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EXPENDITURE BY THE EXTRABUDGETARY ACCOUNTS AND FUNDS AMOUNTED TO R15 409,8 MILLION IN 1995/96

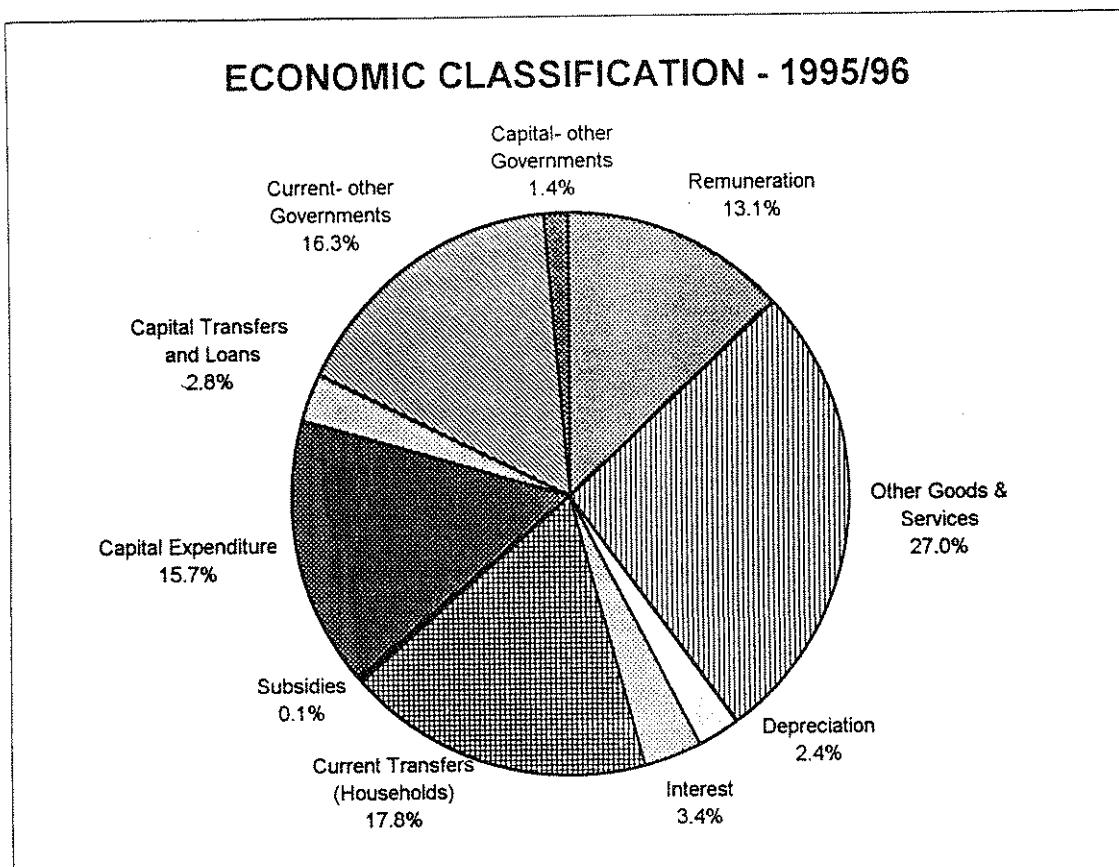
The expenditure by central and provincial extrabudgetary accounts and funds amounted to R15 409,8 m in the 1995/96 financial year (ending on 31 March 1996).

The information in respect of an economic classification shows that expenditure on goods and services for current and capital purposes together with transfers to businesses and households amounted to R12 681,8 m (82,3%) of the total expenditure. Current and capital transfers to other levels of general government amounted to R2 728,0 m (17,7%) of the total expenditure. The extrabudgetary accounts and funds that have been classified as general government spent R12 358,6 m (80,2%) of the total expenditure and those classified as government enterprises spent R3 051,1 m (19,8%) of total expenditure.

As far as direct expenditure is concerned R2 018,9 m (13,1%) was spent on remuneration of employees, R4 157,2 m (27,0%) on other goods and services, R530,6 (3,4%) was paid as interest, R12,0 m (0,1%) was paid as subsidies and R2 747,5 m (17,8%) was transferred to households, R2 414,6 m (15,7%) was spent on capital goods and services, R284,2 m (1,8%) was capital transfers and R150,9 m (1,0%) were classified as purchases of shares and loans and advances. Depreciation on assets amounted to R365,8 m (2,4%) of total expenditure.

