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1. Introduction

1.1 Aim and collection unit

This publication presents estimates in respect of the Census of Commercial Agriculture (CoCA), 2017 – North West. The survey aims to provide financial, production, employment and related information for the commercial agriculture industry in South Africa.

The last CoCA was conducted in 2007 (Reports No. 11-02-08 (2007)).

It is important to note that in 2007 the collection unit was a farming enterprise. The collection unit for CoCA 2017 is a farming unit, where a farming unit consists of one or more farms, holdings or pieces of land, whether adjacent or not, operated as a single unit and situated within the same local municipality. In this report, the word farm means farming unit.

1.2 Scope and coverage

CoCA 2017 covers enterprises registered for value added tax (VAT) and which are mainly or primarily engaged in the following activities classified according to the January 1993 edition of the Standard Industrial Classification of all Economic Activities (SIC), Fifth edition.

- Growing of crops, market gardening and horticulture (SIC 111),
- Farming of animals (SIC 112),
- A combination of the above (mixed farming) (SIC 113),
- Agricultural and animal husbandry services, except veterinary activities (SIC 114), and
- Game propagation, including related services (SIC 1151).

1.3 Data items

The following categories of data items were collected: general information, land use, field crops, horticultural crops, animals, employment, income, expenditure and details of purchases.

1.4 Reference period

The questionnaires were completed for the financial year ended on any date between 1 March 2017 and 28 February 2018, according to the usual reporting schedule of the enterprise, with the following exceptions:

- Animals on farms as at 30 September 2018, and
- Employment as at 30 June 2018.

1.5 Current prices

The rand values are at current prices.

1.6 Reliability of data

The following are some of the likely sources of non-sampling errors: frame not up to date, wrong definitions and classification, phrasing of questions, non-response, processing and estimation. Every effort is made to minimise non-sampling errors by updating the frame, careful design of questionnaires, testing them with a sample of respondents, editing reported data and implementing efficient operating procedures. Non-sampling errors occur in both sample surveys and censuses.

1.7 Confidentiality

According to section 17 of the Statistics Act, 1999 (Act No. 6 of 1999), completed questionnaires remain confidential to Statistics South Africa (Stats SA). Individual business information is never disclosed. Results are presented in aggregated form only.

2. Key findings

2.1 Farming units, income, and employment


The total number of farms/ farming units involved in the commercial agriculture industry in 2017 was 4 920. The largest proportion of farms was in mixed farming (1 946 farms or 39,5% of the total), followed by farming of animals (1 594 or 32,4%) and growing of cereals and other crops (1 157 or 23,5%).

The district municipality with the highest number of farms in 2017 was Dr Ruth Segomotsi Mompati (1 442 farms or 29,3% of the provincial total), followed by Ngaka Modiri Molema (1 419 or 28,8%) and Dr Kenneth Kaunda (1 203 or 24,5%).

The total income for the commercial agriculture industry in 2017 was R39,7 billion, which was 298% higher than the R10,0 billion recorded for 2007. In 2017, the major contributor to total income was farming of animals (R21,6 billion or 54,3%), followed by mixed farming (R11,4 billion or 28,7%).


The district municipality contributing the most to total income in 2017 was Dr Kenneth Kaunda (R13,1 billion or 33,1%), followed by Dr Ruth Segomotsi Mompati (R10,2 billion or 25,6%) and Bojanala (R10,0 billion or 25,1%).

The total number of persons employed in commercial agriculture on 30 June 2018 was 57 759, down from 66 096 on 28 February 2007 (-12,6%). In terms of employment, the major commercial agriculture activity in 2017 was farming of animals (21 032 employees or 36,5% of the total), followed by mixed farming (19 652 or 34,0%) and growing of cereals and other crops (10 248 or 17,7%).


