Total value of recorded building plans passed at current prices increased

As indicated in Table A, the value of recorded building plans passed by larger municipalities (at current prices) during January to April 2008 rose by 11,9% (R2 909,8 million) compared with January to April 2007.

All of the main categories of buildings contributed positively to the 11,9% year-on-year increase recorded for January to April 2008. Non-residential buildings increased by 45,1% (R2 046,6 million), followed by additions and alterations (12,8% or R785,9 million) and residential buildings (0,6% or R77,4 million) (see Table A). The large increase in non-residential buildings during January to April 2008 can mainly be attributed to large increases reported for shopping space in Gauteng, KwaZulu-Natal, Mpumalanga, Eastern Cape and Western Cape.

Five provinces reported increases in the value of building plans passed (see Table B). The largest contributor to the increase of 11,9% was KwaZulu-Natal (contributing 8,5 percentage points or R2 083,4 million), followed by Gauteng (4,3 percentage points or R1 042,3 million) and Western Cape (2,3 percentage points or R553,2 million).

Total real value of recorded building plans passed increased

The real value of recorded building plans passed by larger municipalities (at constant 2000 prices) during January to April 2008 increased by 1,2% (R174,3 million) compared with January to April 2007. Increases were reported for non-residential buildings (30,9% or R832,5 million) and additions and alterations (2,4% or R87,6 million). A decrease of 9,1% (-R745,9 million) was reported for residential buildings.



Seasonally adjusted real value of recorded building plans passed remained constant

The seasonally adjusted real value of recorded building plans passed by larger municipalities during the quarter ending April 2008 increased marginally by 0,2% compared with the quarter ending January 2008. An increase was reported for residential buildings (16,9%). This increase was to a large extent counteracted by decreases reported for additions and alterations (-18,2%) and non-residential buildings (-11,3%) (see Table D).

Figure 1 shows both the seasonally adjusted and the trend series for recorded building plans passed at constant 2000 prices between January 2002 and April 2008. The sharp increases in the seasonally adjusted value for January and April 2008 were mainly due to large projects passed for shopping space and additions and alterations to non-residential buildings.

Total value of buildings reported as completed at current prices increased

As indicated in Table E, the value of buildings reported as completed to larger municipalities (at current prices) during January to April 2008 increased by 7,2% (R978,1 million) compared with January to April 2007.

Increases were reported for additions and alterations (21,9% or R532,2 million), residential buildings (4,0% or R335,4 million) and non-residential buildings (4,0% or R110,5 million) during this period.

Five provinces reported increases in the value of buildings completed. The largest contributor to the increase of 7,2% was Gauteng (3,5 percentage points or R477,7 million), followed by Western Cape (1,9 percentage points or R252,8 million) and Eastern Cape (1,5 percentage points or R205,0 million) (see Table F).

Total real value of buildings reported as completed decreased

As indicated in Table G, the real value of buildings reported as completed to larger municipalities (at constant 2000 prices) during January to April 2008 decreased by 3,1% (-R268,7 million) compared with January to April 2007. Decreases in the real value of buildings completed were reported for non-residential buildings (-5,8% or -R110,8 million) and residential buildings (-5,7% or -R303,1 million). However, an increase of 9,0% (R145,1 million) was reported for additions and alterations during the above-mentioned period.



Seasonally adjusted real value of buildings reported as completed increased

The seasonally adjusted real value of buildings reported as completed to larger municipalities during the quarter ending April 2008 increased by 9,1% compared with the quarter ending January 2008. The biggest increase was reported for additions and alterations (26,9%), followed by residential buildings (8,6%). A decrease was reported for non-residential buildings (-4,1%) (see Table H).

Figure 2 shows both the seasonally adjusted and trend series for buildings reported as completed to municipalities at constant 2000 prices between January 2002 and April 2008.

