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PREFACE

This report contains tourism statistics for South Africa.

The report distinguishes between statistics on South African citizens/residents from those on foreign travellers.

For South African citizens/residents two sources of information are used: The information obtained by scanning the bar codes in their passports, whenever they go across a port of entry/exit, and the departure forms (B1-117) they fill in when they depart through either Johannesburg, Durban or Cape Town international airports.

For foreign travellers information from their passports and arrival forms is captured on the computer at the port of entry. Subsequently, stickers containing bar codes are affixed on their passports. Upon departure the bar codes are scanned at the port of exit, eliminating the need to fill in departure forms.

For foreign travellers the arrival statistics are disaggregated by the following: Purpose of visit by month of arrival; mode of travel and place of entry; country of permanent residence by month of arrival; mode of travel and place of entry and duration of stay by month. For departing foreign travellers, and for returning South African residents the statistics are disaggregated by mode of travel and place of departure. For South African residents departing temporarily the statistics are broken down by purpose of visit, month of departure and by the international airport from which the person departed.

Tourism statistics are also published in the quarterly *Bulletin of Statistics* and in the monthly Statistical release P0351: *Tourism and migration*.

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SUMMARY

Introduction

This annual report presents data on arrivals to and departures from South Africa (SA) both from a historical perspective and during the year 2003. The report distinguishes between visits to SA by foreign travellers and foreign visits undertaken by South African residents. Collectively, these figures on arrivals and departures constitute tourism statistics.

Historical trend in tourism

For most of the 1970s and 1980s the trends in the numbers of arrivals and departures of foreign travellers are fairly similar in pattern. Figure 1 shows that prior to 1986 the trend in the number of arrivals and departures remained reasonably steady at around 500 000 per annum. From 1986 to 1990 there was a gradual increase in the number of foreign travellers to SA and between 1990 and 1993 the rise was very steep. After 1993 the pace of increase in arrivals continued, but there was a marked lag between the number of arrivals and the number of departures, during the 1970s and 1980s there were discontinuities in the collection of data on foreign travellers. For example, from December 1980 to October 1991 data in respect of citizens from Botswana, Lesotho and Swaziland were excluded in the tourism statistics collected. Data from citizens of these countries were then included in the tourism statistics after October 1991, but contract workers from these countries were still excluded from the statistics. It was only in January 1992 that particulars of contract workers and those granted border traffic concessions were included in the tourism data. Data regarding citizens of Namibia were only included in the tourism statistics as from 1 January 1991, when formal immigration control between SA and Namibia was established. We are, therefore, dealing with two discrete periods, i.e. the period before 1990 and the period after 1990.

Figure 2 shows the trend in arrivals and departures of South African residents from 1970 to 2003. In general, the trend in departures matches that in arrivals, showing that many South African residents departing temporarily did return to SA. However, after 1992 there was a marked increase in the number of South African residents making temporary visits out of SA. It must, however, be noted that the discontinuities described above also hold for these statistics. For example, when residents from Namibia were included in the tourism statistics prior to January 1991, they would fall under the category 'Residents' and when they were subsequently excluded, they would fall under the category of 'Foreign travellers'.

Foreign travellers to SA during 2003

Summary of totals

Note: Duration of stay is not included in this report as it indicates the period of the visa or permit and not the actual stay of the traveller.

Table 2.1.1 indicates that during 2003 the number of foreign travellers to SA was 6 640 095, an increase of 1,4% compared to 2002. The highest number of foreign arrivals was recorded in the summer month of December, while the lowest number of foreign arrivals was recorded in the winter month June.

During 2003, 1 943 203 overseas travelers visited SA. The 2003 figure represents an increase of 4,3% over the 2002 figure of 1 862 460. From mainland Africa, the number of travellers visiting SA was 4 519 616. This figure represents a 0,1% increase compared with the 2002 figure of 4 513 694 (see Table 2.1.3).

Mode of travel and ports of entry

Table 2.1.2 indicates that during 2003 as many as 4 487 064 (67,6%) foreign travellers arrived in SA by road, followed by arrivals by air, 1 980 411 (29,8%). About, 0,1% arrived by rail or sea. Of the total number of foreign travellers arriving by air, 1 558 332 (78,7%) arrived through Johannesburg International Airport, while 401 851 (20,3%) arrived through Cape Town International Airport, 7 462 (0,4%) arrived through Durban International Airport and 12 766 (0,6%) arrived through other airports. For foreign travellers arriving by sea, 1 851 (37,2%) came through the Cape Town Harbour, while 436 (8,8%) used Port Elizabeth Harbour, 131 (2,6%) came through East London Harbour and 2 561 (51,4%) through other harbours. Lastly, for foreign travellers arriving by rail, the majority 199 (4,9%) passed through the Botswana border.

In departing from SA, the most common mode of travel used by foreign travellers was road, involving 4 016 461 (67,4%) person-trips, followed by air travel, involving 1 921 178 (32,3%) person-flights. Of the total number of foreign travellers departing by air, 1 501 472 (78,2%) departed through Johannesburg International Airport, 397 424 (20,7%) departed through Cape Town International Airport, 6 719 (0,3%) through Durban International Airport and 15 563 (0,8%) through other airports.

There were 1 638 150 air arrivals from overseas in 2003, which accounts for 84,3% of all overseas arrivals. The number of overseas travellers arriving by road was 297 043 (15,3%), followed by sea was 3 112 (0,2%) and the number arriving through rail or an unspecified mode of travel was 4 898 (0,3%).

The total number of travellers who arrived by road during 2003 from mainland Africa was 4 180 779 (92,5%). The number arriving by air was 329 872 (7,3%) and those arriving by sea, rail or an unspecified mode of travel was 8 965 (0,2%).

