## **QES Background**

QES is an enterprise-based sample survey

QES collects information on employing businesses registered for VAT with annual turnover greater than R300 000

Samples are drawn from private non-agricultural businesses e.g. factories, offices, stores as well as national, provincial and local government entities

Sample size of approximately 20 000 was selected




## **EMPLOYMENT RESULTS**

Number of persons employed in Q1:2023 970 000 down from 9 991 000 in Q4:2022



There was a quarterly decrease of 21 000 jobs (or -0,2%) in Q1:2023 compared with Q4:2022.



There was an annual decrease of 97 000 (or -1,0%) in first quarter of 2023 compared with the same quarter of 2022 (Q1:2022).








### **EMPLOYMENT RESULTS**

There was a quarterly net decrease of 21 000 jobs in Q1:2023. Most of the job losses were reported in full-time employment with a decrease of 63 000, whilst part-time jobs increased by 42 000.

Year-on-year QES reported a net loss of 97 000 jobs in Q1:2023 compared with Q1:2022. Both part-time and full time jobs decreased by 73 000 and 24 000 respectively.








## The mining industry reported net increase of 5 000 jobs in the first quarter of 2023.

Year-on-year the industry increased by 19 000 when comparing Q1:2023 with Q1:2022.










The trade industry reported net loss of 36 000 jobs in the first quarter of 2023 compared to Q4:2022.

Year-on-year the industry added 23 000 jobs compared with same quarter of 2022.







The community services industry reported increase of 41 000 jobs in the first quarter of 2023 compared to previous quarter.

Year-on-year the industry decreased by 122 000 jobs compared with same quarter of the previous year (i.e. Q1:2022).










The total number of persons employed decreased by 21 000 to 9 970 000 in Q1:2023 from 9 991 000 in Q4:2022.

Year-on-year total employment decreased by 97 000 compared with same quarter of the previous year (i.e. Q1:2022).






















Gross earnings decreased by **R34,1** billion (or-4,0%) in the first quarter of 2023 compared to Q4:2022. Decreases in gross earnings were due to decreases in bonus payments by **R22,5** billion, followed by basic salary/wages by **R11,8** billion. However, overtime payments increased by **R197,0** million.

Year-on-year gross earnings increased by **R43,2** billion (or **5,5%**). Increases were due to basic salary payments made by **R32,7** billion, bonus payments by **R7,7**billion and overtime payments by **R2,8**billion.



There was a quarterly decrease of **4,1%** in gross earnings in the first quarter of 2023 compared to Q4:2022. Year-on-year earnings increased by **5,5%** in the first quarter of 2023 compared with same quarter of the previous year.

## The total gross earnings paid to employees decreased by R34,1 billion from R864,2 billion in Q4:2022 to R830 billion in Q1:2023.

Year-on-year gross earnings increased by R43,2 billion compared with the same quarter of the previous year (i.e. Q1:2022)





















AME including bonuses and overtime payments decreased by 2,7% from R26 002 in November 2022 to R25 304 in February 2023. Year-on-year AME increased by 6,8%.








Seven of the eight industries reported decreases in average monthly earnings in the first quarter 2023 compared to Q4:2022.

Year-on-year, business services industry reported the most increase of 8,5% in AME while trade industry reported the least increase of 1,8%.




