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KEY FINDINGS

1. Historical trends

For most of the 1980s the trends in the numbers of arrivals and departures of foreign travellers were fairly similar in pattern. Figure 1 shows that prior to 1986, the trend in the number of arrivals and departures remained reasonably steady at around 500 000 per annum. From 1986 to 1990, there was a gradual increase in the number of foreign travellers to South Africa and between 1990 and 1993, the rise was very steep. After 1993 the pace of increase in arrivals continued, but there was a marked lag between the number of arrivals and the number of departures. The numbers of arrivals and departures declined in 1997 and 2001.

Figure 2 shows the trend in arrivals and departures of South African residents from 1980 to 2005. In general, the volume of departures and arrivals was more or less the same. The sudden drop in the number of arrivals and departures of South African residents in 2003 and 2004 is a reflection of the impact of the new Immigration Act (Section 9 of Act 13 of 2002) that did not require the recording of the international movements of South African residents. The increase in 2005 shows the effect of the amendment to section 9 (Section 10 of Act 19 of 2004) that resulted in the resumption of the recording of the international movements of South African residents.

2. Foreign travellers to South Africa in 2005

2.1 Summary of totals

Table 2.1.1 indicates that during 2005, the number of foreign travellers to South Africa was 7 518 320, an increase of 10,3% compared to the 2004 volume of 6 815 202. The highest number of foreign arrivals was recorded in the summer month of December while the lowest number of foreign arrivals was recorded in the winter month June.

During 2005, 2 012 885 overseas travellers visited South Africa. The 2005 figure represents an increase of 3,1% over the 2004 figure of 1 953 221. From mainland Africa, the number of travellers visiting South Africa, was 5 469 653. This figure represents a 16,1% increase compared with the 2004 figure of 4 709 776 (see Table 2.1.3).

2.2 Mode of travel and ports of entry and departure

Table 2.1.2 indicates that during 2005, as many as 5 208 720 (69,3%) foreign travellers arrived in South Africa by road, followed by air arrivals of 2 127 009 (28,3%). In addition, 2 269 (0,03%) travellers came by rail and 2 759 (0,04%) by sea. Of the total number of foreign travellers arriving by air, 1 643 002 (72,2%) came through Johannesburg International Airport (currently known as OR Tambo International Airport); 467 270 (22,0%) arrived through Cape Town International Airport; 4 583 (0,2%) arrived through Durban International Airport and 12 154 (0,6%) through other airports.

Table 2.1.4 indicates that there were 1 747 599 air arrivals from overseas in 2005 which account for 86,8% of all overseas arrivals. The number of overseas travellers arriving by road was 254 711 (12,7%) and the number arriving by sea, rail and unspecified mode of travel was 10 575 (0,5%). The total number of travellers who arrived by road during 2005 from mainland Africa was 4 943 280 (90,4%). The number arriving by air was 371 943 (6,8%) and those arriving by sea, rail or unspecified mode of travel was 154 432 (2,8%).

Table 3.1.1 indicates that road transport, 4 669 328 (69,4%), was the most common mode of travel used by foreign travellers departing South Africa. This was followed by air travel, 2 048 975 (30,5%). Of the total number of foreign travellers departing by air, 1 574 21 (76,9%) left through Johannesburg International Airport; 457 066 (22,3%) departed through Cape Town International Airport; 4 208 (0,2%) through Durban International Airport and 12 780 (0,6%) through other airports.

2.3 Country of residence

Figure 3 shows the distribution of foreign travellers from mainland Africa by leading source countries. These countries were: Lesotho, 1 693 272 (31,5%); Swaziland, 911 887 (16,7%); Botswana, 798 576 (14,4%); Zimbabwe, 782 548 (14,3%); Mozambique, 648 288 (11,9%); Namibia, 220 000 (4,0%) and Zambia, 128 344 (2,3%).