Country of residence

While foreign travellers come from many different parts of the world, there are a few leading source countries from which a large number of foreign travellers come. In order to bring out some salient aspects of source countries, the countries of origin have been grouped into two categories: overseas and mainland Africa.

Figure 3 shows the distribution of foreign travellers from mainland Africa by leading source countries in the year 2003. For this year, the leading source countries were: Lesotho, 1 291 242 (28,6%); Swaziland, 809 049 (17,9%); Botswana, 797 315 (17,6%); Zimbabwe, 568 626 (12,6%); Mozambique, 474 790 (10,5%); Namibia, 216 978 (4,8%) and Zambia, 115 650 (2,6%). When comparing arrival figures from mainland Africa for 2002 and 2003, there were increases in the number of travellers arriving from the following countries: Lesotho, (11,0% up from 1 162 786 in 2002), Swaziland, (2,6% up from 788 842 in 2002) and Botswana, (1,9% up from 782 189 in 2002). For the same comparison period of the leading mainland African countries, those that had decreases in the numbers of arriving travellers were: Mozambique, (18,1% down from 579 768 in 2002) and Zimbabwe (7,2% down from 612 543 in 2002).

Figure 4 shows that during 2003 the number of travellers from the UK visiting SA was 463 021 (23,8%), making it the leading country of origin of overseas travellers. This was followed by travellers from Germany, 261 194 (13,4%). The other main countries of origin of overseas travellers were: the USA, 192 561 (9,9%); France, 130 365 (6,7%); the Netherlands, 122 565 (6,3%); Australia, 72 728 (3,7%); Italy, 50 403 (2,6%); Belgium, 43 537 (2,2%) and India, 42 954 (2,2%). On comparing the figures for 2003 with those of 2002, the highest increase in the number of arrivals from these leading source countries was for India, (21,3% up from 35 402 in 2002) and France, (13,6% up from 114 797 in 2002). Traditionally, the leading source country for travellers from overseas has always been the UK and this did not change during 2003.

The purpose of visit

Figure 5 shows that of the overseas travellers visiting SA during 2003, 1 769 104 (91,0%) reported that they were in SA on holiday, while 88 696 (4,6%) reported that they were on business trips. Similarly, Figure 6 shows that of the travellers from mainland Africa visiting SA during 2003, 4 069 205 (90,0%) reported that they were in South Africa on holiday, and 193 367 (4,3%) reported that they were on business trips.

During 2003 those visiting South Africa for the purpose of work (including contract work) numbered 44 043 (2,3%) among overseas arrivals, and 86 609 (1,9%) among arrivals from mainland Africa. Figure 7 shows that among the travellers from mainland Africa who stated upon arrival that they were on holiday, the largest numbers came from Lesotho, 1 187 407 (29,2%), followed by Swaziland, 777 602 (19,1%) and Botswana, 715 221 (17,6%). Figure 8 shows that the three leading mainland African countries from which business travellers came were: Lesotho, 75 062 (38,8%), Zimbabwe, 26 620 (13,8%) and Namibia, 24 707 (12,8%).

For holiday-makers from overseas Figure 9 shows that during 2003 the highest number came from the UK, 432 139 (24,4%), followed by those coming from Germany, 247 303 (14,0%) and those coming from the USA, 173 150 (9,8%). For overseas travellers on business trips the highest number during 2003 again came from the UK, 19 901 (22,4%). However, the second highest number came from the USA, 10 377 (11,7%), followed by those coming from Germany, 6 868 (7,7%), as shown in Figure 10.

Arrivals and departures of South African residents in 2003

Totals, purpose of visit and mode of travel

Note: As from April 2003 South Africans were no longer required to have their passport barcodes scanned nor complete departure forms at the ports of entry and exit. Therefore, statistics on their departure and arrival are no longer available. This is due to the implementation of the Immigration Act, 2002 (Act No. 13 of 2002), by the Department of Home Affairs.

During 2003 the total number of South African residents who departed 'temporarily' (through all ports of exit) was 1 163 839, a decrease of 69,3% compared to the number of South African residents who departed temporarily during 2002 (see Table 3.2.1.1). Of these departing South African residents, the number who travelled by air was 426 938 (36,7%). Of those who travelled by air and left through the three international airports of Johannesburg, Cape Town and Durban, 968 038 (83,2%) filled in departure forms (see Table 3.2.2). From the completed departure forms for the year 2003, one can see that, on the whole, South African residents travelled within mainland Africa more for business than for holidays (62,4% as opposed to 35,9%) and similarly, they travelled overseas more for holidays than business (66,7% as opposed to 29,7%) as indicated in Table 3.2.4.

The number of returning South African residents during 2003 was 1 254 063, a decrease of 67,4% compared to the 3 849 790 who returned during 2002. The predominant mode of travel used by South Africans in returning to SA was road, 832 795 (66,4%), followed by air, 418 878 (33,4%) as indicated in Table 2.2.1.

Of the South African residents returning by air, 358 330 (85,5%) entered through Johannesburg International Airport, 48 028 (11,5%) entered through Cape Town International Airport, 4 155 (1,0%) entered through Durban International Airport and the rest, 8 365 (2,0%) entered through other airports (see Table 2.2.1).

Leading destination countries for departing South African residents

For South African residents who departed 'temporarily' during 2003, using the three international airports as ports of exit, the leading countries of destination were the following: the UK, 192 615 (19,9%); the USA, 63 915 (6,6%); Australia, 42 705 (4,4%); Namibia, 40 689 (4,2%); Mauritius, 32 660 (3,4%); Germany, 31 100 (3,2%) and Zambia, 25 398 (2,6%) as indicated in Table 3.2.3.