Explanatory notes

Introduction

- Statistics South Africa (Stats SA) conducts a monthly building statistics survey collecting information regarding building plans passed and buildings completed, financed by the private sector, from the largest local government institutions in South Africa. According to these institutions, they are not always notified about low-cost housing projects and therefore do not include the bulk of low-cost dwelling-houses. Data regarding subsidised low-cost dwelling-houses, supplied by the Housing Subsidy System and Provincial Housing Departments and coordinated by the National Department of Housing, are shown in table 29 to table 31 (page 37).
- 2 In order to improve timeliness of the publication, some information for the current month has been estimated due to late submission by respondents. These estimates will be revised in the next statistical release(s) as soon as actual information is available.

Purpose of the survey 3

The monthly survey data are used in monitoring the state of economy and formulation of economic policy. Furthermore, the results are important inputs to estimate the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) and to calculate the Composite Leading Business Cycle Indicator. The data are extensively used by the private sector.

Scope of the survey

- This survey covers local government institutions conducting activities for the private sector regarding -
 - · passing of building plans; and
 - final inspection of completed buildings.

Classification

Building activities are classified in division 5 according to the 1993 edition of the Standard Industrial Classification of all Economic Activities, (SIC) Fifth Edition, Report No. 09-90-02. The SIC is based on the 1990 International Standard Industrial Classification of all Economic Activities (ISIC) with suitable adaptations for local conditions.

Response rate

The preliminary response rate for the survey on building statistics for April 2008 was 96,6 %. Improved response rate for March 2008 was 98,3%.

Statistical unit

7 The statistical unit for the collection of information is a local government institution. Local government institutions include district municipalities, metropolitan municipalities and local municipalities.

Survey methodology and design

Stats SA conducts a monthly survey of metropolitan municipalities and large local municipalities on building plans passed and buildings completed. An annual survey of the remaining municipalities is conducted regarding buildings completed. The monthly survey represents approximately 90 percent of the total value of buildings completed. Information regarding building plans passed and buildings completed for the private sector is collected by mail, fax and telephone.

According to the municipalities, they are not always notified about low-cost housing projects. Data regarding subsidised low-cost dwelling-houses, supplied by the provincial governments and co-ordinated by the National Department of Housing, are shown in table 29 to table 31 (page 37).

Constant prices

The value of building plans passed and buildings completed at constant prices measures building activities in terms of ruling prices in a specific base year, which is currently 2000. The value of building plans passed at constant prices for each month is obtained by deflating the values at current prices with a price index known as the 'lump sum domestic buildings' as published in statistical release P0151: *JBCC Contract Price Adjustment Provisions Work Group Indices*. In order to be applicable, these indices (base February 1991=100) are converted to the base year 2000=100.

The value of buildings completed at constant prices is obtained by deflating the values at current prices with the price index which is used to calculate building plans passed at constant prices (see paragraph 9). Since the completion of buildings may extend over a few months to a few years, the current value of buildings completed is deflated by price indices which prevailed at the time the plans were passed. Therefore, the duration of the completion of different types of buildings are taken into account in ascertaining the deflators e.g. the value of dwelling-houses completed at constant prices at January 2008 is obtained by deflating the current value of dwelling-houses completed for January 2008 with the price index of a month six months prior to January 2008. Furthermore, the value of other residential buildings, non-residential buildings and additions and alterations at constant prices is obtained by deflating the current values with price indices of 12 months, 18 months and 12 months prior to the relevant month, respectively.

Seasonal adjustment

- 11 Seasonally adjusted estimates of building plans passed and buildings completed are generated each month, using the X-11 Seasonal Adjustment Program developed by US Bureau of the Census Economic Research and Analyses Division, 1968.
- 12 Seasonal adjustment is a means of removing the estimated effects of normal seasonal variation from the series so that the effects of other influences on the series can be more clearly recognised. Seasonal adjustment does not aim to remove irregular or non-seasonal influences which may be present in any particular month. Influences that are volatile or unsystematic can still make it difficult to interpret the movement of the series even after adjustment for seasonal variations. Therefore, the month-to-month movements of seasonally adjusted estimates may not be reliable indicators of trend behaviour.

