KEY FINDINGS

1. Historical trends

For most of the 1980s the trends in the numbers of arrivals and departures of foreign travellers are fairly similar in pattern. Figure 1 shows that prior to 1986, the trend in the number of arrivals and departures remained reasonably steady at around 500 000 per annum. From 1986 to 1990, there was a gradual increase in the number of foreign travellers to South Africa (SA) and between 1990 and 1993, the rise was very steep. After 1993 the pace of increase in arrivals continued, but there was a marked lag between the number of arrivals and the number of departures. The numbers of arrivals and departures declined in 1997 and 2001.

Figure 2 shows the trend in arrivals and departures of SA residents from 1980 to 2006. In general, the volume of departures and arrivals was more or less the same. The sudden drop in the number of arrivals and departures of South African residents in 2003 and 2004 is a reflection of the impact of the new Immigration Act (Section 9 of Act 13 of 2002) that did not require the recording of the international movements of South African residents. The increases in 2005 and 2006 show the effect of the amendment to section 9 (Section 10 of Act 19 of 2004) that resulted in the resumption of the recording of the international movements of South African residents.

2. Foreign travellers to SA in 2006

2.1 Summary of totals

Table 2.1.1 indicates that during 2006, the number of foreign travellers to South Africa was 8 508 806, an increase of 13,2% compared to the 2005 volume of 7 518 320. The highest number of foreign arrivals was recorded in the summer month of December while the lowest number of foreign arrivals was recorded in the winter month of June.

During 2006, 2 160 781 overseas travellers visited South Africa. The 2006 figure represents an increase of 7,3% over the 2005 figure of 2 012 885. From mainland Africa, the number of travellers visiting South Africa was 6 308 636. This figure represents a 15,3% increase compared with the 2005 figure of 5 469 653 (see Table 2.1.3).

2.2 Mode of travel and ports of entry and departure

Table 2.1.2 indicates that during 2006, as many as 5 961 451 (70,1%) foreign travellers arrived in South Africa by road, followed by air arrivals of 2 317 826 (27,2%). In addition, 1 731 (0,02%) arrived by rail and 6 714 (0,1%) by sea. Of the total number of foreign travellers arriving by air, 1 799 325 (77,6%) came through Johannesburg International Airport (currently known as OR Tambo International Airport); 501 603 (21,6%) arrived through Cape Town International Airport; 5 272 (0,2%) came through Durban International Airport and 11 626 (0,5%) through other airports.

Table 2.1.4 indicates that there were 1 885 012 air arrivals from overseas in 2006 which account for 87,2% of all overseas arrivals. The number of overseas travellers arriving by road was 260 125 (12,0%) and the number arriving by sea, rail and unspecified mode of travel was 15 644 (0,8%). The total number of travellers who arrived by road during 2006 from mainland Africa was 5 690 856 (90,2%). The number arriving by air was 422 001 (6,7%) and those arriving by sea, rail or unspecified mode of travel was 195 779 (3,1%).

Table 3.1.1 indicates that road transport, 5 270 845 (70,3%), was the most common mode of travel used by foreign travellers departing South Africa. This was followed by air travel, 2 167 810 (28,9%). Of the total number of foreign travellers departing by air, 1 670 941 (77,1%) left through Johannesburg International Airport; 480 688 (22,2%) departed through Cape Town International Airport; 4 512 (0,2%) through Durban International Airport and 11 669 (0,5%) through other airports.

2.3 Country of residence

Figure 3 shows the distribution of foreign travellers from mainland Africa by leading source countries. These countries were: Lesotho, 1 919 889 (30,4%); Swaziland, 993 030 (15,7%); Botswana, 765 705 (12,1%); Zimbabwe, 989 614 (15,7%); Mozambique, 926 496 (14,7%); Namibia, 225 020 (3,6%) and Zambia, 160 984, (2,6%).