Figure 11 shows the leading destination countries for SA residents leaving for holiday, while Figure 12 shows leading destination countries for SA residents leaving on business trips during 2003. A little over 29% of all South African residents departing for holiday travelled either to the UK (23,5%) or to the USA (6,4%). This was followed by those travelling to Australia (5,6%) and Mauritius (4,8). For South African residents leaving on business trips, the leading destination countries were the UK (14,0%), the USA (6,4), Namibia (5,5) and Mozambique (4,3). The four most popular destinations for South African residents leaving on business trips or on holiday, were the UK, the USA, Australia and Namibia.

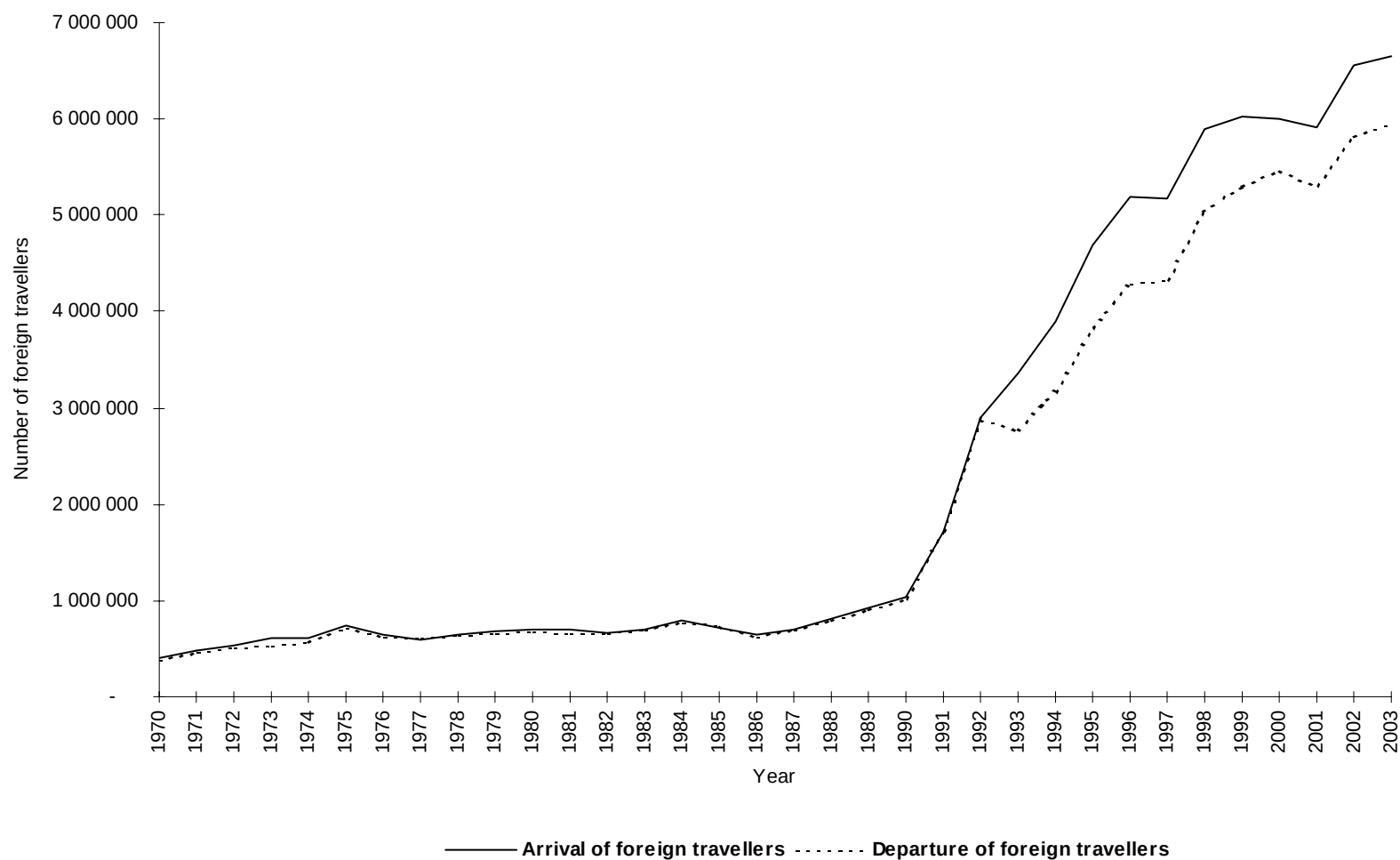
Fig. 1: Arrival and departure of foreign travellers, 1970 - 2003

