

Education inflation the lowest in 30 years


Education inflation recorded its lowest annual rate in three decades, according to the latest consumer inflation data.

Stats SA surveys educational institutions and crèches once a year in March. Education fees increased by 4,1% in 2021. Last year's rise was 6,4%. Historical data shows that this is the lowest increase since at least 1991.

Schools were a contributing factor to the slower rise in education fees in 2021. Concerned about what impact higher costs would have on families during the COVID-19 pandemic, many schools implemented marginal increases to the fees that they charge.

Primary and secondary school fees increased by 2,5% and 4,3% respectively in 2021 (compared with 7,3% and 7,6% recorded in 2020).



Where do your pineapples come from?


Most likely, from Eastern Cape; and most likely, from Ndlambe local municipality.

Eastern Cape was the leading producer of pineapples nationwide in 2017, and the second biggest producer of apples, lemons and oranges.

Ndlambe (which includes Port Alfred) was the top producer of pineapples, responsible for over 60% of the country's total crop!

Other areas where pineapple farming occurs include Buffalo City (Eastern Cape), Makana (Eastern Cape), uMkhanyakude (KwaZulu-Natal) and Makhado (Limpopo).