When comparing arrival figures from mainland Africa for 2005 and 2006, there were increases in the number of travellers arriving from the following countries: Mozambique, (42,9% up from 648 288 in 2005); Zimbabwe, (26,5 up from 782 547 in 2005); Zambia, (25,4% up from 128 344 in 2005); Lesotho, (13,4% up from 1 693 272 in 2005); Swaziland, (8,9% up from 911 884 in 2005); Namibia, (2,3% up from 220 000 in 2005). However, the number of arrivals from Botswana, (4,1% down from 798 576 in 2005), declined.

As presented in Figure 4, the leading source countries for overseas travellers were: the U.K., 494 955 (22,9%); Germany, 263 225 (12,2%); the USA, 259 674 (12,0%); France, 108 713 (5,0%); the Netherlands, 126 327 (5,8%); Australia, 90 419 (4,2%); Italy, 54 214 (2,5%); Canada, 49 963 (2,3%) and India, 49 674 (2,3%).

When comparing arrival figures from overseas for 2005 and 2006, there were increases in the number of travellers arriving from all the leading countries. India (22,8% up from 40 437 in 2005); Canada, (19,4% up from 41 843); Australia, (15,6% up from 78 235 in 2005); the USA, (8,6% up from 239 036 in 2005); Netherlands (7,5% up from 117 517 in 2005); France, (4,9% up from 103 668 in 2005); Italy, (4,0% up from 52161 in 2005); UK, (0,4% up from 475 916 in 2005) and Germany, (3,8% up from 253 527 in 2005).

2.4 Purpose of visit

Figure 5 shows that, of the overseas travellers visiting South Africa during 2006, 1 980 137 (91,6%) reported that they were in South Africa on holiday, while 82 938 (3,8%); 65 308 (3,0%) and 15 966 (0,7%) had come for business, to work and to study respectively. Similarly, data presented in Figure 6 indicate that 5 866 426 (93,0%) of the travellers from mainland Africa reported that they were in South Africa on holiday, while 113 553 (1,8%); 33 034 (0,5%) and 109 010 (1,7%) had come for business, to work and to study respectively.

Figure 7 indicates that most of the travellers who were here on holidays from mainland Africa came from Lesotho, 1 752 264 (29,9%); followed by Swaziland, 968 567 (16,5%); Zimbabwe, 937 766 (16,0%); Mozambique, 906 656 (15,5%); Botswana, 713 819 (12,2%) and Namibia, 174 305 (3,0%). Furthermore, travellers who came to South Africa for business (see Figure 8) were mainly from Zimbabwe, 24 853 (21,9%); Namibia, 24 027 (21,2%) and Zambia, 20 441 (18,0%). With respect to travellers from overseas, those on holiday (see Figure 9) were mainly from the UK, 466 630 (23,6%), Germany, 247 557 (12,5%) and the USA, 242 521 (12,2%). Travellers who came to South Africa for business were from the UK, 17 426 (21,0%); the USA, 8 264 (10,0%) and Germany, 8 240 (9,9%), as shown in Figure 10.

3. South African residents in 2006

Table 2.2.1 indicates that during 2006, as many as 2 606 614 (60,4%) South African residents arrived in South Africa by road, followed by 1 674 551 (38,8%) air arrivals. A total of 36 310 (0,8%) arrived by sea, rail and unspecified mode of transport. Of the total number of South Africa residents arriving by air, 1 430 087 (85,4%) arrived through OR Tambo International Airport while 202 241 (12,1%) arrived through Cape Town International Airport; 12 181 (0,7%) arrived through Durban International Airport and 30 042 (1,8%) arrived through other airports.

Table 3.2.1 indicates that road, 2 623 570 (60,5%), was the most common mode of travel used by South African residents departing South Africa. This was followed by air travel, 1 692 415 (39,0%). A total of 22 929 (0,5%) left by sea, rail and unspecified mode of transport. Of the total number of residents departing by air, 1 446 535 (77,1%) used Johannesburg International Airport, while 202 312 (22,2%) left through Cape Town International Airport; 13 042 (0,2%) through Durban International Airport and 30 526 (0,5%) through other airports.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

1. Introduction

This annual report contains information on population movements into and out of South Africa for the year 2004. It reports on arrivals and departures of South African and foreign travellers. Travellers include (a) same-day visitors and tourists and (b) other travellers such as migrant workers, business persons and students.

