The survey

When was it conducted?

- Questionnaires were completed for the financial year ended on any date between 1 July 2020 and 30 June 2021
- Employment figures are for 30 June 2021
- The survey was also conducted in 2005, 2008, 2011, 2014 and 2017

What did it measure?

Activity in the industry, in terms of

- Manufactured products
- Finances
- **Employment**
- ICT usage
- Provincial and district level information

The survey

Why was it conducted?

- **General objective:** To collect financial and quantitative information that is essential for planning and policy formulation
- For external users of Stats SA data: To generate information on the size, structure and nature of the industry
- **For internal use:** Mainly used for benchmarking the gross domestic product (GDP) and its components. Also used in the compilation of the Producer Price Index (PPI)

Factors and limitations to keep in mind

- Some enterprises were affected by the COVID-19 lockdown
- The survey does not include enterprises engaged in manufacturing as a secondary activity

The survey

Who was included?

The survey was a large sample survey. It covered about 11400 enterprises that were registered for value-added tax (VAT), engaged in the manufacturing of:

- Food products and beverages
- Textiles, clothing, leather and footwear
- Wood and wood products, paper, publishing and printing
- Coke, petroleum, chemical products, rubber and plastic
- Glass and other non-metallic mineral products
- Basic metals, metal products, machinery and equipment
- Electrical machinery and equipment
- Telecommunication and professional equipment
- Transport equipment
- Furniture and other manufacturing (including tobacco and recycling)

Activities of South African-based companies in other countries were excluded








The manufacturing industry accounted for 13,2% of economic activity in 2021












Total income generated by the industry has grown over time (R trillion)



'Petroleum & chemicals' and 'food & beverages' generated almost half of total income in 2021



Petroleum & chemicals dominated in 2014, accounting for a third of total income





Percentage contribution to the national total of sales of goods & services (R2,3 trillion)





Top ten districts by sales of goods & services. Ekurhuleni overtook Joburg for the #1 spot in 2021



Despite a rise in total income, overall profit for the manufacturing industry has declined


Profit margin for the whole industry

Telecommunication, medical & optical manufacturers recorded the highest profit margin in 2021








In 2021, SMMEs* accounted for **24%** of income and **58%** of employment in the manufacturing industry





Number of manufacturing jobs by year (in millions)












In 2021, women occupied 65% of jobs in textiles & clothing



Percentage contribution to the national total (1,092 million)








Diesel fuel generated the most income in 2017 and 2021 (top 10 manufactured products)











Where are salaries & wages concentrated in each province?


Percentage breakdown of salaries & wages in each province by district, 2021 Northern Cape does not appear here as the data were only published for the province as a whole










Overview

- Manufacturing's contribution to total economic activity has eroded over the years
- Despite a rise in total manufacturing income, overall profit has declined
- The industry has also lost jobs, with the workforce size declining since 2005
- Textiles & clothing manufacturers were hardest hit by job losses
- Gauteng is the manufacturing hub of the country, accounting for 43% of the manufacturing workforce and 42% of sales of goods & services
- Manufacturing is mainly concentrated in Johannesburg, Ekurhuleni, Cape Town and eThekwini, with the four cities accounting for 60% of the national manufacturing workforce and just over half of sales of goods & services
- In 2021, the top 10 manufactured products that generated the most income were related to the automotive, beverage and steel sectors
