Inflation eases for a second consecutive month


Annual consumer price inflation pulled back in December, easing to 5,1% from 5,5% in November and 5.9% in October.

The December release concludes the results for 2023. The average inflation rate for the year was 6,0%, lower than 2022's 6,9%. Inflation was relatively hot in the first five months of 2023 (January–May), with the headline rate consistently above 6,0%. Inflation eased below this level for the remaining seven months of the year.

The highest reading in 2023 was 7,1% in March. The lowest was 4,7%, recorded in July.

Product categories ending the year with annual rates higher than 6.0% in December were food & non-alcoholic beverages (8.5%), restaurants & hotels (7.0%) and health (6.5%).