Legal movements across South African borders as well as legal immigration into South Africa fall under the jurisdiction of the Department of Home Affairs (DHA). Statistics South Africa (Stats SA) then processes and publishes this information.

Administrative data sources from the DHA, that is, information from all the country's ports of entry and applications for permanent residence constitute the only comprehensive source of information on foreign arrivals and departures, documented immigrants and emigrants. The information from this source of data provides the best national coverage (in terms of both space and time) of the population movements of South African residents and foreign travellers. The data:

- can be used to estimate, monitor and understand salient characteristics of foreign travellers and volumes of South African residents travelling outside South Africa;
- can, in the absence of information on foreign tourists, be further analysed to provide some indication of international tourism; and
- provide information that can be used to (a) assess the extent of government's progress in strengthening bilateral political and economic relations by assessing the number of international tourist arrivals; and (b) benchmark surveys focusing on demand for local tourism services by foreign travellers.

2. Data

Data routinely collected by immigration officers at all land, air and sea entry ports on all travellers (South African residents and foreign travellers) arriving into or departing from South Africa are captured into the DHA's population Movement Control System (MCS). Generally the data are collected directly from travel documents either by scanning or capturing onto the port's electronic database. Individual ports regularly transmit data onto the national database at the head office of the DHA. Statistics South Africa (Stats SA) downloads the data covering a particular calendar month from the mainframe of the State Information Technology Agency (SITA), where the DHA stores its data.

3. Definitions

3.1 Definitions used by the United Nations World Tourism Organisation (UNWTO)

International traveller refers to any person on a trip between two or more localities in different countries.

Tourism comprises the activities of persons travelling to, and staying in places outside their usual environment, for not more than one consecutive year, for leisure, business and other purposes. The usual environment of a person consists of a certain area around his/her place of residence, plus all other places he/she frequently visits.

Tourist (overnight visitor) is a visitor who stays at least one night in collective or private accommodation in the place.

Traveller refers to any person on a trip between two or more localities (e.g. Countries).

Visitor refers to any person travelling to a place other than that of his/her usual environment for less than 12 consecutive months and whose main purpose of trip is not the exercise of an activity remunerated visited. An international tourist is an international visitor who stays at least one night in collective or private accommodation in the country visited. Domestic tourist refers to a domestic visitor who stays at least one night in collective or private accommodation in the place visited.

2.2 Definitions used specifically in this report

Border traffic concession is granted to a person who crosses the border on a frequent basis. This concession is granted for a maximum of six months after which it can be renewed if necessary. No mode of travel is available for border traffic concessions.

Foreign traveller refers to a person who is not a South African citizen or permanent resident.

South African resident refers to either a South African citizen or a non-South African citizen with a South African permanent residence permit.

Overseas refers to all countries outside mainland Africa

5. Limitations

The main limitation of the published information is its inability to directly measure the volume of tourists. The main aspects of the United Nations World Tourism Organisation's (UNWTO) definition of a tourist are duration of stay and whether individuals are remunerated in the place being visited. Although the intended duration of stay can be inferred from the expiry date of the temporary residence permit, this does not necessarily translate into actual duration of stay. In addition, the data do not provide information on the remuneration status of travellers in South Africa.

The information on the total number of arrivals and departures of South African residents is collected from the scanning of passports. However, data on country of final destination and purpose of visit will be available when the re-introduction of the departure forms is in full operational at the three international airports (OR Tambo, Cape Town and Durban). Processing of available departure forms from the three international airports is currently underway.

6. Related publications

Tourism statistics are also published in the quarterly *Bulletin of Statistics* and in the monthly Statistical Release P0351: *Tourism and Migration*.