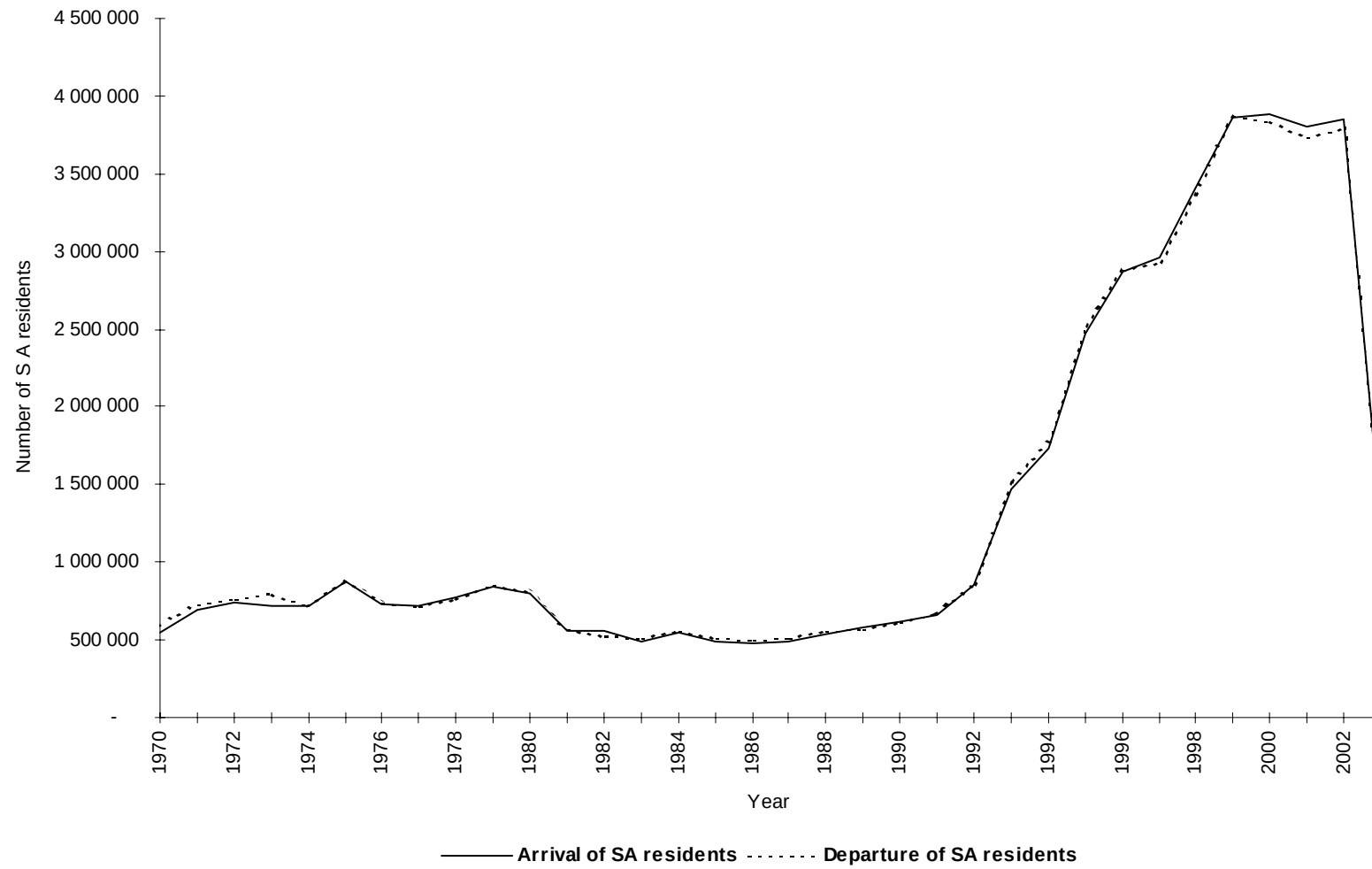
Fig. 2: Arrival and departure of South African residents, 1970 - 2003

