income and expenditure based on IES 2022/23. An IES 2022/23 project closure report, an assessment document on GHS and IES for the youth Multidimensional Poverty Index (MPI) and 3 documents on the Continuous Population Survey were compiled.

Response to prioritising women, youth, and persons with disabilities: Published statistical releases on gender, labour market information, and the national poverty line for 2024. The programme is committed to improving employment equity through the prioritisation of youth and persons with disabilities in the recruitment process. Women in SMS as at the end of March 2025 were 57,1%.

Strategy to overcome areas of underperformance/Challenges and impact of resource constraints: The branch has made significant progress in achieving its targets; however, several key strategic projects are currently encountering challenges due to resource constraints. There has been a gradual decline in the response rates for certain surveys, and updates to the Master Sample Frame for the Continuous Population Survey have been temporarily paused. Additionally, there is a backlog in the processing and analysis of mortality and cause of death data. Efforts to identify alternative data sources are also facing some delays, which may affect the programme's overall resilience. Considering the organisation's broader financial constraints, the branch utilised only 60% of its allocated budget. A strategic decision was taken to defer operations related to the Master Sample Frame updates to the 2025/26 financial year to support effective expenditure management at an organisational level.

3.4 Programme 4: Methodology and Statistical Infrastructure

Programme purpose: Develop standards, statistical frames, methodologies and conduct statistical research.

Objectives:

- o Improve the quality and methodological soundness of statistical information by researching, developing, applying and reviewing statistical methods, standards, classifications and procedures in the statistical value chain annually.
- o Monitor and evaluate the methodological compliance of statistical operations by conducting independent evaluations on statistical practices annually.
- o Ensure complete and accurate sampling frames to enhance the quality of economic and social statistics by maintaining and updating business and geographic information frames annually.

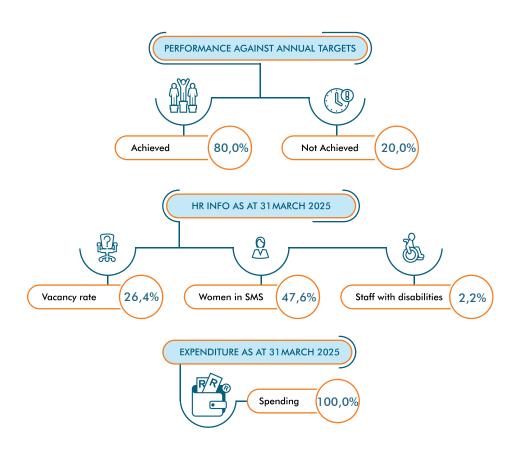

Statistical Programme 4: Methodology and Statistical Infrastructure achieved 80,0% (4) of its annual targets (5) as at March 2025, and 20% (1) was not achieved.



Programme Management for Methodology and Statistical Infrastructure provides strategic direction and leadership to the programme. Key activities in 2024/25 included providing strategic guidance on the development of standards, statistical frames, and methodologies, and monitoring the implementation of the work programme. The programme contributes towards achieving the organisational strategic outcomes of an agile operating model and interconnected statistical systems. The key deliverables are essential and critical elements that form the support system and foundation of core statistical products.

Statistical Methods provides technical expertise and advice on statistical methodologies and practices for producing official statistics. A key output was a redesigned master sample for the Continuous Population and Household Surveys.

Statistical Standards develops standards, classifications and definitions for surveys undertaken by the department. A key output was a preliminary report on the adoption of the International Standard on Industrial Classification (ISIC Rev.5).

Business Register maintains and improves the sampling frame for economic statistics. A report on the evaluation of additional sources for the business register was not compiled as scheduled due to dependency on external stakeholders. Work will continue in 2025/26.

Geography maintains and improves the frame for geographic information in household surveys and censuses. A key output included an updated frame of PSUs for the Continuous Population and Household Surveys.