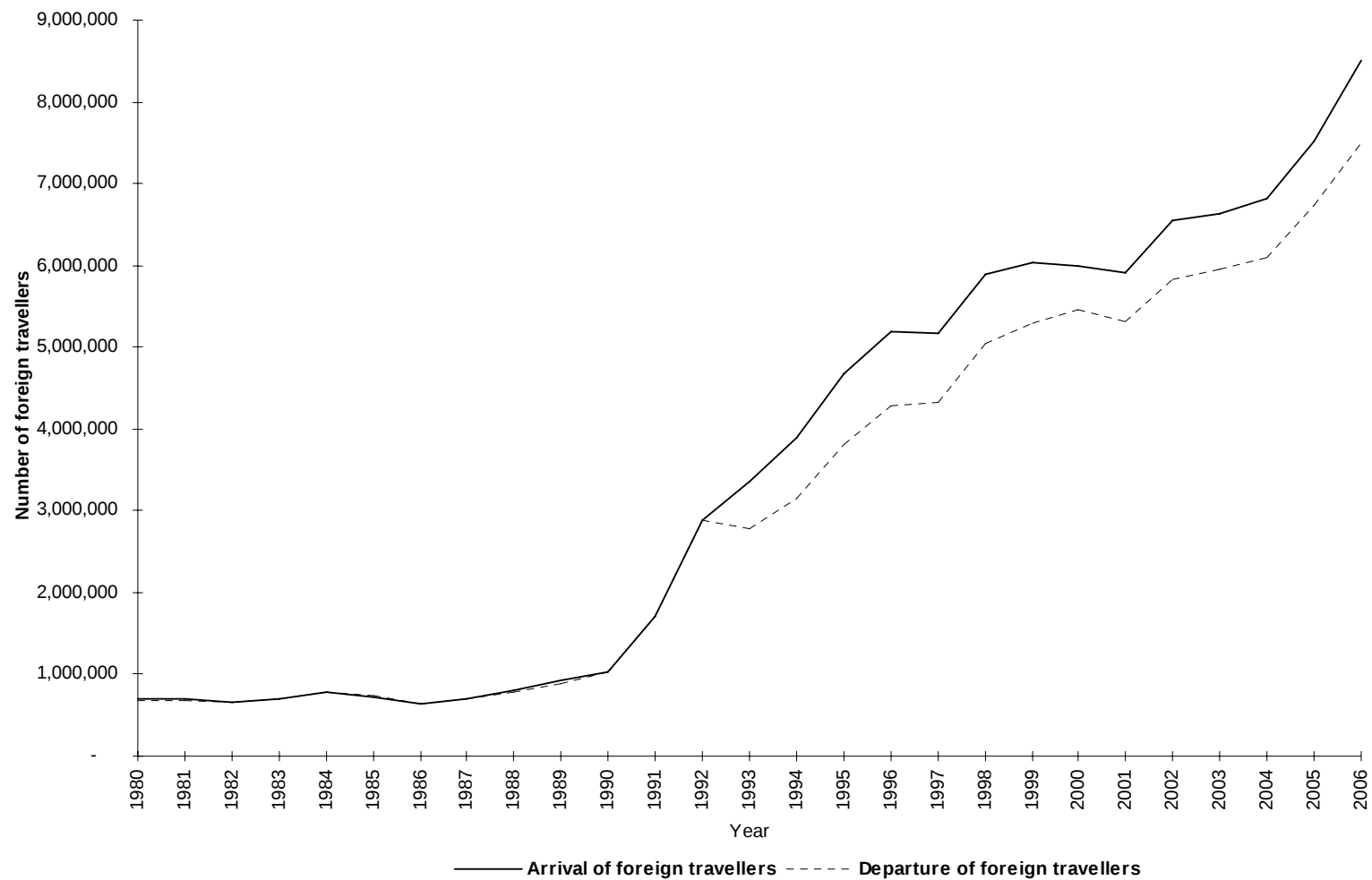
Figure 1: Arrival and departure of foreign travellers, 1980 - 2006

