KEY FINDINGS FOR THE QUARTER ENDED JUNE 2002

Total remuneration increased by 5,4% and total turnover decreased by 1,7% in the second quarter of 2002

According to the June 2002 survey of remuneration of employees and turnover of institutions, based on the levies received by district and metropolitan municipalities, the total remuneration of employees, based on the regional services levies received by district and metropolitan municipalities, increased by 5,4% in the second quarter of 2002 compared with the first quarter of 2002. Furthermore, the total remuneration of employees, based on the regional services levies received increased by 13,5% in the second quarter of 2002 compared with the second quarter of 2001.

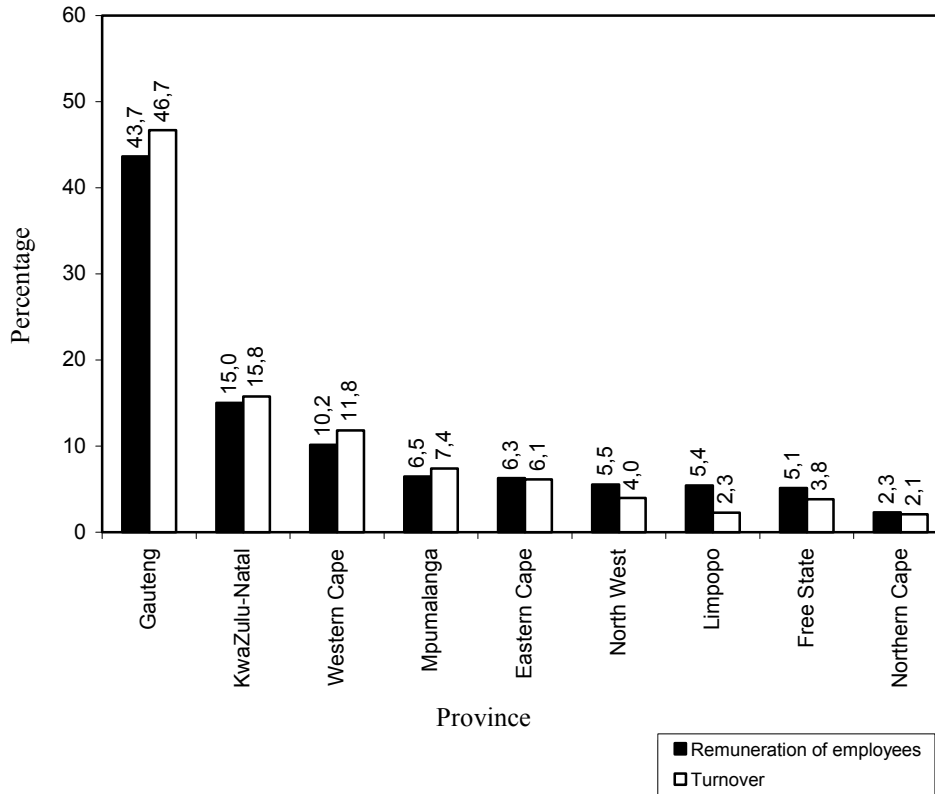
The total turnover of institutions, based on the regional establishment levies received by district and metropolitan municipalities, decreased by 1,7% in the second quarter of 2002 compared with the first quarter of 2002. However, the total turnover of institutions, based on the regional establishment levies received, increased by 16,2% in the second quarter of 2002 compared with the second quarter of 2001.

Percentage distribution of remuneration of employees and turnover of institutions based on levies received by district and metropolitan municipalities according to province

The largest provincial contributor to the total remuneration of employees for the second quarter of 2002, based on the regional services levies collected by the district and metropolitan municipalities was Gauteng (43,7%), followed by KwaZulu-Natal (15,0%), Western Cape (10,2%), Mpumalanga (6,5%), Eastern Cape (6,3%), North West (5,5%), Limpopo (5,4%), Free State (5,1%) and Northern Cape (2,3%) (cf. figure 1, p.2).

The largest provincial contributor to the total turnover of institutions for the second quarter of 2002, based on the regional establishment levies collected by the district and metropolitan municipalities was Gauteng (46,7%), followed by KwaZulu-Natal (15,8%), Western Cape (11,8%), Mpumalanga (7,4%), Eastern Cape (6,1%), North West (4,0%), Free State (3,8%), Limpopo (2,3%) and Northern Cape (2,1%) (cf. figure 1, p. 2).

Increases and decreases in remuneration of employees and turnover of institutions based on the levies of the district and metropolitan municipalities

The fluctuations in the levies received by district and metropolitan municipalities can be caused by:

- legal action taken to recover outstanding amounts which may result in significant increases from one quarter to another;
- levies paid annually and not on a quarterly basis;
- the turnover of institutions and remuneration of employees;
- public holidays as well as other periods when institutions are closed;
- revisions to previous quarters are made in the event of new information being furnished by the respondents; and
- creation of new district municipalities and payments made at different district municipalities.

Quarterly percentage change between previous and current quarter	Quarterly percentage change is the change in the remuneration of employees (or turnover of institutions) of the given quarter compared with the remuneration of employees (or turnover of institutions) of the previous quarter expressed as a percentage.
Quarterly percentage change between a specific quarter of the previous year and the same quarter of the current year	Quarterly percentage change between the previous year and the current year for the same quarter refers to the comparison of the three months of the current quarter in the current year with that of the similar period of the previous year. The amounts shown for each quarter are not cumulative. The year figure refers to the total amount for the four quarters (i.e. sum of March, June, September and December of the same year).
Reference quarter	Reference quarter for the survey refers to the three months up to the end of each quarter. The reference quarter for this survey was 1 April 2002 to 30 June 2002.
Reference year	The reference year for the survey means one calendar year.
Remuneration of employees	Remuneration of employees includes primarily – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • salaries; • wages; • services and other bonuses; • allowances (including car allowances); • overtime payments; • retirement benefits; • contributions to medical, pension and provident funds; • unemployment insurance and accident funds; • remuneration in kind; and • housing subsidies.
Turnover	Turnover refers to total gross sales of institutions.
Valued Added Tax	Value added Tax (VAT) has been excluded from all calculations.
