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The survey

Large sample survey covering approximately 3000 enterprises registered for value-added tax (VAT)

Included activities

- Railway transport
- Other passenger land transport
 - Other scheduled passenger land transport
 - Other non-scheduled passenger land transport
- Freight transport by road
- Transport via pipelines
- Water transport
 - Sea & coastal water transport
 - Inland water transport
- Air transport
- Cargo handling
- Storage & warehousing
- Other supporting transport activities
- Travel agencies & related activities
- Activities of other transport agencies

Excluded activities

- Minibus taxis
- Municipal bus services
- Bus companies that are not registered for VAT
- Rental of private cars/buses without drivers
- Rental of trucks without drivers
- Enterprises for which transport is a secondary or auxiliary activity

- Questionnaires were completed for the financial year ended on any date between 1 July 2022 and 30 June 2023
- Employment figures are for 30 June 2023



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




Transport, storage & communication accounted for 7,9% of economic activity in 2023
















Contribution to value added remains below pre-pandemic levels

















Financial summary

In 2023, the transport & storage industry generated R717 billion in income, up from R544 billion in 2019





Total income increased by 7,2% per annum in 2023 compared with 2019






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Freight transport by road accounted for **31,5%** of total income in 2023




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Air transport and storage & warehousing recorded a decline in income










The profit margin for the transport & storage industry has declined since 2013










Railway transport recorded a loss in 2023











The largest five enterprises contributed 17,3% of total income in 2023, down from 22,5% in 2019












Transport & storage is more concentrated than manufacturing

The percentage of income in each industry generated by the five largest firms










Motor vehicles, locomotives & other transport equipment accounted for 45,5% of capital expenditure

Capital expenditure on new assets by type of asset in the transport & storage industry, 2023




- 1 45,5% Motor vehicles, locomotives & other transport equipment











The labour force shrank by 0,6% per annum in 2023 compared with 2019












Which activities gained or lost jobs?










Freight transport by road was the largest employer in 2023










Women occupied 28% of jobs in the transport & storage industry

Employment by type of activity and gender, 2023







Freight transport by road accounted for 31,5% of income and 39,2% of employment






SMMEs accounted for 26,1% of income and 37,5% of employment




















Breakdown of income from services rendered: Railway transport activities










Breakdown of income from services rendered: Road freight transport activities










Breakdown of income from services rendered: Pipeline transport activities










Breakdown of income from services rendered: Air transport










Breakdown of income from services rendered: Supporting and auxiliary transport activities










The rail transport of mineral products recorded the most significant rise in the 2019–2023 period








Rail transport of containerized goods recorded the most significant decline in the 2019–2023 period













Gauteng, KwaZulu-Natal and Western Cape are the most influential provinces
