Introduction

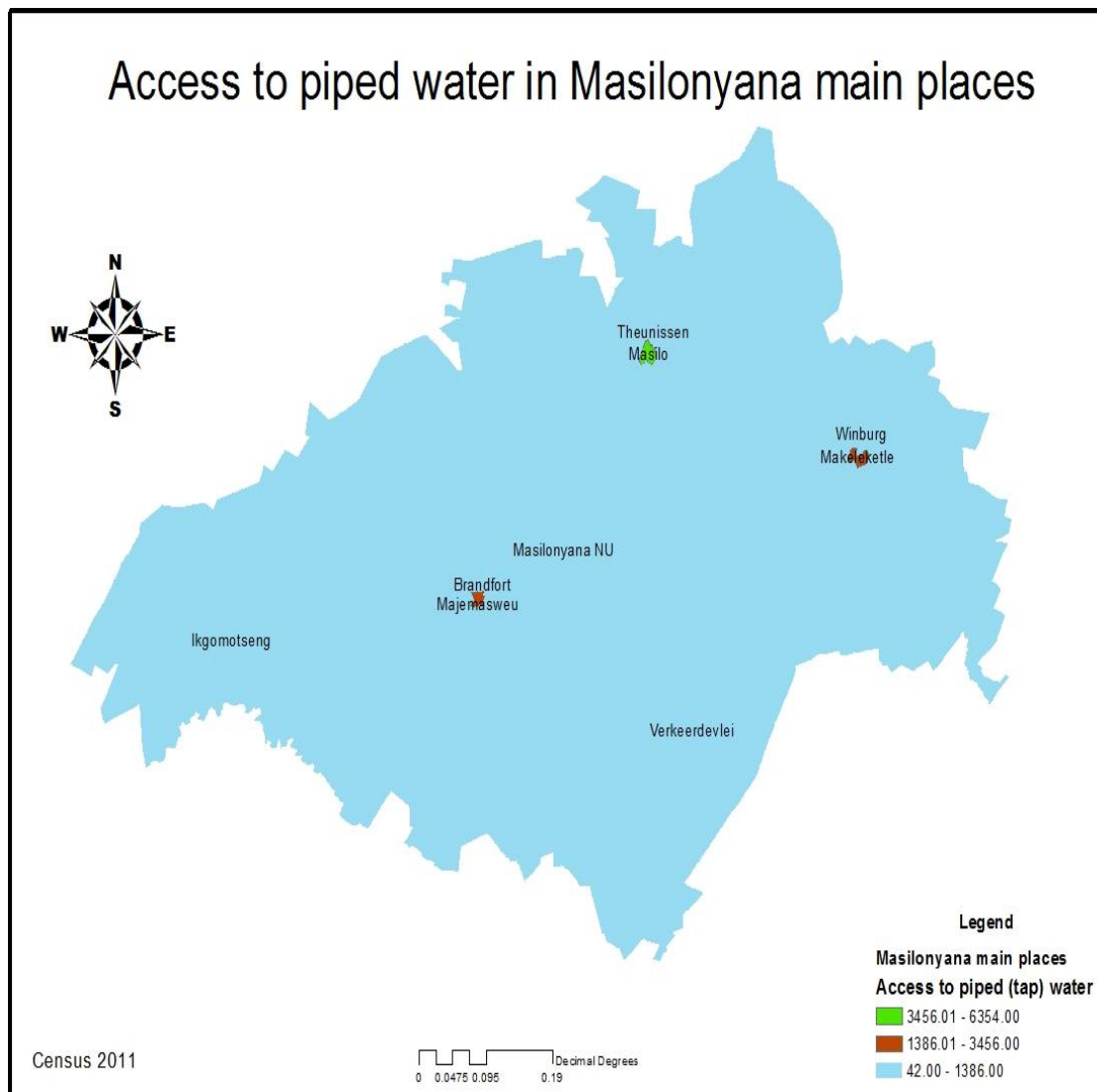
Census 2011 data was used to determine the living condition in Masilonyana local municipality

Background

Masilonyana is a local municipality in Free state province with a population of 63 333 and 17 577 households. Majority of households (91.86%) 16 146 live in urban settlements, while (8.11%) 1 425 in farm areas.

According to census 2011:

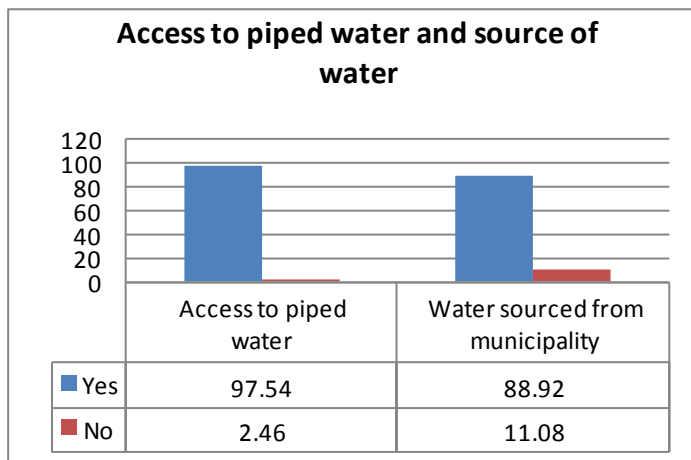


Figure 2 above indicates that (97.54%) 17 145 of households have access to piped water and (2.44%) 429 have no access to piped water. Majority of households (88.92%) 15 630 receive water from the regional/local water scheme (operated by municipality or other water services provider), while (11.06%) 1 944 of the households receive water from other water source. The number of households which are 12 145 indicated that the water supply is reliable, whilst 3 485 of households said it was not reliable.