When comparing arrival figures from mainland Africa for 2004 and 2005, there were increases in the number of travellers arriving from the following countries: Lesotho, (14,2% up from 1 483 331 in 2004); Swaziland, (6,9% up from 852 682 in 2004); Zimbabwe, (40,3% up from 557 911 in 2004); Mozambique (59,8% up from 405 606 in 2004) and Zambia (4,8% up from 122 516 in 2004). However, the volume of arrivals from Botswana, (1,0% down from 122 516 in 2004) and Namibia (2,9% down from 226 523 in 2004) declined.

As presented in Figure 4, the leading source countries for overseas countries were: the U.K., 475 916 (23,6%); Germany, 253 527 (12,6%); the USA, 239 036 (11,9%); France, 103 668 (5,2%); the Netherlands, 117 517 (5,8%); Australia, 78 235 (3,9%); Italy, 52 161 (2,6%); China, 42 153 (2,1%) and India, 40 437 (2,0%).

When comparing arrival volumes from overseas countries for 2004 and 2005, there were increases in the number of travellers arriving from the following countries: the UK, (2,9% up from 462 644 in 2004); Germany, (1,6% up from 249 575 in 2004); the USA, (12,0% up from 213 369 in 2004); Australia, (2,0% up from 76 709 in 2004); Italy, (2,2% up from 51 063 in 2004) and India (3,2% up from 39 198 in 2004). However, the number of arrivals from France, (7,1% down from 111 635 in 2004); Netherlands (3,9% down from 122 274 in 2004) and China, (8,5% down from 46 050 in 2004) declined.

2.4 Purpose of visit

Figure 5 shows that, of the overseas travellers visiting South Africa during 2005, 1 855 973 (92,2%) reported that they were in South Africa on holiday; while 70 814 (3,5%); 55 000 (2,7%) and 14 742 (0,7%) had come for business, to work and to study respectively. Similarly, data presented in Figure 6 indicate that 4 943 687 (90,4%) of the travellers from mainland Africa reported that they were in South Africa on holiday; while 130 280 (2,4%); 34 663 (0,6%); and 117 510 (2,1%) had come for business, to work and to study respectively .

Figure 7 indicates that most of the travellers who were here on holidays from mainland Africa came from Lesotho, 1 495 075 (30,2%); followed by Swaziland, 885 956 (17,9%), Botswana, 734 525 (14,9%) and Zimbabwe, 729 496 (14,8%). Furthermore, travellers who came to South Africa for business (see Figure 8) were mainly from Zimbabwe, 27 753 (21,3%); Lesotho, 27 220 (20,9%); Namibia, 21 640 (16,6%); Zambia, 15 857 (12,2%) and Mozambique, 9 022 (6,9%). With respect to travellers from overseas, those on holiday (see Figure 9) were mainly from the UK, 452 300 (24,4%); Germany, 240 547 (13,0%) and the USA, 223 431 (12,0%). Travellers who came to South Africa for business were from the UK, 13 297 (18,8%); China, 8 827 (12,5%) the USA, 6 830 (9,6%) and Germany (9,0%) as shown in Figure 10.

3. South African residents in 2005

Table 2.2.1 indicates that during 2005, as many as 1 302 885 (61,7%) South African residents arrived in South Africa by road, followed by 798 869 (37,8%) air arrivals. A total of 10 546 (0,5%) arrived by sea, rail and unspecified mode of transport. Of the total number of South African residents arriving by air, 678 945 (85,0%) came through Johannesburg International Airport while 101 500 (12,7%) arrived through Cape Town International Airport; 4 371(0,5%) through Durban International Airport and 14 053 (1,8%) through other airports.

Table 3.2.1 indicates that road, 1 385 843 (63,2%), was the most common mode of travel used by South African residents departing South Africa. This was followed by air travel, 802 435 (36,6%). A total of 3 321 (0,2%) left by sea, rail and unspecified mode of transport. Of the total number of residents departing by air, 682 104 (85,0%) used Johannesburg International Airport, while 100 626 (12,5%) left through Cape Town International Airport; 5 044 (0,6%) through Durban International Airport and 14 661 (1,8%) through other airports.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

1. Introduction

This annual report contains information on population movements into and out of South Africa for the year 2005. It reports on arrivals and departures of South African and foreign travellers. Travellers include (a) same-day visitors and tourists and (b) other travellers such as migrant workers, business persons and students.