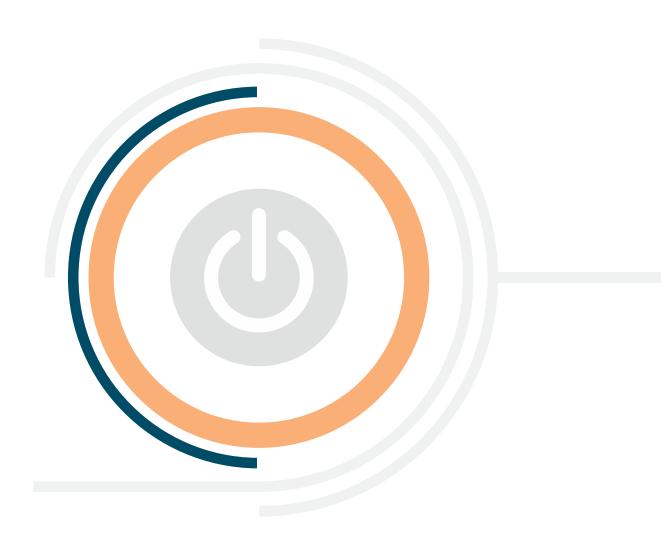
Survey Monitoring and Evaluation monitors the quality of statistical operations for surveys and censuses and conducts independent evaluations. A key output included a report on the piloting of a code of practice for the Quality Management System (QMS).

Response to prioritising women, youth and persons with disabilities: The programme is committed to improving employment equity through the prioritisation of women, youth and persons with disabilities in the recruitment process.

Strategy to overcome areas of underperformance/Challenges and impact of resource constraints: The branch is currently operating with a vacancy rate of 26,4%, compounded by the departure of highly experienced staff. This poses a significant risk to the delivery of methodological support for surveys and the maintenance of a robust statistical infrastructure. The modernisation and innovation of the statistical value chain rely heavily on strong foundations in statistical methods, frames, classifications, and standards. Recent amendments to the Statistics Act are expected to place additional demands on the programme, particularly in establishing statistical standards across the national statistics system and providing methodological support to the statistics units within the National Statistical System entities. The branch's research and innovation hub is severely under-resourced, limiting its ability to explore emerging technologies and methodologies.

3.5 Programme 5: Statistical Support and Informatics

Programme purpose: Enables statistical production through technology and promotes the use of statistics.

Objectives:

- o Modernise business processes by building enterprise architecture and applying emerging technologies for data collection and processing, and the dissemination of statistical information over the medium term.
- o Enable the department's production of official statistics by providing a technology infrastructure that is reliable, sustainable and cost effective over the medium term.
- o Increase awareness about and the use of official statistics by government and the public on an ongoing basis by reaching out to stakeholders and responding to user enquiries, educating users, and improving access to statistical information and making it easier to use.
- o Manage external and internal communications on statistical matters by issuing daily, weekly and monthly information updates through the media on an ongoing basis.

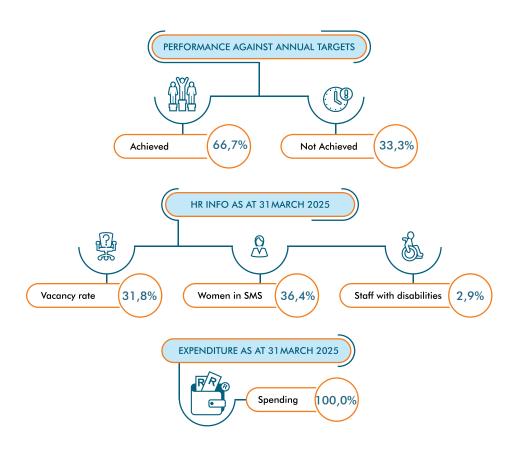

Programme 5: Statistical Support and Informatics achieved 66,7% (8) of its annual targets (12) as at 31 March 2025 and 33,3% (4) of targets were not achieved.



Programme Management for Statistical Support and Informatics provides strategic direction and leadership to the programme. Key activities in 2024/25 included leading strategic engagements with external stakeholders on creating an enabling ICT environment to support and enable business operations, especially for the census operations, providing strategic guidance on the establishment of an enterprise-wide architecture as a technology platform for the future, and monitoring the implementation of the work programme. This programme contributed to the achievement of the strategic outcome *Transformed capability*.

Advocacy and Dissemination manages external and internal communication and increases the use of statistical information through stakeholder engagement and the dissemination of official statistics on various platforms.

The alignment of the branding strategy to the integrated stakeholder management strategy was not completed due to human resource constraints. Internal stakeholder consultation is still in progress for Phase 4 of the website enhancement project. A user satisfaction survey was not conducted as scheduled due to dependency on internal stakeholders. A report on communication and marketing support to the dissemination of results of the IES was not compiled as the dissemination is in progress.

Business Modernisation improves data and information management across the department by modernising the way business is conducted and supported by technology. Key outputs included a report on the implementation of an enterprise architecture digital roadmap and the modernising of two business processes.