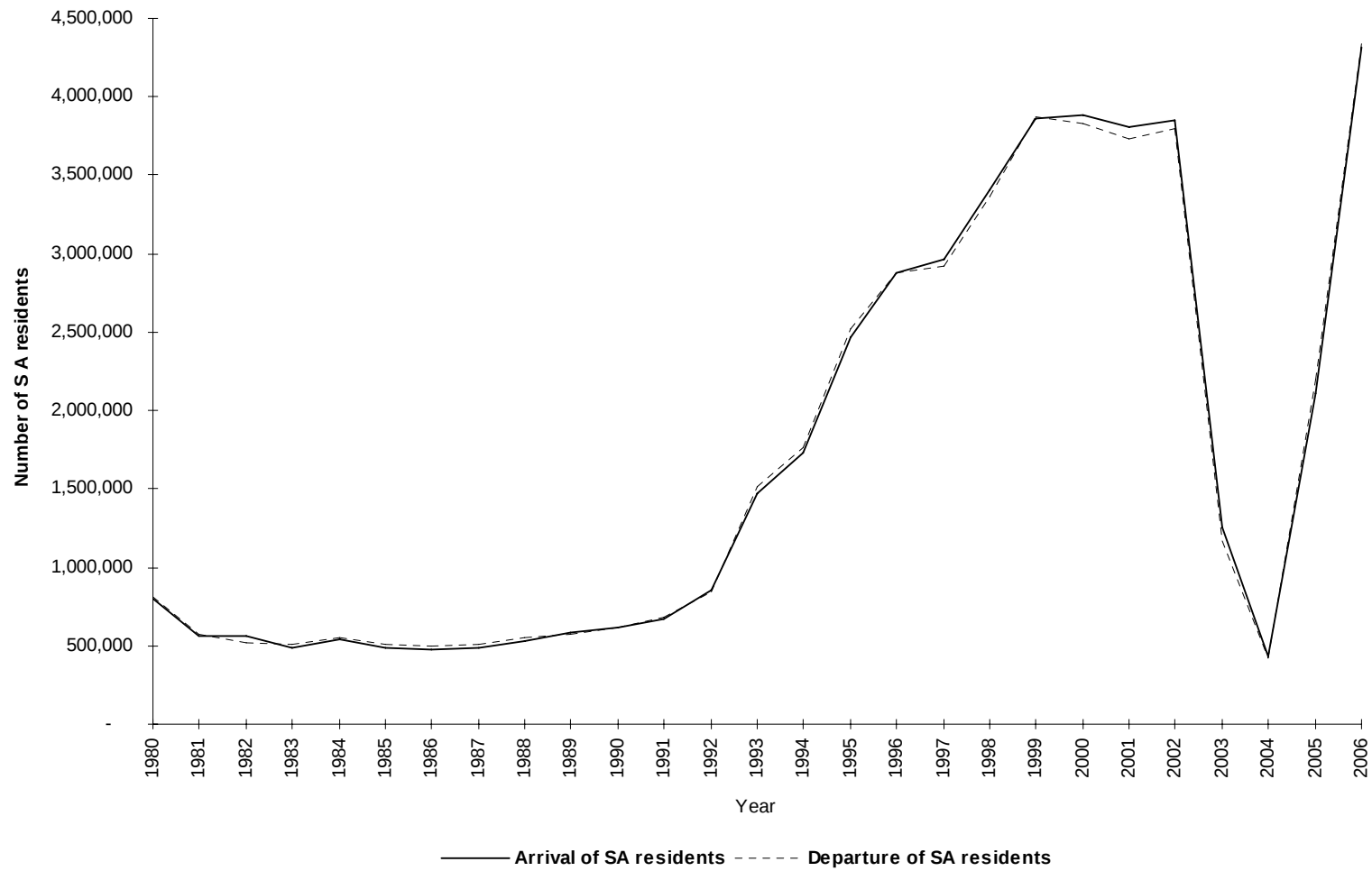
Figure 2: Arrival and departure of South African residents, 1980 - 2006