Legal movements across South African borders as well as legal immigration into South Africa fall under the jurisdiction of the Department of Home Affairs (DHA). Statistics South Africa (Stats SA) then processes and publishes this information.

Administrative data sources from the DHA, that is, information from all the country's ports of entry and applications for permanent residence constitute the only comprehensive source of information on foreign arrivals and departures, documented immigrants and emigrants. The information from this source of data provides the best national coverage (in terms of both space and time) of the population movements of South African residents and foreign travellers. The data:

- can be used to estimate, monitor and understand salient characteristics of foreign travellers and volumes of South African residents travelling outside South Africa;
- can, in the absence of information on foreign tourists, be further analysed to provide some indication of international tourism; and
- provide information that can be used to (a) assess the extent of government's progress in strengthening bilateral political and economic relations by assessing the number of international tourist arrivals; and (b) benchmark surveys focusing on demand for local tourism services by foreign travellers.

2. Data

Data routinely collected by immigration officers at all land, air and sea entry ports on all travellers (South African residents and foreign travellers) arriving into or departing from South Africa are captured into the DHA's population Movement Control System (MCS). Generally the data are collected directly from travel documents either by scanning or capturing onto the port's electronic database. Individual ports regularly transmit data onto the national database at the head office of the DHA. Statistics South Africa (Stats SA) downloads the data covering a particular calendar month from the mainframe of the State Information Technology Agency (SITA), where the DHA stores its data.

3. Definitions

3.1 Definitions used by the United Nations World Tourism Organisation (UNWTO)

International traveller refers to any person on a trip between two or more localities in different countries.

Tourism comprises the activities of persons travelling to, and staying in places outside their usual environment, for not more than one consecutive year, for leisure, business and other purposes. The usual environment of a person consists of a certain area around his/her place of residence, plus all other places he/she frequently visits.

Tourist (overnight visitor) is a visitor who stays at least one night in collective or private accommodation in the place.

Traveller refers to any person on a trip between two or more localities (e.g. countries).

Visitor refers to any person travelling to a place other than that of his/her usual environment for less than 12 consecutive months and whose main purpose of trip is not the exercise of an activity remunerated visited. An international tourist is an international visitor who stays at least one night in collective or private accommodation in the country visited. Domestic tourist refers to a domestic visitor who stays at least one night in collective or private accommodation in the place visited.

3.2 Definitions used specifically in this report

Border traffic concession is granted to a person who crosses the border on a frequent basis. This concession is granted for a maximum of six months after which it can be renewed if necessary. No mode of travel is available for border traffic concessions.

Foreign traveller refers to a person who is not a South African citizen or permanent resident.

South African resident refers to either a South African citizen or a non-South African citizen with a South African permanent residence permit.

Overseas refers to all countries outside mainland Africa

5. Limitations

The main limitation of the published information is its inability to directly measure the volume of tourists. The main aspects of the United Nations World Tourism Organisation's (UNWTO) definition of a tourist are duration of stay and whether individuals are remunerated in the place being visited. Although the intended duration of stay can be inferred from the expiry date of the temporary residence permit, this does not necessarily translate into actual duration of stay. In addition, the data do not provide information on the remuneration status of travellers in South Africa.

The information on the total number of arrivals and departures of South African residents is collected from the scanning of passports. However, data on country of final destination and purpose of visit will be available when the re-introduction of the departure forms is fully operational at the three international airports (OR Tambo, Cape Town and Durban). Processing of available departure forms from the three international airports is currently underway.

6. Related publications

Tourism statistics are also published in the quarterly *Bulletin of Statistics* and in the monthly Statistical Release P0351: *Tourism and Migration*.