Publication Services provides editing, publishing, and distribution services to survey areas. Key outputs included monthly and annual publications to high schools and researchers and 60 databases with generic data storage.

Information and Communication Technology provides technology infrastructure to the department, and supports data management across statistical series. Key outputs included reports on the implementation of an ICT environment upgrade and an ICT Cybersecurity risk initiative.

Analytical Studies provides integrative statistical advice and support to policy planners and development practitioners, and participates in knowledge research and innovation on key development themes. Key outputs included 2 research reports on spatial analysis.

Response to prioritising women, youth and persons with disabilities: The programme is committed to improving employment equity through the prioritisation of women, youth and persons with disabilities in the recruitment process.

Strategy to overcome areas of underperformance/Challenges and impact of resource constraints: The branch is currently operating with a vacancy rate of 31,8%, further impacted by the loss of highly experienced technical staff. This presents a significant risk to the delivery of systems development support and the sustainability of a robust ICT infrastructure. The successful modernisation and innovation of the statistical value chain depend on a solid end-to-end enterprise architecture, where technology must effectively enable operations aligned with the Fourth Industrial Revolution. However, the ICT infrastructure remains critically under-resourced, limiting the organisation's ability to invest in current emerging technologies that could enhance its business operations.

3.6 Programme 6: Statistical Operations and Provincial Coordination

Programme purpose: Collects and processes data, and interacts with stakeholders and users at provincial and local levels.

Objectives:

- o Provide integrated data collection services, and disseminate quality statistics to provincial and local stakeholders and the public by ensuring an average annual response rate of 85%.
- o Expand the statistical information base for use by government, the private sector, and the public by conducting a population census every 10 years, and large-scale population surveys between censuses.
- o Ensure the efficiency and effectiveness of survey operations conducted by the department by coordinating household survey operations to ensure an average annual response rate of 85%.
- o Improve the quality and timeliness of the editing and processing of statistical data by administering a common data processing platform for censuses, household surveys, administrative records and ad hoc survey data over the medium term.

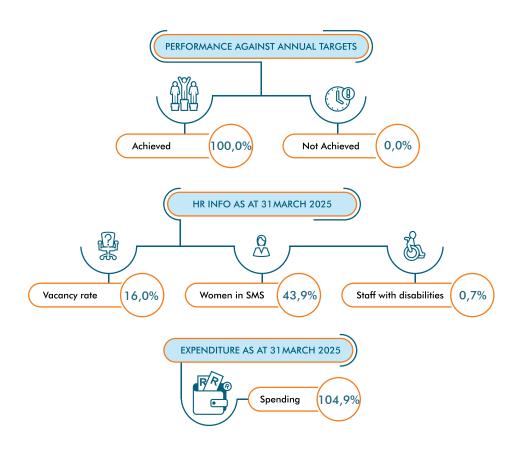

Programme 6: Statistical Operations and Provincial Coordination achieved 100,0% (24) of its annual targets as at 31 March 2025.



Programme Management for Statistical Operations and Provincial Coordination provides strategic direction and leadership to the programme. Key activities in 2024/25 included providing strategic guidance on improving integrated field operations, leading dissemination of Census 2022 in the provinces, addressing the backlog in data operations, and monitoring the implementation of the work programme. The programme contributes towards achieving the organisational strategic outcome of agile operating model. The key deliverables are essential and critical elements of the statistical value chain.

Provincial and District Offices provide integrated data collection and dissemination services and promote the use and coordination of official statistics to provincial and local stakeholders. Key outputs included a report on the implementation of the integrated fieldwork operations model (Phase 1), 9 provincial reports on Census 2022 dissemination (Phase 2) and 9 provincial reports on the dissemination of the results of the IES 2022/23.

Data Operations manages the processing and editing of census, survey, and administrative data. Key outputs included reports on the processing of death notification forms for the Mortality and Causes of Death (2022), and innovations for the Continuous Population Survey.

Household Surveys and Censuses conducts periodic population censuses and large-scale population surveys and coordinates and integrates collection activities across household surveys. Key outputs included reports on CPS field operations, improvements in digital data collection and the implementation of quality assurance tools.

Response to prioritising women, youth and persons with disabilities: The programme is committed to improving employment equity through the prioritisation of women, youth and persons with disabilities in the recruitment process.