Figure 3: Arrivals from mainland Africa by country of residence, 2006

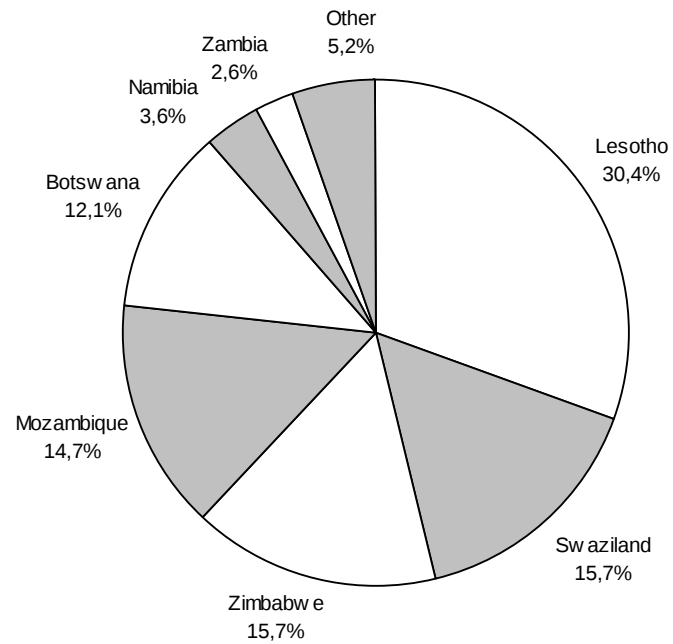


Figure 4: Arrivals from overseas by country of residence, 2006

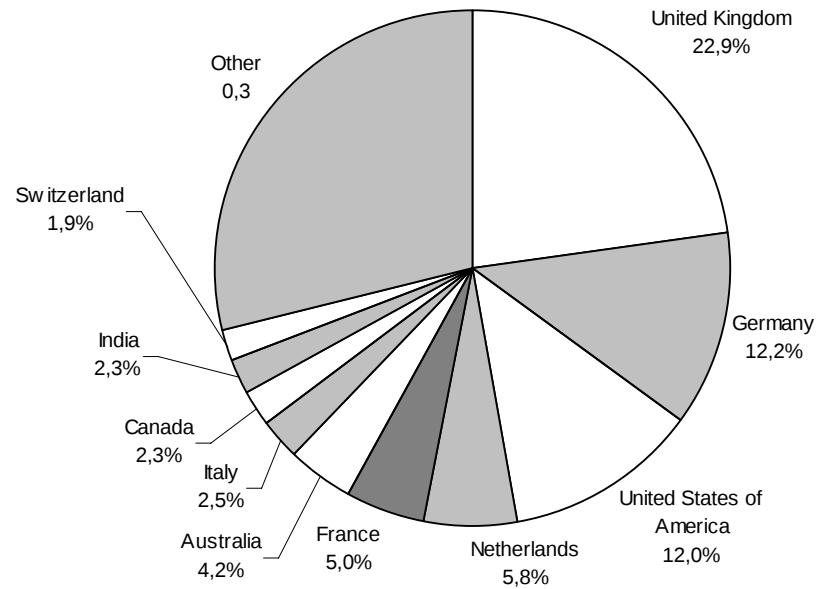


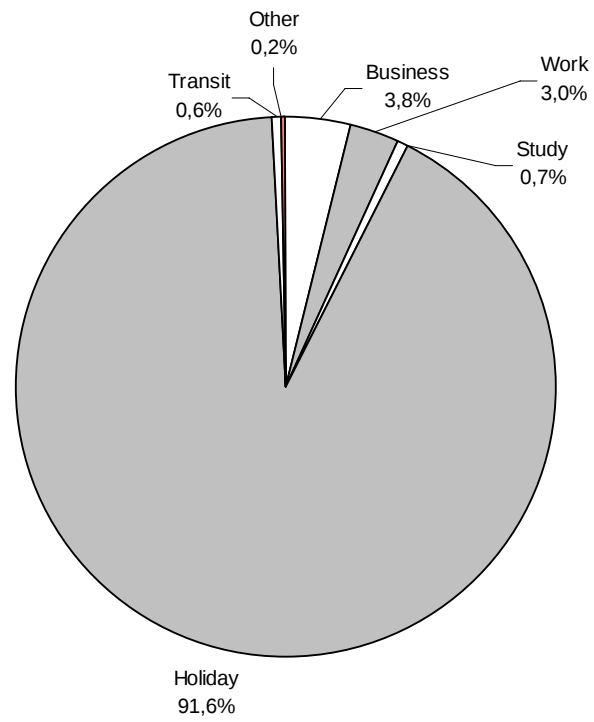
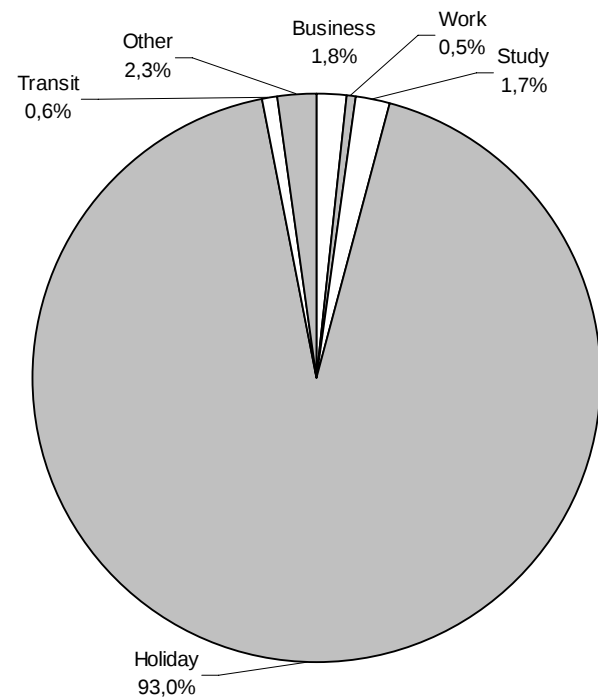
Figure 5: Arrivals from overseas by purpose of visit, 2006**Figure 6: Arrivals from mainland Africa by purpose of visit, 2006**