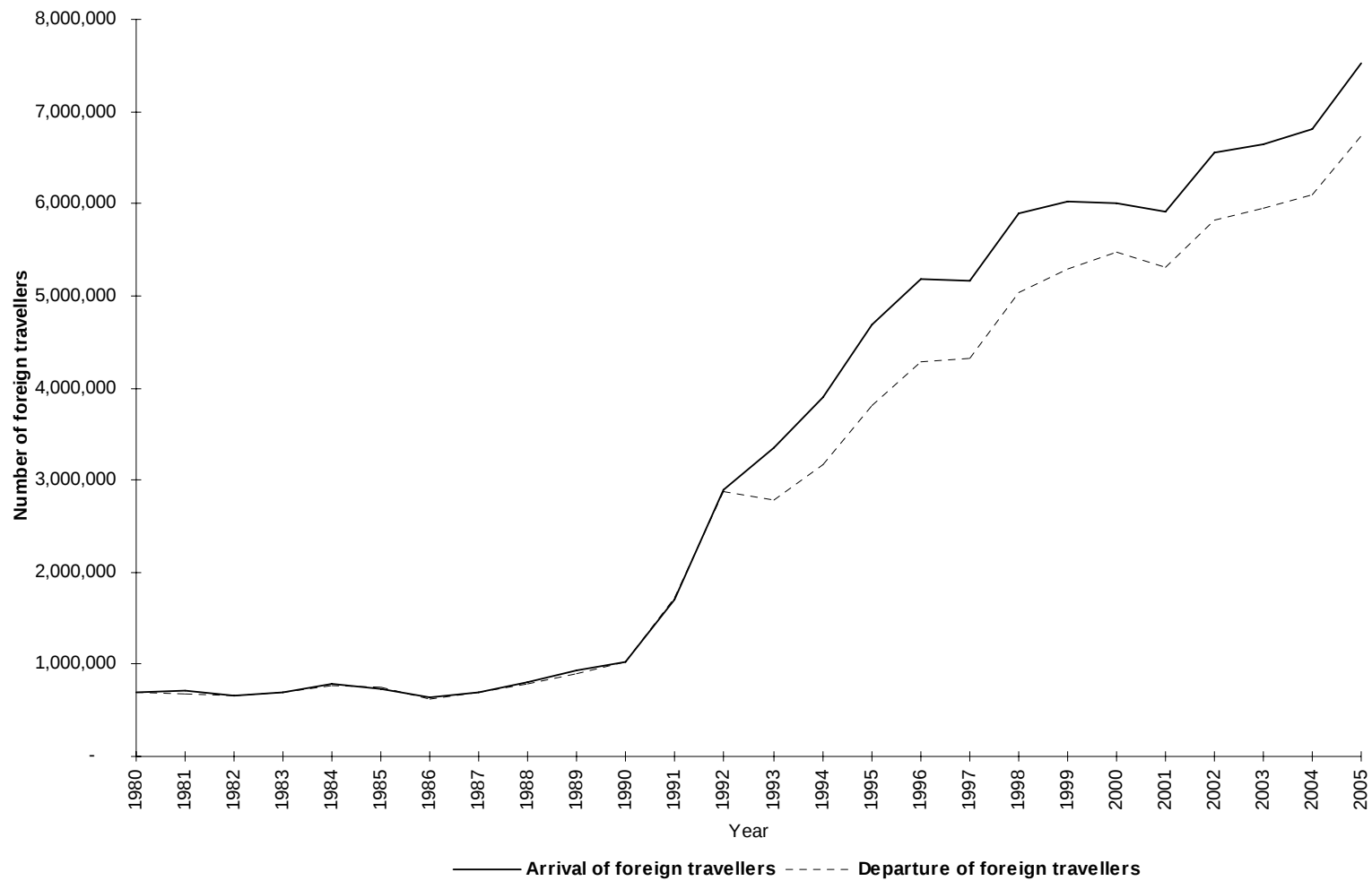
Figure 1: Arrival and departure of foreign travellers, 1980 - 2005