Fig. 3: Arrivals: Travellers from Africa by country of residence, 2003

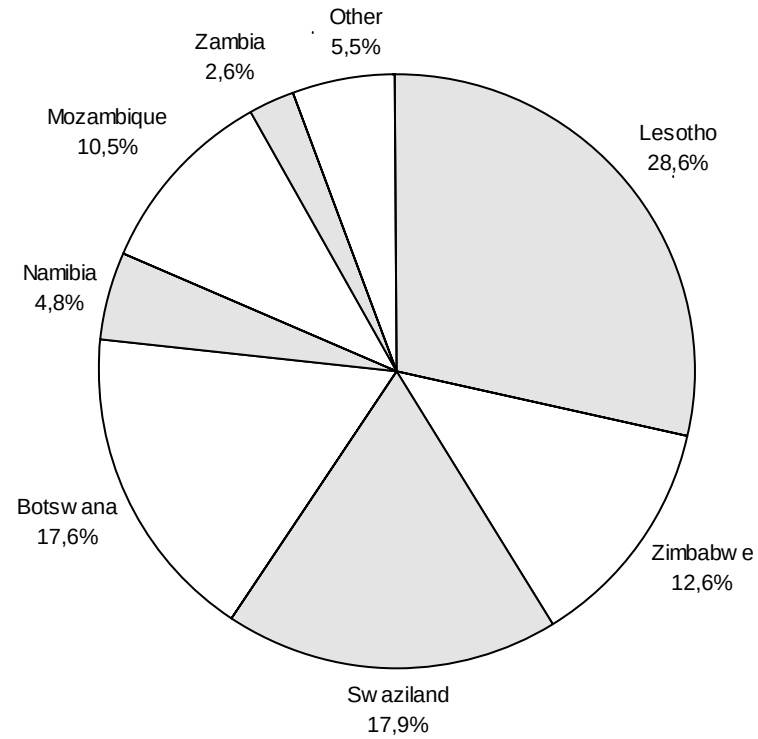
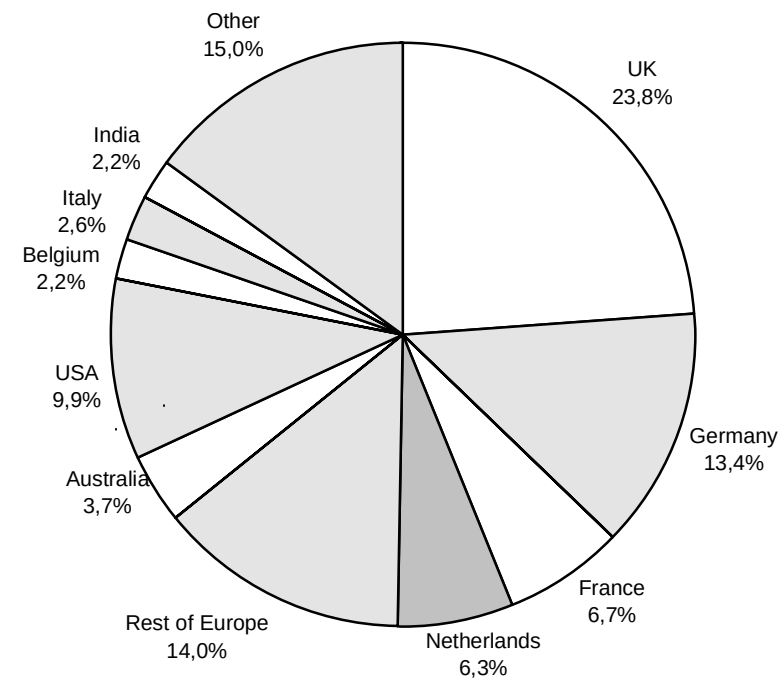
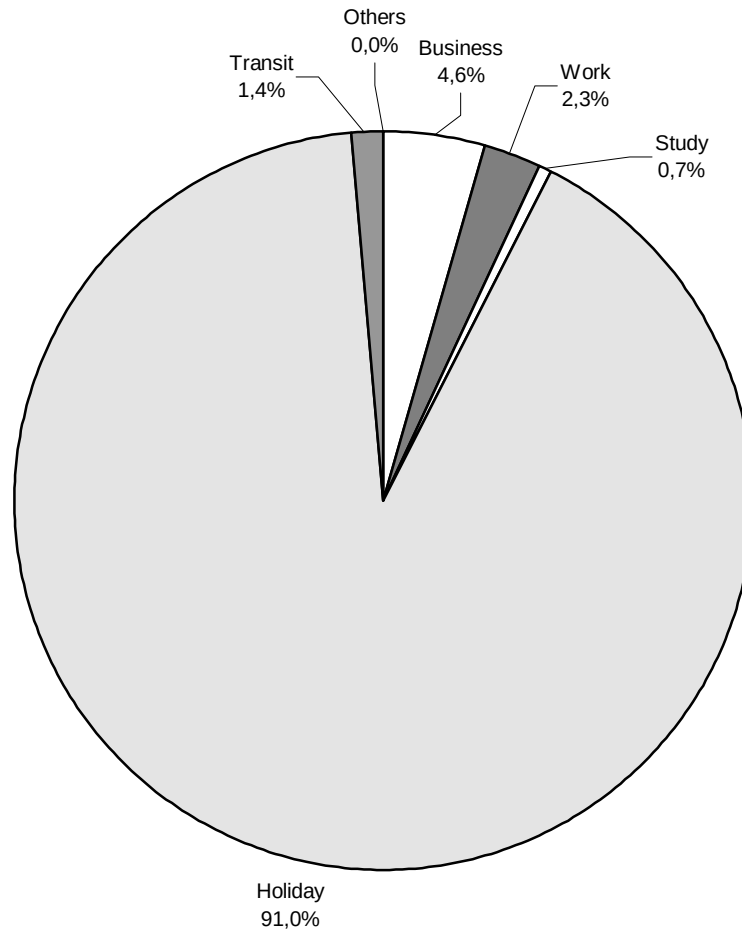


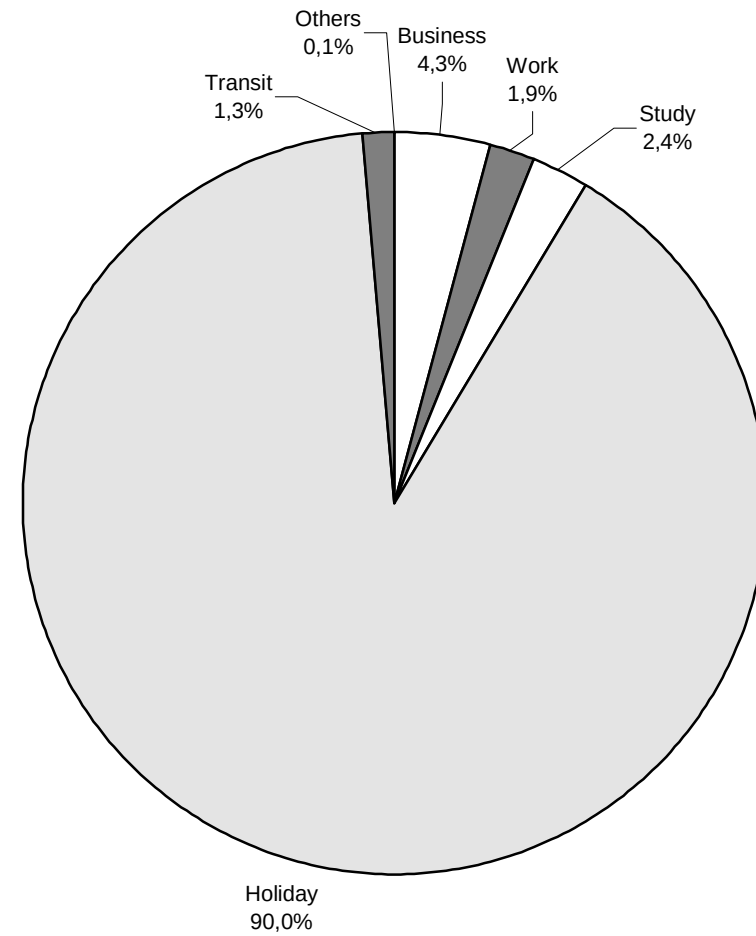
Fig. 4: Arrivals: Overseas visitors by country of residence, 2003