Figure 7: Distribution of arrivals from mainland Africa on holidays, 2006

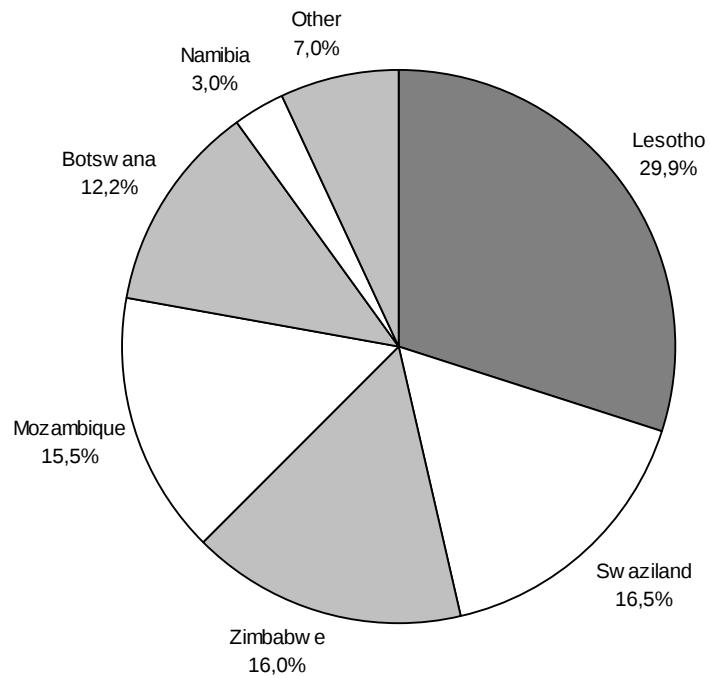


Figure 8: Distribution from mainland Africa on business trips, 2006

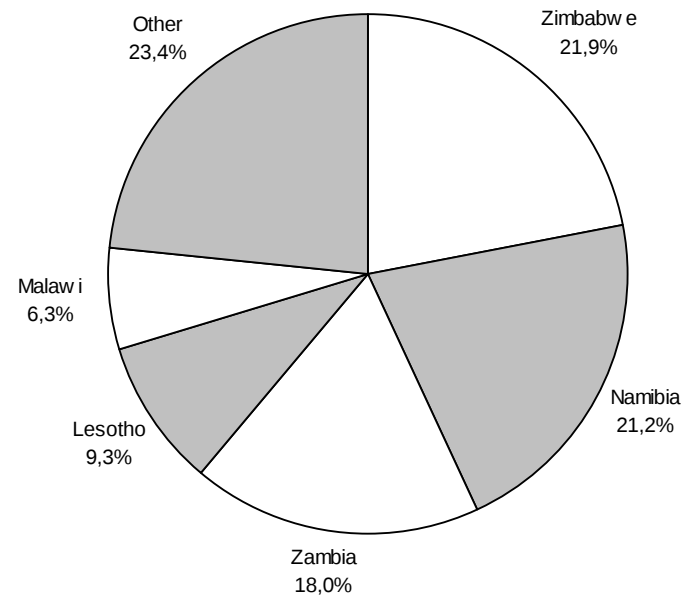