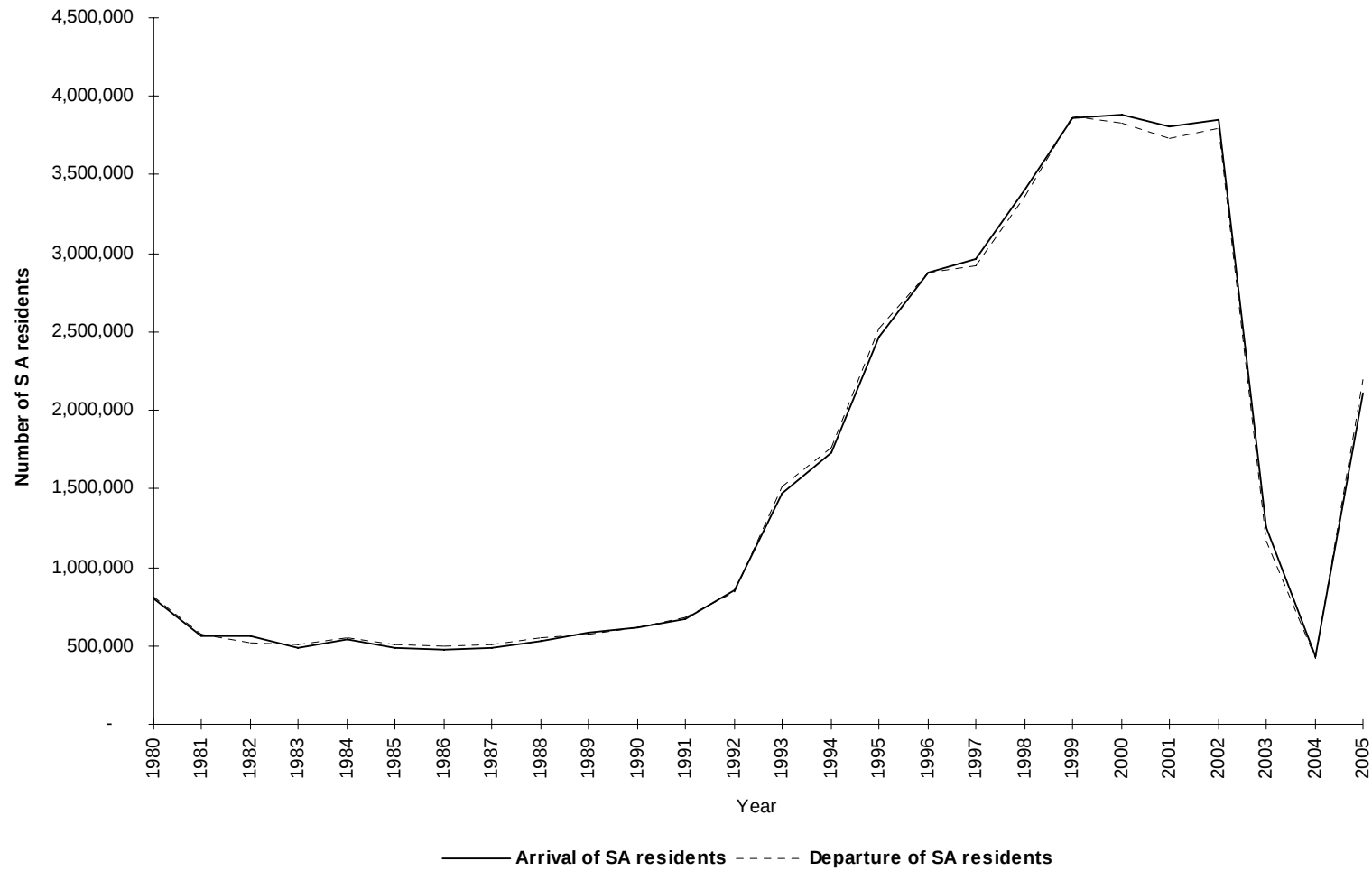
Figure 2: Arrival and departure of South African residents, 1980 - 2005