2003**

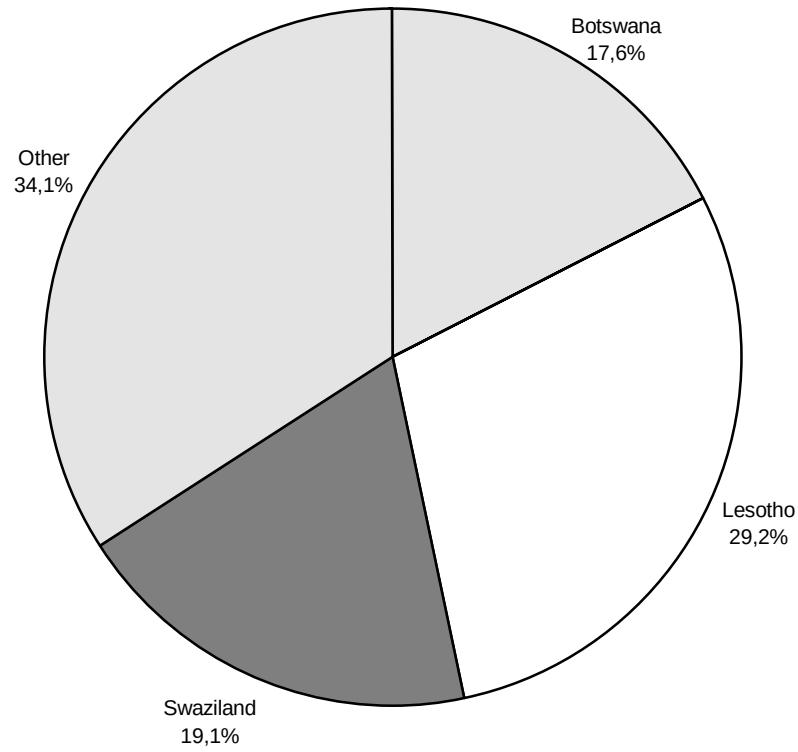


Fig. 8: Arrivals from mainland Africa on business trips 2003

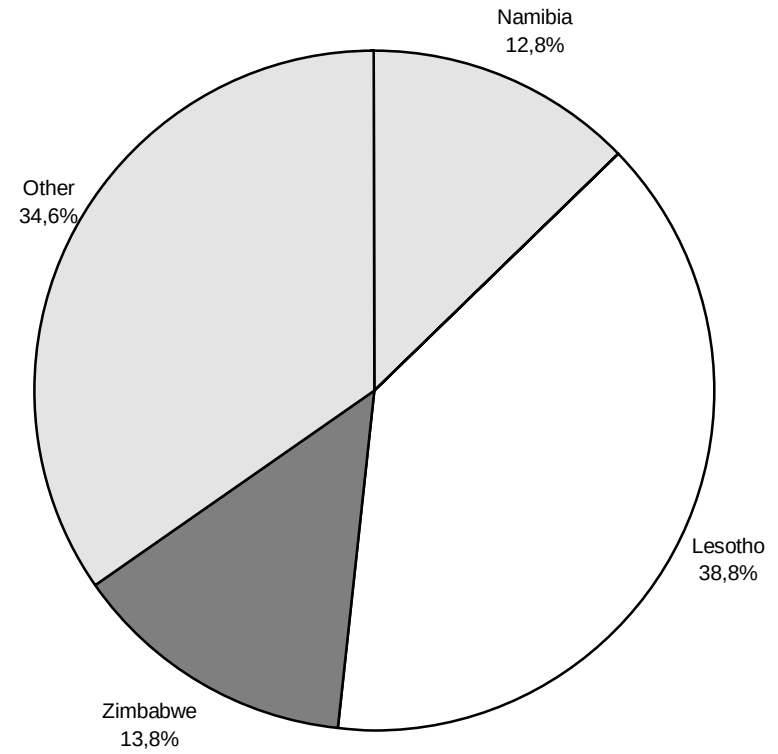


Fig. 9: Overseas holiday-makers by country of residence, 2003

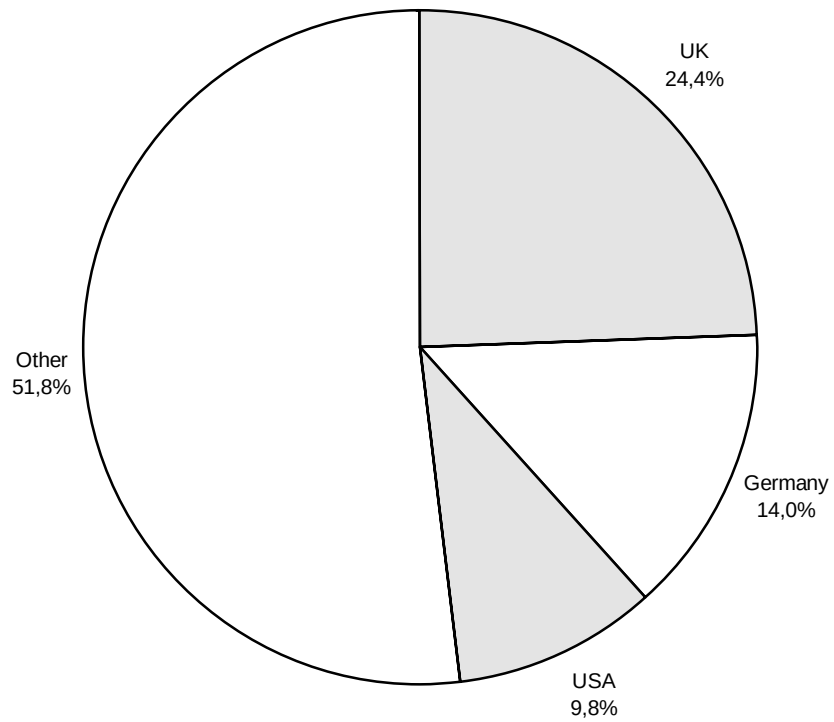


Fig. 10: Overseas arrivals on business trips by country of residence, 2003

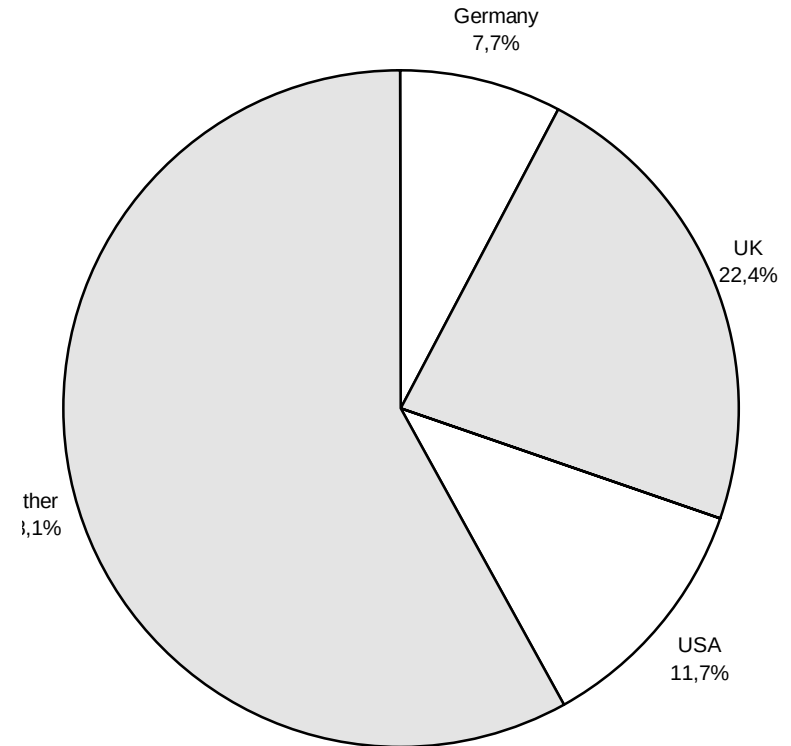


Fig. 11: Leading destinations of South African residents departing for holidays, 2003

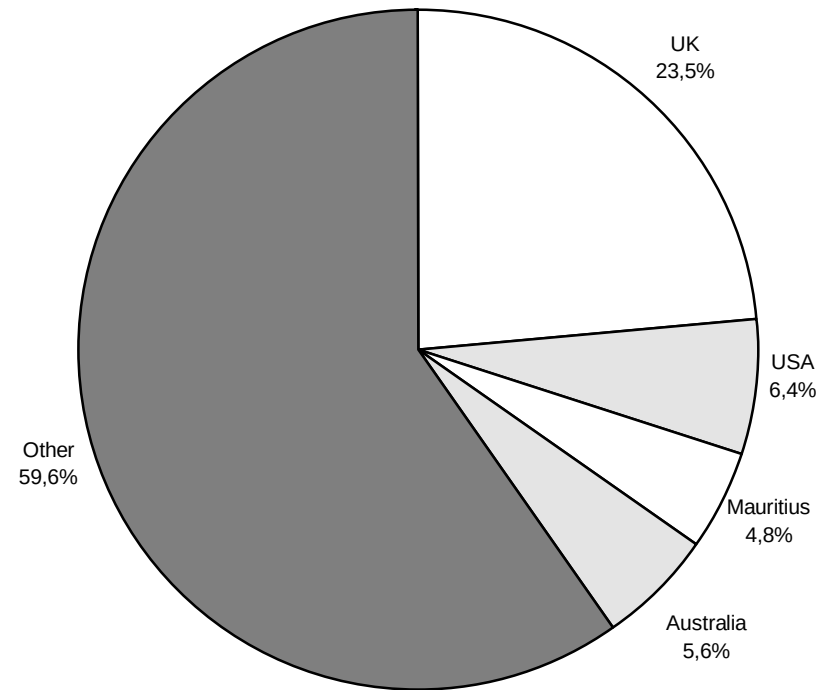