Regarding current transfers to other levels of general government R2 293,2 m (14,9%) was transferred to the central government, R31,8 m (0,2%) to other extrabudgetary accounts and funds and R187,9 m (1,2%) to local authorities. Capital transfers and loans exist of R30,9 m (0,2%) transferred to other extrabudgetary accounts and funds and R183,4 m (1,2%) to local authorities.

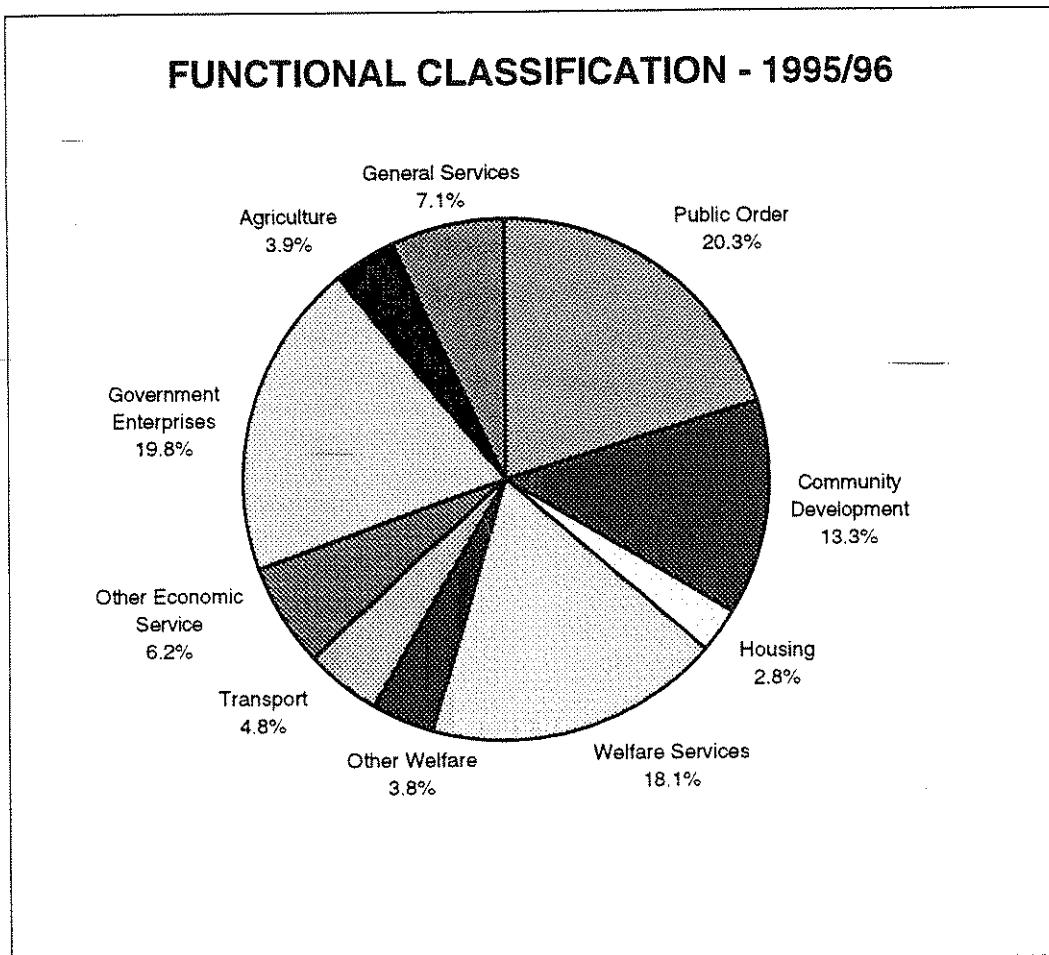
The expenditure (economically classified) by the extrabudgetary accounts and funds can be portrayed graphically as follows:



As regards the different types of services rendered to the community by the extrabudgetary accounts and funds R1 086,5 m (7,1%) of the total expenditure of R15 409,8 m was spent on general services, R3 130,5 m (20,3%) on public order and safety, R5 851,1 m (38,0%) on social security and welfare services and R2 290,5 m (14,9%), on economic services. Government enterprises spent R3 091,1 m (19,8%) of the total expenditure.