Figure 3: Arrivals from mainland Africa by country of residence, 2005

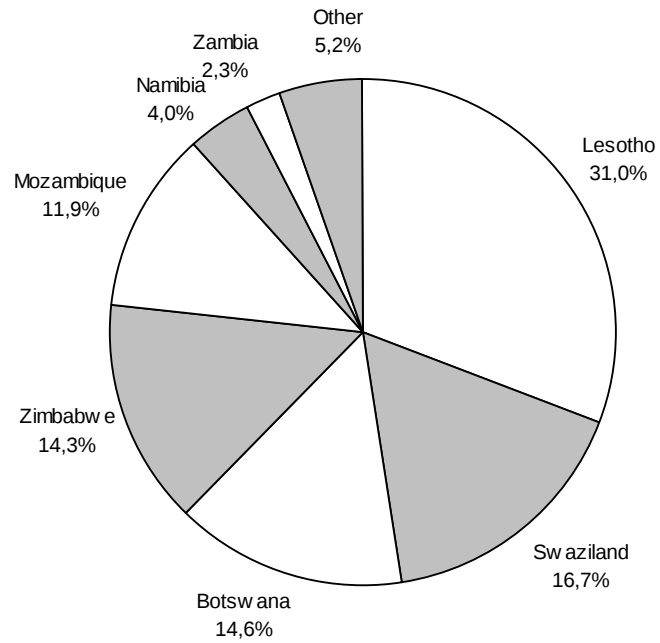


Figure 4: Arrivals from overseas by country of residence, 2005

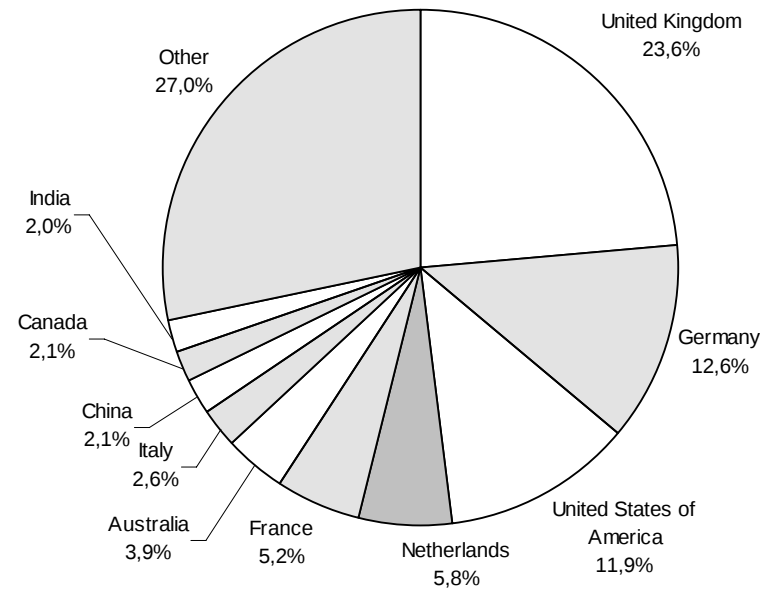


Figure 5: Arrivals from overseas by purpose of visit, 2005

