General information	

Calculation of the weights

The PPI is weighted at an aggregate industry level and at the level of indicator product or elementary index.

Industry weights

The industry weights are derived from the estimates of value added from the national accounts and are updated on an annual basis.

Product weights

The primary sources of weighting information for elementary indices are large sample surveys of businesses, national accounts, and information from relevant government departments. The criterion for use is the level of detail available. In some instances, supplementary data is required to select indicator products. These include administrative sources, association surveys and customs data. The PPI manufacturing basket was updated using data from the 2021 manufacturing large sample survey, which was published in 2023. These changes took effect from the January 2024 PPI release. Table A below outlines the sources used to derive the 2025 PPI weights.