Figure 9: Distribution of arrivals from overseas on holidays, 2006

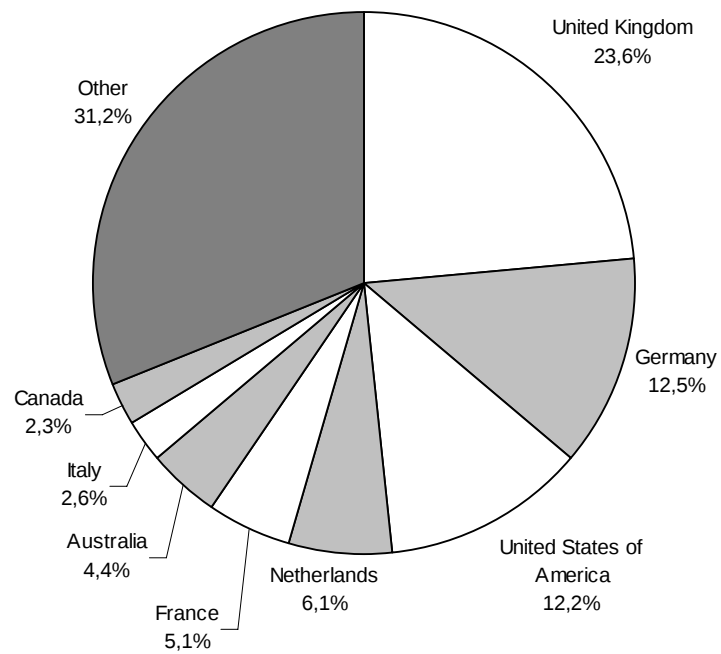
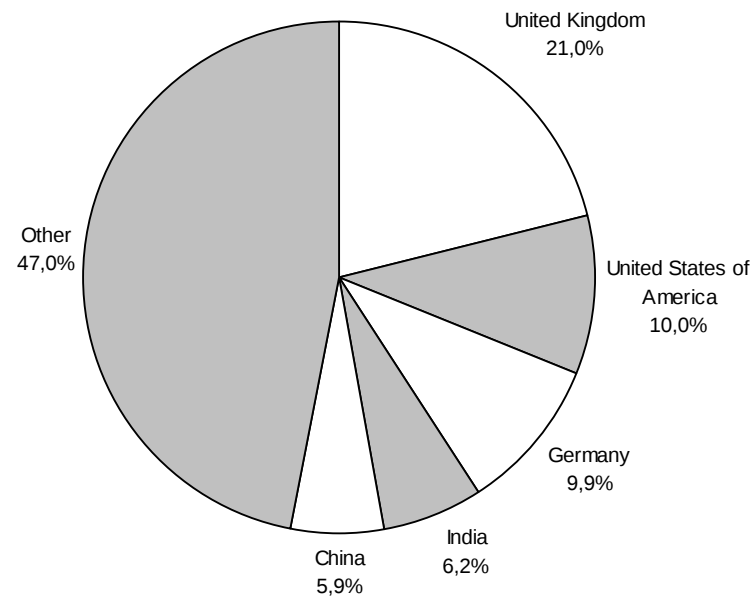


Figure 10: Distribution of arrivals from overseas on business trips, 2006