Trend cycle

13 The trend is a long-term pattern or movement of a time series. The X-11 Seasonal Adjustment Program is used for smoothing seasonally adjusted data.

Revised figures

- Revised figures are due to late submission of data to Stats SA, or to respondents reporting revisions or corrections to their figures. Figures for the latest month are therefore preliminary. Data are edited at municipal level.
- Once a year the annual statistical release P5041.3 is published with the revised and updated information at provincial and municipal level for the previous calendar year. Due to this comprehensive revision, the monthly statistical release P5041.1 reflects provincial revision for 2007 where applicable.

Information relating to the 2010 Soccer World Cup new stadia and renovations, as well as other public sector infrastructure spending e.g. Eskom expansions and the Gautrain project, will not be included in the private sector building data series, as these are partially public sector funded.

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Glossary

Additions and alterations

Include extensions to existing buildings as well as internal and external alterations of existing buildings.

Blocks of flats

High-density housing consisting of a number of self-contained dwelling-units, each with at least one living-room together with a kitchen and bathroom, conjoined to similar units in one building.

Dwelling-house

A free-standing, complete structure on a separate stand or a self-contained dwelling-unit, e.g. granny flat, on the same premises as an existing residence. Out-buildings and garages are included.

Local government institutions

Include -

- District municipalities;
- Metropolitan municipalities; and
- Local municipalities.

Municipality

A generic term describing the "unit" of government in the local spheres responsible for local government in a geographically demarcated area and including district, metropolitan and local municipalities. It is an institution consisting of a municipal council (elected political representatives) and municipal administration (appointed officials).

District municipality

A municipality that has municipal executive and legislative authority in an area that includes more than one municipality, and which is described in section 155(1) of the Constitution as a category C municipality (refer to Local Government: Municipal Structure Act, 1998 (Act No. 117 of 1998)).

Metropolitan municipality

A municipality that has municipal executive and legislative authority in an area that includes more than one municipality, and which is described in section 155(1) of the Constitution as a category A municipality (refer to Local Government: Municipal Structure Act, 1998 (Act No. 117 of 1998)).

Local municipality

A municipality that shares municipal executive and legislative authority in its area with a district municipality within whose area it falls, which is described in section 155(1) of the constitution as a category B municipality.

Non-residential buildings

Comprise factories, commercial, financial and other office buildings, as well as other buildings not used for residential purposes, such as churches, halls, clubs, schools and hospitals.

Other residential buildings

Institutions for the disabled, boarding houses, old people's homes, hostels, hotels, motels, guest-houses, holiday chalets, bed-and-breakfast accommodation, entertainment centres and casinos.

Percentage change

When using monthly actual values, the percentage change is the change in actual values of building activities (building plans passed or buildings completed) of the relevant month compared with the actual values of building activities (building plans passed or buildings completed) of the same month in the previous year expressed as a percentage.

When using annual actual values, the percentage change is the change in the actual values of building activities (building plans passed or buildings completed) of the relevant year compared with the actual values of building activities (building plans passed or buildings completed) of the previous year expressed as a percentage.

When using seasonally adjusted values, the percentage change is the change in the seasonally adjusted values of building activities (building plans passed or buildings completed) of the relevant month compared with the seasonally adjusted values of building activities (building plans passed or buildings completed) of the previous month expressed as a percentage.

Reference period One calendar month.

Residential buildings Comprise dwelling-houses, flats, townhouses and other residential buildings.

TownhousesMultiple, medium-density dwelling-units and include cluster housing, group housing, simplexes, duplexes, triplexes and other similar dwelling-units which are usually

grouped together, with one level of each unit on ground level. This category

excludes blocks of flats.

General information

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