Figure 1 - Number of farms, income and employment in the commercial agriculture industry by farm size, as a percentage of total, 2017

In 2017, 235 large farms (those with annual income of more than R22,5 million) constituted 4,8% of the total number of farms in the commercial agriculture industry, and accounted for 67,5% of total income and 44,1% of total employment. This was in contrast to the 2 415 micro farms (annual income below R1 million) which made up 49,1% of the total number of farms, but which accounted for just 2,1% of total income and 7,7% of total employment. Taken together, there were 1 752 large, medium and small farms in 2017, with combined shares of 35,6% of the number of farms, 95,0% of income, and 85,9% of employment.

Measured by farm size, small farming units were the second largest in terms of number of farms, income and employment in 2017.

Farming of animals had the largest share of income (54,3%) and employment (36,5%) as well as the second largest share of number of farms (32,4%) in 2017. Mixed farming had the largest share of number of farms (39,5%) and the second largest share in income (28,7%) and employment (34,0%).

Dr Ruth Segomotsi Mompati district municipality recorded the largest provincial share of the number of farms (29,3%) in 2017, while Dr Kenneth Kaunda had the largest share of income (33,1%) and Bojanala had the largest share on employment (31,5%).

Of the total income of R39,7 billion in the commercial agriculture industry in 2017, R35,9 billion was derived directly from agricultural activities, which is herein referred to as gross farming income. The animals and animal products category was the biggest contributor to gross farming income with 72,3% of the provincial total, followed by field crop products (20,6%). Field crop products accounted for 52,2% of gross farming income in the Ngaka Modiri Molema district municipality, and animals and animal products accounted for 47,2%.

2.2 Land use

On 30 September 2018, the total land used for commercial agriculture in North West was 5,3 million hectares, which represents 50,8% of the total land area of North West (10,5 million hectares). Commercial agricultural land use in North West comprised mainly grazing land (3,5 million hectares) and arable land (1,1 million hectares). Grazing land is used for livestock and game farming, and arable land is used for crop production.

The Dr Ruth Segomotsi Mompati district (41,8%) accounted for the largest share of the North West's commercial agricultural land use, followed by Bojanala (23,6%) and Ngaka Modiri Molema (22,2%).

Regarding grazing land, 88,8% was located in three districts, namely Dr Ruth Segomotsi Mompati (55,7%), Ngaka Modiri Molema (17,8%) and Bojanala (15,3%). Ngaka Modiri Molema (48,5%), Dr Kenneth Kaunda (23,8%) and Dr Ruth Segomotsi Mompati (21,8%) accounted for 94,1% of arable land.

2.3 Field crops

Field crops are important for food security, and they account for the largest portion of cultivated land in South Africa. In terms of area planted, the major field crops in North West in both 2007 and 2017 were maize, sunflower seeds, soya beans and groundnuts (peanuts). The major field crops, with the exception of groundnuts (peanuts), were mostly planted under dry land, i.e. their main source of water was rain. In 2017, sunflower seeds had the highest proportion (99,8% of sunflower seeds) planted under dry land, followed by maize (95,6%) and soya beans (76,1%).

Between 2007 and 2017, maize production increased by 6% (from 1,6 million to 1,7 million tons). This was driven by an increase in the volume of production per hectare from 2,7 to 3,7 tons. Ngaka Modiri Molema district produced 58,9% of maize in the province in 2017, followed by Dr Ruth Segomotsi Mompati and Dr Kenneth Kaunda (each 18,0%).

Sunflower seed production increased by 79% (from 95 thousand to 170 thousand tons) between 2007 and 2017. Two districts accounted for 87,0% of the province's total in 2017, namely Ngaka Modiri Molema (69,6%) and Dr Ruth Segomotsi Mompati (17,4%).

There was strong growth in soya beans between 2007 and 2017, namely 165% (from 12 thousand to 32 thousand tons), due to a large increase in area planted. The leading districts for soya production in 2017 were Ngaka Modiri Molema (42,3% of the province's total), Bojanala (33,0%) and Dr Ruth Segomotsi Mompati (21,4%).