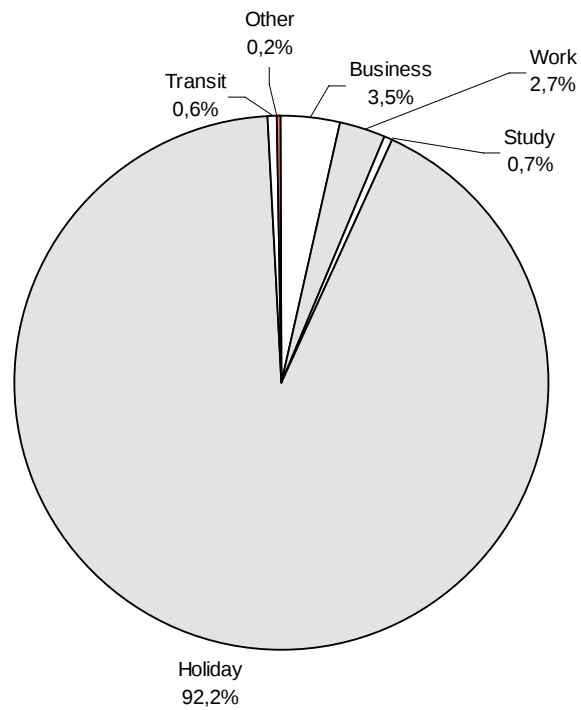


Figure 6: Arrivals from mainland Africa by purpose of visit, 2005

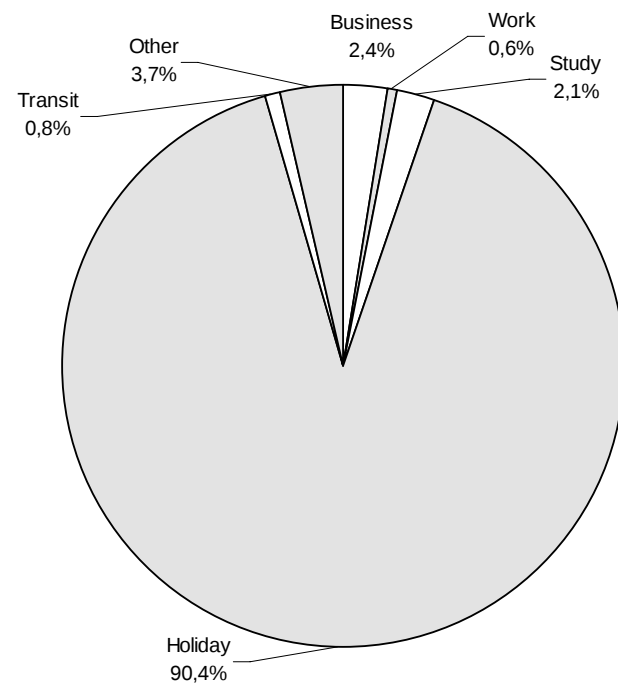


Figure 7: Distribution of arrivals from mainland Africa on holidays, 2005

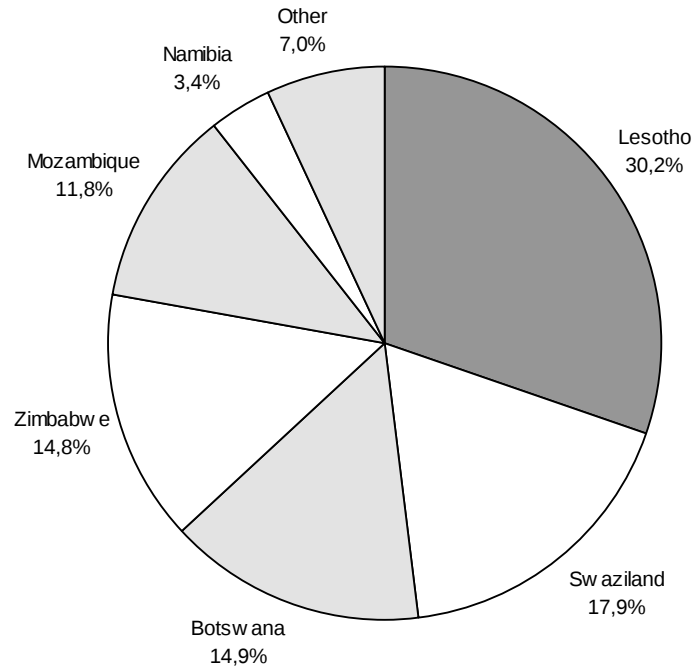


Figure 8: Distribution of arrivals from mainland Africa on business trips, 2005

