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KEY FINDINGS: CONTRACT PRICE ADJUSTMENT PROVISIONS (CPAP)

In April 2022, month-on-month percentage changes in the CPAP work group indices ranged from -2,1% for work group 122 – non metal roofing to 10,9% for work group 120 – waterproofing (Table 1).

Noteworthy changes in April 2022 were as follows:

- **Work group 120:** The index increased by 10,9% month-on-month. There was an increase of 16,4% month-on-month in the PPI for bituminous mixtures (accounting for 65,0% of this work group).
- **Work group 113:** The index increased by 7,7% month-on-month. There was an increase of 10,2% month-on-month in the SEIFSA index for strand (accounting for 73,0% of this work group).
- **Work group 136:** The index increased by 6,8% month-on-month. There was an increase of 14,2% month-on-month in the SEIFSA index for Iscor steel price light sections (accounting for 10,0% of this work group), an increase of 9,0% month-on-month in the SEIFSA index for channels and PFC's (accounting for 9,0% of this work group), an increase of 8,1% month-on-month in the SEIFSA index for equal angles (accounting for 9,0% of this work group), an increase of 14,9% month-on-month in the SEIFSA index for flat bars (accounting for 9,0% of this work group), an increase of 14,7% month-on-month in the SEIFSA index for IPE's (accounting for 9,0% of this work group) and an increase of 15,6% month-on-month in the SEIFSA index for unequal angles (accounting for 9,0% of this work group).
- **Work group 134:** The index increased by 4,8% month-on-month. There was an increase of 14,9% month-on-month in the Seifsa index for flat bars (accounting for 7,0% of this work group), an increase of 14,7% month-on-month in the SEIFSA index for IPE's (accounting for 7,0% of this work group) and an increase of 15,6% month-on-month in the SEIFSA index for unequal angles (accounting for 7,0% of this work group).
- **Work group 154:** The index increased by 4,3% month-on-month. There was an increase of 16,4% month-on-month in the PPI for bituminous mixtures (accounting for 21,0% of this work group).

KEY FINDINGS: CONSTRUCTION INPUT PRICE INDICES (CIPI)

- **Total construction:** The index increased by 1,8% month-on-month (Table 2).
- **Civil engineering material – total:** The index increased by 2,9% month-on-month (Table 6).

The indices reported on in this publication are mainly based on a combination of PPI, SEIFSA and CPI indices for the particular month.
