Fibre optic broadband soars as ADSL loses out


The most striking change in the telecommunications sector over the period 2019–2022 was a rapid fall of ADSL and the rise of fibre optic broadband. In 2019, ADSL was the largest generator of income in the internet access services category, falling to third place in 2022.

Fibre optic broadband expanded to fill the gap, increasing by more than three-fold. The rise in fibre optic could be due to several reasons, including increased demand during the pandemic.

Other internet access services increased too, helping to push total income for the category up from R17,3 billion in 2019 to R18,8 billion in 2022.