Groundnut production increased by 113% to 36 thousand tons in 2017. Two districts accounted for 91,4% of the province's total in 2017, namely Dr Ruth Segomotsi Mompati (68,1%) and Ngaka Modiri Molema (23,3%).

2.4 Horticultural crops

2.4.1 Vegetables

The major vegetables in terms of production were potatoes, onions, carrots and beetroot. With the exception of potatoes, all major vegetables showed an increase in area planted.

Regarding production, there was an increase of 48% in potatoes (from 80 thousand to 118 thousand tons) between 2007 and 2017. Onions showed an increase of 320% (from 16 thousand to 66 thousand tons) between 2007 and 2017. Increases of 391% in carrots (from 11 thousand to 56 thousand tons) and 473% in beetroot (from 10 thousand to 56 thousand tons) were recorded between 2007 and 2017.

The largest proportion of the province's potatoes in 2017 was produced in the Dr Ruth Segomotsi Mompati district (95,9%). Dr Ruth Segomotsi Mompati and Bojanala produced 96,2% of the province's onions in 2017. Bojanala produced most (91,4%) of the province's carrots in 2017. Over half of beetroot in 2017 was produced in Bojanala (68,0%).

The largest proportions of all major vegetables were sold through fresh produce markets in 2017. This were the largest marketing channel for potatoes (63,6%), onions (80,0%), carrots (74,3%) and beetroot (77,4%).

2.5 Fruits

2.5.1 Citrus fruits

Citrus fruits continue to play an important role in the economy, with strong links to packaging, processing and distribution in the agricultural value chain. Oranges accounted for 497 hectares planted in 2017, down by 62,3% from 2007.

Regarding production, naartjies increased by 16,6% between 2007 and 2017 (from 4,6 thousand to 5,4 thousand tons). Oranges fell by 44,2% (from 33 thousand to 18 thousand tons) and lemons fell by 21,3% (from 3,7 thousand to 2,9 thousand tons); in all three cases, production per hectare increased between 2007 and 2017.

The two leading districts in orange production were Bojanala (81,2% of the province's total) and Dr Ruth Segomotsi Mompati (16,7%) in 2017. Bojanala was also the main producer of lemons and naartjies in 2017.

Most of the 2017 production of oranges (56,1%) and lemons (72,1%) was sold to processing factories. The largest proportion of naartjies (56,5%) was exported in 2017.

2.6 Animals

Cattle, sheep, pigs and chickens are the most reared animals in commercial agriculture in the North West Province.

Between 2007 and 2017, the number of cattle sold decreased by 34,7% (from 687 thousand to 448 thousand). The leading districts in cattle sales in 2017 were Dr Ruth Segomotsi Mompati (51,6% of the province's total) and Ngaka Modiri Molema (37,4%). The number of cattle on farm in the province decreased by 9,3% (from 833 thousand to 756 thousand) between 2007 and 2018.

Compared with 2007, the number of sheep sold in 2017 decreased by 68,3% (from 133 thousand to 42 thousand). Most sheep in 2017 were sold in the Dr Ruth Segomotsi Mompati (38,3%), Ngaka Modiri Molema (37,3%) and Dr Kenneth Kaunda (20,0%) districts. The number of sheep on farm fell by 35,0% (from 173 thousand to 113 thousand) between 2007 and 2018. In 2018, Dr Ruth Segomotsi Mompati district (36,7%), Ngaka Modiri Molema (34,1%) and Dr Kenneth Kaunda (23,5%) had the highest number of sheep on farm.

There was a decrease of 17,4% (from 280 thousand to 231 thousand) in the number of pigs sold between 2007 and 2017. Pigs were sold mainly in Dr Kenneth Kaunda (81,5%) in 2017. Between 2007 and 2018, the number of pigs on farm increased by 0,3%. Dr Kenneth Kaunda (84,9%) had the highest number of pigs on farm in 2018.