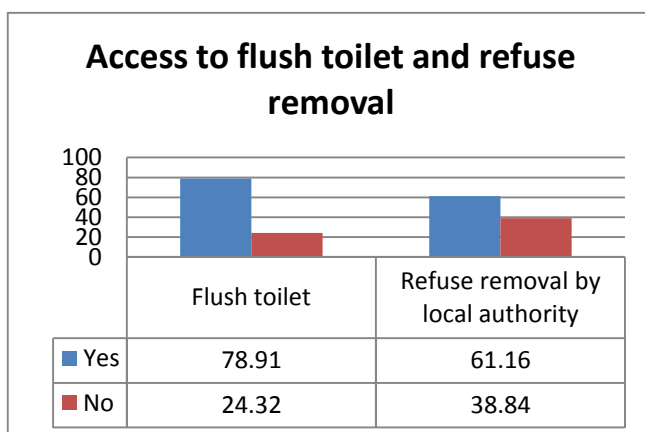


Figure 2 illustrates that (73.55%) 12 399 of the households have access to flush toilet connected to sewerage system and (5.36%) 903 use flush toilet with septic tank. While (24.32%) 4 274 of households use other type of toilet facilities. Majority of households (61.16%) 10 748 have their refuse removed by the municipality, while (38.84%) 6 826 use other methods of refuse disposal.

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Figure 2: Access to piped water and source of water

Figure 3: Access to flushing toilet and refuse removal

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Conclusion

From the data gather we can conclude that majority of households in Masilonyana has access to piped water and are using flush toilets as a facilities. Refuse disposal in the area is removed by local authority.

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Introduction

According to census 2011 Brandford is a main place that falls under Masilonyana local municipality.

Background

Brandford has the total population of 31 314, in which there are 891 households

Figure 1: Access to piped water and source of water

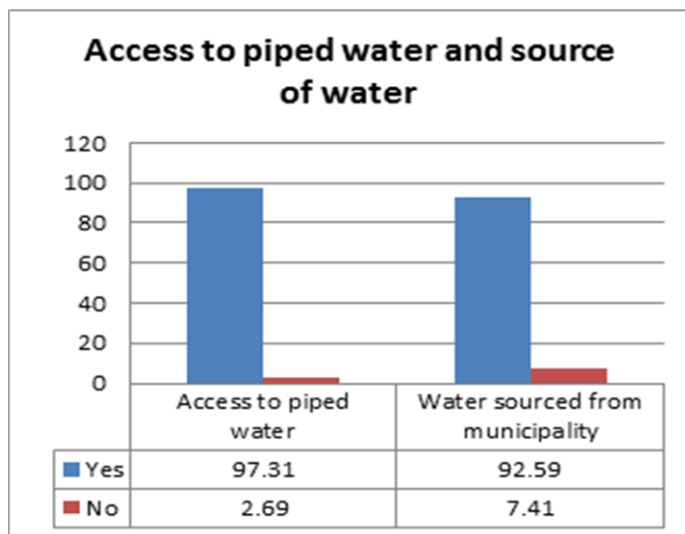


Figure 1 indicates that majority of households(97.31%) 867 have access to piped water. , while (2.69%) 24 have no access to piped water.The local municipality provides water to (92.59%) 825 of the households,while (7.41%) 66 of the households get water from other water sorces.

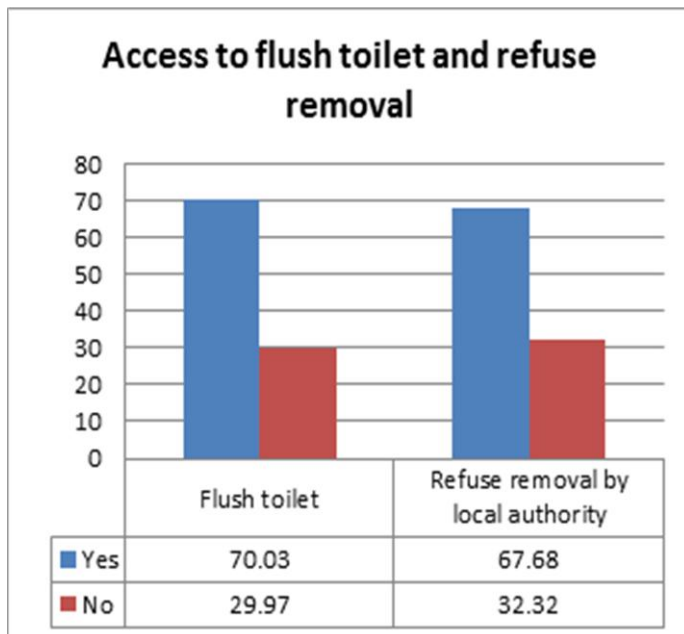


Figure 2 demonstrates that (69.7%) 621 of households have access to flush toilets connected to sewerage, while (0.34%) 3 have access to flush toilets with septic. Households that have no access to toilet facility are (2.36%) 21 and (27.95) 249 use other toilet facility. Majority of households' refuse is removed by local authority/private company amounts to (67.68%) 603, while (32.32%) 288 household's refuse is removed by other refuse removal.

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Figure 2: Access to flush toilet and refuse removal

Conclusion

Majority of households in Brandford have access to piped water and flushing toilets. The refuse removal in the area is provided by the local authority.

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
