



Characteristics of the not economically active, Q2:2022 vs Q3:2022





Labour force participation and absorption rates Q3:2012-Q3:2022





#### Unemployment rate trends: Q3:2012 to Q3:2022



#### Expanded unemployment rate **decreased by 1,0** percentage point to **43,1%** in Q3:2022 compared to Q2:2022.








**NW** (53,3%) recorded the **highest expanded unemployment rate** in Q3:2022, followed by EC (50,6%). **NC, LP and KZN** recorded more than 15 percentage points difference between expanded and official unemployment rates

Provincial unemployment rate: Official vs Expanded Q2:2022





The number of unemployed people in South Africa increased from 4,9 million in Q3:2012 to 7,7 million in Q3:2022. The proportion of those in long-term unemployment increased from 67,3% in Q3:2012 to 77,0% in Q3:2022

\*Long term unemployment –unemployed for a year or longer





Employment share by sector, Q3:2012 to Q3:2022












### Formal and Informal sector employment increased by **235 000 and 6 000** jobs respectively between Q2:2022 and Q3:2022.



Employment and GDP share per industry





Official Unemployment rate Q3:2022




Youth aged 15-24 years and 25-34 years recorded the highest unemployment rates of 59,6% and 40,5% respectively.



2014-2022 NEET rate for ages 15-24 & 15-34





**OFFICIAL** unemployment rate by population group, Q3:2022





#### Black African women are the most vulnerable with an unemployment rate of 39,1%

in Q3:2022. This is 4,0 percentage points higher than the national average for women at 35,1%.










#### **Black African** and **Coloured** population groups remain vulnerable in the labour market.

# RECAP (QLFS, Q3:2022)

- ❖ Unemployment rate decreased by 1,0 percentage point to 32,9%. The Absorption rate (39,1%) increased by 0,4 of a percentage point and labour force participation rate (58,3%) decreased by 0,3 of a percentage point.
- ❖ The number of those unemployed and those discouraged decreased by 269 000 and 54 000 respectively in Q3:2022 compared to Q2:2022. The not economically active increased by 264 000 in the same quarter.
- The largest employment gains were recorded in Manufacturing (123 000), Trade (82 000), Construction (46 000).