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1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 This statistical release reflects an economic and functional classification of the expenditure of extrabudgetary accounts and funds of the central and provincial governments for the 1995/96 financial year. The Central Statistical Service has recently developed a new computer programme which encompasses more detailed financial statistics on the expenditure of the general government sector than in previous releases. The information in this statistical release is presented according to the new computer programme. Mainly as a result of definition and classification changes and the implementation of the new computer programme, the information contained in these tables are not strictly comparable with the information published in previous releases on this series. Therefore information regarding this series was not published in a separate statistical release for the 1994/95 financial year. The information dealing with the general government part of this series was however included in the statistical release as the expenditure of the consolidated expenditure of the general government sector for the 1994/95 financial year (P9119 dated 22 January 1997). Statistical information on the income of extrabudgetary accounts and funds will be published on a later stage.
- 1.2 The CSS also publishes statistical releases on the expenditure of the following levels of the general government.
- 1.2.1 Central government (P9119.2).
 - 1.2.2 Provincial governments (P9142.2).
 - 1.2.3 Universities and technikons (P9103).
 - 1.2.4 Consolidated expenditure of the total general government (P9119).
- 1.3 The tables contain details of extrabudgetary accounts and funds of the central government including those which are administered by government departments, as well as provincial extrabudgetary accounts and funds which are not administered by the provincial administrations. The transactions of the Secret Services Account are however excluded from these tables and are consolidated with the transactions of the National Revenue Account (statistical release P9119.2). The agricultural control boards and pension and provident funds of the State do not form part of the government sector and are therefore excluded from these tables. The Public Investment Commissioners are also excluded from the tables. Certain particulars on the acquisition of funds by this institution are published by the South African Reserve Bank in its Quarterly Bulletin.
- 1.4 The transactions between the various extrabudgetary accounts and funds have not been eliminated, but are shown as transfers to other extrabudgetary accounts and funds.
- 1.5 In contrast to government departments, which keep their accounts on a cash basis, the accounts of extrabudgetary accounts and funds, with a few exceptions, are kept on an accrual basis, i.e. the payments are recorded in the period to which the transactions relate and surpluses, deficits, assets and liabilities are carried over to the next financial year. In the case of the cash basis, the transactions are recorded at the time when cheques are issued for payment.
- 1.6 Depreciation represents the provision shown in the audited financial statements of the accounts or funds. There is, however, not uniformity in the method for providing for depreciation. In some cases the assets are written off over their whole useful life, while in other cases the assets are written off in full in the year of purchase.

2. CONCEPTS

2.1 Economic and functional classifications

The economic and functional classifications used in this statistical release are in accordance with the standard classifications of the International Monetary Fund as described in their manual on Government Finance Statistics. The economic classification distinguishes the transactions in accordance with their effects on the economy and the rest of the world. The functional classification classifies the transactions in accordance with the various kinds of services rendered by the government to the community.

2.2 Individual and collective services

The CSS also publishes tables in this statistical release dividing government consumption expenditure between individual and collective services (Annexure A) and subsidies between subsidies on products and subsidies on production (Annexure B). These categories are recommended in the 1993 System of National Accounts (SNA) of the United Nations. Individual services refers to services rendered to individuals or to a small group of persons and is particularly applicable to social security and welfare services; for example education, health, welfare, etc. Collective services on the other hand refers to services provided collectively to the community as a whole and is particularly applicable on services like general administration, public order and safety and economic services.

2.3 Subsidies on products and subsidies on production

Subsidies on products is defined in the 1993 SNA as subsidies payable per unit of goods or services, and subsidies on production are subsidies which resident enterprises may receive as a consequence of engaging in production.

3. DEFINITIONS

3.1 Expenditure

3.1.1 Remuneration of employees

Remuneration includes primarily salaries, wages, service and other bonuses, allowances (including car allowances), overtime payments, retirement benefits, contributions to medical, pension and provident funds, contributions to unemployment insurance and accident funds, remuneration in kind and housing subsidies.

3.1.2 Other goods and services

This item includes purchases of goods and services, except remuneration of employees, for current activities. It includes *inter alia* subsistence costs, transport costs, communication expenses, rental of equipment, entertainment expenses, printing and stationery.

3.1.3 Households

Non-profit institutions serving households are also included.

3.1.4 Residential buildings

Residential buildings, flats, hostels and nursing homes.

3.1.5 Non-residential buildings

Clinics, hospitals, offices and office blocks, laboratories, workshops, etc.

3.1.6 Other constructions

Construction works, fencing, roads, etc.

3.1.7 Machinery and equipment

Motor vehicles, ships, aircraft, equipment and furniture. Expenditure for military purposes are included in this definition.

4. METHOD AND SCOPE OF THE SURVEY

- 4.1 The information is processed from the audited financial statements of the accounts and funds. Government departments supplied the information in respect of the accounts and funds administered by them from the Financial Management System on magnetic tape.
- 4.2 Financial statements of the Housing Funds were not available at the time of compiling these tables. Instead the Department of Housing supplied the CSS with computer print-outs containing limited information on the transactions of these funds. The information have however been classified economically and functionally and is included in the tables.