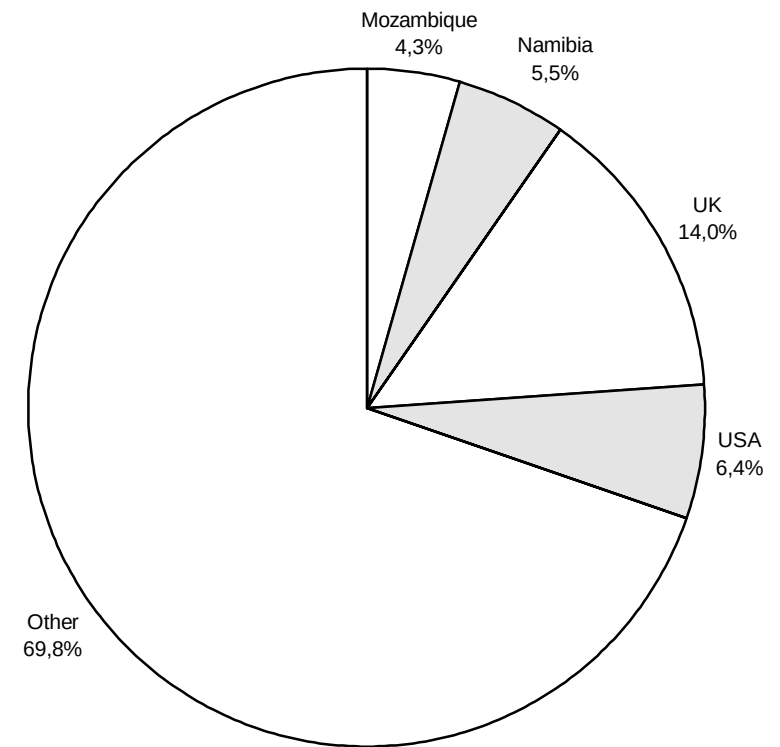


Fig. 12: Leading destination of South African residents departing for business, 2003



EXPLANATORY NOTES

1. Background

1.1 Data collection instruments

Legal movements across South African borders, as well as legal immigration into SA, fall under the jurisdiction of the Department of Home Affairs (DHA). Data on tourism are obtained through three main data collection instruments: the arrival form, the departure form and the passport.