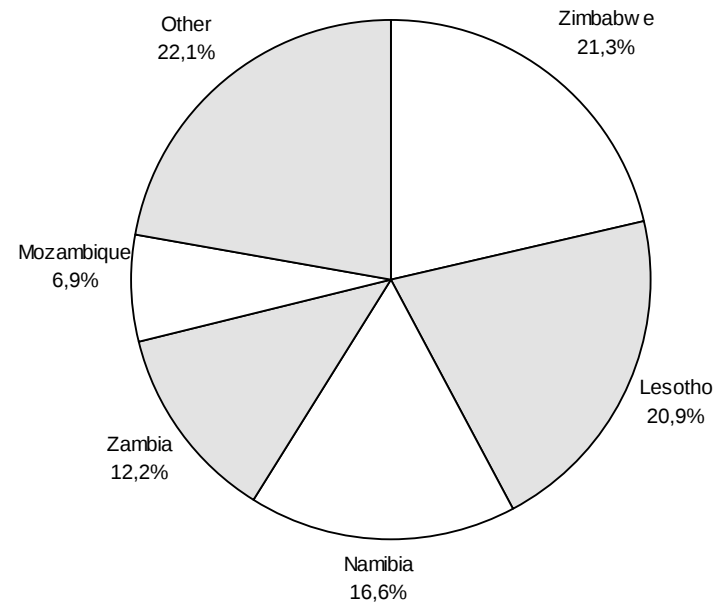


Figure 9: Distribution of arrivals from overseas on holidays, 2005

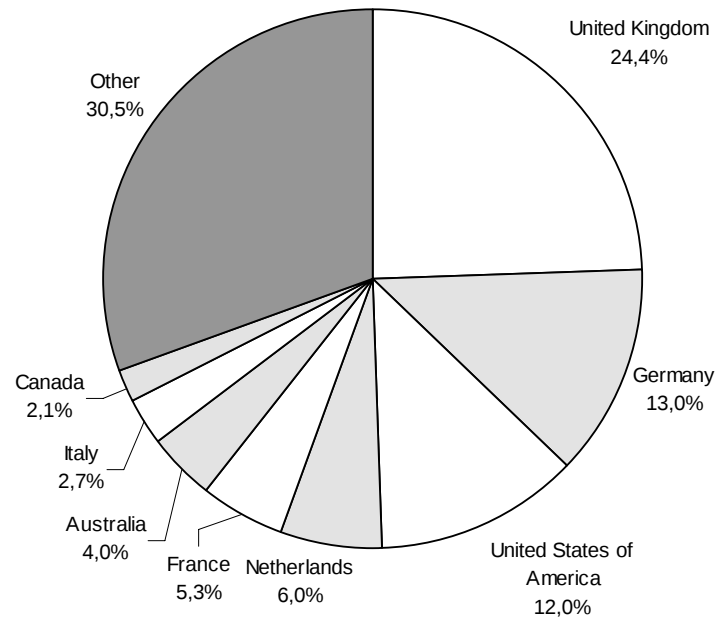
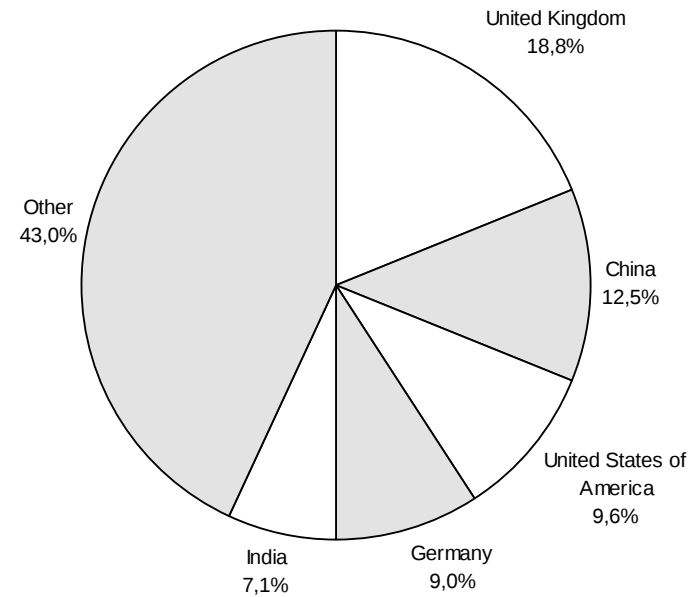


Figure 10: Distribution of arrivals from overseas on business trips, 2005
