QES Background

QES is an enterprise-based sample survey

QES collects information on employing businesses registered for VAT with annual turnover greater than R300 000

Samples are drawn from private non-agricultural businesses e.g. factories, offices, stores as well as national, provincial and local government entities

Sample size of approximately 20 000 was selected

EMPLOYMENT RESULTS

Number of persons employed in Q3:2022 984 000 from 9 974 000 in Q2:2022



There was a quarterly increase of 10 000 jobs (or 0,1%) in Q3:2022 compared with Q2:2022.



Jobs **increased** by 31 000 (or 0,3%) in the reference quarter compared with the same quarter of 2021 (Q3:2021).








EMPLOYMENT RESULTS

There was a quarterly net increase of $10\,000$ jobs in Q3:2022. Most of the job gains were reported in full-time employment with a net increase of $36\,000$. Part-time jobs decreased by $26\,000$.

Year-on-year QES reported a net gain of 31 000 jobs in Q3:2022 compared with Q3:2021. Part-time jobs increased by 47 000 while full-time jobs decreased by 16 000.








The mining industry reported net increase of 5 000 jobs in the third quarter of 2022.

Year-on-year the industry increased by 18 000 when comparing Q3:2022 with Q3:2021.










The trade industry reported net gain of 10 000 jobs in the third quarter of 2022 compared to Q2:2022.

Year-on-year the industry added 59 000 jobs compared with same quarter of 2021.










The community services industry reported a net loss of 49 000 jobs in the third quarter of 2022 compared to Q2:2022.

Year-on-year the industry decreased by 26 000 jobs compared with same quarter of the previous year (i.e. Q3:2021).










The total number of persons employed increased by 10 000 in the third quarter 2022 to 9 984 000 from 9 974 000 in Q2:2022.


Year-on-year total employment increased by 31 000 compared with same quarter of the previous year (i.e. Q3:2021).

















Gross earnings increased by **R11,1**billion (or **1,4%**) in the third quarter of 2022 compared to Q2:2022. Increases in gross earnings were due to increases in basic salary/wages by **R12,0** billion. However, there were decreases reported in bonus payments by **R622,0** million and overtime payments by **R293,0** million.

Year-on-year gross earnings increased by **R17,5** billion (or **2,2%**). Increases were due to basic salary payments made by **R17,8** billion and overtime payments by **R2,0** billion. Bonus payments decreased by **R2,3** billion.


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There was a quarterly increase of **1,4%** in gross earnings in the third quarter of 2022 compared to Q2:2022. Year-on-year earnings increased by **2,2%** in the third quarter of 2022 compared with same quarter of the previous year.

The total gross earnings paid to employees increased by **R11,1** billion from **R789,4** billion in Q2:2022 to **R800,5** billion in Q3:2022.

AME including bonuses and overtime payments increased by **0,6%** from **R24 668** in May 2022 to **R24 813** in August 2022. Year-on-year AME increased by **3,8%**.

Average monthly earnings (AME)













Year-on-year, both the trade and electricity industries reported the most increases of 6,3% in AME while community services industry declined by 3,2%.











Average monthly earnings were measured at R24 813 in the formal non-agricultural sector of the economy in August 2022.











Number of employees increased by 10 000 Q/Q & increased by 31 000 Y/Y.



Gross earnings increased by **R11,1** billion Q/Q & increased by **R17,5** billion Y/Y.



Full-time jobs increased by 36 000 Q/Q & decreased by 16 000 Y/Y.



Basic salaries/wages increased by **R12,0**billion Q/Q & increased by **R17,8** billion Y/Y.



*Part-time jobs decreased by 26 000 Q/Q and Y/Y gained by 47 000.



*Bonus payments decreased by R622,0 million Q/Q & decreased by R2,3 billion Y/Y.



Average monthly earnings increased by **0,6%** Q/Q & increased by **3,8%** Y/Y.



*Overtime payments decreased by R293,0 million Q/Q & increased by R2,0 billion Y/Y.