With effect from 4 January 1993 a new computerised system for the recording of travellers to and from SA was implemented by the DHA. For South African residents data on temporary departures are obtained from scanning of the bar codes in the passport (upon departure and upon return) and from the departure forms. The filling-in of departure forms used to be done at all ports of entry, but since 26 November 1993 this system is only implemented at the three international airports of Johannesburg, Cape Town and Durban.

For non-South African residents, data on entry into SA for temporary stays are obtained from the arrival form submitted at the port of entry. When non-South African residents first enter SA, bar codes (TRP label) are affixed to their passport. This bar code is subsequently scanned into the computer when the non-South African resident is leaving the country. This facilitates the recording of departure dates from SA and avoids the need for filling in departure forms. Lastly, administrative records are kept for all non-South African residents who have been granted permanent residence status (either before arrival or after arrival).

1.2 Compilation of tourism statistics

For foreign travellers information on their arrivals and departures is obtained from all ports of entry. After the data have been captured at the port of entry, they are sent electronically to the DHA, and loaded onto the mainframe computer at Bureau Nucleus. Statistics South Africa (Stats SA) accesses these data remotely and processes them to produce tourism statistics for foreign travellers. A South African resident who leaves or re-enters South African borders by rail, road, air or sea gets his/her passport scanned to read the bar code. This simple action provides basic particulars about the person. For those passports that do not have a stripe or bar code, the Home Affairs official at the port of entry captures onto the computer the personal details reflected on the passport. This information is directly up-dated on the mainframe computer of the DHA.

Information on country of destination and reason for temporary departure of South African residents is obtained from departure forms. The forms are sent to Stats SA on a weekly basis for data capturing and processing. It must be noted that the filling in of the departure forms is not strictly enforced, hence the statistics on the actual number of South African residents who depart temporarily, are obtained from the data based on the scanning of the bar codes in the passports.

For both foreign travellers and South African residents, the information collected on purpose of visit or departure, comes from what has been stated by the traveller. What is stated by the traveller is accepted as correct.

1.3 Shortcomings in tourism statistics

All statistics have their limitations. An important distinction to be noted is that the statistics presented here refer to the number of movements of travellers rather than the number of travellers. Because of multiple movements of travellers, the number of movements is always larger than the number of travellers. In the case of travel by air to and from overseas, the gap between the two statistics tends to be rather narrow, while in the case of travel by road within the Southern African region, the gap tends to widen.

2. Definitions

2.1 Definitions used by the World Travel Organisation (WTO)

- 2.1.1 **Tourism** comprises the activities of persons travelling to, and staying in places outside their usual environment, for not more than one consecutive year, for leisure, business and other purposes. The usual environment of a person consists of a certain area around his/her place of residence, plus all other places he/she frequently visits.
- 2.1.2 **Tourist** (overnight visitor) is a visitor who stays at least one night in collective or private accommodation in the place visited. An international tourist is an international visitor who stays at least one night in collective or private accommodation in the country visited. Domestic tourist refers to a domestic visitor who stays at least one night in collective or private accommodation in the place visited.

- 2.1.3 **International tourist** is an international visitor who stays at least one night collective or private accommodation in the country visited.
- 2.1.4 **Domestic tourist** refers to a domestic visitor who stays at least one night in collective or private accommodation in the place visited.
- 2.1.5 **Traveller** refers to any person on a trip between two or more localities.
- 2.1.6 **International travellers** refer to any person on a trip between two or more localities in different countries.
- 2.1.7 **Domestic traveller** refers to any person on a trip between two or more localities in his/her country of residence.
- 2.1.8 **Visitor** refers to any person travelling to a place other than that of his/her usual environment for less than 12 consecutive months and whose main purpose of trip is not the exercise of an activity remunerated from within the place visited.
- 2.1.9 **International visitor** refers to any person travelling to a country other than the one in which he/she has his/her usual residence, but outside his/her usual environment, for less than 12 consecutive months and whose main purpose of trip is not the exercise of an activity remunerated from within the place visited.
- 2.1.8 **Domestic visitor** refers to any person residing in a country, who travels to a place within a country other than the one in which he/she has his/her usual environment, for less than 12 consecutive months, and whose main purpose of trip is not the exercise of an activity remunerated from within the place visited.
- 2.2 Definitions used specifically in this report**
- 2.2.1 **Overseas traveller** refers to a traveller from overseas. It does not include a traveller from mainland Africa, African islands or from an 'unspecified' country.
- 2.2.2 **Foreign traveller** refers to a person who resident outside SA and visit the country temporarily for one or more of the following reasons:
- Business purpose (including official visits) for a duration of less than 90 days;
 Holiday (including visits to family or friends);

Study purpose;
 Work purpose (for duration of less than 90 days);
 Contract work;
 Transit (for persons staying less than 24 hours in the country).

- 2.2.3 **Border traffic concession** is granted to a person who crosses the border on a frequent basis. This concession is granted for a maximum of six months after which it can be renewed if necessary. No mode of travel is available for border traffic concessions.
- 2.2.4 **South African residents** are persons resident in SA (South African citizens and persons with permanent residence) who leave the country temporarily.

3. Classifications used

- 3.1 For occupations the occupational classification used is based on the *Standard Classification of Occupations, First Edition, 1986* (Report No. 09-90-01).
- 3.2 Geographical classification of countries was based on the list used by DHA.