The number of chickens sold increased by 29,6% between 2007 and 2017 (from 188 million to 244 million). In 2017, the largest number of chicken sales took place in Bojanala (50,7%), followed by Ngaka Modiri Molema (29,0%) and Dr Kenneth Kaunda (18,3%). Ngaka Modiri Molema (46,4%), Bojanala (30,5%) and Dr Kenneth Kaunda (19,8%) reported the largest number of chickens on farm in 2018.

Explanatory notes

Background

The results presented in this publication have been derived from the Census of Commercial Agriculture (CoCA), 2017 – North West. This publication summarises data on the size, structure and nature of the commercial agriculture industry.

The frame was drawn from Stats SA's business register. The business register is mainly based on the value added tax (VAT) database of the South African Revenue Service (SARS).

The last CoCA was conducted for the year 2007 (Report No. 11-02-07 (2007)).

Value added tax (VAT)

All figures exclude value added tax (VAT).

Reference period

The information was collected from enterprises for their financial year which ended on any date between 01 March 2018 and 28 February 2019.

Statistical unit

The statistical unit is an enterprise. An enterprise is a legal unit (or a combination of legal units) that includes and directly controls all functions necessary to carry out its production activities.

Collection unit

The collection unit is a farming unit. A farming unit consists of one or more farms, holdings or pieces of land, whether adjacent or not, operated as a single unit and situated within the same local municipality. Thus, an enterprise can have one or more farming units.

Classification

The 1993 edition of the Standard Industrial Classification of all Economic Activities (SIC), Fifth Edition, Report No. 09-09-02, was used to classify the statistical units in this census. The SIC is based on the third revision of the 1990 International Standard Industrial Classification of all Economic Activities (ISIC), with suitable adaptations for local conditions. Farming sectors included were classified to the five-digit (subgroup) level for the detailed results.

Size groups

The enterprises are divided into four size groups according to the value of turnover recorded for them on the Stats SA business register. Table H presents the cut-off points for size groups.

Survey methodology and design

Initially, telephones were used to contact enterprises and update their information on the frame in terms of specific agriculture activity and location. Enterprises were given an option of either self-enumeration or a visit by a Stats SA official. CAPI (Computer Assisted Personal Interview), on both tablet and desktop, was used to conduct the interview and/or capture the data.

Collection rate

Collection rate = ((collected enterprises + finalised investigations) / sample size) * 100. The collection rate was 76,9%.

Turnover collection rate	Turnover collection rate = ((collected enterprises BR turnover + finalised investigations BR turnover) / population BR turnover) * 100. The turnover collection rate was 88,9%.
Rewvisions to 2007 results	Rewvisions were made to previous results due to new information obtained after publication.

Glossary

Dry land	Main source of water was rain.

Exports	Outward flow of goods and services leaving the economic territory of a country to the outside world.
Farmer	A farmer is the individual, partnership, close corporation, company, or other enterprise that operates a farming unit for their own account; or the manager, foreman or other person to whom the control of the farming unit was entrusted.
Farm operator/ manager	This is the person who exercises management control over the agricultural holding operation and takes major decisions regarding the use of resources.
Farming unit	A farming unit consists of one or more farms, holdings or pieces of land, whether adjacent or not, operated as a single unit and situated within the same local municipality.
Field crops	Includes grains, oil seeds, legumes, fodder crops and other field crops (e.g. cotton, sugarcane and tobacco).
Fodder crops	Includes grass, lucerne and maize for silage.
Game	Includes elephant, buffalo, rhino, springbok, impala, wildebeest, kudu, zebra, lion, leopard and cheetah.
Grains	Includes maize (white & yellow), wheat, sorghum, barley, oats and rye.
Gross farming income	Includes income earned from agricultural products sold, but excludes other income generated outside farming.
