Statistics of insolvencies (Preliminary)

June 2026

In April 2023, the publication *Statistics of Liquidations and Insolvencies (P0043)* was split into two separate releases: *Statistics of Liquidations (P0043.1)* and *Statistics of Insolvencies (P0043.2)*. The release of *Statistics of Insolvencies (P0043.2)* was delayed following a cyber incident at the Department of Justice and Constitutional Development in September 2021. With the issue now resolved, the first standalone release of P0043.2 is being published for the current period. Users should note that this release does not represent a continuation of the previous series, as there is a break in the time series data between September 2021 and December 2022.

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Insolvencies: results for June 2026

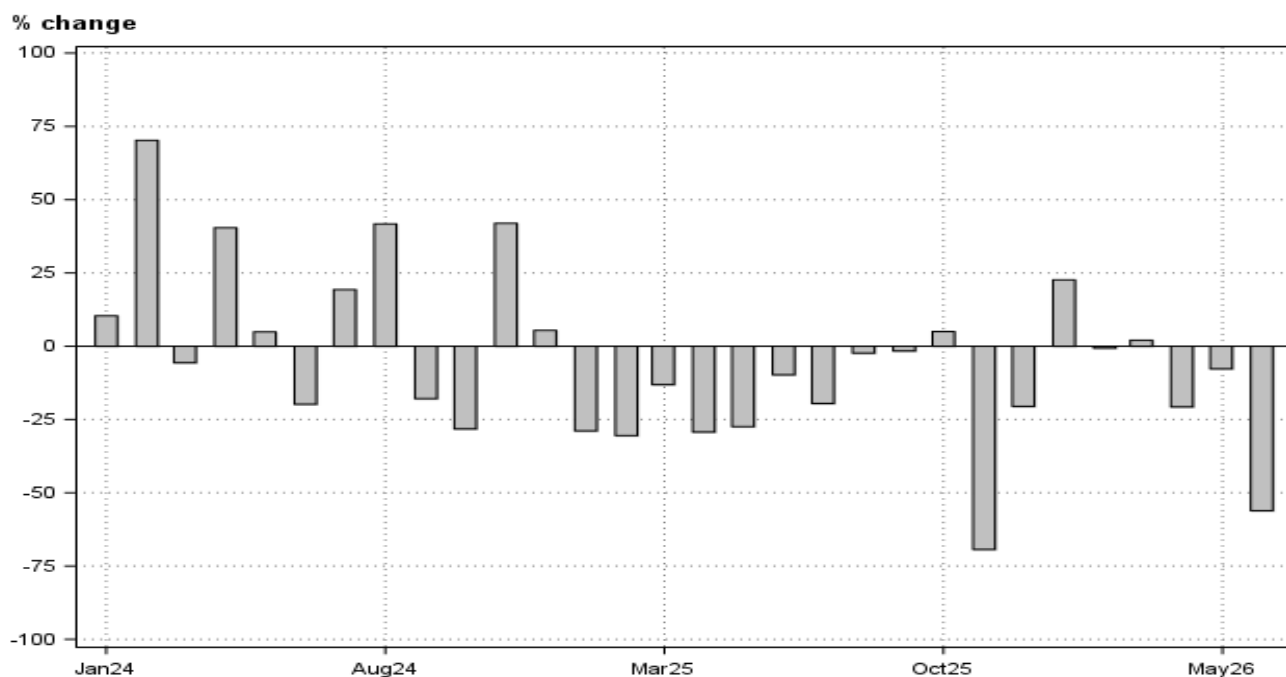

The total number of insolvencies decreased by 27,3% (from 440 to 320) in the second quarter of 2026 compared with the second quarter of 2025. There was a year-on-year decrease of 56,1% (from 139 to 61) in June 2026.

The total number of insolvencies decreased by 11,1% (from 847 to 753) in the first six months of 2026 compared with the first six months of 2025.

Introduction	1	Statistics South Africa (Stats SA) collects administrative information on insolvencies from the Department of Justice and Constitutional Development (DoJ&CD).
	2	This statistical release reflects insolvencies of individuals and partnerships.
Purpose of the survey	3	The aggregated data in this release are used by the private and public sectors to measure economic performance and are also an important indicator of the scope of unpaid debt in South Africa.
Scope of the survey	4	This survey covers the total number of individuals and partnerships placed under final sequestration.
Symbols and abbreviations	5	Stats SA – Statistics South Africa DoJ&CD – Department of Justice and Constitutional Development YTD – Year-to-date

Glossary

Insolvency	Insolvency refers to an individual or partnership which is unable to pay its debt and is placed under final sequestration. The number of insolvencies does not refer to the number of persons involved, as a partnership which is unable to pay its debt is regarded as one insolvency, irrespective of the number of partners.
Individual	An individual refers to a natural person whose estate is sequestrated by a court order in terms of the Insolvency Act, 1936. This category includes sole proprietors, where the individual and the business are not separate legal entities.
Partnership	A partnership refers to a business arrangement between two or more persons conducting business jointly for profit without forming a separate juristic person.