Strategy to overcome areas of underperformance/Challenges and impact of resource constraints: The branch is responsible for the provincial and district office infrastructure and is currently operating with a vacancy rate of 16%. This shortage, compounded by the loss of skilled personnel, poses a significant risk to the effective collection of household statistical data and the subsequent processing required for analysis and dissemination. The inability to fill critical vacancies at these levels will lead to declining response rates, which in turn compromises the quality of data released to the public. A key challenge is the deterioration of the sampling frame due to insufficient resources for its regular updating. This has led to an out-of-scope rate exceeding 20% in household surveys, significantly compromising the quality of the collected statistics. Furthermore, the limited capacity of provincial and district offices hampers their ability to provide essential statistical services to provincial and local authorities, undermining evidence-based planning and development at the municipal level.

Programme purpose: Develop and coordinate the national statistics system in South Africa.

Objectives:

- o Ensure that the production of national statistics is based on common statistical standards and principles by providing statistical support and advice, and certifying statistics as official on an ongoing basis.
- o Ensure the sharing of statistical information by establishing and providing mechanisms, platforms and criteria for the sharing of data on an ongoing basis.
- o Drive statistical reporting by coordinating the compilation of statistical reports, in line with the integrated indicator framework, on an ongoing basis.

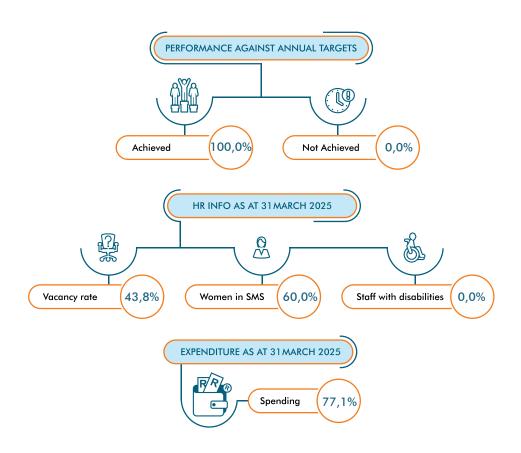

Programme 7: South African National Statistics System achieved 100,0% of their annual targets (18) as at 31 March 2025.



Programme Management for the South African National Statistics System provides strategic direction and leadership to the programme. Key outputs in 2024/25 included leading the legislative reform process, leading strategic engagements at national and international level on the Sustainable Development Goals programme, providing strategic guidance on the independent quality assessment programme and monitoring the work programme deliverables. This programme contributes to the achievement of the strategic outcomes *Insightful data* and *Interconnected Statistical Systems*.

Economic Subsystem coordinates and facilitates the production of economic and environmental statistics in the national statistics system and provides statistical support and advice to producers of official statistics. Key outputs included a report on the rationalised Integrated Indicator Framework (IIF) for the economic statistics subsystem and MoUs signed between Stats SA, National Treasury and the Reserve Bank and Stats SA and the Harry Gwala District Municipality.

Social Subsystem coordinates and facilitates the production of population and social statistics in the national statistics system and provides statistical support and advice to producers of official statistics. Key outputs included a reviewed clearance protocol, a report on the rationalised Integrated Indicator Framework for the social statistics subsystem and MoUs signed between Stats SA and the Department of Basic Education and SALGA.

Independent Quality Assessment conducts independent statistical reviews to assess the quality of statistical information, in line with the South African Statistical Quality Assessment Framework (SASQAF), to certify statistics as official. Key outputs included reports on four SASQAF quality assessments conducted and the review of SASQAF standards and guidelines.

Statistical Reporting coordinates the reporting of statistics to fulfil South Africa's statistical reporting obligations. Key outputs included a report on the updated Integrated Indicator Framework data values, a preliminary SDG report and a progress report on the legislative reform process.

Data and Information Management coordinates and manages the transfer and sharing of data among entities in the national statistics system. Key outputs included reports on the updated IIF portal, the updated online system for independent SASQAF assessment, and the review of an online metadata repository for indicators.

Response to prioritising women, youth and persons with disabilities: The programme is committed to improving employment equity through the prioritisation of youth and persons with disabilities in the recruitment process. Women in SMS as at 31 March 2025 were 60,0%.

Strategy to overcome areas of underperformance: The SANSS branch has achieved 100% of its targets as set out in the Work Programme.

The branch currently has a vacancy rate of 43,8%. The inability to fill vacancies in the branch has a major impact on the statistical services offered to other organs of state as well as other entities of the national statistical system.
